



This is a re-interview of 1(d) - known as 1(d)  
This took place at the University of Washington Hospital at 1100 Hours 9/18/75.

Interviewers were: Reporting officer and Detective Deputy Jerry Thompson,  
Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office.....

1(d) was asked as to her knowledge of the attitude towards police officers in general and she said Ted has a very good attitude and is usually praising police departments. 1(d) was then asked Ted's habits towards mixing with groups and she stated he mixes quite well, however, he does not have a lot of close male friends.

She was asked what type of sports he participated in and she stated tennis and hand ball. She stated she did not know of any other particular ones than this.

Liz was asked what contact she has had since September of 1974 with Ted. She stated she has talked with him several times by telephone and in December of 1974 at Christmas time she came to Salt Lake. In January of 1975 he visited her in Seattle between quarters and in August of 1975 she again visited him in Salt Lake City. She stated while she was visiting with him in December in Salt Lake she learned Ted was smoking a lot of pot with his roommate or an acquaintance that lived across the hall from him by the name of Scott. She stated this was always a problem between them after she learned it and they argued quite considerably about him using marijuana and the effects it could possibly have on him.

1(d) then referred back to the picture which she was shown in the last interview and asked if that girl's name was Gloria Ann or Glory Ann. She was told no it was not. She stated that he had developed a friendship with a girl by the name of Gloria A-n who is a law student at the University of Utah as they worked together on several projects for class.

1(d) was then asked if Ted had ever mentioned to her anything in regards to the missing girls, especially in the Washington area or the Salt Lake area. She stated he has talked to her about the girls in the Washington area, however, he has not talked to her very much. He stated since the time he was arrested in Salt Lake he has talked to his ex landlord in the Seattle area who has been contacted by the Seattle King County Sheriff's Office in regards to a background check on Ted and that his landlord had told him he is being investigated in the possible disappearance of the girls. He stated he had discovered it is not a good thing to be named Ted in the Seattle area.

She stated he had contacted a friend of his by the name of Ann Rule who lives in Seattle and who writes crime stories for magazines and that Ann contacted King County to see what was going on and they told her it was strictly a routine investigation. She stated Ann recontacted Ted and informed him of such.

She was asked if Ted had mentioned anything to her about the type of evidence the police had in regards to the disappearances and slayings of the girls and she stated he had not.

1(d) was then asked if she had ever known Ted's car to be any other color than the beige color which it presently is. She stated she has not that it was beige when he got it. 1(d) was then asked if Ted has ever mentioned any girls or types of girls which he does not like or any types particularly that he likes and she stated he has not.

1(d) was then asked what her girl friend's name was to which she had referred to previously that she had discussed this situation with. She gave the name as Mary Lynn Chino was lives at 914 West Emerson in Seattle, Washington, phone number 282-8289. When 1(d) was asked if her girl friend Mary Lynn had any doubts toward Ted she stated Mary Lynn definitely has some doubts.

1(d) was then asked again in reference to a raft which she stated Ted had. She stated he has a four man yellow rubber raft which she had given to him as a graduation present when he graduated from the University of Washington.

1(d) was then asked if Ted had ever mentioned being to Bountiful or knowing anyone in the Bountiful area and she stated he has not.

1(d) was then questioned again in regards to the mustache. She stated it was a brown mustache. It was straight and quite sparse brush type and just came to the corner of the lips and did not droop at all.

In reference back to the night of 9/16/75 when 1(d) had talked with Ted she stated that he had lied to her about being arrested. But when she told him she knew that he had been arrested he stated he had been arrested for speeding. She then informed him that she knew why he had been arrested and he became quite upset at her knowing. He then stated that after they had stopped him they had gone through his car looking for anything and everything to bust him on and he was surprised they had not taken the fire extinguisher out of his car and try to charge him with arson also.

At the time 1(d) talked to him she did not know anything about the handcuffs and therefore did not ask him anything about it. Also, she stated that her car had been stolen for a few days in the summer of 1973 and was gone for two or three days and when the car was returned the oriental type knife in the wood sheath was missing at that time. She stated that Ted did drive her car occasionally.

1(d) was then asked if Ted had ever been to California. She stated Ted had been to the San Francisco area in the spring of 1973 for a few days on business. She did not know anything more about his visit there.

1(d) then stated one thing that struck her funny that she had talked with Ted in June and he was talking about hearing one report on the radio in regards to several rapes which had occurred on 1st Avenue in Salt Lake which is near the area he lives. The description of the guy involved was a guy with a beard and he stated to her I guess that lets me out. He stated that he thought a possible suspect was an individual that lives in a house for mentally retarded people around the corner from him which would be on "F" Street and that right after this description came out this individual shaved his beard and head. 1(d) he stated, isn't that kind of funny. 1(d) stated that she told him not any funnier than a guy that is growing a beard. She stated Ted grew a beard in June of 1975.

1(d) then referred to a question that had been asked in an earlier interview in regards to two separate Teds or schizophrenic personality. She stated that in thinking back Ted is very jealous of her. He follows her when she goes to various places or meetings to see who she is with or what she is doing. She stated he takes naps and sleeps a lot during the day and is out a lot late at night. She stated he used to sneak up on her when she was walking alone at night when she had no idea he was around and suddenly jump out of the bushes and grab her scaring the hell out of her.

She stated that this really made her angry. 1(d) referred back to the girls which were missing from the Seattle area stating that the only one she could really pin-point was one on July 14, 1974 which turned up missing shortly after she started becoming suspicious of Ted.

She stated on Saturday night they had been out and had argued. Q: Has he ever mentioned the name or the town of Bountiful, Utah?

A: Uh uh.

Q: Okay, going back to that mustache you said he had, what color was that, do you recall?

A: Brown.

Q: It was brown?

A: Um hum.

Q: Was it, I know you said the other day it looked more like a brush or something, do you know, what it one that come to the end of the lips or a little one inside?

A: It just ended squared off

Q: At the lips, the end of the lips?

A: Yeah, it didn't come down like,

Q: It didn't droop down but it came to the

A: Yeah, it was like straight, it was not (?) at all, like a straight mustache.

Q: Now, going back to that sack of clothes you told me that you thought was clothes that, that there was a bra on the top, do you have an idea when this was, 73, 74, or

A: Yeah, it was the Fall of 73.

Q: It was 73? That was before the girls in Seattle came up missing? Okay.

Has he ever been in California?

A: Yeah.

Q: Do you know when?

