PENSACOLA, FLA. (AP) -- THEODORE ROBERT BUNDY, A CUNNING FUGITIVE ACCUSED OF ONE MURDER AND SUSPECTED IN 35 OTHERS, HAS BEEN TRACKED TO A JAIL CELL BY FBI AGENTS WHO USED FINGERPRINTS TO PENETRATE HIS LATEST GUISE -- THAT OF A COLLEGE TRACK STAR.

BUNDY -- WHO UNTIL LATE THURSDAY WAS SIMPLY A PRISONER WHO HAD BEEN HELD 40 HOURS IN THE PENSACOLA CITY JAIL -- WAS BEING QUESTIONED TODAY BY INVESTIGATORS IN THE JAN. 15 BLUDGEON MURDERS OF TWO CHI OMEGA SORORITY SISTERS AT FLORIDA STATE UNIVERSITY IN TALLAHASSEE.

"HE IS ALREADY COOPERATING AND TALKING WITH INVESTIGATORS," SAID WAYNE SMITH, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE LEON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE IN TALLAHASSEE, 200 MILES TO THE EAST.

BUNDY, 31, ESCAPED FROM JAIL DEC. 31 IN GLENWOOD SPRINGS, COLO., WHILE WAITING TRIAL FOR THE 1975 SEX-SLAYING OF DEARBORN, MICH., NURSE CARYN CAMPBELL.

ACTING FBI DIRECTOR JAMES ADAMS SAID IN WASHINGTON, D.C., THAT BUNDY WAS WANTED FOR QUESTIONING IN 35 OTHER SEX SLAYINGS THAT BEGAN IN CALIFORNIA IN 1969, EXTENDED THROUGHOUT THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST AND INTO UTAH AND COLORADO.

BUNDY WAS ARRESTED WEDNESDAY AT 1:30 A.M. WHEN PENSACOLA PATROLMAN DAVID LEE STOPPED A MAN IN A VOLKSWAGEN THAT HAD BEEN REPORTED STOLEN IN TALLAHASSEE EARLIER THIS MONTH.

THE MAN SCUFFLED WITH THE OFFICER, WHO FIRED TWO SHOTS BEFORE SUBDUING THE MAN. THE MAN WAS CHARGED WITH RESISTING ARREST AND POSSESSION OF STOLEN PROPERTY, INCLUDING A TELEVISION SET AND CHARGE CARDS REPORTEDLY BELONGING TO FLORIDA STATE WOMEN.

THE PRISONER GAVE HIS NAME AS KENNETH RAYMOND MISNER, 29, OF TALLAHASSEE. HE CARRIED MISNER'S IDENTIFICATION PAPERS, POLICE SAID. BUT THE REAL KENNETH MISNER, A FORMER FLORIDA STATE TRACK STAR, SOON CAME FORWARD IN TALLAHASSEE, WHERE HE IS ATTENDING GRADUATE SCHOOL.

DETECTIVE NORMAN CHAPMAN SAID POLICE DEVELOPED A HUNCH LATE THURSDAY AFTERNOON THEIR PRISONER MIGHT BE BUNDY. THEY SUMMONED FBI AGENTS, WHO ARRIVED TWO HOURS LATER WITH WANTED POSTERS AND FINGERPRINTS.

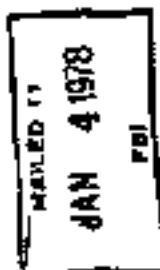

Credit Card Number 945-5075-153V. BUNDY was raised in the Tacoma, Washington area and graduated from University of Washington with a BS Degree in Psychology. He attended one year law school at the University of Washington, then started over law school at the University of Salt Lake.

BUNDY'S arrest record reflected he was arrested 8/16/75, Salt Lake City, Utah Sheriff's Office, for attempting to elude police. 9/10/75, for aggravated kidnapping, attempted criminal homicide on 7/6/77, sentenced to Utah State Penitentiary, Draper, Utah, for aggravated kidnapping, 1 to 15 years. 11/23/77, murder, Pitkin County Sheriff's Office, Aspen, Colorado, 7/24/77, felony escape, second degree burglary, felony theft, Pitkin County Sheriff's Office, Aspen, Colorado.

