Did 'Ted' Abduct N.Y. Coed?

A suspect in a Syracuse, N.Y., abduction bears a strong resemblance to the elusive "Ted" who figured in the disappearance of at least two local women, police here learned yesterday.

The two are among six Washington women who have mysteriously dropped from sight since Jan. 31.

The Syracuse case concerns a young coed who vanished 20 months ago. A description and composite drawing of a young man the coed was last seen with is similar to that of "Ted," the man who was seen leaving Lake Sammamish State Park July 14, with Janice Ott, 23, of Issaquah.

Syracuse police said yesterday that Karen Levy, 18, a Syracuse University freshman, posted a notice on a school

bulletin board asking for a ride to Monmouth, N.J., where her boyfriend was attending college.

A man calling himself Bill Lacy responded. He claimed he was in Syracuse on business and was heading back to the Monmouth area.

Like "Ted," Lacy was described as being slim, clean-cut and in his early 20s. He had brown hair like Ted's. However, he was near six feet in height compared to Ted's five feet six or seven.

Capt. Herbert Swindler of Seattle's Homicide and Robbery Section said yesterday that estimates of height "are frequently way off." Lacy also parted his hair differently and wore it shorter, but facial features were similar.

Miss Levy was last seen heading to-

ward a parking lot near the Syracuse campus with Lacy. As in the cases of the missing Washington women, no trace of Miss Levy or the young man has been found.

The lead came to light yesterday from information given to The Post-Intelligencer by an Olympia resident who responded to The P-I's plea for information on the baffling disappearances.

City and county police are investigating. The P-I has posted a \$5,000 reward for information leading to the conviction of the person or persons responsible for the disappearances of the six Washington women and four-year-old Heidi Peterson.

In a related development, yesterday, Ellensburg, Wash. police said an attempted abduction occurred four days after Susan Rancourt, 18, disappeared from the CWSC campus.

The information came from a library worker who told of an unidentified coed who was approached April 21 by a young man with his arm in a sling. The "Ted" at Lake Sammamish had his arm in a cast.

The man asked for help in loading some books in his car. The girl assisted him. Then he ordered her to start the car.

The coed refused and was told to get in the car. She ran to the library and told several people what had happened. The young man apparently did not try to follow her.

City and county police also will investigate the Ellensburg report. At the moment, the strongest leads in any of the disappearances relate to the so-called

Ted. But the disappearances may not all be connected.

Mrs. Ott and Denise Naslund, 19, both vanished from the state park on the same day, July 14. Miss Rancourt was last seen on the evening of April 17 near her dormitory.

The other disappearances involve University of Washington coeds Linda Ann Healy, 21, and Georgann Hawkins, 18.

Donna Manson, 19, was on her way to a concert March 12 at Evergreen State College near Olympia when she was last seen. Yesterday the Manson family added another \$1,000 to the \$500 reward offer for information leading to her whereabouts. The reward is being administered by the college.

Heidi Peterson, 4, was apparently taken from the front yard of her home on Feb. 21.

No trace of any of the missing people has been found.

Lt. Richard Kraske of the county Homicide and Robbery unit made a plea again yesterday for photographs or film taken at Lake Sammamish State Park on July 14.

"We're looking for crowd shots or parking lot shots. Anything that might have unidentified people in it. We will return any film that is given to us."

County police yesterday added six more men to the investigation to handle the leads that have been coming in since The P-I posted its reward. The county now has 12 men working on the case who have put in more than 5,000 hours of investigation.

City police have assigned seven men to work on the disappearances.

The Reward

The Post-Intelligencer, in an attempt to assist authorities in the solution of the mysterious disappearances of six women and Heidi Peterson since Jan. 31 of this year, is offering a reward of \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of any person or persons responsible for the disappearances. This reward of \$5,000 will be paid to the first person who comes forward and whose information leads to the first conviction. Write any information to "P-I Reward," The Se-

The P-I's reward raised to \$30,500 the amount being offered in connection with the disappearances. The other \$25,500 has been offered by families and friends for the safe return of all seven missing persons — Heidi Peterson, \$15,000; Lynda Healy, \$2,000; Janice Ott, Denise Naslund and Susan Rancourt, \$1,000 each; Georgann Hawkins, \$5,000, and Donna Manson, \$500.

