I know how busy you are and hesitate to bother you, but please have your "Ted" Team at least read my theory:

- What if "Ted" carried a tranquilizer gun in his arm sling, cast or metal brace? This might explain why the victims all disappeared without causing any disturbances and may explain the blood spots on Ann Healy's pillow.
- RE: The Cast:
 - 1. Were autographs or drawings seen on cast? Important as to whether cast was authentic.

2. Assuming that the cast was "Teds":

Killer Of Seven

SEATTLE (UPI) - Bit by bit, piece by piece, King County police are solving the grisly mystery of what happened to young women who disappeared from this area and from neighboring Northwest states within

the past year.

The remains of seven young women have been found so far at two sites within 10 miles of each other. Police are looking for a man who calls himself "Ted," who apparently enticed his victims by asking for their help.

The latest breaks in the case came last week with

en. One of the victims was Kathleen Parks, 20, Lafayette, Calif.

Miss Parks, a 5-foot-7 coed from Oregon State University, left her resi- July 14. dence hall last May 6 to take a walk on the campus at Corvallis, Ore. That was the last time she was seen fied. Other missing womalive.

Earlier in the day, the remains of Linda Ann Healey, 21, the first of the young women to suddenly disappear, were identified.

Miss Healey, Seattle, disappeared from her apartment near the Uni- 18, Evergreen State Colversity of Washington Jan. 31, 1974. A rumpled bed and a trace of blood on the bedspread suggested to police that she had struggled with her abductor.

Police said their search of the Mt. Taylor area near North Bend, Wash., had recovered the bones of four persons, three of them now identified.

A comparison of dental charts with teeth remaining in a jawbone resulted in identification of the remains of Brenda Carol Ball, 22, who last was seen about 2 a.m. June 1, 1974, near a south King County tavern.

The latest dental charts of Susan Rancourt, 18, a Central Washington State College coed who vanished from the Ellensburg campus last April 17, were sent to her dentist at Anchorage, Alaska.

The remains of Miss Parks and Miss Healey were also identified through dental charts.

Gentlemen:

This letter is in reference to the enclosed article clipped from our Sunday paper, March 9th.

Last summer, about the 2nd week of August or there abouts, my husband and I stopped for a couple of days at the Vasa Park camping site on Lake Sammanish (3500 W.) on our way to British Columbia.

The evening we arrived we could not locate the showers (which our AAA book had described as being at this park) to refresh ourselfs after the long trip from Spokane. Early the next morning, just at the crack of dawn and it still being quite shadowy, I arose and went out in a desperate search for a shower. I met a man coming out of the restrooms, going back to his camper, who directed me to a house type of structure... directly on the water which he said he thought might be a "bathhouse" and where I might find a shower. I walked down to the waterfront and tried the door on the right (facing the lake) of the building. It seemed locked but I tried turning the knob an other time thinking that it might just be stuck. It didn't open and seeing that the "bathhouse" looked a little unkept I presumed that it was probably just a storage place. I turned to go whereupon I thought I heard a low muffled moan. I then rapped on the door a couple of times at which point the "moans" came again low and long. At this point I became fearful thinking I had probably come upon "hippies" under the influence of drugs who had taken advantage of this empty building to stay in for the night. I hastened away a little frightened returning immediately to our campsite and related the incident to myhusband. We decieded it would be best for us to notifythe manager but we forgot to do so in the excitement of planning a day of sightseeing in Seattle. When we returned that night it was too late to talk with the manager as they had a sign posted that they wanted no distrubance after a certain hour because of an invalide member of the family. (We never saw them out once while we were there) We left early the next day, too early to talk with them and of course the whole thing soon left our minds.

My sister visted with us from Spokane in the fall and I mentioned this experience to her. She said that she had known about the disappearance of the two women near that lake at the time we were in Washington but did not want to tell us fearing that it would dampen the excitement of our trip. We would have called the police before leaving Seattle if we had of known this.

The memory of this incident revived again upon reading the enclosed article. My husband and I deceided we should convey this information to you assuming a search of this place might uncover evidence that would trap this terrible killer and bring them to justice.

If we can be of further help please feel free to call upon us.