BUNDY was awaiting trial for the 1/12/75 murder of a Michigan nurse CARYN EILEEN CAMPBELL who had been vacationing at Snowmass, Colorado, near Aspen. Her nude and partly decomposed body was found near Aspen, Colorado, 2/17/75.

b7c [REDACTED] advised BUNDY has been considered a suspect in 36 similar type sexual slayings which started in California in 1969 and extended throughout the Pacific Northwest and into Salt Lake City, Utah, and on to Colorado. In a number of the cases the bodies have not been located.

BUNDY after being sentenced to the Salt Lake State Penitentiary on aggravated kidnapping was furnished some forged documents and apparently was planning an escape. He was transferred to Colorado and escaped from the Pitkin County Court House, 7/27/77, eluding law enforcement officers in the nearby mountains for approximately seven days. He carefully planned a second escape from the Garfield County Jail, Glenwood Springs, Colorado, which he effected on 12/31/77.

BACKGROUND

BUNDY is described as a physical fitness and health nut, who enjoys natural foods and is extremely conscientious about self cleanliness and his appearance. He is described as a glib talker, very intelligent, who makes a good impression. He has been known to wear false beards and mustaches and is described as having a positive determined attitude but is considered high strung.

He is left handed and has used marijuana and drinks moderately, possibly preferring Scotch. He has a preference for VW bugs and appears to be a patient person except when cornered. He used to smoke but quit and on occasion still burns cigarettes. He chews gum often.

BUNDY has been fascinated by politics and law enforcement and would probably consider his escape an exhilarating challenge between himself and law enforcement authorities.

CRIMINAL SPECIALITY

BUNDY is believed to have attracted a number of young girls through his excellent ability to talk and his good looking appearance. A number of the victims believed to be possibly associated with BUNDY have been stripped of their clothing and jewelry and usually dumped off the side of the road or into a remote area after having been sexually assaulted.

OUTSTANDING PROCESS

On 12/31/77, Assistant U. S. Attorney ROY W. SNOW, authorized the issuance of a complaint charging THEODORE BUNDY with UFAP for the crime of murder - violation of Title 18, U. S. Code, Section 273. On 1/5/77, the complaint was filed by SA EDWARD R. NIEMANN before U. S. Magistrate HILBERT SCHAUER at Denver, Colorado, and warrant was issued. Mr. SNOW recommended subject if arrested be held without bond.

DN 88-10975

Subject is well educated, cunning, clever and has successfully escaped from law enforcement authorities on two occasions. He should be considered an escape risk and extremely dangerous in view of the crime for which he has been charged.

Bureau is requested to issue a wanted flyer and Identification Order for subject and consider him for an immediate addition as a top ten fugitive.