IT WAS TOO LATE TO FIND KAREN

To the parents of 18-year-old Karen Levy, a freshman at Syracuse University, the policeman at the other end of the telephone line seemed cold and indifferent. Mr. and Mrs. Bertram Levy had called the Syracuse police from their home in Cherry Hill, N.J. to report their only daughter missing. "She's probably gone south," the policeman replied laconically. "They all do. She'll be back in class on Tuesday."

She wasn't. Now, 18 months later, Mrs. Levy thinks that Karen is almost surely dead. And she and her husband are just as certain that had police acted more quickly, Karen might still be alive.

The experience has prompted the Levys to lead a fight to change the laws to authorize—and in some cases force—law enforcement agencies, including the FBI, to enter "missing persons" cases more quickly. More than a million children are officially listed as

missing every year, and many more run away and are not reported. Most eventually return home or later contact their parents, but an astonishing number are never heard from again, and some, inevitably, meet foul play.

Karen had advertised on her dormitory bulletin board for a ride from Syracuse to Long Branch, N.J. to join her boyfriend for his birthday celebration. A stranger, who identified himself as Bill Lacy, answered her ad. Karen was careful enough to ask two friends to accompany her to look Lacy over. He seemed harmless enough.

Karen's boyfriend called the police that evening when she did not show up, but they would not accept a missing report from a nonrelative. Her parents, out of town until the following day, filed a report, but got the impression they were not being taken seriously. "Every time we'd call," Mrs. Levy remembers, "some different officer would take

the same information over and over." It was not until Monday evening, 72 hours after Karen's disappearance, that the police undertook a full investigation. The FBI never officially entered the case at all.

Sylvia Levy is resigned. "My husband's just not willing to accept it," she explains, "but I do. But I will never rest until Karen is brought home and buried with some dignity."

With the aid of Rep. Edwin Forsythe (R., N.J.), Sylvia Levy has zealously campaigned for special legislation that would authorize FBI intervention when someone voluntarily accepts a ride to a destination across state lines and doesn't arrive within a reasonable time—a case like Karen's. Because of the staggering work load this would generate, the FBI has thus far opposed the idea. But Sylvia Levy is not to be dissuaded. "It's not just Karen Levy legislation I'm after," she insists. "Some other kid is going to make the same mistake. I fear for the next one. Why should another family have to endure this?" It was little consolation, she recalls, when one detective told her: "Don't worry. Whoever did this, we'll catch him. They're all repeaters. He'll do it again."

I am forwarding enclosed reports to you for whatever it's worth. This man was booked on several Fail to Appear Traffic Warrants out of Fife, Wash., on 12-1-75. I was called at home by jailor Menson who observed the strong similarities between your Ted suspect and this subject [REDACTED]. He also noted that he fit the physical description very well, even to having a small scar on his right cheek which is vertical and not too pronounced. Menson asked this man about the cars he now owned and was told that he owned a 64 Ford T-bird. He then asked him if he ever owned a Volkswagon and [REDACTED] said he owned one at one time but he sold it three months ago. Menson noted that in [REDACTED]'s property, he had received a citation by a Trooper last month on a Volkswagon with lic #AQK [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] tends to favor his right arm as you will note in the photograph. A copy of the booking sheet is forwarded as well as cases involving prior arrests as a juvenile by Tacoma Police Dept. We have a couple colored pictures that are available in the event you wish to pursue this subject further. I must admit in comparing it with the composite your dept. submitted earlier, there is a strong resemblance. But I could not find any sexual misconduct in the local files on him. However I did not check Western State Hospital or Seattle files.

Mrs. Jarvis did not attempt to contact me until Sunday because she had not seen the most recent sketch. It was only after she saw the sketch that she connected the suspect "Ted" with the young man she had seen. Mrs. Jarvis stated that the man was standing beside the road but was not hitchhiking. He was short (about 5'7) with sandy hair, parted in the middle. He had a cast on his left arm, which was in a sling and was wearing a blue denim type shirt. (She does not recall any other items of clothing.) Mrs. Jarvis said she was attracted to him because as she stopped her car she noticed he stared at her with an unusual intense look and it frightened her as it appeared he could be mentally disturbed. Mrs. Jarvis said there was no visible car (VW or any other make) in the vicinity.
