On Sunday, July 14, 1974, I went to Lake Sammamish State Park with my family. We got there at 3:30 P.M. and we stayed there until 4:45 P.M.

Between 4:00 and 4:30, I went to the women's restroom with my 22 year-old daughter. The restroom is located in the middle of the park by the concession stand. As I was waiting for my daughter, I noticed a man with a sling on his left arm. He was walking back and forth in front of the restroom. He is described as follows: 5'7" - 5'8", 170 lbs., good build, tan, but fair complected. He wore boxer-style swim trunks with Hawaiian print, with possibly a white waist band. He had some hair on his chest, but was not "hairy". No shirt. The sling on his left arm was a regular triangular bandage, beige in color. The sling was soiled. It had a safety pin on the outside of the left elbow.

His hair was dark brown, clean cut, sideburns about to the middle of the ear lobe. I don't recall if he had glasses.

Me and my daughter left the restroom area about 4:30 P.M. I don't recall if he was still there when we left.

My name is CINDY LYNN GALLOWAY, 5/16/59, 23231 SE 57th, Issaquah, Wash., 392-6743. On July 14, 1974 I arrived at Lake Sammamish State Park to participate in the Rainier Beer Picnic. There was a time when there was a break in the events when the band was playing so I went over to check on my bike. It was located 60 yds. north of the concession stand. This was approximately 2:30 P.M. I started to walk south on the sidewalk listening to my radio when I noticed a man with a sling. I recall him as being a white male, about 18 - 20, very good looking, about the same height as me, which is 5'8"; he had sandy colored hair about shoulder length. It had some body to it. His face was tan, but lighter complexion, no shirt, was tanned all over, no noticeable amount of hair on back or chest, well built, didn't appear to have a fat stomach, had short cut-offs on, appeared to be corduroys and were frayed around the bottom. No recollection of legs or feet. He had on his right arm a sling. Its main body was a canvass of muslin color with leather trim and supportive strap. No cast or bandage. Appeared to be for broken collarbone. He appeared to be standing around just north of lifeguard's picnic table. He was all alone. He was doing nothing out of the ordinary.

I made my statement which is of two pages on July 17, 1974, on my own free will.

the races. A guy came up and said hello and I said hello. Then I kind of moved away.

He asked me if I could help him for a minute. I said yeah, what do you want? He said

he was waiting for friends, but couldn't find them. He said he wanted to load his

sailboat on his car. I told him sure. I would describe him as being 5'8" - 5'10",

sandy blond hair, curly, short on sides, longer in back, 150-160 pounds, about 24-25 years

of age, dressed in a white tee-shirt with red trim (neck line was crew-type) and it had

short-sleeves, blue levis type jeans (long length, I think), I didn't notice his shoes.

Then we walked up to the car which was parked in the parking lot between the bandstand

and restrooms. He asked me what I was doing. I told him I was waiting for my husband and

parents. He said, "This is out of sight, there are so many people." He stopped many times

to hold his arm against his body as if it was hurting. That was when I first noticed he

did not have a cast on. He said he hurt it playing racket ball. Then he asked me if I had

ever played it, then he said it was alot of fun. He asked if I lived around here and I

told him Bellevue and where I worked. By that time we were close to the car. This is

when I noticed there was no trailer on the car or sailboat anywhere around. The car was

a newish looking volkswagon, bug, metallic brown in color. I asked where it was. This is

when he said, "It's at my folks house; it is just up the hill." I said I really couldn't

go with him because I had to meet my folks, that's when I asked him what the time was. I did not notice if he looked at a watch but he replied it was 12:20 and I said I was late already because I had to meet them at 12:15. He said "Oh, that's okay, I should have told you it wasn't in the parking lot." "Thanks for bothering to come up to the car."

He walked me about half way back up toward the park. He went to the right toward the bandstand and I went to the left to the concession stand. He said again, "Thanks for coming with me; I should have told you it was not in the parking lot." He was very polite at all times, very sincere, easy to talk to, he kept up a continual conversation, he was really friendly and nice smile and did not get upset when I told him I wouldn't go with him. He walked to the bandstand and I went to the concession stand and bought a snowcone. I stayed at the concession stand while eating it. It was about 10 minutes later when I saw him walking with a girl to the parking lot. The girl had a yellow bike and it looked like a ten speed because of the curved handlebars. I thought to myself that it didn't take him very long to get someone else to go to the parking lot with him. They were walking towards the parking lot (he was on the side closest to me) and the girl was inbetween him and the bike she was pushing. I could not see the girl very well. I wondered where he was going to put the bike. I met my folks about 12:45, and did not see him for the rest of the day.