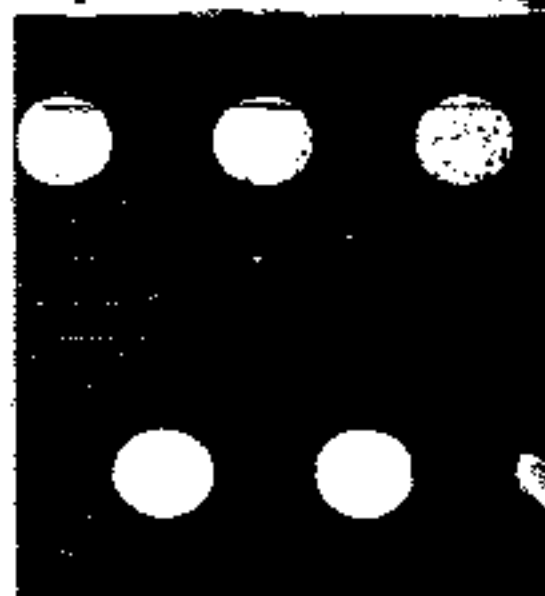

THEODORE ROBERT BUNDY, White Male, date of birth November 24, 1946, place of birth Burlington, Vermont, was being held in the Garfield County Jail, Glenwood Springs, Colorado, awaiting trial for the murder of CARYN EILEEN CAMPBELL, whose nude body was found February 17, 1975, near Aspen, Colorado. He had previously escaped from the Pitkin County Court House, Aspen, Colorado, on June 7, 1977, by jumping from a second story window. He was rearrested by local authorities June 14, 1977, and charged with three additional felonies.

On December 31, 1977, BUNDY escaped from the Garfield County Jail by removing an electrical fixture in the top of his cell and crawling in the space above the ceiling to the jailor's apartment closet where he is believed to have walked out in the morning of December 31, 1977.

BUNDY was previously convicted on June 6, 1976, in the State of Utah for aggravated kidnapping and was sentenced to one to fifteen years which he was serving when he was charged with the murder of CARYN EILEEN CAMPBELL. He is currently charged with violation of Colorado Revised Statute, 1973, 18-3-102, Murder, issued October 21, 1976; 18-4-208, Escape; 18-4-203, Second Degree Burglary; and 18-4-401, Felony Theft, all issued June 15, 1977.

THEODORE ROBERT BUNDY was raised in the Tacoma, Washington area and was graduated from the University of Washington with a Bachelor of Science degree in Psychology. He has attended law school at the University of Washington and the University of Utah.

BUNDY has been characterized as a physical fitness enthusiast who enjoys natural foods and is fastidious regarding his dress and appearance. He has quit smoking, and drinks moderately, preferring Scotch. In the past, he has shown a preference for Volkswagen "Bug" automobiles. BUNDY, while not an outdoor type person per se, has gravitated to ski lodges, resorts, and college campuses.

BUNDY is considered very intelligent, good looking, and is a glib speaker. Local officers throughout the Western United States consider BUNDY to be a suspect in as many as 36 sexually related murders or mysterious disappearances. A number of victims, believed to be possibly associated with BUNDY, have been stripped of their clothing and jewelry and are usually dumped off the side of the road or into a remote area after having been sexually assaulted. The victims have ranged in age from 17 to 26, have had light brown or dark blond hair parted in the middle and all have had pierced ears. All the victims have weighed between 100 and 110 pounds with a height range of 5'2" to 5'6" tall.

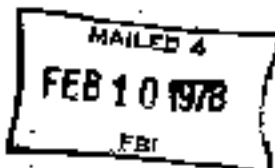

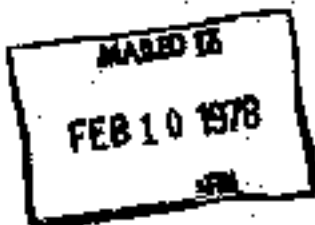

Attached from Jacksonville Office advises of the arrest of "Ten Most Wanted Fugitive" Theodore Robert Bundy on early a. m., 2/15/78, by officers of the Pensacola, Florida, Police Department (PFPD) after PFPD officer ran an NCIC check on license plate of car Bundy was driving which revealed car was stolen in Tallahassee, Florida.

Bundy resisted arrest and was subdued by PFPD officers after a brief chase and scuffle in which one shot was fired by PFPD officer. No one was injured. Bundy's true identity not determined until evening of 2/16/78, when recent Identification Order (No. 4775) was furnished to PFPD and positive identification of Bundy was made.

Bundy is considered a prime suspect by Florida State authorities in the murders of two sorority sisters of Chi Omega Sorority House, Florida State University, on 1/15/78, and is possibly involved in the disappearance of a nine-year-old female and twelve-year-old female who disappeared on 1/23/78, from Ocala, Florida, and 2/9/78, from Lake City, Florida, respectively.

