

NARRATIVE: At 2211 hrs., this same date, this writer received a call from the above complainant Mr. Sheneman stating that there was an older man; not student; bothering some girls in Anderson Hall. This writer and student patrolman Jones left the office at 2212 hrs. and arrived at Anderson Hall at 2214 hrs. This writer then talked to Mr. Sheneman who stated that the suspect had left the building saying that he would be back tomorrow as he was looking for someone. The suspect also told Mr. Sheneman that he lived in the Koinonia House across from Anderson Hall. At approximately 2220 hrs. while talking with the victim and witness, this writer and student patrolman Jones saw the suspect go into the Koinonia House. After talking with Mr. Sheneman this writer talked with Miss Campbell who told me that the suspect had spoken to her twice earlier on this same date; at 1315 hrs. in Tawanka Commons he asked her for a cigarette and commented on her beauty. This second incident apparently scared her and she went to her dorm. At approximately 2200 hrs. Miss Campbell and Franklin saw him in the Anderson Hall entrance and ran upstairs attracting the attention of Mr. Sheneman, who then called this office. I told Miss Campbell and Franklin that if the suspect continued this strange behavior that they should again contact this office and that a report would be taken. This writer was clear of Anderson Hall at 2235 hrs.

The enclosed criminal file is transferred to the Spokane County District Court for convenience of witnesses.

The Public Defender's Office is appointed to represent the defendant. The defendant has also been referred to the Spokane Mental Health Center for evaluation.

The defendant refuses to comply with the necessary booking procedure and hence cannot be released. The defendant has refused to speak in the presence of the court and has refused all food for the last 24 hours. He was forcibly removed from his cell in the Cheney City jail for the preliminary hearing, however because of his actions his statutory and constitutional rights were not explained to him.

I am appointing a Public Defender because the defendant is a transient with known resources of approximately \$8.00. Further, his conduct in court clearly indicates a need for professional assistance.

The defendant was transported to the Spokane County.

DETAILS: On 02-25-75 at approximately 2315 hours writer was contacted by Chief Issel stating that writer's assistance was needed on campus. At approximately 2320 hours writer contacted student patrolman Crowley in front of Louise Anderson Hall. Patrolman Crowley stated that suspect had been bothering some of the students in Louise Anderson Hall. When suspect was asked to remove his body from the school properties, suspect refused to do so. (It should be noted suspect [REDACTED] is not a EWSC student.) At that point writer arrested suspect for Vagrancy and suspect was transported to Cheney Police Department. Suspect was advised of his suspect's Constitutional Rights via Miranda, but stated he, suspect, wished not to waive his rights. Suspect was photographed and fingerprinted but refused to sign his, suspect's fingerprint cards.
