MUTILATION OF BONES

27 YRS

I am looking for a maniac, a man wanting to be male, but frustrated and angry over traits within himself which he considers weak and female. One quality which worries him terribly is his indecisveness. To him, being unable to make up his mind, is feminine and deplorable. When he makessthe decision to kill, he feels strong and male.

He considers the sun to be all-powerful, diagonally directional, decisive, and therefore male. He feels that he can draw strength from the sun, and therefore carries his head at a downward slant so that the sun beats down on the top of his head. The moon is weak and feminine, pallid, and he feels that he is weakening in the dead of night. He is most likely to kill a girl at two or three o'clock in the morning. I think he killed Ott at 3 a.m.

He is almost surely a boxer by profession or as a hobby. He's right-handed, leads with his left and kills with his right. He killed the girls by punching them with his right fist again and again. He feels strongest and most male when his hand is clenched into a fist. He enjoys using a punching bag.

He feels the strongest when completing a cone-shape or triangle and is attracted to cone-shapes (such as Mount Si) and diagonal roads. When driving or walking or running, he travels first on the left, then cuts across and completes a cone or triangle as he returns. He likes to live on the left-hand side of a triangle and approaches his shack from the lefthand side of the triangle.

He considers it a weakness to retrace his footsteps because he is somehow recreating himself or wiping out his own footsteps, and he must be directional. On leaving his shack he probably makes a triangle by leaving the front door and travelling on the left side of the house, diagonally travels to another road which is also diagonall and leads him back to his starting point. He may feel this eliminates pursuers also.

Any round shape or egg shape is feminine to him.

Even the wheels of a bake probably lured him to Janice

Ott because of his instinctive pull toward male and female shapes found in the wheels of a bike. Since the major shape of bike wheels is round, a bike to him is a feminine item. He will hide it in a shallow basin or land or in a small dark tunnel attached to the basin. The blackness of the tunnel will make him think of a vagina.

He enjoys the color of the sun, likes his own hair color, and likes a dark berenn brown landscape. He drives a brown Volkswagon, which, in its outline, is feminine. He likes to be inside it, and feels perhaps protected by its feminine shape. Inside the round shape he feels less violent. The brown to him represents the vagina or womb. Near where the bodies of the two girls were found, half-way up the cone-shaped mountain likes an egg-shaped basin, dark brown in tone, mulchy in odor. The basin is perhaps twelve feet long and eight feet deep. He approached the basin by travelling up the mountain

on the left and returning on the right, creating a triangle. One question is bothering me. Would be beat girls to death inside a feminine-shaped basin? Or would be first kill them and carry them to the basin? According to newspaper reports, the girls were probably left up high on the mountain and carried down by animals.

This man likes brown so well that he enjoys the floor of a forest, b own trunks of trees, and lives in a dark-brown, unpainted shack. He approaches, the last twenty feet, on foot and is drawn to it by several triangular-shapes on the left-hand side of the shack. One of these is the roots of a fir trees, on the surface of the dark brown ground, pointing toward the corner of the shack. There is a small brown triangle in the side of the small porch roof, another triangle in the broken window on the side of the building. The triangle in ghe window may be a cream-colored rag, spread to keep out the wind, but since this "rag" looks stiff and unbending, I think it is a piece of light ply-wood nailed on from the inside of the window. The glass is broken and roughly represents a triangle. He further likes the house because of a saucer-shaped hill behind it. He can see about one-third of the saucer from looking out a small back window of the back door. One leaving, he somehow creates a triangle as he moves. Janice Ott or one of his other victims saw this shack from the outside, but was blindfolded inside the house, seeing only floor boards.

As the rain comes on this fall, and the sun begins to pale, he will feel less strong, and he will tend to go inside his shack or cave and reads books, which he likes to do but considers feminine. He has read John Steinbeck books, and in particular, he may have read the book, Native Son by Richard Wright. Bigger Thomas, a black man, frustrated by his place in society, feeling hemmedn in by white society, pummels his black girlfriend to death with a rock (while she sleeps) and throws her body down an airshaft. For the last one-third of the book he states his satisfaction at having expressed himself and having made the world notice him. I think "Ted" is doing his best to sav he is male, strong, worth notice. Considering that he wants to be noticed, he has taken some big risks, such as walking off with two girls in broad daylight, with the added complication of a yellow bike. He has probably not gone to a real clever lengths to hide it. It probably rests in a semi-open, opval spot, not now covered with water. ground is brown, may contain rotting leaves.

At the same time he has made some indecisive attempts to avoid being found. He feels his triangular movements are clever enough to outwit law enforcement people. He has cut his hair to a shore Butch, possibily wears a brown wig. He has hidden or painted his brown Volkswagin.

....

