3.	3-6-74	0900 To victims home. Statement signed and she signed medical release form. As she never saw his face or hair, she cannot state if he is a blonde or brunette but is positive he is white as she saw his arms. Believes he is 20-24 from his build, voice. After he left she phoned Rape Relief about 7:30 that morning and talked with a girl named Maria and she is the first person she told. Then Maria sent 2 girls over who took her to KCH for exam and she notified the police later that night. Claims that Thursday night 2-28-74 she heard something and got up about 1:30 am and looked (Friday am 1:30am) and saw nothing so went back to bed. Then Friday afternoon a friend of her noticed the screen had been removed but she did not notice it. Then he came in about 2 am on Sat morning 3-2-74. She said he did not ask for money and she had some good jewelry laying on the table and he did not touch it, in fact he did not touch anything in the apt. She is moving and will call in her new address. Does not want her parents notified. Realizes she was careless in not drawing the drapes or locking the window.

STATEMENT OF: Feldman, Martha S ue WF 20 I live at 4220 12th N.E. #14, 633 5469

On Saturday, March 2, 1974 I went to bed about 1am. My shades were drawn but on one of the curtains you can look in on the side and see my bed and see that no one was in that bed. About 3/4ths of the time I have someone staying with me. I was sound asleep, probably about 4am when I was awakened (I believe by him opening the window and shutting it). I had forgotten to put the wooden slot in the window to lock it and although it would be difficult to see that it was not there in the dark, he must have seen it as he took off the outer screen to reach the window. I opened my eyes and he was standing in the doorway and I saw only the profile of him. There was a light shining from the living room where he had left his flashlight on the table and left it lighted as later I asked him where the light was coming from and he told me it was none of my business. He came right over and sat on my bed and told me to relax that he was not going to hurt me. I asked him how he got in and he said it was none of my business. He sat there for maybe 10 minutes and mostly I asked questions and his answers were confined to just relax and that he would not hurt me. He was wearing a/white T undershirt short sleeved levis and no shirt or jacket although it was cold outside. He had a dark navy watch cap pulled down over his head to below his chin. It was not a ski mask as there were no holes for nose and I think he must have made slits in it for his eyes although I could not see them. So I never saw his face or his hair and I have no idea of the color of his hair, if he had mustache or beard or anything like that. I know it was not a ski mask as it did not go down on his neck. His voice sounded like a Northwesterner and he was well educated and could be a student at U. of W. I do not recall any jewelry or watch and although I saw his bare arms, did not see any hair on his arms. He told me he would not use his knife if I did not scream and he showed me a hunting knife and it looked like a carved bone handle, dark with streaks in it. He had been drinking but was not drunk. After about 8-10 minutes he got some tape out of his pocket and taped my eyes. Then he turned on my light and left it on while he took off

my clothes, unzipped his pants and had sexual intercourse with me. Then he taped my hands and feet and I asked him why he was doing that and he said, "Just to slow you down". After he taped me, he turned off the light, covered me up and said, "Now go back to sleep". I heard him go into the living room, open the window and leave by the window and he took his flashlight with him. He went out the back and ran towards the alley. I listened but did not hear a car start up. He was so calm and sure of himself I think he has done this before but he did not say anything to make me believe he has done this before.
