(11) CP REPORTS THAT HER DOG HAD BEEN SHOT. CP HAD BEEN ADVISED BY NEIGHBOR THAT THEY THOUGHT THAT BILL COSDEN HAD BEEN RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SHOOTING. THIS OFFICER HAD CONTACT WITH A MRS RAFFELSON, WHO LIVES NEXT DOOR TO SUSP. SHE STATED THAT SHE WAS AWAKENED BY THE SHOT, WHICH APPEARED TO COME FROM THE COSDEN YARD. SHE THEN OBSERVED THE DOG RUNNING FROM COSDEN'S YARD, AND SAW MR. COSDEN IN HIS YARD. CONTACT MADE WITH SUSPECT WHO DENIED SHOOTING DOG.

Contacted Mrs. CAIRNS by phone this date, states Dog, Smokey is a 5 month old Black Lab and German Shepard Cross (Paul Buenger knows this dog & CP) that plays with Suspect's dogs, a white German Shep. and a Norwegian Elk Hound both in her yard and in Suspect's yard. Smokey is very friendly and not all vicious. CP stated she took Smokey to Deschutes Animal Clinic where he was treated by Dr. Cobbinco.

This officer contacted Dr. Cobbinco who gave the following:

Stated Dog Smokey was definitely shot, as there was head flecks in wound, no bones were shattered, bullet went on thru. Dog is at this time, home and is expected to recover.

Contacted neighbor of CP, a Mrs. Elmer RAFFELSON, (Scott Lake - phone 352-3595) by phone. She stated, heard gunshot at approx 0630, day of incident and saw Dog Smokey rolling on ground about a foot from Suspect's porch, howling in agony, was afraid to go to its aid as she had heard dogs in this shape may bite. Dog finally drug himself home.

Later she saw Suspect, COSDEN, looking all around his house and shrubs as if looking for the dog that may be dead.

Cosden, No Record Thurston Cty, has Beckhese Driving Reduced To Neg with DPD.

Under Sheriff made known to this officer, that COSDEN is convicted murderer, incarcerated for being mentally insane.