A: Yeah, he was there in 73, he went to San Francisco...

Q: Do you know how long he lived down there or just vacation?

A: Oh no, it was just a few days.

Q: He was just down there a few days. Any other time you know that he was down there?



A: Not since I've known him,...the summer before I met him.

Q: That was in the summer of 73, do you think?

A: Which.

Q: That he was in San Francisco?

A: Oh, yeah, no, I think it was in the spring.

Q: Spring of 73? And you met him when, 6 years ago, didn't you say?

A: Yeah.

Q: He was down there in 73?

A: Um hum.

Q: A week or two or a day?

A: No, just about four days.

Q: Okay. What did you want to ask me?

A: Um, what you write everything down for...

Q: Well that's, like I say, I'm a, my memory isn't the greatest in town either.

A: Okay. Oh, this is the most important thing, my father used to, um, in June, before he came up here, he told me in great detail about that he'd heard on the news, just one time only, about some rapes on First Avenue, which he lives on, and he says they were all college girls, and aah, he said something like the guy had a beard, so that lets me out, and he says that he thought he had an idea who might have done it... retarded people around the corner from him, and one of the guys that was a (?), he had heard on the news.

Q: He called you and told you about this?

A: Yes.

Q: In June of this year?

A: Yes. So he told me that, I can't remember, if he came up or asked me to come up, he says that he called a detective down there, a woman, who was handling the case, and she contacted him...about this possible suspect. In June he started growing a beard and when he was up here he said that this guy he thought was a possible suspect

had shaved his head, and he said, "Doesn't that seem really odd to you that he would do that right after the news had come <sup>out,</sup> / and I wanted to say no...beard.

Q: And he was growing a beard in June?

A: Um hum.

Q: Last year?

A: Of this year.

Q: Of this year, rather.

A: Um hum...suspicious of this case of rapes?

Q: Now that would have been handled by the Salt Lake City Police, and they did have some rapes in the Avenues last summer, or this summer, I don't know the month and I don't have any details in regards to the suspect, whether he had a beard, I'll have to check that out. There is a woman detective down there that works rapes. Her name is Pat, and that I don't know, but yes they did have what they called an "Avenue Rapist."

A: Oh.

Q: Okay, but I don't have the details on the thing.

What else did you want to ask me, 1(d)

A: Oh, um, he asked me yesterday if I thought there was two separate (?), and I do, <sup>put</sup> like, I couldn't / my finger on it until I was talking to Mary Ann about it, but like he was insanely jealous of me.

Q: Very jealous?

A: Yeah, and it, like um, he went so far as to follow me when I went out sometimes, you know, and I thought, I thought that was odd, and the other thing is that he used to take naps in the day, and so therefore he was wide awake at night and he used to go out walking around a lot late at night. A couple of times when I was walking home from meetings he snuck up on me and scared the hell outta me... He was out a lot late at night and it bothered me.

Q: (Can't hear question)

A: Uh uh.



Q: Were the girls up here in the Seattle area publicized to the point that publicity gave the dates when they turned up missing?

A: Um hum.

Q: Okay, and you being familiar with the dates, you told me the other day that those particular dates, the ones you could remember, he wasn't with you. Do you remember anything about those particular dates, the next day if he got a hold of you, his comments, any way he acted unusual, or did he make any comment about it?

A: No. I'm really, I, the only dates that I know anything about is the July 14th one, because by that time I was/a little bit suspicious, and I reconstructed what had happened, but I, I can't find anything, and I've really looked hard, you know, to give me any memories about the other dates.

Q: July 14th when you remember well.

A: Yeah.

Q: What can you tell me about him on that?

A: On that day?

Q: Um hum.

A: He came over in the morning and I was just getting ready to go to church.

Q: That was a Sunday?

A: Yes, and it was a sunny day. We had an argument the night before because I wanted to do something and he didn't, um, well anyway so he came over early in the morning and I said well I'm going to church and then I'm gonna go lay out in the sun. So he asked me where I was going, I thought maybe he'd meet me there, but he didn't, and I didn't, we quarreled again that morning, and I was really mad at him so I was really surprised when I got home he called me about oh six and said let's go eat, and I was surprised at this, I thought he was mad at me; and so we went out and ate that night.

Q: At six o'clock?

A: Yeah.

Q: Was there anything unusual about him that night?

Q: Well, he looked really wiped out, he was gettin a bad cold, which really turned into a whopper, but I asked him what he had done and he said he'd laid around and rested, but he looked just so tired, and aah, he told me his (?) were gone.

Q: Okay, let me ask you another personal question, 1(d) in regards to his sex life, was he a type of an individual that, from sex that he could go one right after the other continue, or was he an individual that wasn't, what I'm trying to say, unusual for the fact that a man that if he had intercourse with a girl that he could have one right after the other, or would he be more less the normal type, did he have an extra strong situation in that line?

A: Its hard to tell, when we first met each other, I mean

Q: Right, no, I realize that.

A: Yeah right, well after 6 years, you know, he was normal.

Q: Okay. Maybe I shouldn't do this, I hope I got your confidence enough, that you, like I told you yesterday, that you won't talk to him, and perhaps that we can get the doubt out of your mind and maybe a doubt out of ours both, one way or the other. Maybe this will help you. I have a picture here of all the items that we took from his car, and one particular item here you don't know about, and I wanted to ask you something about it. But I will let you look at them first.

A: What's all this stuff?

Q: Okay now I can tell you. This stuff here is bit of sheets torn in about one or two inch strips, and there are some, that's what basically all that stuff is, and then this is, there is cord and rope in small sections. Its the handcuffs and its the punch, the gloves, the ski mask, this is a pair of women's nylon pantihose with eye holes and a mouth cut out. This is, like a canvas gym bag they were all in. This is a bag of those garbage can liner bags, 30 gallon garbage can liners. This is a flashlight and that's the crowbar. Have you ever seen that crowbar before?

A: No.

Q: Have you ever seen any of that stuff before?



A: Yes, I've seen the gloves and I've seen the gym bag.

Q: Have you ever seen what's in that gym bag?

A: No, it was usually empty, he has another one that he carries his, you know, athletics stuff in.

