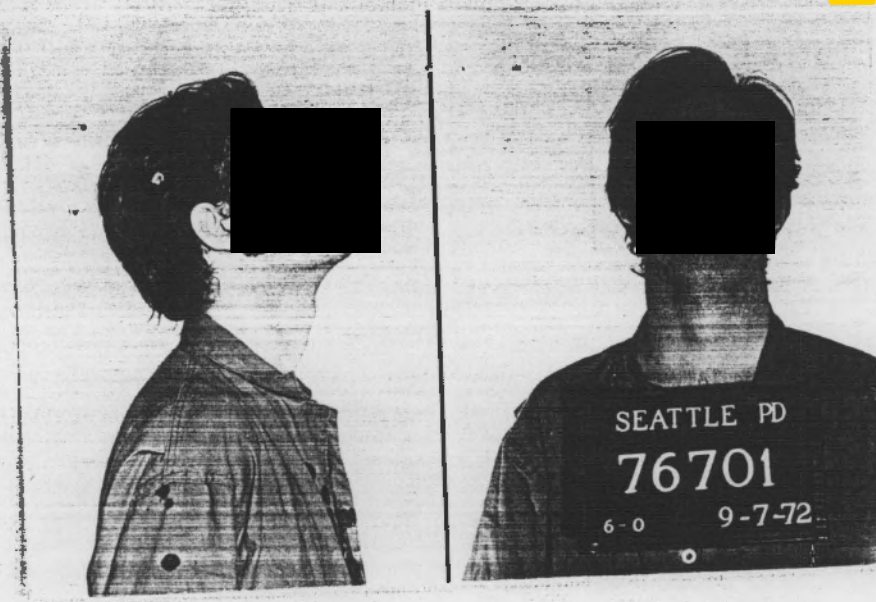



I am sending you this information with a request that you forward it to the interested agency or agencies in your area. It pertains to a possible suspect in the slayings of young women in the Washington State area and may or may not amount to anything.

The suspect, captioned above, is an obvious mental case who, as best we can tell, moved to Alaska in the Spring of this year and has been living at Mile [REDACTED] on the Glenn Highway - mailing address: Star Route [REDACTED] Box [REDACTED], Palmer, Alaska. He is from Yakima, Washington and his 1972 Chevrolet 3/4 ton pickup truck, white in color Washington license GK 8 [REDACTED], is registered to a [REDACTED], 4 [REDACTED] Snow Mountain, Yakima, Washington. He is known to have flown back to Washington at least once since he initially arrived in Alaska. He is presently confined in the Alaska Psychiatric Institute.

[REDACTED] was arrested on September 15th for malicious destruction of public property, specifically, setting fire to some timberland and shooting up his own vehicle. While he was being transported to the State Jail in Anchorage, [REDACTED] repeatedly made remarks to the effect that he had shot numerous individuals in the past. He mentioned nothing specific and nothing that would tie him into the disappearances and murders in your area. He does, however, somewhat resemble the composite of the suspect "Ted" which appeared in Peoples Magazine. That, coupled with his remarks and obvious mental derangement would make him a possible suspect.

Police Pondering New Suspect In Search For Marcia Trimble

Metro Youth Guidance Director George Currey today released composite drawings of a man "seen in the immediate vicinity" of Marcia Virginia Trimble's home "at the approximate time" the 9-year-old girl vanished suddenly.

Currey said the man was accompanied by a boy about 12 or 13 years old. They were on foot.

The youth director said the descriptions of the man and boy were obtained from "additional witnesses" authorities located in "in the course of our continuing investigation."

He declined to identify the witnesses but said they were not the same persons who provided police with information when two other composite drawings were made and distributed to the news media.

The fourth grade schoolgirl disappeared about 5:30 p.m. Feb. 25 when she left her home at 4009 Copeland Drive in the Green Hills area to sell four boxes of Girl Scout cookies to neighbors.

CURREY said the man sought for questioning is white and between 18 and 25 years of age.

He is between 5-foot-7 and 5-foot-9 and has a slender build. He has a dark, but smooth complexion and

prominent cheek bones. His dark brown hair "has a lot of body and waves" and covers his ears. The hair is brushed back from the face.

Witnesses said the man was wearing a light blue cotton shirt, work trousers with cuffs and a long green Army-type raincoat.

CURREY said witnesses stated the white boy accompanying the man was 12 or 13 years of age and between 5-foot and 5-foot-2. He has straight brown hair reaching down to his collar. His ears are exposed and he wears glasses.

The boy was wearing a blue jean jacket and heavy, dark cotton

trousers. He had on dark blue tennis shoes with white soles.

