Another possible lead includes the following suspect:

GOODRICH, James Roy - Rt. 1 Box 355, Rochester, Wa.

W/M/A - DOB-11/15/43, 160", 5'11", brn, blue TC#58542

He owns the residence that below listed girls live.

Informants known to this writer, Co. #32, #50, & Deputy Prosecutor Rick Straphy - identified the victim's coat as similar in appearance to that of a girl they know.

Girls are Anita age 19, Sandra age 16, Victoria age 13

THARP of Rt. 1 Box 355B, Rochester, Wa.. Mother is "Mary" THARP

Allegedly, the mother "prostitutes" the girls out & did so to some loggers who were camped at a park near Rochester, Wa.. Description fit the deceased, & so Co. #16 & #20 checked it out.

Neg. Results.

Girls were accounted for & one did closely fit the description & coat - even the teeth, but were accounted for.

However, it might be well to remember GOODRICH. See Deputy Humphrey's report, Lewis County indicated him a likely suspect as he "likes to hurt them & will cut off the girls clothing with a knife". Lead will be more thoroughly investigated.
