Theories In Death Of Seattle Girl, 14

Thurston County sheriff Don Redmond said yester-day it is possible that 14-year-old Katherine Merry Devine of Seattle was sexually assaulted, murdered and then left where her body was found south of Olympia last Thursday

The girl, daughter of Sally and William L. De-yine, was last seen hitch-

yine, was last seen hitch-hiking at N. 92nd Street and Aurora Ave. N. on Nov. 25 by two classmates at Ingraham High School, according to Redmond. The Thurston County coroner, Hollis Fultz, said the girl died of strangula-tion or by a knife wound. Her throat had been slit. Katherine's body was Katherine's body was found in a wooded area of McKenny State Park, 12 miles south of Olympia, by park employes. The time of death was set at Dec. 1 or 2 by Fultz. or 2 by Fultz.

Redmond said the case may have been one of attempted rape and then homicide, with the body later dumped in the park. The girl's clothing had been partially removed.

She had been wearing bell-bottom blue denimbants, a peasant blouse,

The sheriff said Kather-ine, who would have been 15 on Christmas Day, had broken up with her boy-friend recently and may have been hitchiking to Oregon where she had friends.

Redmond and Thurston County detectives remained in Seattle last night investigating the case with the aid of Seat tle homicide detectives.

Attempt Now To Trace Girl's Path

Thurston County sheriff's deputies were in Seattle Wednesday trying to pick up the trail of a 14-year-old Seattle girl who was found dead last week in woods near Littlerock.

After four days of investigation, the body Tuesday was identified as Katherine Merry Devine, 743 North 92nd Street, Seattle.

Sheriff Don Redmond said Miss Devine was last seen November 26 at 92nd and Aurora at her home. The sheriff added the young woman had had a fight with her boyfriend, and told girlfriends she was hitchhiking south to Oregon.

Redmond said Wednesday morning from Seattle that deputies are investigating reports of a vehicle picking the Devine girl up.

According to the sheriff, November 26 was not the first time the girl had hitchhiked south. She is known to have gone to Oregon once before, and there are also reports she spent some time in Olympia Redmond said.

Last Thursday the body of Miss Devine was discovered lying face down and partially nude near the parking area of Margaret McKenny Park.

Redmond said his men are trying to pick up the Devine girl's trail and work back to December 1, the day deputies estimate she was killed.

Four Thurston County deputies are working in Seattle with that city's police department.

Thurston County Coroner Hollis Fultz said Wednesday morning he has not received an autopsy report, but hoped to get it in the morning mail.

In Olympia, deputies were confpleting identification of the girl and checking out local leads. Although Inspector Charles Graefsaid the body has been identified, he added that deputies plan to use dental charts and footprint records to complete and further confirm the identification.

An uncle, grandfather and Seattle friend were in Olympia Wednesday to identify the body.

In a false lead Tuesday, deputies went to a Lacey drive-in restaurant where a boot was reported in one of the garbage containers. Miss Devine's left boot, purse and wallet have never been found.

Officers emptied the garbage can, sifted through the refuse and found a boot — but it was a man's and had no connection with the case.
