SUBJECT REPORT ON PAPER ENTITLED "SEXUAL VIOLENCE" BY TED BUNDY

Pursuant to your request to ascertain the existence of a paper entitled "Sexual Violence" authored by "Ted Bundy", I have made a number of inquiries amongst people who knew him. As of this date, I have not been able to ascertain the existence of such a document.

My search for the document brought me into contact with the following people:

(1) Dr. DONNA SCHRAM, Tel. #525-3130, who knew him through her work in the Law and Justice Planning Office for the City of Seattle.

(2) Dr. PATRICIA LUNNEBORG, Tel. #543-2698, who knew him through her work at the University of Washington Psychology Department.

(3) Dr. EZRA STOTLAND, Tel. #543-6523, who is the current director of the Society and Justice Program at the University of Washington and who maintains a mammoth file of papers that students have done in all fields relating to criminal justice.

(4) Mr. JERRY FISH, Psychiatry Department, University of Washington, who researched and surveyed all papers and professors that Mr. Bundy might have had.

(5) Ms. SHIRLEY SCHNEIDER, Tel. #322-1191, who formerly worked in the Sexual Assault Center at Harborview Hospital, and who has done considerable research and literature review in the area of sexual assaults.

(6) Ms. BETTY DOCEKAL, Tel. #474-0561, Puget Sound Hospital, Tacoma, Washington, who supervised a Social Service Unit at Harborview Hospital in which Mr. Bundy did some type of student placement.

(7) Dr. JENNIFER JAMES, University of Washington Psychiatry Department, Tel. #543-8397, who has heard rumors of a paper on "Sexual Violence" by Mr. Bundy.

I have had telephone contact with all of the foregoing people and nobody can verify the existence of the alledged paper. The one person in the foregoing group who probably should be personally interviewed by an investigator is Ms. Docekal. Although my telephone call took her by surprise, she claims to recall Mr. Bundy. She didn't think well of him at all. She remembers him as "argumentative" and "opinionated". She also recalls that he seemed to have some particular interest in sex offenders and was involved in some type of behavior modification therapy with two sex offenders (that she can recall). She does not recall any paper on "Sexual Violence".

968. Phone contact with [REDACTED] and requested she contact the registrar at the University of Washington so that we might be able to obtain her transcript.
969. 11/10/75 - 0915 hrs. - Phone contact with MIKE MUDGETT, U.W. Police, who was not able to learn LARRY's last name, but has the information from BUNDY's law school records.
970. 1000 hrs. - Phone call received from Mrs. WILKINSON, owner of 1845 E. Shelby. She advised that Mrs. BEWULOW, the former owner of the house lived with her daughter, Mrs. HANS GEISE.
971. Phone call received from KAREN JOHNSON, Jay Jacobs, who advised that LIZ KLEPFOR made purchases at their store on May 4th and June 22nd.
972. 1300 hrs. - Phone message left for TIM BURGESS, S.P.D.
973. Phone contact with LIZ KLEPFOR to advise her that Salt Lake was preparing to release BUNDY from jail. Phone message left for MARY CHINO.
974. Phone contact attempted with KAREN SKAVLEM, negative results.
975. Phone contact with TIM BURGESS, S.P.D., who advised he was not able to locate a report done by BUNDY, but that the Seattle Crime Commission information was at Room 410 of the Seattle Police Department.
976. 1430 hrs. - Phone message left for GAIL ROTHROCK, Metro Transit, 447-5800.
977. Phone contact attempted with WARREN DODGE - negative results.
978. 1445 hrs. - Phone contact with PAUL BARCLIFF, Thurston County S.O. TOM SAMPSON has signed a statement given to them regarding BUNDY. SAMPSON also told BARCLIFF that while in Seattle he and BUNDY went out to eat a few times, usually to the Braiserrie Pitts-bourg or in the Pioneer Square area. They didn't go to any bars together according to SAMPSON.
979. BARCLIFF found no connections between BUNDY and any members of the gay community in Olympia. He showed the Rape Report to SAMPSON, who advised he thought that it was done by DONNA SCHRAM and PHIL SHERBUNE rather than BUNDY.
- 98D. R/O and Det. DUNN to S.P.D. to go through Crime Commission Files. Nothing pertinent on BUNDY was located.

1023. In May or June of 1974 a lady living at DIANE's parents' house had some jewelry and a pair of shoes taken. The parents lived in a condominium in San Mateo and TED BUNDY did know where they lived. There was no evidence of forced entry. DIANE was living there at the time.
1024. Phone contact attempted with DONNA SCHRAM - message left.
1025. 11/14/75 - 1045 hrs. - Phone call received from DONNA SCHRAM. The report on rape in Seattle in 1972 was written by her and PHIL SHERBUNE. She doesn't feel that a report by BUNDY on this subject exists - that he may have lied about it.
1026. DONNA also thought that she helped TED with a project he did on the court system.
1027. After TED's possible involvement in the stealing of records at Harborview Hospital of the patients of JIM MC DERMOTT, DONNA had little else to do with TED and told PAT LUNNABORG of the U.W. the same. PAT, DONNA says, is TED's greatest advocate and PAT has an interest in his career.
1028. 1330 hrs. - R/O and Det. DUNN attempted to locate the antique store on Greenwood or Phinney with negative results.
1029. R/O attempted personal contact with WILLARD WILHELM at his residence, negative results. A message was left.
1030. 11/17/75 - 0830 hrs. - Phone call received from MABLE WILHELM, 5221 - 16th N.E., 522-9929. She and her husband have owned the residence at 5015 - 16th N.E. for about four years. Prior to that it was owned by LUCY PACKOWITZ, who had few renters and was afraid of people. She has since moved to the midwest and lives in a nursing home. The mortgage on the house is paid to Seattle-First National Bank and was sold by Smythe Realty.
1031. Phone contact attempted with JOHN DUFFY, Negative results.
1032. Phone contact attempted with [REDACTED], negative results.
1033. Phone call to MIKE MUDGETT, U.W. Police, and requested dates of U.W. Summer Session, 1967, and [REDACTED] transcript.
1034. 1000 hrs. - Phone contact with MARY CHINO who recalls LIZ' and MOLLY's trip to San Francisco to visit her during Thanksgiving of 1973. LIZ came down on Wednesday night and left the following Sunday around 4:00 or 3:00 P.M.