Bundy was placed on the "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives" list on 2/10/78 after he escaped from a Colorado jail on 12/31/77, while awaiting trial for the murder of a nurse near Aspen, Colorado. Bundy is wanted for questioning in connection with 36 similar-type sexual slayings which began in California in 1969 and extended throughout the Pacific Northwest. A Federal warrant was issued on 1/5/78, at Denver, Colorado, charging Bundy with unlawful flight to avoid prosecution for the crime of murder. Bundy is currently being held in the PFPD city jail.

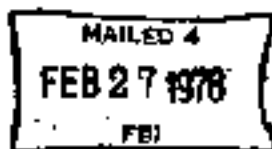

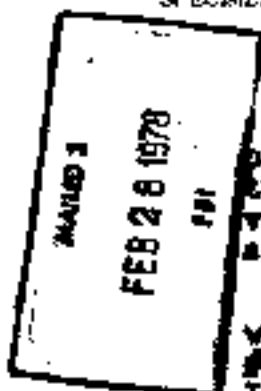

Theodore Robert Bundy, wanted for unlawful flight to avoid prosecution for murder in Colorado, has been added to the FBI's list of the "Ten Most Wanted Fugitives."

Bundy, who had been awaiting trial for the January 12, 1975, murder of a Michigan nurse near Aspen, Colorado, escaped from a Colorado jail on December 31, 1977. Wanted for questioning in connection with 36 similar-type sexual slayings which began in California in 1969 and extended throughout the Pacific Northwest and into Utah and Colorado, Bundy has been convicted of aggravated kidnaping. A Federal warrant was issued on January 5, 1978, at Denver, Colorado, charging Bundy with unlawful flight to avoid prosecution for the crime of murder.

Born November 24, 1946, in Burlington, Vermont,

Bundy is a white male who is 5 feet 11 inches to 6 feet tall, weighs 145 to 175 pounds, and has a slender, athletic build. He has dark brown collar-length hair, blue eyes, and a pale

He has used Social Security Account Number 312-44-4583. Bundy should be considered armed, dangerous, and an escape risk.

During the past, Bundy has used the following aliases: Rex Bundy, Ted Bundy, Ted Covell, Theodore Robert Covell, Theodore Robert Nelson, and Bundy.

The Bureau's attention is directed to the case captioned, "THEODORE ROBERT BUNDY, aka - FUGITIVE (A); UFAP - MURDER (TEN MOST WANTED FUGITIVE PROGRAM); IO # 4775; OO: DENVER". On 2/15/78, at approximately 1:30 a.m. Patrolman [redacted] of the Pensacola, Florida, Police Department while on routine patrol observed an orange colored Volkswagen circling in the area of V Street in Pensacola, Florida. Officer [redacted] followed this vehicle north and requested an NCIC check on the Florida tag and proceeded to stop the vehicle with his blue lights. Officer [redacted] ordered the subject out of the vehicle at which time the subject exited the vehicle and was ordered to lie down on the pavement, which he complied. As Officer [redacted] approached the subject in an attempt to place handcuffs on him, the subject rolled over, striking Officer [redacted] and knocking Officer [redacted] to the ground. The subject then fled and Officer [redacted] fired a warning shot at subject BUNDY and immediately pursued the subject on foot. At one point during this foot pursuit, Officer [redacted] observed the subject turning and looking over his shoulder and raising his hand with an unknown object in it. Officer [redacted] fired one additional shot and the subject fell to the ground. At this point, Officer [redacted] believes the subject to have been wounded but as he approached him to complete the handcuffing of the subject, the subject struck Officer [redacted] with his feet and attempted to disarm Officer [redacted] of his weapon. The subject was then struck by Officer [redacted] several times with his revolver in order that Officer [redacted] could protect himself at which time additional Pensacola PD units arrived and completed the physical restraining of the subject.

Subsequent identification by the FBI, Jacksonville Division determined that the subject was identical to THEODORE ROBERT BUNDY.
