My reason for contact was to determine for sure what is known of the ownership of two (2) coats connected to the body of Brenda BAKER.

The victim was wearing a waist length brown corduroy coat, which is still well recalled by Margaret, Tina and Randy.

Officers found another coat placed over her body, described as a thigh length navy blue coat, "Grenoble" label, initials "RN", #27952, made in Singapore, size XL - 17-17½, "Lion" insignia. The victim's family never saw this coat. Thus, it is now discovered that the suspect is connected to this coat and brought it to use for concealment, and this is new info.

We also now know that Brenda was wearing maternity clothes loaned by her sister, Margaret, and jewelry of sister Tina. (who wants it back).