I arrived at the Suds Shop at 32 E. Sunset approximately 10 A.M. on Sunday, July 14, 1974, to clean up. As I entered, a young woman entered carrying a basket of laundry who later identified herself as JAN OTT. She was wearing cut-off blue jeans, a white open collar button-up blouse, tucked in, no bra, and tennis shoes. I don't recall any jewelry. Her hair was about 2 - 3" longer than shoulder length worn loose. As I cleaned around the laundramat, we talked about what ever came up. Nothing in particular. She was going to the beach on her bike - she was a probation officer in Seattle. Lived with a friend who worked there too, but different hours. Didn't share a ride, however, because of different hours. She finished about the time I did and I asked her if she wanted a cup of coffee since I was going too, and she said, sure, as soon as she took her laundry across the street to her house. I walked to the corner of Sunset and Front with her and she took her laundry in and came out about five minutes later, looking the same as before. We walked down to Fasona's Restaurant, and sat at a small booth and talked over coffee. She said she was separated from her husband, "liberated woman". Used to live in Seattle but moved because she was ripped off and lost most of her things. All she had now was her Volkswagen,

I talked a little about myself, that I had two girls, lived in North Bend, what I did for a living and how I got involved with my business. She was a very friendly person, very outgoing and easy to talk to. Mentioned that she had had breakfast, a week or two earlier, at the Snoqualmie Falls Lodge. Mentioned that her parents lived in Spokane, WN. I believe we left the restaurant about 11:15 A.M. and walked back down to the house. She went inside after saying good-bye and I left for North Bend. That was the last I saw of her until hearing about her being missing on Tuesday evening.

I was approached by a white male, early twenties, 5'8", medium build, dark blond hair, hair length was about to the middle of his ear, average skin tone, left arm in a sling and sling was beige in color. The sling was not neat, something, either a cast or wrap was over his arm. He had a wide face, average features and his speech was smooth. He talked clearly, no slang words - everything was distinct. Sunday, July 14, 1974, I left my home with my five children about 11:00 A.M. We arrived at Lake Sammamish State Park about 11:45. I sat down and prepared my children for swimming. Approximately fifteen minutes passed and a girl sat down next to me. She was approximately 10 - 15 feet from me.

She was dressed in blue jean levi cut-offs, real short, similar to hot pants, an off-white midriff blouse with three or four buttons. She took these articles of clothing off and sat down in her swimsuit. The suit was a two-piece black bikini. She put Cocoa-butter on - it comes in a small orange jar.

Prior to laying down, she layed her 10-speed bike down in the sand, in front of where she was going to sit. The bike was a bright yellow.

When she layed down, she layed on what appeared to be a white, ordinary towel.

She layed down until 12:30. I know this because I always look at my watch. At 12:30 P.M., a guy came walking up to her. He said something about a sailboat. It sounded like, will you help me with my boat, or would you like to ride in my boat. The girl sort of hesitated, but then said

can I bring my bike with me? He said, sure, Okay. She thought the boat was at the lake, and he said no, it was at his parent's house. She looked like she wasn't going. I couldn't hear what was said then, but then I heard her say, under one stipulation, that I meet your parents. He said, sure. Then she said I don't know how to sail. He said that's OK, it will be easy for me to teach you. She asked him if there was room in the car for her bike. He said it will fit in the trunk. She got up, slipped her blue-jeans and her top on, and she then picked up her beach bag. I don't remember what the bag looked like. The two of them then left.

Monday, I heard on the radio that two girls were missing. I didn't pay too much attention until today, then I heard they were missing from Sunday at the park.

The guy I saw looked to be about 6', 180 - 185 lbs., his hair was brown and about collar length, wavy. He had a tan. It really showed up because of his white outfit. His shirt was white, T-shirt with some type of design, I don't remember what it was. He wore white shorts, similar to a swim suit, I don't remember if he had shoes on. His left arm was in a sling. The sling was beige in color. I didn't feel his arm was really hurt. I do remember he took his arm from the sling and moved it around. I didn't notice any tatooes or any scars on him. He had real hairy arms and legs. If I saw the man again I can identify him. He looked to be about 25 to 30 years old. I never saw any vehicle they left in.

