Deputies Still Lack Clues To Victim's Identity

Despite a flood of calls, Thurston-County sheriff's deputies Tuesday morning reported no few firm leads on the identity of the slain woman found last week in Margaret McKenny Park.

"We have been busy, but there are no new developments. There have been lots of calls and lots of visitors," explained Inspector Charles Graef.

Last Thursday Mrs. Dale Saling found the woman's partially nude body near a parking area at the park. Mrs. Saling's husband has contracted with the Department of Natural Resources to keep the Capitol Forest park clean.

Since the body was found, deputies have been unable to find a clue to the woman's identity. No purse, wallet or identification for the woman have been found.

The woman has been described as 15 to 20-years-old wearing shoulder length straight brown hair, and weighing 120 pounds. She had pierced ears with gold cross earrings.

Deputies said she was wearing a brown mock suede coat, a peasant blouse and blue jeans with an embroidered dragon patch on the left rear pocket.

Chief Criminal Deputy Dwight Caron said his office is receiving information from all over the Northwest. None of the leads, however, has gone very far, he said

Caron said he was amazed there are so many spouses and children missing from this area who were not reported gone until the body was found.

Slain girl identified

OLYMPIA — The identity of a girl whose body was found last Thursday in a park near Littlerock was established as Katherine Merry Devine; age 14, Tuesday morning, according to the Thurston County Sheriff's Department.

The girl daughter of Mr. and Mrs. William Devine, Seattle, was identified by her uncle, Delmar Bennett. The girl's body was found partially disrobed at the edge of a clearing in McKenney Park. She had a knife wound in the neck and her wallet and purse were missing.

The uncle and parents of the girl had been working with detectives from the Thurston County Sheriff's Department and detectives and juvenile authorities from the Seattle Police Department. Bennett traveled to Olympia Tuesday

The girl was a runaway and was last seen in the Seattle area by a girl friend Nov. 25, according to Dwight Caron; chief criminal deputy for the Thurston County Sheriff's Department.
