

At approximately 1045-1100 hrs. on 3/8/75 while I was assigned to the Taylor Mountain search site for security, a blue datsun 240Z stopped across from the main entrance where I was located. The driver looked around for a few moments and then continued southbound on Hwy. 18. Shortly after (30 - 40 min.) I was checking the parking lot across Hwy. 18 from the search site and I saw this same vehicle parked there. The driver approached me (I don't know where he was <sup>and</sup> I did not see him return to the car.) and asked me if he would get a "jaywalking ticket" for crossing the road. I said no and why did he want to cross. He told me that he was a volunteer working in the commissary.

I can't quite explain his attitude- not quite nervous or upset, but it was weird. The questions he asked and manner of talking, and his clumsiness walking up the low bank (driveway more than bank) just struck me as strange.

I went back to the command post and contacted Sgt. Urban and Officer McKinney and told them about this subject and pointed him out to them. By this time the subject was at the commissary <sup>but</sup>, staffed mostly by girls I might add, McKinney said he looked a lot like the Forest Service employee who had volunteered but was turned down by McKinney.

I contacted the commissary supervisor and asked her if she knew the subject and all she knew was that he was a Forest Service employee. I contacted the subject who was not doing much of anything except standing around with his hands in his pockets and talking to some girls. I asked him to come with me to the S & R truck

Summary of 1971 arrest. On July 23, 1971, suspect [REDACTED] picked up two hitch hiking females in Spokane during the early morning hours. He told them he would drive them home. When the girls started to get into the car, they observed an object later identified as a hatchet, between the drivers legs. They started to get backout of the car, but the man picked up the hatchet and told them to get back in. One girl got in the front and the other got in the rear. He then drove out to a remote area, where he stopped and told the girls to get undressed. Both girls did as they were told, getting undressed and getting back into the vehicle. One girl started to get sick and was told to get out of the car, which she did. She then got dressed. Bailey then required one girl to undress him. He then forced her to felate him twice. He then opened a can of beer and them share it with him. He then required the one girl to undress again and started fondling both of their bodies and kissing their bodies. He required them to get back into the car and to commit sodomy on each other, but they refused. He then ordered one girl to commit sodomy on him and she first refused, but he got mad, so she tried but got sick and he told her to get out of the car and get dressed. He then made the other girl get on top of him, later he had her get on the bottom. He then made her get on her knees and tried to insert his penis into her rectum, but she started crying and he quit. He told her to get dressed. He then went and got the hatchet and opened the truck and then stood over them and raised the hatchet above his head as if to strike them, but when they gasped, he laughed and put the hatchet in the trunk. He then drove them back near their homes and let them out. [REDACTED] was subsequently arrested, convicted and sent to Western State Hospital in 1971. [REDACTED] states he was not out of the hospital for any reason until December 17, 1973 when he went of work release. He states he continued to live at the hospital until March 1974 when he found a job at Sambo,s in Auburn, and took a hotel room in Olympia at the [REDACTED] Hotel.

On March 12, 1974, Donna Gail Manson, an Evergreen State College student disappeared and has not been seen since. She disappeared from the campus. Her home is 124 O street, Auburn. [REDACTED] has seen the poster on Manson, but states he has never seen her.

Among items of personal property of [REDACTED] at time of his most recent booking is a wood token for coffee given by SAMBO,s, Eugene, Oregon. Another girl, Roberta Parks, disappeared from the University of Oregon at Corvallis, which is near Eugene. He has not been questioned on this.

[REDACTED] home is Spokane. This would take him through Ellensburg where Susan Rancourt disappeared from CWSC. The interstate highway system would also take him through Seattle close to the University of Washington where Linda Healy and Georgann Hawkins disappeared. He would also pass Sammamish Lake near Isaquah where Ott snd Nasland disappeared and the spot where their bodies were found.

During March 1974 [REDACTED] picked up two young girls hitch hiking south of Tacoma and gave them a ride to Trosper Road in Tumwater. The girls were Mary Handel and Brenda Baker. He denies molesting them in any way. He states he does not recall if they all introduced themselves, but he states he probably told them he worked at the TYEE Motor Inn and that he could only give them a ride that far. He denies ever seeing either of the girls again.