On Sunday, July 14, 1974, I was at Lake Sammamish State Park. At approximately 4:00 P.M., I was heading back from the restrooms towards the point where my friends were. I was about 100 yards from the restrooms when a man who was walking towards me said, excuse me, young lady, could you help me launch my sailboat. I then asked him what he had done to his arm; he stated he had sprained it and that he couldn't find anyone to help him. I told him I was sorry, but I couldn't help him because I had people waiting. He told me that the sailboat was up the beach and that it would only take a few minutes. It appeared to me ~~that~~ he meant the boat was up towards the restrooms. I again told him I couldn't help, however, he kept on asking. I talked to him for 5 or 10 minutes. I finally just told him I was sorry and left. The last I saw of him he was walking towards the restrooms. The man I was talking with was about 6'0" to 6'2". I'm not sure how much he weighed, but I remember that he was really skinny. I would say that he had a small frame and kind of boney. His hair was salt and papper colored about 2" below his ears. It was parted in the middle and bangs over his forehead. It was curly, but looked like it

had been styled. I think his eyes were either green or blue, and he looked bug-eyed and set back. His pupils were real small. I would guess this man to be in his 30's. He was clean shaven. A guy walked by us and PAT told me he had walked around us about 8 times. I would describe him as about 24 - 25 yrs., 5'6", medium build, 150 lbs., blondish-brown curly hair covering ears and down the back of his neck, dark tan. I think the right arm was in a white sling; white cast; he wore cut-offs, unknown what type, a white or yellow shirt was tied around his waist; white low-topped tennis shoes, no glasses. He was a white male. This guy walked around us for 10 minutes and a girl came up and sat down about 4 feet from us. The girl had on a pair of cut-offs, white earrings and a light brown shag hair cut. The guy came up and talked to her. I did not hear anything that was said. He talked to her for about 15 minutes. I did not pay any attention to them. We left and I did not see him again. The girl he was talking to was not one of the missing girls.

On Sunday, July 14, 1974, my youngest daughter, BECKY, 5 yrs., and I went to Lake Sammamish State Park near Issaquah. We arrived at the park at approximately 12:30 P.M. and by the time we found a parking spot and got out of the car, it was approximately 1:00 P.M. I parked across from the Ranger Station entrance in the grass parking area, and we walked from there through the wooded area toward the beach, passed the concession stand. We stopped by the second lifeguard stand, south of the peninsula, and I layed on the sandy beach on a blanket while my daughter played in the sand nearby. I stayed in this area the entire afternoon, sunning and picnicing. We were about ten feet from the lifeguard stand.

Later in the afternoon, I observed a young white male walking toward me from the area of the small peninsula, north of me. The reason I noticed him, among all the people, was because he had his left arm in a sling. He walked slowly, looking around, toward me and passed in front of me at a distance of about six feet. He walked right by the lifeguard stand, just on the east side of it, in the sand. I paid particular attention to him because I have suffered four broken arms and the sling the man had his arm in was very unusual. The man was about 20 to 26 years old, 5'6", or 5'7" tall, average

build, with an even, medium suntan, and brown hair that I would call short by today's standards. The hair appeared to be combed back from the forehead, neatly groomed, exposing his ears. The hair would not have reached his collar had he been wearing a shirt with a collar. He had no moustache or sideburns. He was wearing an ordinary white short sleeved T-shirt, made of thinner material as I could almost visualize his tan through the T-shirt. He wore a red pair of boxer swim trunks with short legs. They may have had some white piping on the side where the seam would be. He was barefoot. I did not notice any unusual amount of body hair. I noticed no watch or jewelry. I would describe his facial expression as sort of expressionless without smile or frown. He casually glanced from side to side as he passed.

The most unusual thing about him was the sling on his left arm. It didn't look like a typical muslin sling, but rather a thin off-white dish towel. The sling covered from the wrist to the elbow and appeared to be frayed or worn along the outside edge toward the left shoulder. The sling was looped around his neck. The sling looked like he could take his arm in and out of it without untying it. The arm was not in the usual sling position. It hung lower than his wrist. The ribbon looked separate from the sling and didn't seem to have any purpose. I couldn't visualize any useful purpose for the ribbon.

SGT. RANDALL received a call from MRS. EWBANK (Psch. #2) with an updated chart reading concerning the missing women, OTT and NASLUND.