Q: Okay, now this might enlighten you to why we suspect something wrong, very highly unusual, would you say, that any man would have these things, other than for what reason, an armed robber maybe? Very much, armed robberies are handled daily with these and these. Of course we didn't come up with any gun or anything else. And the handcuffs, the rope bindings, what would you surmise they might be in a person's possession for? To tie somebody up, I would assume. So, I can't answer that, but those are the things that was in his car, and those are the things that he was arrested for, and the statute we use is what we call Burglar Tools, at 3:00 o'clock in the morning, on the west side of Salt Lake, and his explanation was, "I was just driving around, couldn't sleep." I cannot tell you what he was doing. I have no idea. But that's basically one of my concerns. I don't buy his explanation for them. Like I say, even the nylon pantihose he had an explanation, that he put them on to keep his ears and his face warm when he was skiing, and I says you don't ski in August. "But I just still had them in my car." So I, that's my concern.

A: What about the ice pick?

Q: I can't answer that either.

A: What'd he say?

Q: It was just a house tool, just a thing that he had in his car. But I can't answer that either, I don't know why or what the, but you have never seen the ice pick or any of these other items?

A: Uh uh. I told Kathy, and I double checked, when he used to drive my car, I noticed that the crowbar, I mean the jack hammer, was taped with adhesive tape, and it still is to this day.

Q: Where's your car?

A: In the parking lot.

Q: Far from here?

A: Its not walking distance.

Q: You say its not in walking distance?

A: No, it is, yeah.

Q: Long ways?

A: Yeah.

Q: Okay. And that's a Volkswagen lug wrench.

A: (Can't hear answer)

Q: Okay. We'd like to look at it before we leave, some way or another.

A: Okay.

Q: Okay?

A: Alright.

Q: But its taped, where is it taped?

A: I don't know, one end.

Q: Okay, but you noticed it, that since he drove your car and that that it was taped?

A: Yeah, no that was, I mean its been taped for years.

Q: (Detective Beal) Does it look similar to this to where it has the part that you undo the lugs with and it just comes up and curves right to there?

A: I don't remember, It seems to me its straight, not curved on the end. We can go look at it. I can, I don't know, I remember one time

Q: (Detective Thompson) Did you ever confront him about it?

A: Yeah I asked him about it and he says it, well this is a long time ago we were having student riots up here, and he said you never know when you can get caught in the middle of one.

Q: Okay now where did he keep it?

A: In the trunk of my car.

Q: Your trunk, but you never noticed it when he had it it was in the front or under the

seat or anything?

A: I think it was in the front of the car at one time. Then there was another, a tire iron, I mean a, I don't know what it was, but he used to sleep in front of my house, and it was sitting there, this is a long time ago but its just weird, and he left my house late at night and then he came back and I opened the door to see what he was doing and he came back to get that, and he looked really sick, you know, like he was hiding something, and I says what have you got in your pocket, and he wouldn't show me and I reached in and grabbed it and it was pair of surgical gloves. Weird.

Q: He had them in his pocket? What did he say he was doing with them?

A: I think he turned around and left, I can't

Q: And this was in the middle of the night?

A: Yeah, it was late at night. It seems incredible as I say all this that I didn't, you know, say you're weird, go away.

Q: Well no, I realize these things, you know, of course a lot of things you don't have explanation for, you know, and you don't think and with someone else you think, well what the hell, you know, something, you don't think of them until later, and that's why, like I say, as things come up just like myself, I think of things different, and you probably will too, and I hope that I can still communicate with you. Like I say, if you think of anything, or you want to ask me any questions, and you think of anything else that may be of interest, if you'll call me, and call me collect, you, now you have that card.

A: Um hum.

Q: I don't think I put my area code on that, let me see.

A: I know what it is, its 801.

Q: You would know the area code there. Let's see which office number I have on there,

1(d) Okay, now let me tell you the best time, if you want to call me there, to get me, in which our time, we're an hour later than you, is I'm always in my office at 8 or 5 after, about quarter after 8, between 8 and 8:30 you will always catch me



in my office, in the morning is the very best time; other than that I could be in or out, you see what I mean.

A: Um hum.

Q: But if you do call there and I am not there, if you want to leave a message with the secretary I'll certainly call you back. But if you want to call and ask for me, and like I say call collect, they probably wouldn't accept the call, but if you call and ask for me and I'm there, why I will.

A: Okay.

Q: And so I can get it that way. Or I have, I will give you an address. If you want to write anything, you would like to write to me there at the Sheriff's Office, I would appreciate it, and like I told you before, there's no way I'm going to tell Ted that I communicated. If you do, that's up to you. I don't think it would be a good idea, but I can't tell you what to do.

A: Yeah, I know that.

Q: But I hope you don't communicate with the man, because there is a doubt in your mind, and frankly you've put a good doubt in my mind, and I, he is one of ten thousand suspects that we have worked on, and a lot of them have looked good and a lot of them have went down the drain. Here again, but you have put a strong doubt in my mind, and as an investigator I won't quit until I'm convinced that I'm wrong or I come up with the right answer, one way or the other, the same as we do on others, when we can definitely eliminate an individual, then we just eliminate him and keep the file, but until I can do that, I won't quit.

A: You keep all the files?

Q: Yes we do.

A: Forever (?)

Q: Well, I can't say how long. At the time, which I hope we find the individual, then the ones that didn't have nothing to do with it, I'm sure we're going to do away with, because of the office space, but until that time, I'm sure we'll hang onto

them for some time.

A: Yeah, I have wondered, I read in the paper long ago that there was a girl in Salt Lake that had gotten away, that she'd been abducted and the guy tried to handcuff her to him...and I wondered if you had shown his picture to her.

Q: Yes.

A: And?

Q: You put me on a spot, don't you. I can't tell you 1(d)

A: Oh God.

Q: I know what you're going to say.

A: The next thing you ask me

Q: You're going to tell me I can't tell you, Jerry, I can't tell you. I'll tell you this much, I will let you know, but I can't tell you right now. I will communicate with you and let you know at a later date, but I cannot tell you and not only can I not tell you, I can't tell anyone, even fellow officers other than my partner on the case, just what all we're doing and what we have, because we can't take a chance in such a case, any kind of a leak or anything else or losing a piece of evidence publicity wise or anything else, so that's, not that I don't want to tell you and not that I don't want to do this or that, but I just can't. And I hope you can understand my position in that, but I promise you I, like I say, I hope to keep communicating with you and I will let you know, but I cannot tell you right now.

Has he ever mentioned anything about that individual to you?

A: Uh uh.

Q: Now you read this in the paper?

A: Yeah (?)

Q: Did it mention what we...(end of tape) END OF INTERVIEW.

