On September 17, 1974 I contacted a Mercer Island citizen who advises a friend of hers in Issaquah has information on a possible suspect in this case.

The friend named "Hap" (name and address available if necessary) was phoned and he related the following information:

Hap shoes horses for a family named Thiessen -- Mr. & Mrs. Peter Thiessen, 8634 S. E. 40th - Mercer Island, Washington - phone: 232-5728, and he knows their daughter, Patricia. [REDACTED] (Thiessen) [REDACTED], WFA - DOB: 12-50, 23 [REDACTED] S. E. 192nd Street - Maple Valley, Washington.

Hap has also talked with Patricia's husband, [REDACTED] WMA, DOB: 12-14-49, 6'1", 135, Blonde Hair, Blue Eyes, sloped build, on a few occasions. Hap also knows many persons in the Issaquah area and rumor or hear-say from them about [REDACTED] reveals several items.

- (A) [REDACTED] is known as a mama's boy.
- (B) [REDACTED] is acquainted with many motorcyclists and owns a large red chopper.
- (C) [REDACTED] has been known to carry a sawed-off shotgun when he bikes near Issaquah.
- (D) Hap has seen [REDACTED] wearing "expensive" tennis shoes.
- (E) Someone in [REDACTED]'s family (Mother, [REDACTED] or wife Patricia) works in a doctors' clinic in Bellevue or Mercer Island and has access to casts or materials for same. (Hap thinks [REDACTED] may have had a job as a cast remover but rarely went to work).

NOTE:

While [REDACTED] was on Mercer Island he was a screwball, known to carry concealed weapons and was known by many of his friends as a general nut.

Also, while talking with Hap, this officer detected no malice (on Hap's part) towards [REDACTED] - Hap is forty (40) or fifty (50) years old and sounds like a fair man not too willing to pass on hearsay and rumors. Hap does not trust [REDACTED] and feels he could easily be a good suspect.