1. Stated that on April 29, 1974, this Department handled someone concerning gambling, money or death, that had something to do with NASLUND missing.
2. On approx. 7/18/74, an unreliable witness threw us off the track.
3. She feels that either on the 25th or 26th, something may have happened to DENISE, possibly death. She feels that the OTT girl is dead.
4. She feels that the unreliable witness may have had something to do with the death of NASLUND.
5. Six days from now (7/26/74) we will receive some kind of communication regarding locating DENISE.
6. Her daughter saw (in a vision) a dark haired female dead in the bathtub, and the girl's hair was parted in the middle. She saw the body coming up, from the tub, at her.
7. She "saw" a swimming pool - at a very large house with a tall brown fence (with slats very close together so as to not be able to see in), and the swimming pool had a body in it. She saw someone standing on the diving board. She saw a man, with a lot of hair (with bangs) who pushed the person on the board into the pool.
8. She feels that two different people, not associated with one another, but who are working for the same business, possibly organized crime, are possibly involved with the girls' disappearance.
9. She feels the location of the missing girls has changed from that which was originally charted, and in an earlier report. She feels that DENISE will be located 2 miles N-NE of Queen Anne Hill, in a large house.

She feels that JAN OTT will be located 9 miles W-NW of Lake Sammamish State Park, from where she was missing.

DET. ROLF GRUNDEN - INTERVIEW WITH PSYCHICS

Det.: I understand you can possibly help us with the two missing girls, is that right?

Psyc: Well, I'd like to try and I'll go back to the beginning. . . a week ago Sunday, I suddenly saw a young woman, in the water, all I could see was her hair and her face, and I knew she was dead. I remember thinking how irritating it must be to have the water lapping at her lower lip, and around her ears, because I didn't like that when I did a lot of swimming. Then I realized she was dead. All of a sudden I thought, my gosh, I was concerned as I have an 18 year old daughter and for just a minute I thought it was my daughter, then I realized no, the girl's hair wasn't as long, or as thick. I didn't remember mentioning it to my husband, but he said I did, and it was between 8:00 and 8:30, closer to 8:30 he thinks. Anyway, the picture kept coming back and I couldn't put it out of my mind. I did, however, and it wasn't until Wednesday when someone at work mentioned the disappearance of the girls that I said I had briefly heard something about it. Then when I picked up the paper and saw the pictures, there were so many that I try not to read or think about them that upsets me since I have three young daughters of my own. . . . This man at work said the TV stations said they would like some help, so if ever there was a good reason to help, this is it. I called and offered my help, or said I understand you would like some help on this, and JEAN ENERSON said, No, we didn't say that, we said that a Psychic had been called in from out of state. Then I decided I would call the Issaquah Police, so I gave the information I had to a girl there whom I now know as PAULA. I gave the full description of the young lady I had seen to PAULA, the one in the water.

PSYC: The next day I had additional information and when I called, PAULA said they did want the information and that Chief PROSISE had some other people there at the time she brought my note in, and that he said I had described the DENISE NASLUND girl. The girl that I saw had not dark brown hair, that's why I didn't tie them in as the girl I had seen in the picture had very black hair, and this girl had Patrician-type features; her hair, I felt, was parted in the middle - you see, that's the picture they had in the paper, and the hair isn't that dark. Later on I'll tell you about the blonde, her hair is blonde, and not that brown. But in that picture you can see, and Chief PROSISE showed us a close-up of her, you can see her nose and chin. She is more Patrician ^{he said} than it looked in the papers. What occurred to me is that/I couldn't have gotten that from the newspapers (the description), and that she was very fair skinned. That was the NASLUND girl.

The first one. . . she was right up next to shore, and there was a tree branch right over her. I didn't know you had Maples here, but I said I thought it was a Maple just from the way the branch was, and the way the leaves were. I was sure it wasn't a Weeping-Willow, although later a Weeping-Willow did enter the picture. Later, we found . . . I said, what is that tree, and it turned out to then be a Maple which had a branch falling just exactly the way I had seen it over the girl in the water.

DET.: Can I interrupt you for just a minute?

PSYC.: Certainly.

DET.: When you say water, are we talking about a big body of water, such as this . . . or are we talking about a possible creek bed, such as that . . . or that . . .

PSYC.: Okay. The first one - I can't tell you that because the way she was in the water, she was up close to shore, and she wasn't floating.

PSYC.: She was ~~lay~~ing and her shoulders were under, and the way the light was hitting the water I couldn't see whether she had clothing on, a bathing suit, or what. But at that point I couldn't tell you.