This will be a summary of a suspect developed in the killing of the girls in the Salt Lake area, and possibly into surrounding states, being compiled by Detective Jerry Thompson of the Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office, Homicide Division.

The suspect is a THEODORE ROBERT BUNDY, DOB 11-24-46, white male, 5'11", 170 pounds, brown hair, blue eyes. Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office arrest number is 78058.

The subject first basically really came to light in my eyes on 8-16-75 when he was arrested by a Highway Patrol trooper in the early morning hours driving around a subdivision, and in his vehicle he had a satchel full of numerous items--handcuffs, pantihose, a ski mask, strips of rope, a crowbar, an ice pick, etc. His explanation for these items was very poor.

On 8-21-75 this detective picked the subject up from the Salt Lake County Jail and took him to his apartment at 565 First Avenue #2, where he signed a consent search of his apartment. A thorough search was made of the apartment by this detective. Basically, we came up with only three items--a Colorado map, a brochure from Colorado on the ski resorts in the state, and a recreational type brochure from a Bountiful recreation center, also one book called the Joys of Sex. Before finding these particular items, the subject was asked by this officer if he had ever been to the state of Colorado, if he had ever been over there skiing. His comment was, "No, that is one state I have never been in." He was asked if he had ever been in the town of Bountiful, just north of Salt Lake, and he stated, "Not to my knowledge; if so, I've just passed through." In finding these items, he was asked by officer how come he had them. He had another explanation for everything, that a friend, he couldn't remember who, left them in his apartment, he didn't know why they were in there. The subject was then asked for his permission



to look through his car and also to take photographs. Photos were taken of his Volkswagen vehicle, which at this time was bearing Utah license LJE 379, on a 68 Volkswagen, registered to the subject. The color was either an off-white or a light brown or light beige. Observed in the vehicle at this time is that it did not have a front bumper nor a front license plate, and that in the back window the back seat on the top had a large tear across the top; also, there was a different paint coloration on the right door and towards the fender. The subject never at anytime asked why or what we wanted any pictures for or anything else. He was asked to come into the office the next day and talk to myself and Capt. Hayward, to which he stated he would be more than willing to, again never asking what for. The very next morning we received a call from his attorney, John O'Connell, who stated that his client would not come in, he had advised him not to come in and talk to us, and he wanted to know what we wanted to talk to Bundy about, we surely didn't think that he had killed all these girls. He was informed negative, we just wanted to talk to him.

From this point on, a more thorough investigation went into the individual by myself; Mike Fisher from the District Attorney's Office in Aspen, Colorado; Sgt. Bill Baldrige from the Pitkin County Sheriff's Office in Colorado; Milo Vig from the Mesa County Sheriff's Office in Grand Junction, Colorado; and Lt. Ron Ballantine from the Bountiful City Police Department and the rest of his staff; and Robert Keppel from the King County Sheriff's Office in Seattle, Washington, and his staff. It was then learned from Mike Fisher from Colorado, where he obtained some charge receipt invoices from Chevron Oil, after having been given Bundy's credit card number by this detective, and came up with the first 6 months of 1975's charge cards. The rest had been subpoenaed by this detective and are awaiting arrival, for the years of 1973, all of 1974, and the current 1975. It was observed at



this time, however, of particular notice that on 1-12-75 the subject bought gasoline in Glenwood Springs, Colorado, two times on this date. This is the date in question when CARYN CAMPBELL turned up missing and was killed out of Aspen, Colorado. Glenwood Springs is just a short distance from Aspen. Again of particular notice, on 3-15-75 the subject was observed buying gas in Golden, Colorado; also on the same date in Silver Thorne, Colorado; and the same date in Dillon, Colorado. This is the date when JULIE CUNNINGHAM turned up missing from Vale, Colorado, and has never been seen or heard from since. These towns are all within a very short distance of the ski resort. Again, in April of 1975, on the 4th, it was observed that the subject bought gas in Golden, Colorado; in the 5th in Silver Throne, Colorado; on the 6th in Grand Junction, Colorado. This is the date when DENISE OLIVERSON from Grand Junction, Colorado, turned up missing and has never been heard from or seen since. Her bicycle was recovered along a street. Bundy's whereabouts other than that are not known, other than that he was living in the Salt Lake area during October and November, the time that are girls were missing, and that he was living in Seattle, Washington, in the early part of 1974, when the 7 or 9 girls were missing up there.

In an attempt to learn more about this individual, a subpoena was served on Mountain Bell by this detective, and I obtained telephone receipts of his long distance phone calls. Ones of particular notice were to a Dr. R.N. HIRST in Ogden, Utah, phone 394-9230; and (d), who lives at (d) 18th N.E. in Seattle, Washington, phone (d). Several others were noted and are on record, but these two are of significant value. In checking out the call to Dr. Hirst in Ogden, it was learned that this subject is the father of Bundy's girlfriend, (d), and that he was familiar with the subject. An interview was made with the doctor by this



detective and Lt. Ron Ballantine. From this interview it was determined that it would be of great value to interview his daughter in Seattle, Washington.

On 9-17-75 this detective, Detective Ira Beal from Bountiful Police Department, and Detective Dennis Couch from the Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office went to Seattle and talked to 1(d). It was of particular interest to this officer that his girlfriend had numerous doubts about him, going back to when the girls turned up missing in the Seattle area and had at that time contacted the King County Sheriff's Office with her suspicions. Her suspicions first started approximately June or July of 1974 when Seattle put out a composite which resembled Ted very much, according to her, and also that the subject's name was Ted. From then on she claims that she found numerous items in her apartment which were unexplained, like plaster of Paris, elastic bandages, which the subject so called used up in the Seattle area, which Bundy could not explain to her. She also found a meat cleaver, an ax, and a large knife in her apartment, which he could not explain to her. Her lug wrench from her Volkswagen was taken out of the trunk and it was taped about halfway up and put in the front seat of her vehicle. He told her that that was in case she ever needed it. He was observed on other numerous occasions of going out during the middle of the night most of the time, and one particular time he hid an object in his pocket, which she later found out to be surgical gloves. She claimed that he napped a lot during the day and was out during the night; that he followed her and her girlfriends and seemed to like to jump out or come out from behind the bushes and grab them just to scare them. Things from here had just built up, and in 1(d) opinion, she is still very fearful of the individual and believes that he is the one involved. His sexual habits, according to her,



