I talked with his counselor, Mr. A. Gonzalez who advised:

1. Corden threatened a staff member on 4/30/92
2. Fighting in May '92, serious infraction
3. Fighting in May '93
4. Prior prison time at Walla Walla was numerous serious incidents, including drug use
5. He is pretty much a loner, doesn't hang out with any group, due to his unpopular reason for incarceration.
6. His release date is 5/26/96 still.
7. He has asked to go to the Sexual Predator Program & is eligible, because of the time left on sentence. He is now being "considered" for the program by DOC, Olympia, & would likely go about 9 months prior to his release date.

I advised Mr. Gonzalez on the second statement against him by a sister & that the ex-wife is considering a statement also. Bill will likely hear of this via mother or brother & prison staff should know of him likely becoming upset.

As you know through our prior correspondence, I still represent the above-named client, Mr. Cosden. I have previously indicated to Mr. Cosden that you had forwarded numerous Federal forms to the FBI regarding the possible further testing of evidence obtained of my client regarding the unsolved homicide of 303C [REDACTED]. I have further indicated to Mr. Cosden that this further testing may or may not be conclusive in either exculpating him or involving him further as a possible suspect in this matter. My client has indicated that he is obviously anxious to receive the results of this testing but I have advised him per your advice that this process may take up to one year or more.

However, it would be appreciated if you would be so kind as to forward a copy of your written correspondence to the FBI in order to simply verify to my client that this matter is currently being processed. Please delete any portions of such correspondence that you deem to be sensitive or inappropriate for review by Mr. Cosden.
