0900 hrs: Received TT from Thurston County with details of unidentified MF found in their area. Descriptions given in TT match very closely to that of R/W Katherine Merry Divine. The mother was contacted under the pretext that additional information was needed for a TT that I wanted to sent to Oregon. Information gained, such as, 1. Missing party does have pierced ears, clothing described in TT is exactly as described by mother, even to the point of very recently acquired, waffle stompers. Jeans were of the navy type as opposed to the levi type.

1000 hrs: To the Seattle Public Health and Dental Department, 14th floor Public Health and talked to Dr. Prince. He looked up R/W dental chart and compared in to the description in the TT. R/W had not had too much dental work done at the clinic, however their records as far as they have, are identical to the description in the TT. He does have x-rays.

1130 hrs: To medical examiners office and talked to Dr. P.F. Resant-Matthews. He did autopsy for Thurston County. He looked at picture and states that the dental formation in the picture is as he remembers it to be on the victim. He also took x-rays and has them at his home. He will cooperate in any way.

1200 hrs: Contacted University of Wash. Dental school. Subject was to have started dental work there, however no work has been done at this date, so they have no records on child's teeth.

It is this Detectives opinion that the victim in the Thurston County Fomicide is the same as Our Runaway CS# 73-57047, DEVINE, Katherine Merry.