have changed tremendously. She has known him for six years, and just this last year his sex habits have changed considerably, which is on another report. Another girlfriend in the Seattle area was confronted about him, MARY LYNN CHINO, DOB 2-16-45, who lives at 914 West Emerson in Seattle, home phone 282-8289. She more or less substantiates the same feelings as 1(d) does about the subject. Between the two of them it was found that his family background goes as follows: his father is a cook at Ft. Lewis in Washington; his mother is a secretary at Puget Sound University; they do not have a lot of money; there are five or six brothers and sisters in the family; they are originally from Vermont or Pennsylvania; they apparently came to Seattle in 1969. The subject was told by a cousin that he was an illegitimate child and that his parents have never really told him that; they claim that has had quite a bearing on his life. They claim that the subject is a petty thief and he has stolen televisions and numerous items up there; that he is an individual that has a champagne diet and a beer income, he does not have money. In fact, at the present time he needs money badly for his tuition. He asked his girlfriend for \$700.00 to help pay attorneys' fees. This subject does have a college degree from the University of Washington, a B.S. degree in Psychology. He is presently attending the University of Utah in Law School. He has been quite prominent in the Republican Committee in the Seattle area and the Governor Evans' campaign in 1972. He appears to be definitely a loner, according to everyone we have contacted. We have been unable to come up with any close friends at this time, other than 1(d) his girlfriend. They claim he has a tremendous personality when he first meets people, but shortly after you can see through him and the fact that he likes to use you. They all described him as very educated, a very handsome individual,



and a tremendous personality.

An around-the-clock surveillance has been put on the subject by our office and Bountiful Police Department in an attempt to locate or come up with friends or associates. We have been unable to come up with this, even during our surveillance. We did come up with the information that he joined the Mormon Church a month or so ago and went to one of their overnight outings at Sweetwater in Bear Lake, Utah. He appeared to stay for the most part alone up there. He does not appear to have any close friends that we have been able to come up with up there either. We have come up with one possible girlfriend, a MARGUERITE CHRISTINE MAUGHAN, DOB 3-20-47, who lives in the same apartment complex at 565 First Avenue apartment 1 in the basement. She was observed with this individual on two or three occasions. It should also be noted that she does have an arrest record with our office for Possession of Narcotics and a Shoplifting charge.

That basically is all that we know about the subject at this time.

On 11-8-74 a CAROL DaRONCH was abducted from the area of the Fashion Place Mall this evening in a Volkswagen she describes as an older model, light in color, with a large tear in the back seat across the top. Also, there was a discoloration or some type of marking on the right door and fender. The subject attempted to handcuff her and got both handcuffs on one wrist. He also produced a small calibre weapon, unknown on the calibre, and at one time produced what she describes as an 8 sided lug wrench, or something to that effect. Since that time, this detective showed this victim numerous pictures, approximately 40, with the suspect Bundy. She pulled out Bundy's picture, giving all the rest back, stating she had not seen the individual in there. When questioned about the one in her hand, she stated, "I don't know why I pulled it out, I guess its because he looks like him." She was then shown the photos that I took of the subject's car. She stated that in her opinion it was the same color, the same type of tear in the back window, and the only thing she could tell me was that looked like the vehicle that she was in. Since that time, Bountiful Police Department officers showed her a group of drivers license pictures, along with the subject, and she pulled out the suspect's picture, stating, "I believe that's the man, but I cannot be positive." She was then taken up in an attempt to eyeball the vehicle in person. At this time the subject had put in a new back seat or else had the back seat repaired, there is no tear in the back of it. He has put on the front bumper and the license plate. The hubcaps are changed from what originally photographed by this detective, and it appears that the vehicle has been painted a darker brown color than originally painted. Also, the Bountiful Police Department took both photos of the subject and showed them to their witnesses at the



Bountiful High School, who saw the so-called suspicious person on the night of the DEBBIE KENT disappearance. They pulled a drivers license and mug shot photo from a group of others out and stated, "If you would put a mustache on the man I would say that that was him."

It should also be noted that the subject's attorney, John O'Connell, called Bob Keppel, King County Sheriff's Office in Seattle, Washington, and made the comment to him that the police in Salt Lake were harrassing or bothering his client and that he wanted to know basically if they thought he was involved in the killing of the girls in that area, that his client definitely was not and that his client would be more than willing to come in there and talk to them about this if this is what they were looking at him for. They informed him that he could come in and talk with them anytime and they would be more than happy to talk to him about anything. What the Salt Lake authorities were doing here, they did not know and they suggested that he talk to the Salt Lake police. They stated it appeared that he was more or less fishing wanting some information about what we knew about his client.

Also it should be noted that a Detective Bob Denning from Clear Creek County Sheriff's Office in Golden, Colorado, contacted this officer and stated that they had found a nude female down in a mine shaft late in August and it was determined that she turned up missing around July 1 or July 2 of this year. He was inquiring if we had any information that this subject was in that town at this time. I do not have July records from the Chevron Oil Company to see if he was over there in July. They are in the process of obtaining them now. He was in the Golden, Colorado, area however on two occasions, one in March and one in April. A copy of his report is being sent over in regards to his case.

SUMMARY OF INTERVIEW WITH THEODORE (TED) BUNDY

1. Bundy stated that he never misrepresented himself as other than an Evans' campaign worker.
2. He said that he was open to the press. The AP and UPI correspondents knew who Bundy was and what his position was.
3. Bundy stated that he never had any private conversations with Rosellini or Rosellini's campaign people. All his notes and recordings were taken from public speeches or press conferences.

01-30-89 1130 A meeting was held at an initial staging area in the City of Issaquah to discuss a primary search of an area that possibly contained the remains of one of Ted Bundy's victims. Those present at this briefing were Captain Robert Evans, Robert Kepel--State Attorney General's Office, Bill Haglund--King County Medical Examiner's Office, Sergeant Bruce Peterson, Detective Cecil Ray and I.

01-30-89 1205 We all proceeded to an area which can be described as land that was owned by Burlington Northern Railroad approx. 1.8 miles west of High Point Road, and approx. 450 to 500 feet north of I-90. The site itself was approx. 250' north of an abandoned railroad grade which runs parallel to I-90 in a east west direction and is on the west side of a trail that runs north off of the railroad grade. The area of concentration was approx. 209' north of and area that two sets of human remains were discovered and could be attributable to Bundy's killing spree. Det. Ray and I began to dig in an area about 5' off of the northwest shoulder of the trail. The radius of our excavation attempt was approx. 8' and the depth was up to 18" in some spots. It was determined that this attempt was a futile one due to the area to be covered. A decision was made to come back at a later time with heavy equipment and additional manpower to process this location properly.