Currey said artist Marvin Thompson, who donated his services, "spent several nights" with the witnesses before he completed three composite drawings of the man.

He said one of the drawings is a full length picture of the man, another is a profile drawing and the third is a "full face view."

Currey, who has headed the investigation since the girl disappeared, said police "are very hopeful" the latest descriptions and drawings "will provide the necessary information."

THE TWO-DAY trial was Pyle's second on a charge of voluntary manslaughter in the Feb. 1, 1973, shooting death of Cedric Overton.

The first trial, in October 1973, ended in a mistrial when the jury failed

Long Search

By GEORGE ZEPP

Marcia Trimble was last seen by her family on the afternoon of Feb. 25, when at 5:20 p.m. she walked out her back door to deliver Girl Scout cookies to a neighbor across the street.

The search, which began that Tuesday night and ended yesterday with the discovery of the 9-year-old's body, is considered the broadest in Nashville history.

HERE IS a day-by-day recap of developments in the disappearance and investigation:

Feb. 25—The neighbor, Mrs. Marie Maxwell, saw a girl she believed was Marcia at 5:30 p.m. as she drove up to her house. Mrs. Maxwell later told police the girl was standing in a driveway adjacent to hers with two other persons.

Because a hedge obstructed her view, she was unable to give a good description. She said one was taller than the other, probably an adult and child.

After a search of the neighborhood in his car failed to locate Marcia, her father called Detective Sherman Nickens at 7:15 p.m. Homicide officers arrived soon after, followed by more than 200 police and civil defense workers.

Their hunt for the girl continued throughout the night.

Feb. 26—Police set up a search command post in a bedroom of the Trimble home. More volunteers arrived, nearly 1,000 by day's end. Police began to think in terms of an abduction.

Questioning of neighbors, the first of several lie detector tests and a compilation of names of known sex offenders led to no concrete clues.

Feb. 27—A white car, possibly driven by a bushy-haired man, was seen in the neighbor on the afternoon Marcia disappeared, neighbors told police. Hopes that this might be a good lead were expressed by police.

Mr. and Mrs. Trimble made a public appeal for help in locating their daughter. A total reward of \$30,000 was offered from various sources for the girl's return. Dragging operations at a lake in Percy Warner Park were fruitless. A pair of socks had been found near there, but they were later determined not to be Marcia's.

Feb. 28—An early morning lead that Marcia had been seen at a truck stop near Dickson, Tenn., was looked into by police, but nothing definite turned up.

Exhaustion began to show on the faces of police and volunteer workers. Hundreds were gathered in the yard of the Trimble house, nourished by sandwiches from food vans.

March 1—Officers began to retrace Marcia's steps the afternoon she vanished, as they continued to question neighbors. In the evening, two composite drawings of possible suspects were made public. One was the "bushy-haired man," another a young man seen in the Dickson truck stop.

March 2—The Trimble family attended Sunday church services. Mrs. Trimble's first trip from the home since Tuesday, as youth guidance officers relocated their command center to youth guidance headquarters on Elm Hill Pike.

March 3—Police announced that they had questioned and cleared a bushy-haired man who admitted driving a white car in the area of the Trimble home on Feb. 25.

By nightfall, police released another drawing of a man with prominent cheek bones who a neighbor said she saw driving fast and recklessly on Feb. 25 with a girl in his car.

March 4—Two highly trained German shepherd tracking dogs were flown into Nashville and put on Marcia's trail near her home at about sunset. They had been used to hunt for missing heiress Patricia Hearst and, officials said, had a good tracking record.

March 5—Amid talk of using a psychic to help locate Marcia, the dogs resumed their sniffing in neighborhood yards and woods. Their search was inconclusive.

March 6—The German shepherds were taken to the Dickson County truck stop, but also failed to find any evidence of Marcia there.

March 7—The dogs were taken through two homes near the Trimble's residence in Green Hills, but again located nothing. Calls from the public to youth guidance headquarters began to slacken as leads became fewer.

March 8—The search dogs were flown back to Philadelphia in the morning, as police abandoned that aspect of their investigation. Civil defense workers left the Trimble home, moving their headquarters to a church.

March 15—After a week of relative silence in the police case, a young woman reported seeing a girl fitting Marcia's description trying to flag down cars on the interstate. Nothing developed from the tip, but it was a sign that the public had not forgotten.

March 18—Police prepared and distributed the first of 4,000 missing person posters to youth and law enforcement agencies across the nation. They also began to drag a pond at Percy Warner Park, after receiving another tip.

March 19—The dragging was halted.

March 21—A new sketch of a suspect believed linked with the case was prepared for circulation in the Trimble neighborhood.