Later in the afternoon I did something I had never done before; I meditated on, and tried to get some more information on that original impression I had gotten. I got some very strong impressions of a creek bed or stream, it is that stream at Lake Sammamish Park. Through the process of elimination, I knew how the trees felt, I knew what the opposite bank was like, and I knew how wide the area was from my second impression. Then I felt it must be Marymoor, so Wednesday night, when I decided to help, I went out there and I didn't get a feeling about anything, and later I knew that if her body had been there, I'd have been able to feel it. Thursday night we went to Marymoor and it didn't feel right. Then Friday night, we went out in the boat with Chief PROSISE. Friday morning, I got this impression of this house, have you seen the drawing of the house? The weeping-willow tree? We found everything almost exactly as it had popped into my mind, and I've never been in a boat on Lake Sammamish. The only thing was, the house was a little more over, instead of being back, up from the steps and the dock where it should be, and there is "something" about that house . . . But that's on MRS. OTT - that has to do with MRS. OTT.

Sunday afternoon, about 5:00, I was absolutely impelled to get out there to Lake Sammamish Park, and I absolutely don't like public places.

DET: This last Sunday, the 22nd?

PSYC.: Umm-hmm. We've been here for 8 or 9 years, and I've been there once on a picnic with the children, and once we drove around, so twice in all this time. I could see the bend in the park, or rather in the stream, and we walked along there. There is one place, and maybe this will mean something. . . there's one place where is, I said to LYNN, let's wait,

PSYC.: let's sit down here, and stop a minute. There's a tree stump right on the bank, and I sat down there and looked toward the river, and for just a couple of seconds I felt I was going to be sick at my stomach. So Monday, I called PAULA at Issaquah and I told her to please have them check that area again. I know, I know that she wasn't in there before, but I . . . I can't say that I know. . . I feel that she is in there now. I was curious, and my husband showed me a picture of an aerial view taken. . .

DET.: Here's an aerial showing the river . . . can you see it?

PSYC.: Is that a river? What I called a stream?

DET.: This would be the stream you are referring to right here, OK?

PSYC.: And this is the beach, here?

DET: This is the beach, the float, the parking lot you're referring to. The only stream I'm aware of, keep in mind I've not personally tromped through this area, I've been doing different types of work, but our crews have gone through all this area here. So the only stream I'm aware of in the park area is this one.

PSYC.: Okay, is there . . . and I don't know because I've purposely refrained from reading. . . was she seen way up here by the stream?

DET: Hmm-mm. (Negative)

PSYC.: Okay. By the way, I very definitely had the feeling, even the first time I had this impression, that the girl had been gotten to. She was trusting and her end had come very quickly.

PSYC. #2: Now let's see, you were parked in the second lane the other night. You parked right in here, walked down here to somewhere right in here.

(Discussion about some pictures being shown the Psychics by Det. GRUNDEN followed.)

PSYC #3: Is this what you call the Sammamish Slough? That goes down into the lake also?

DET: No. The Sammamish Slough, that I'm aware of, is down towards the Bothell. . .

PSYC #2: There's another one like this - the one we saw Sunday?

There are lots of streams that lay like this, and all these places.

Was the bank the same, do you remember?

#2

PSYC: Its the trees . . . there were lots of trees but not as wide. One ~~of the~~ descriptions ~~by you~~ omitted (from your flashes) ~~was~~ ~~rding~~ the ~~the~~ opposite bank of about 20 feet.

PSYC.: It was a small bank, about 2 feet high that was absolutely clear of vegetation - it was as though it was just too high for vegetation to grow. Then off to the right there was something brown. . . could be a bridge. . . I couldn't make it out.

PSYC. #2: That was opposite the body, you thought.

PSYC: That was opposite the body, and there was a small boat to the right of the body, and somewhere in there there was a giant, enormous weeping-willow. (But a lot of that could be symbolic, and I don't know anything about that.) When I did the meditation, and we can send you copies of the drawings and the things that I did that afternoon, the thing that I saw then was the same individual. . . the impression of a man. This man was . . . now I think that MRS. OTT is getting involved somehow, because I definitely feel she's alive, and I don't feel that DENISE is alive. I think its her body that they'll find on a cold, rainy, windy day. But this man, that I've drawn a picture of, I tried to draw him a little more clearly on Sunday because he kept coming back to me. That is the man, I feel, you should be looking for. You know how his hair is featured was featured in Sunday's newspaper; its chopped, and kind of blunt, and its full. He's got a lot of hair, I guess they call it tapered, don't they? But this man is going to fall into your hands, somehow; at first I thought it was giving himself up, but

PSYC.: that's not it. Somehow, or other, you're going to come into possession of this man, but if you don't know that its the man you want, you're going to let him go. But if when you see him, if you picture him with a lot of hair all over him, as though he was in a gorilla or monkey suit, you will know, and he's like this . . . he blows his smoke, . . . you see. . . like that. A real up-tight, bad individual.