He was recently contacted by Sergeant Barclift during his investigation into the homicide of Brenda Baker. He was questioned about his contact with her in March. He related the story of picking them up while hitch hiking. I asked him if he knew that one of the girls had later been found murdered in Thurston County. He stated he didnt, but that he wanted me to know that he had been a sexual offender and had been in Western State Hospital. I told him I would come by in a few days and discuss the matter with him. The following morning he came to the office to see me. He told me about his prior incident in Spokane and having picked up Baker and Handel. He denied ever having seen them again. He was not questioned further at this time, so that a record check could be conducted.

A short time later he was apprehended by Lacey Police during a burglary of Peoples Dept Store. At this time he is in the Thurston County Jail for the Lacey charge.

On Dec 18, 1974, he was advised of his rights and he then gave a statement, telling of his movements since being released from the hospital. He was not given any details of the Baker homicide as to where the body was found, how she died, or even which of the two girls was murdered. He knows only that one of the two girls was found dead somewhere in Thurston County.

He states he will submit to a polygraph examination.

The composite photo of "Ted" was shown to Mrs. Vivian McDonald, however, this particular composite is not the one she has viewed on television nor in People's Magazine. Attempts to locate August issues of People's magazine have been unsuccessful.

Mrs. McDonald informs she has since observed the same composite as she saw before on another American Newcast and still feels the composite bears a resemblance to the male she came in contact with during the first week of September, 1974.

It is, of course, possible that other police agencies in your area are publicizing another composite photo which Mrs. McDonald is referring to. It is requested Captain Mackie forward any other composite photos that your department has been giving wide range publicity to or suggest what department or agency Cst. Woods can contact to ascertain what composite photos have been given television exposure.