March 26—The sketch of a man between 18 and 25, was made public. Police said his description was provided by a new witness. He was thought to be the taller person seen by Mrs. Maxwell with Marcia.

March 27—A Florida psychic told officers here he had seen a vision of a girl's body in an abandoned mill in Nashville.

March 30—Marcia Trimble's body was found near noon in a garage near her home.

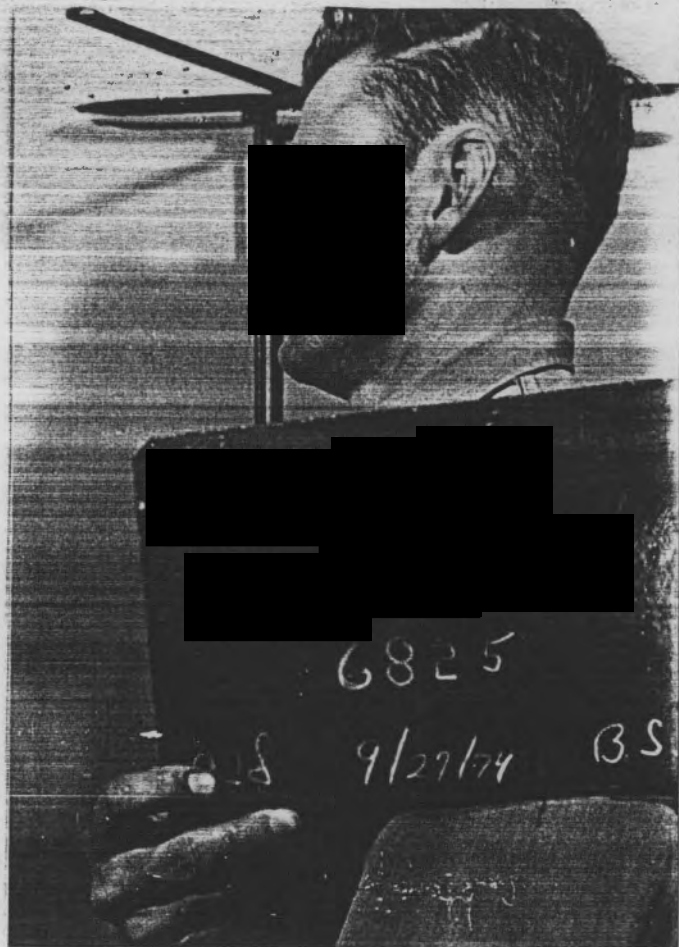
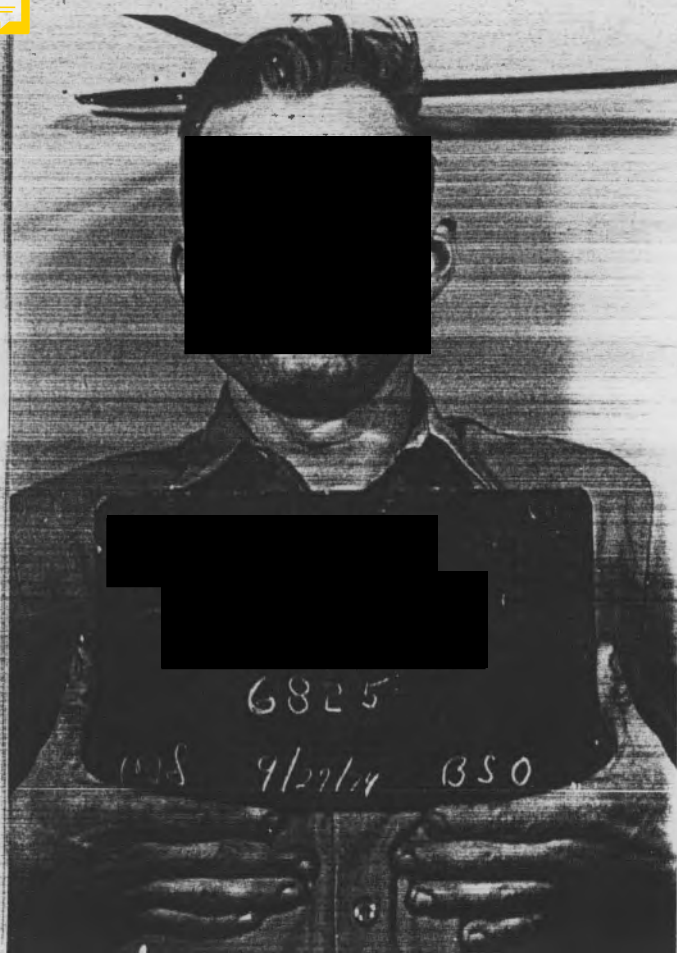