Prior to our going back to this site, Det. Ray and I, through the Department of Assessments determined the owners of this land, obtained maps of the area and passed this information on to Capt. Evans and Sgt. Peterson.

It was recently discovered that one of the suspected Bundy victims, GEORGANNE HAWKINS, listed as a missing person with the Seattle Police Department, had been dropped from the NCIC computer system. That system uses dental records for comparison of unidentified remains with missing persons. Neither the Seattle Police, Washington State Missing Persons Unit, K.C. Medical Examiner nor Washington State Forensic Dentist has copies of the dental records on Ms HAWKINS.

Some time back I acquired a spread sheet with a list of files and documents in Archive Storage regarding Bundy. I found that Box 32 folders 6 and 7 are said to contain HAWKINS' dental records and a report on a 1989 search for HAWKINS remains, along with photos of the search area. I have been looking all over for the latter documents.

What would it take to get copies of the dental records (and X-rays, if any) and reports and photos of the 1989 search?

Since these remains could (theoretically) turn up at any time, I would like to have copies for the small file that we keep her in Major Crimes.

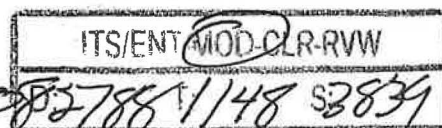



R/O was dispatched to 2212 No 30<sup>th</sup>, where contact was made with the victim regarding a sex crime. Victim stated that she had been walking down the stairs behind Annie Wright Seminary leading to the Garfield playground. Stated that the suspect was also hanging around the stairway. Stated the suspect said "Hey, got a light?" and when the victim replied in the negative, the suspect ran up from the rear and put his arm around her neck, as in a strangle hold. Susp said, "Got any money?" and when the victim produced only 6 dollars, the susp. said, "That's not what I wanted anyway."

Susp. then placed his knit watch cap over the victim's head and pulled it down over her face, saying something to the effect that he didn't want the victim to see him. Victim was then turned around and forced to her knees and the suspect grabbed her by the head and forced her to perform oral copulation on him. Suspect then brought the victim back to her feet and told her to lean up against a wall, spread eagle type of stance, after pulling down her pants and tossing them aside. Susp. then seemed surprised, and stated, "Hey, you're a girl.", to which the victim replied, "Thanks A lot". The victim then grabbed the suspect about the waist and bent her over, so he could have intercourse with her. Victim stated that the penetration was in the vagina, with full penetration. Victim stated that the suspect tried unsuccessfully to

reach a climax, but was unable and contact was broken after approx. 3-4 min.

Susp. then removed his cap from the victim and told her that he was leaving and didn't want the victim to look at him. Susp. then walked off in the direction of Buttroughs Rd.

Victim stated that she waited a minute or two. She then retrieved her pants, put them on and went home. Victim stated that the susp. didn't take her money. Victim was unable to give any more description to R/O, as the light was very poor at that time, except that the susp. was very powerful and the threat of physical injury was implied, so she offered no resistance.

R/O returned to the scene of the crime, but no evidence was observed. No further investigation by R/O.

Victim was concerned that she could get pregnant, and was advised by R/O to consult a doctor.

SUBJECT Information received from Det. F.L. Roesler 2127-352 re missing females from University area.

At approximately 1820 Hours on this date, Roesler called and stated that he was to meet an informant at the University Towers bar who was to give him information about the females missing from the University area. Roesler stated that he would meet with his informant alone and would call this office with whatever information he learned.

At 1930 Hours Roesler called back and advised that he had met with his informant who advised him that the bodies of the missing girls were at an unknown location "...all hacked up." The informant further advised that the girls (possibly Healey and Hawkins) had been taken by a group of freaks and had been hacked up and killed during this cult's "religious" rites. Roesler's informant sells drugs and his contact with the cult is through their purchasing hallucinogenic drugs from the informant to be used during their rites. The informant advised that the cult was a wierd group with a house on Capitol Hill and one in the Fremont area. The informant does not know any of the cult by name nor does he know the addresses to the two houses. The only name that the informant does have is that of a "Joanne" who was kidnapped by the cult to be used during their rites. The informant advised that this "Joanne" is a 220 with a mental history who lives on 12th Ave. N.E. near the University District. The informant will give no further information about "Joanne" as he states any contact with her will "burn" him. He stated that "Joanne" had been taken by the cult but apparently made so much noise screaming that she frightened them and they let her go. The informant stated that during the rites, the lips, ears, etc. are cut off the girls and they are eventually killed and disposed of. Roesler's informant was to meet one of cult members at 2000 Hours this date at Fat Albert's Tavern on Eastlake Ave. E. This meeting was apparently to arrange for the sale of hallucinogenic mushrooms to be used by the cult in an upcoming meeting. Roesler's informant, who Roesler described as paranoid, will apparently attempt to get names or addresses during this meeting. Roesler advised that he will surveil from outside Fat Albert's in an attempt to obtain a description of the cult member or to identify him from past contacts. The informant apparently believes that another girl will be kidnapped soon and used in another rite. Roesler stated that he told his man not to sell any hallucinogens to the group this date but to put them off until another time. Roesler has not direct contact with his informant but will apparently receive a call from him sometime tomorrow regarding any information learned tonight at Fat Albert's. Roesler will contact this office when he has further information. Roesler is apparently of the opinion that his informant's information is good.

It came to my attention last night that Bundy had lived across the street from my residence in the University District. Members of my family were acquainted with Bundy on a speaking basis and remembered several things about him. I will attempt to relay the various bits of data that could be gleaned from the memories of these people as well as several other bits of hearsay that might or might not be helpful.

My daughter, Laureen M. Moore, <sup>age 21</sup> former member of S. P. D. told me she had had several conversations with him when he struck up conversations as she or she & her sister were sitting on our front lawn.

Laureen says the man was a very smooth talker and was very easy to converse with, seemed polished and educated. He told her he was attending school here and was from Tacoma Wn. He mentioned an interest in Tennis, Skiing & Sailing. One time he mentioned that he was going to go to a cabin, "to get away from it all". She says that she got the impression the cabin was owned by his parents.

Bundy was observed by Laureen on a bike and also getting out of a V.W. driven by a woman.

SUBJECT Information received from Det. F.L. Roesler 2127-352 re missing females from University area.