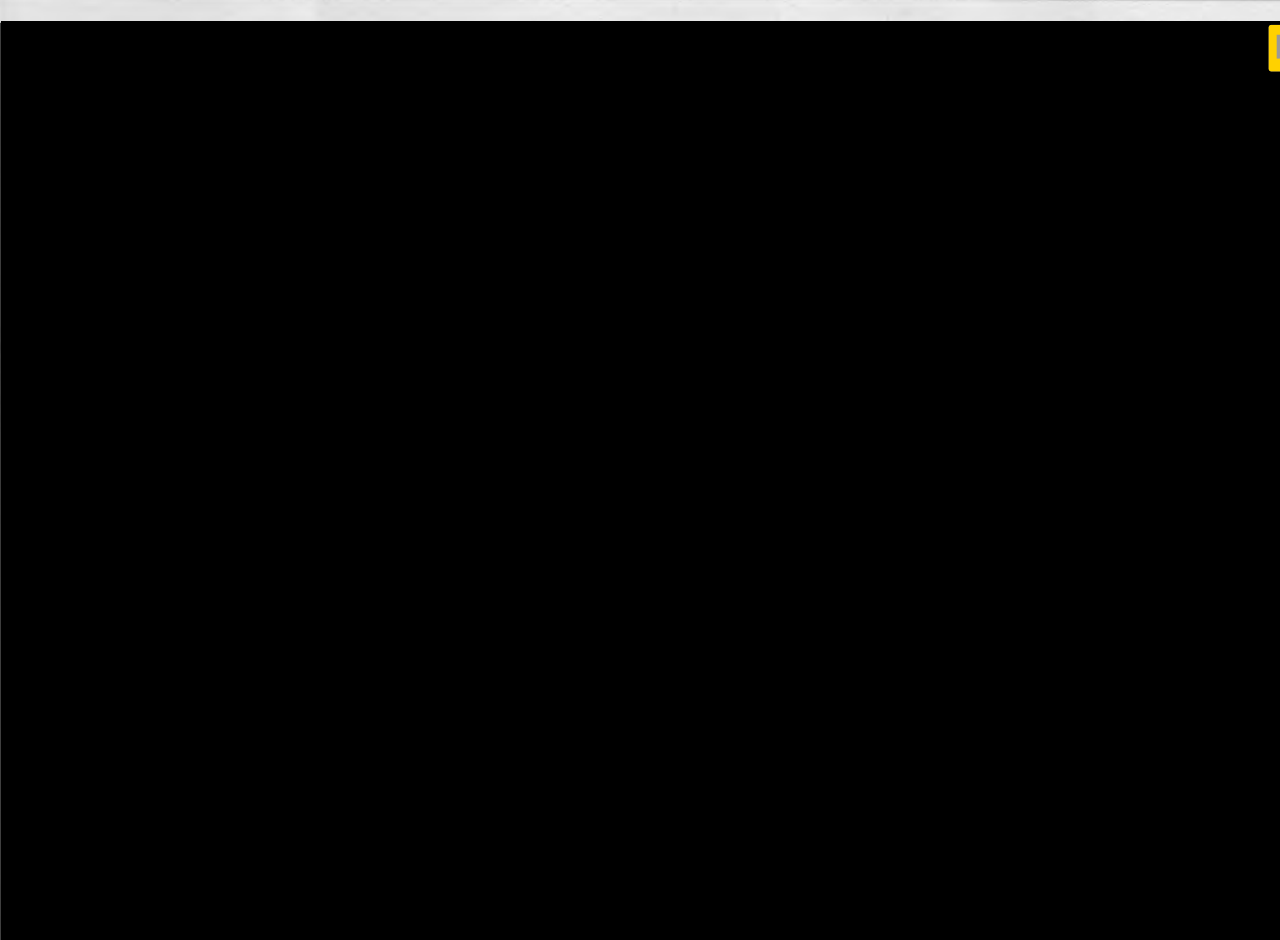

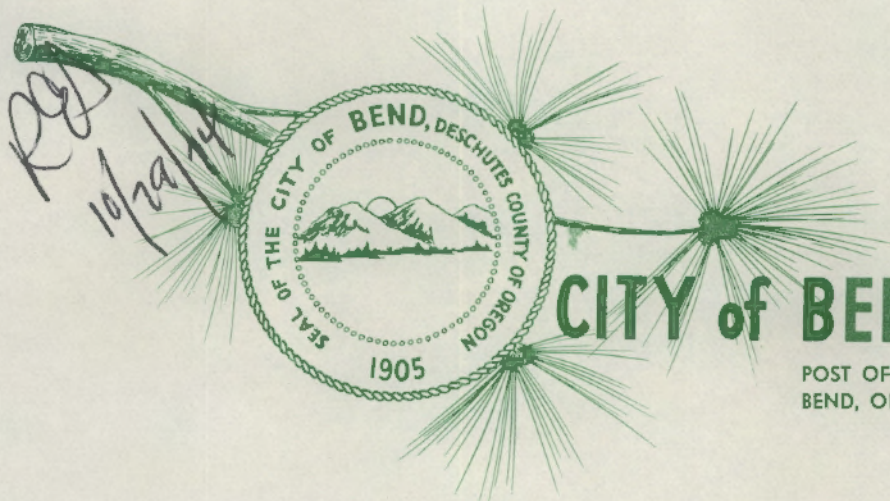

This letter is in reference to the unidentified female bodies that have been found in your area. We have a girl missing from our area since July 12, 1973. She is:

SUSAN ANN WICKERSHAM, DOB 112155

When she disappeared she was wearing a silver wedding band with a slight design. Her ears were pierced, she wore size 6½ shoes. An attempt was made to obtain dental records, but due to a change of dentists at the clinic her records have been destroyed. Information from her mother reveals the cuspid teeth of the lower jaw did not come in after her baby teeth were lost. Other than this she had very little dental work that could be identified.

We have hair samples from curlers she used prior to her disappearance and items that may have latent fingerprints from the missing girl.

We hope this scant information will be of value in either eliminating the possibility of one of the bodies being Miss Wickersham or make further investigation feasible.