I got a strong impression of another man - the GEORGE MAHARIS-type. And why I was so confused. . . there's still something there because this fellow. . . I thought the other fellow was this fellow, but with sunglasses and a moustache, at least that's what I said in the meditation. But I really do have a sense of urgency about this. I had told PAULA I would get the picture in to her, and I was so busy, I worked late last night . . . but this morning, I really, just feel better if you all know that this is the fellow.

DET: What is that on top of his head?

PSYC.: Its a cap. And I cannot get that visor. . .

PSYC #2: Is it like an Andy Capp. . . you know, in the Seattle Times?

PSYC.: Ya, and one of the flashes (impressions), I even drew a picture of the beak being curved like that. But on this, I couldn't get it. But on this I couldn't get it . . . there was so much hair, and I tried to show. . . I'm not an artist at all. . . I'm trying to show how its in layers. . . its not done by a barber. It looks like it was just snipped, like that.

DET.: Okay. Now you say that we'll encounter this man. Do you mean "we" as the Homicide Unit back there, or "we" as the police agency?

PSYC.: No. . . no, the police. Its going to be some little innocuous thing. . . you won't have to go after him. You won't have to fight for him or anything. He's going to fall into your hands.

DET.: Like a traffic citation, or something . . .

PSYC.: Something like that . . . and he's cool. Unless you know that you're looking for him, you're not . . . he's going to get away. But he's the key to that young lady, I feel.

PSYC #2: You stated that the moustache was out also, you know, you kind of skipped that one flash that you got on the other man and the impression of him. The motorcycle and the . . .

PSYC.: Oh yes. . . now the motorcycle and that man with the big moustache, and the big sunglasses and the cap, and black motorcycle jacket . . . very GEORGE MAHARIS-type, I had feeling was a very suave sort of person, and he's the one I tie up with that house. I saw him and the motorcycle right in front of that house when I saw the house. The first time we went by, LYNN got a real funny feeling, and I was going like this, but Chief PROSISE was going so fast and the noise of the boat, it was just . . . I said I would like to go back and look at that and I touched Officer PEECH, so we went back and then I saw that the house was exactly like I had drawn it, and its quite different from most of the styles around here, and I didn't realize that until after we'd gotten out on the lake , but I'd like to. . .

OET.: Did ^{Chief} the/get that guy's name and address, do you know?

PSYC.: There was an automobile in the driveway, and they were going to check out the license.

PSYC. #2: They said it was close to the Vasa, or . . .

PSYC.: Vasa Park, or Waverly, I couldn't remember whether its either Vasa Beach Park, or Beach Club, or Waverly Apts. We'd been out for 4 hours, and we were so tired and exhausted.

Also, now on to the OTT girl. . . I feel very definitely that she's still alive and she's being held prisoner. . . in something enclosed. Whether its a shed, or. . . it wouldn't be a basement. . . its a cellar, an old-fashioned cellar, you know, like with either no windows, or very small windows. She's hidden, but she's alive.

DET: Who's hiding her?

PSYC.: I don't know. I think that this fellow that I saw on the motorcycle has a part in it. We don't have, uh . . .

DET.: Now, this motorcycle guy we're talking about, do you know what the terminology "colors" means?

PSYC.: Colors?

DET.: Okay, "colors" in motorcycle terminology means (to a motorcycle gang) the Levi jacket, cut-off and they wear their emblem on the back whether its Hell's Angels, or . . .

PSYC.: Oh, like that, ya. . . I didn't know that's what they called it.

DET.: Did you see anything like that in your thoughts, or . . .

PSYC.: There was something up here. . . uh, I used to work for the military so I understand bars. . . it wasn't that although it did seem to me that he did have the Epaulets , but there is something here, and I don't even know if that's where they would be wearing them, but besides his jacket, there was something here . . . I had the feeling that one was round and one was like a diamond shape, but right there. . . .

DET.: Was this guy a dirty-looking guy?

PSYC.: He could be if he weren't clean-shaven. But he's too much of a lady's man, the one I saw . . .

DET.: Now, back to the NASLUND girl. How did she die?

PSYC.: Uh, it was quick, whatever it was. I have . . .

DET.: Did you see a lot of blood? Or did someone strangle her?

PSYC.: No. . . no, as a matter of fact, in the meditation, it was this fellow, or someone like him, wearing a cap. Now, if it is this fellow, and I believe that it is, he hit her, he had something in his right hand and he hit her, right here, one DREADFUL blow, and then she fell.