At approximately 1820 Hours on this date, Roesler called and stated that he was to meet an informant at the University Towers bar who was to give him information about the females missing from the University area. Roesler stated that he would meet with his informant alone and would call this office with whatever information he learned.

At 1930 Hours Roesler called back and advised that he had met with his informant who advised him that the bodies of the missing girls were at an unknown location "...all hacked up." The informant further advised that the girls (possibly Healey and Hawkins) had been taken by a group of freaks and had been hacked up and killed during this cult's "religious" rites. Roesler's informant sells drugs and his contact with the cult is through their purchasing hallucinogenic drugs from the informant to be used during their rites. The informant advised that the cult was a wierd group with a house on Capitol Hill and one in the Fremont area. The informant does not know any of the cult by name nor does he know the addresses to the two houses. The only name that the informant does have is that of a "Joanne" who was kidnapped by the cult to be used during their rites. The informant advised that this "Joanne" is a 220 with a mental history who lives on 12th Ave. N.E. near the University District. The informant will give no further information about "Joanne" as he states any contact with her will "burn" him. He stated that "Joanne" had been taken by the cult but apparently made so much noise screaming that she frightened them and they let her go. The informant stated that during the rites, the lips, ears, etc. are cut off the girls and they are eventually killed and disposed of. Roesler's informant was to meet one of cult members at 2000 Hours this date at Fat Albert's Tavern on Eastlake Ave. E. This meeting was apparently to arrange for the sale of hallucinogenic mushrooms to be used by the cult in an upcoming meeting. Roesler's informant, who Roesler described as paranoid, will apparently attempt to get names or addresses during this meeting. Roesler advised that he will surveil from outside Fat Albert's in an attempt to obtain a description of the cult member or to identify him from past contacts. The informant apparently believes that another girl will be kidnapped soon and used in another rite. Roesler stated that he told his man not to sell any hallucinogens to the group this date but to put them off until another time. Roesler has not direct contact with his informant but will apparently receive a call from him sometime tomorrow regarding any information learned tonight at Fat Albert's. Roesler will contact this office when he has further information. Roesler is apparently of the opinion that his informant's information is good.

Roesler said he had another man inside but it was so crowded that he couldn't do any good. The informant is supposed to contact Roesler tomorrow.

It came to my attention last night that Bundy had lived across the street from my residence in the University District. Members of my family were acquainted with Bundy on a speaking basis and remembered several things about him. I will attempt to relay the various bits of data that could be gleaned from the memories of these people as well as several other bits of hearsay that might or might not be helpful.

My daughter, Laureen M. Moore, <sup>age 21</sup> former member of S. P. D. told me she had had several conversations with him when he struck up conversations as she or she & her sister were sitting on our front lawn.

Laureen says the man was a very smooth talker and was very easy to converse with, seemed polished and educated. He told her he was attending school here and was from Tacoma Wn. He mentioned an interest in Tennis, Skiing & Sailing. One time he mentioned that he was going to go to a cabin, "to get away from it all". She says that she got the impression the cabin was owned by his parents.

Bundy was observed by Laureen on a bike and also getting out of a V.W. driven by a woman.