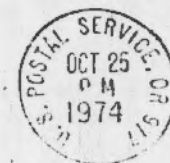



King County Sheriff:

On July 17, 74, we were on an outing to Neah Bay and when returning we stopped at the Lake Crescent Ranger station about 5:00 PM. There were two young men talking to a young dark haired attendant at the dock. I heard her give them directions to go to Lake Ozette. They then left in an <sup>old</sup> Packwagon bug which was light grayish blue I think there was a British Columbia license on it. The tall man, about 22, was nearly six foot, slim, with blue prominent eyes and slight wavy hair with a natural part in the middle. There was something about him which made the hackles on my neck rise. I told my wife that man is pure animal. The next day I saw a composite drawing of Ted on television which was a dead ringer of <sup>the</sup> man with a foreign accent. We had Calif. visitors with us so I didn't call anyone. <sup>When I first saw the sketch those days,</sup> In a few days there was a more finished drawing like the one I saw again tonight. But it was the first incomplete drawing which had the striking resemblance.



The other young man was about 5'6", had wavy dark hair, brown eyes and good looking. He had more the general brow and aquiline features of these later pictures of Ted. There was a similarity between the two men though they were different in build. It is quite possible your Ted had an accomplice and if so you might get two different descriptions. The California Ted in the news might be two Teds working together.

Well I have gotten this off my chest, and of course the young men I saw may have been harmless tourists, but one never knows where a few clues may turn up. I have often regretted not having reported to the lawmen an incident which happened in Monroe when a car almost collided with mine in the fog. <sup>1941</sup> They came from a side street, though we did not touch. They stopped and got a gun from under the front seat, then chased me and pulled alongside and the man in the back seat with window <sup>down</sup> was about to shoot when a car came around

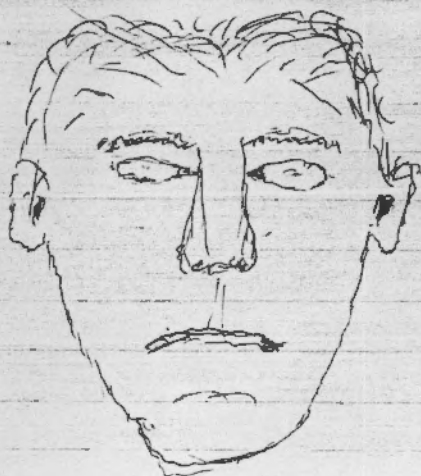
the bend and so they speeded up to avoid  
a collision. I turned off on a side street near  
the reformatory and escaped. That same morning  
they killed a Service station operator in Seattle  
and escaped. Later Tacoma police arrested  
them for a holdup and they were sent to prison.  
They still kept their guns under the front seat  
in a special compartment, I recognized the  
pair when I saw their pictures ~~in~~ in the  
papers when they were sent to prison. Both  
died there. They had been inmates at Monroe  
and looked like they were dope friends.

I am a retired farmer living in peace  
so dont publish my name.

Gentlemen:

Since time is of the essence (in case the vehicle is either sold or painted another color), an idea came to mind that may serve very useful in possibly locating or identifying "Ted".

You might put out a request via television, radio & newspaper for every concerned citizen to write down license numbers of 'all' V/W's that resemble the suspect-vehicle, and turn them in to your Department (as well as the location of said-vehicle).

You might then run registered owner checks on these numbers, requesting a date of birth from Department of Motor Vehicles. Any vehicle-owner with a date of birth close to the approximate age of "Ted" might be looked into, and a photograph requested from the Department of Motor Vehicles. From this photograph, any subject resembling suspect might be shown to the witnesses that actually did see the suspect-vehicle.

Also - does the Department of Motor Vehicles have in their registration files, a listing of 'all' V/W's - all Chevrolets, etc. If so - even though this would be time-consuming, you might check out all V/W owners with the approximate date of birth resembling "Ted" - and come across a past history for this subject.

I believe that all 'concerned' citizens would be willing to help by keeping a pencil/pen and paper handy, and automatically writing down all V/W license #'s resembling "Ted's" vehicle.

This would be a great process of elimination; although Department of Motor Vehicles would have to work extensively with you in supplying you the necessary photos.

At least it would be something to go on, and an actual picture might be of great assistance.

Hopefully, something can be done to capture "Ted" - and the above is my suggestion, since the process would be quickly done via your computers, and the Department of Motor Vehicles does speedily mail necessary photos.

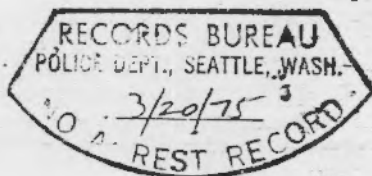