PSYC.: Also, this I'm not too sure of, whether the girl I saw like this, tied by her wrists, was the NASLUND girl, or the OTT girl. I don't know why I reject it for the NASLUND girl. I . . . I think its the OTT girl, but I feel that the NASLUND girl was hit, it was fast, it was swift. . .

DET.: What was she hit with?

PSYC.: In the meditation that I saw, the impression was something that looked like an upside-down bottle, but not quite like a bottle. . . like . . . a . . . what was it that I called it. . . like this . . . and I think that you're going to find this when you find her. Its going to be at the scene, because something just like this was in this other flash I got this morning. . . now whatever that is . . .

DET.: Like a "sap"?

PSYC.: Like a what?

DET.: Like the old police used to use. . . the saps, leather with, uh,

PSYC.: Uh, black-jacks, billy-clubs. My uncle was a policeman. . . only it was larger. . . my uncle's would have been comparably speaking like that, yes. . . now this was about 4 times thicker. So it might have been, maybe a piece of driftwood - looked like driftwood, but it was solid, and he hit her right here. But the feeling that I got when I saw it was that it was very quick.

DET.: Okay. Were either of these girls sexually abused?

PSYC.: I don't get anything out of that. I didn't get anything out of that. Now the OTT girl, by the way, and we discussed this just a little bit, on Sunday, but let's go back then to Thursday night, well about 9:00 after PAULA called and we had gone out to Mary Moor and we had come back in, Chief PROSISE called and he said that he'd like to meet and talk, and I said all right. I said, by the way, a little while ago, I saw the picture of the other girl, the light-haired girl, whose

PSYC.: hair looked very brown in the paper, but I said that the hair that I have with that face is light hair, blonde hair, with brownish streaks, not dark like that. He said that was right, apparently that was an older picture. But that girl, I saw her, the impression I got of her, was dancing like this, you know, then all of a sudden I thought that's funny, what was it, and analyzed it later, but the reason she was appearing to be in slow motion, I feel she was either very, very tired, or doing a Go-Go-type dance, it wasn't a party as I had first thought, or I've never seen anyone drugged, except on television but there's the possibility of that.

DET.: Anything else that . . .

PSYC. #2: You kept mentioning that this man looked like a Chimpanzee or monkey with a smashed-in face, and I don't know if you had that on the description.

PSYC.: Yes, looks like an ape, gorilla or chimpanzee, my husband says there are differences, and I don't know the difference between them. All I know is that he looked like an ape, gorilla or chimpanzee, and his features are flat. And I wish I could have drawn that nose.

DET.: Is it like a "pug" nose?

PSYC.: No, its not a "pug nose, it comes down, and see everybody else's sort of comes ^{out} /s, and his, I don't know, it just spreads, but its got sort of a . . .

DET.: What type of weapon, or how was she killed in your opinion? Or can you do this?

PSYC #2: At this point I can't. It might be that if I studied the charts some more that I could tell some more, but at this point, I really can't.

PSYC: Did you, or could you get the feeling of blood, or anything?

With me it was. . . it seemed . . . even strangulation, if I hadn't had

PSYC #2: No, I didn't.

PSYC.: if I hadn't had that picture of the man hitting her, because it was . . clean, she was not bruised or battered but then all I could see was this side, but there was no blood. You said also that he would fall into their hands. . .

PSYC. #2: I didn't say that, but I felt that he seems to be fairly close to the police, in terms of the charts, that's not physically necessarily, but that he's someone you could find easily, except that he's disguised.

PSYC. Isn't that funny that you would say that. I'm glad that you were able to see that because I felt silly to say that the fellow may not give himself up, but he's so close to it, so close to being.

PSYC. #2: Ya, I think he makes a mistake somewhere along the line. I think he had maybe a plan, or something, and something about it doesn't work. I almost get the feeling he's a drug pusher, but that's not really what he's doing it for. I think there's more involved. There's money involved somewhere. And I thought even maybe it could be prostitution, of some sort.

DET.: Regarding which girl now?

PSYC. #2: Well, I assume its the same person. I get kind of a similar picture with both of them. Like I say, there are these two different things involved, whether its two people, or one man with two different intentions, or like schizophrenic - two different personalities, I don't know just what it is. But, somehow or other, what he does and his intentions, and the way he goes about it, he makes a mistake somewhere.

PSYC.: We thought about White-slavery. This is the feeling I got with the OTT girl, that she was captured, and is being held to try to convince her to go into this type of a life, and she's resisting it.