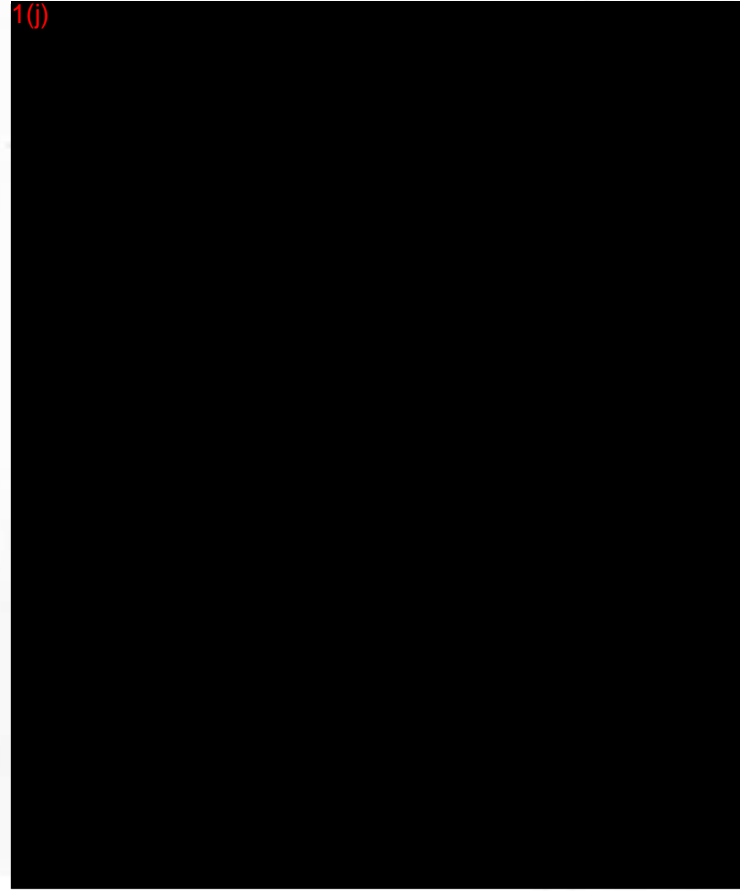

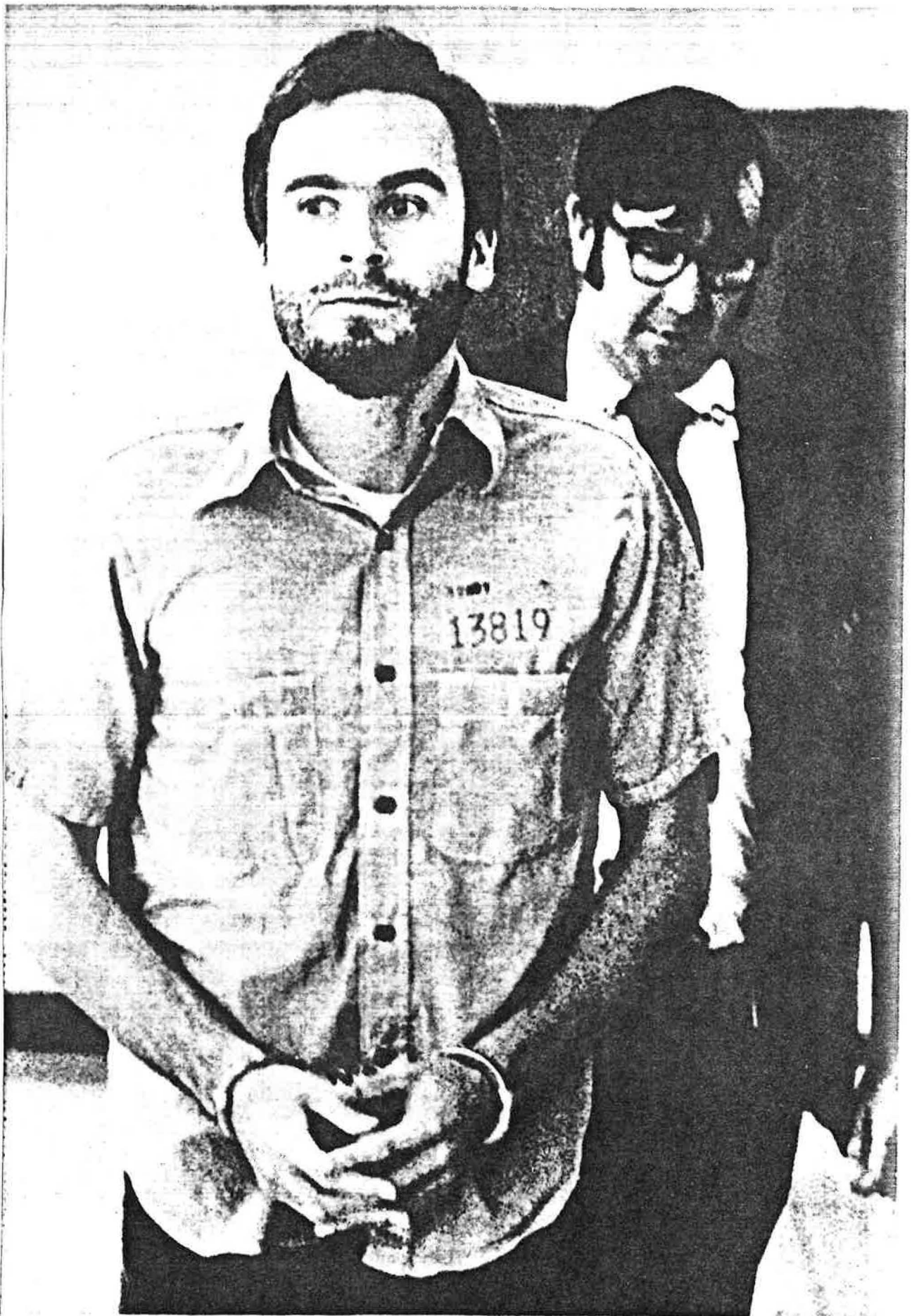

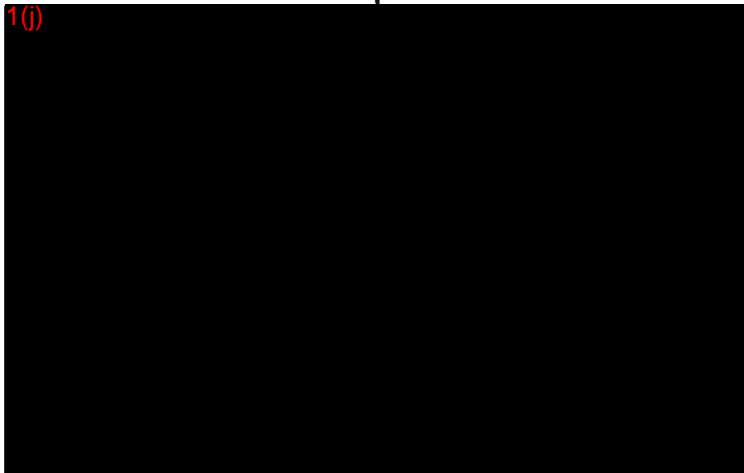

During a conversation this morning, it came to my attention that during the kidnap/assault incident presently pending trial, Mr. Bundy may have initially identified himself to the victim as a police officer. He most probably used the name, "Detective Roland", "Detective Rossland", or some phonetic equivalent.

I am not entirely sure, but the name(s) ring a bell and I think it was in connection with a series of obscene/threatening telephone calls that I investigated in 1972 and 1973, possibly early 1974, in sex crimes. As nearly as I can recall, the M.O. was something like this:

Suspect called victim and identified himself by name as a Seattle Police Detective investigating a series of obscene telephone calls. The suspect would tell the victim that his investigation lead him to believe she would be contacted shortly, and her cooperation was desperately needed to catch the caller. The victim was told that some type of telephone trace had been attached to her phone and when the obscene call came, she was to do whatever was necessary to keep the caller on the line.

Without fail, the victims would do as they were asked. It was somewhat embarrassing to all parties when the victim would telephone the Sex Crimes Squad, after keeping the caller on the line for an extended period, asking if the suspect had been caught. The suspect would use a multitude of names when calling as a police officer, and I think "Roland," "Rossland" or some other phonetic equivalent was one of the names he used.

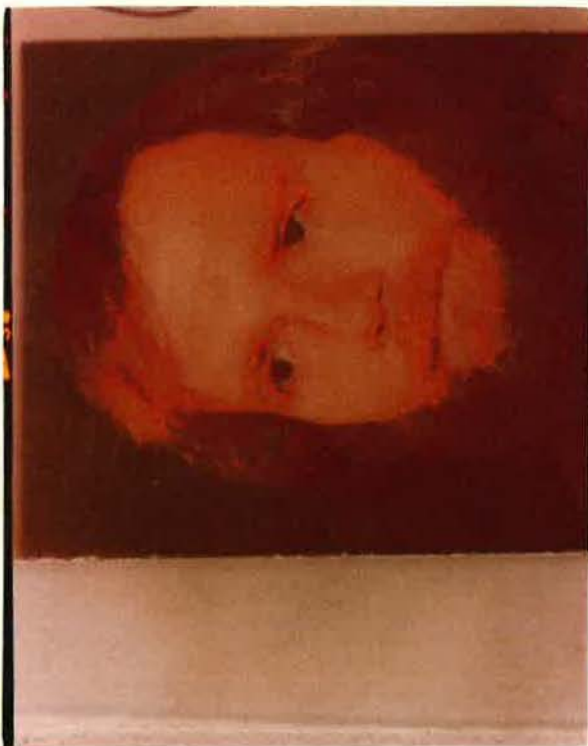