PSYC. #2: I can't tell whether it would be drugs, or what. All those fit into this one particular pattern. It could be any of them. . . . Because unfortunately you have only one little symbol to work with that covers a lot of things, you have to decide what it is.

DET: Okay, on NASLUND . . .

PSYC. #2: On the other one, I got the impression she was all right, at least at the point of, I believe, Wednesday was the last chart I did on her. She was cooperating with whatever was going on. She was cooperating intentionally, like she was having a love affair with one of the persons who is involved, or thought she was, and also that she was quite heavily under drugs so she'd be totally in a state of illusion. It wouldn't be anything real, or anything she intended to get into, but that she was under the illusion that she was having a love affair, or something. But there's money involved there, and that's probably because its the same person, but I felt that wherever she was, she was in very fancy, expensive surrounding. Now, maybe she's not there, maybe she's down in the basement or something, but wherever she is, is a very fancy, expensive place. Whether its a place of entertainment, I can't tell, it looked like it might be. Also, I don't know, I was wondering if this is true, it seems to say that she had a very unhappy early family-life and is a rather independent person as a result.

DET.: That's correct.

PSYC. #2: She had at least one court appearance?

DET.: Yup.

PSYC. #2: Well, that's encouraging because the rest of it might then be true. Uh, she did have a transaction concerning money and maybe drugs. And I get the feeling that its all a part of something bigger, you know, like either organized crime, drug traffic, or whatever. (All this happening within something like that.)

PSYC. #2: There's something about the person who called in. . .to report her being missing. There's something undisclosed about that person according to the chart. There may be a clue as to what has happened through him. Is he separated from her?

DET.: Well, he and she are, so to speak, roommates, they're separated now I guess.

PSYC. #2: I guess I was thinking that was the one who had a husband from Issaquah . . .

DET.: No, we're talking about NASLUND.

PSYC. #2: I guess I got her mixed up, I was thinking that was the one who had a husband in California.

DET.: The other girl - ya, she's separated also . . . due to him going to school, and her job.

PSYC. #2: Ya - well, this wasn't that chart - I forgot which one I was talking about for a minute. . . . Ya, this had to do with DENISE . . . that the person who called might have . . . there might be something to do with him that is undisclosed that could bring some clue. Now, I have never been sure if I trusted this kind of thing - the distances and time, but the chart shows her being 44 miles N-NW of a point somewhere on Queen Anne Hill. And I don't know if this means anything, or not, because its always been really hard for me to find the distances involved, and sometimes there's other elements involved.

DET.: Why did you use Queen Anne Hill as a point of reference.

PSYC. #2: Because this particular chart I got this information out of was based on a conversation that came up about it which took place on Queen Anne Hill. You could say, maybe, just Seattle, in general, I don't know, that's how I pin-pointed it.

DET.: Okay. . .

PSYC. #2: But when I looked on the map, it would have had to have been, maybe across the Sound on one of the islands, and I don't know, it didn't make any sense to me and it might not be meaningful at all. But that was the only distance I was able to figure out.

And the other one came to about 9 miles N of someplace in Seattle. Whether it was the city limits, or somewhere, I don't know. The one that I felt would be dead when she is found - that the body would be at that distance.

DET: OTT would be dead, and NASLUND be alive?

PSYC. #2: That's according to my charts. Ya.

PSYC.: Well, now she may . . . see there was the business about transposing - and so I might have them transposed - remember, I told you about that . . . that whole problem with the typing . . .

PSYC. #2: Ya. . .

PSYC.: That whole night, that's what you said. . . transpose . . . transpose. . .

PSYC.: Something was transposed. . . it was driving me nuts . . . what was transposed? I wonder if I got the girls transposed.

(Conversation with each other - the Psychics. . . they seemed to agree that it was probably the girls that the first Psyc. had transposed.)

DET: How much have any of you read in the paper, of this material?

PSYC.: With me, I didn't read anything until the night you showed me the pictures.

PSYC. #3 - Ya, that's when I did, the first time I saw it, was that Thursday?

DET.: How 'bout you, , have you read any of this in the paper?

PSYC. #2: The first I read, was the article she showed her, and what was in that? It was just briefly describing the pictures . . .

PSYC.: Just the picture, ya.

PSYC. #2: Then in the Sunday paper, I saw that there was a picture like this one here, with some little circles around it, and I read the caption that was under that, that's all I read.

PSYC.: I have tried, deliberately, not to. In fact, I almost decided this morning not to talk with you so I wouldn't be thinking up from you until . . . you know, because . . .