His feminine months are coming on. November 1st is a bad day for him. also months of Dember and January because

there will be the least amount of sun, and he will feel
the least like resisting. The natural landforms and
road shapes of the Snoqualmie Falls aread are attractive
to him, because they are symbollic of his internal
battle. He is currently arguing with himself over
whether or not to return to the area. I think he will
be likely to return in late October or early November.

### OTHER THOUGHTS

His father left for one reason or another when "Ted" was small; the mother, strong, domineering, opinionated, has raised him. He eternally tries to gain her sympathy to get what he wants. Then she falls for it he despises her. She is troubled about him, but does not know that he has killed. He sees her sometimes, but she is at some distance. I do not know how he makes his living, unless by occasional boxing fights or getting money from his mother. He blames her for his mental confusion about sex. I do not think he raped Janice Ott, and perhaps none of the other girls, paining more satisfaction by violently hitting.

One question: In which library does he get his books? Or does he buy them?

Does he further entertain himself with grotesque mustaches of his victim's hair?

Did Ted's male qualities did in the living room, and does the female side take over in the "bathroom", as withess the dead man in the chair, the live blonds girl in his lap.

What are the patterns of light? Light flashing from the knife he wields or patterns of light he sees in his own distorted mind as he studies moonlight through a window?

Another question: Since the cabin seems to/anntinum a bathtub and running water, this is probably not an abandoned cabin, but one that he rents. He can dissect his victims in the bathtub, thus avoiding bloodstains. The floor appears smooth and shiny like tile, something easily washed. I see no bloodstains in the living room.

### ADDITIONAL THOUGHTS

(Received between October 7 -13)

Because Ted seems to show a duality of nature (affected strongly by sun and adversely by moon) a man warring with a feminine side, I decided to look up an extensive book on astrology, even though I have never been a firm believer. I also took into account the fact that he took two girls from Lake Sammamish on the same day. Gemini (its symbol is the Roman II) also has another highly interesting sign, a man on horseback whose favorite sport in the 15th century was hawking for birds and small animals. Another interesting itom is the two figures shown in the Gemini symbol, a naked man and a naked woman with the winged horse, Pegasus, in the background. A Gemini is born between May 22 and June 22, and his negative nature is described as changeable, restless, cunning, inconsistent, two-faced, unable to control nervous energy. On the good side he is intellectural, witty, logical, lively, has a flair for writing and for languages and is always youthful and up-to-date in outlook and appearance. In the pirture in the astrology book the face of a male Gemini strongly resembles the newspaper drawing of Ted. A strong love of books and intellectual pursuits, plus a tendency to become bored and drop out in midterm in a university also ties in with my impressions of this man.

Now for some of my thoughts about horses. The puppet he received from his mother as a child was a black stocking horse, with a white left eve and a white ruffle around its neck. The horse had a broomstick leg. Early in his life, Ted began to mutilate and destroy the horse. For some strange reason he did not cut out nor destroy the left eye, but the right is gone. He also cut holes in the black stocking and decorated the ruffle with blood, some old and lavender, other new and red. He hid the mutilated horse in the back of his closet, on a narrow board, where it may still rest as a horror to his mother. He took the stick with him and may have used it later to going out right eyes of small animals which he struck repeatedly with the stick, especially in the area of the eyes. Somewhere in his youth, he probably castrated a dog and mutilated it even further, again, later he mutilated a horse and rolled inside it. Now one of the items I see in the mutilated stick horse is the suggestion of three sticks of wood above its head. These are climbing rungs extending off into infinity. By interpreting this, I think it is highly likely that Ted served on a flying Pegasus, a type of helicopter, in Vietnam, as a medic. I think he climbed up and own rungs, trying to defeat death in Vietnam. He saw many mut ated bodies and sometimes could not save the people because death had beaten him. that later, after serving in Vietnam, and coming back at roughly the age of 25, he (likes to read Greek and Celtic mythology) perhaps likes the story of the Greek horse, the Trojan horse, in which soldiers leapt out of a horse and destroyed the enemy. I began to get an impression of a man wearing a black stocking (like the puppet horse) to hide his blond hair and blond features, clothed in black running through the forests under a full moon. Celtic mythology (which I then looked up) talks about the werewolf returning to a "cottage" where the severed body awaits him.

#### FURTHER THOUGHTS

As I drew and re-drew my first horse puppet image, I began to notice all the marks of severing. I saw that the heart rested neatly to the right of the body .... the liver balancing it off on the left. The intestines are spread out in neat lines to the right. An appalling idea, which I'm sure he did, is to cut the legs off the body at the top of the thigh, then sever just below the knees. He did this so neatly and efficiently that the thighs Will stand up on the ground exactly like knxkma two small smokestacks. These two thighs stand to the right of the head. The head is bald. He removed the hair, like in scalping. The jaw bone was carefully removed just below the nose. The region of the eyes interests him the most because the widest marks of severing include the eyes and frontal part of the brain. He perhaps (I think strongly on this) urinated into the hole left by the right eye. He diembowled his victims, but what he did with the area below the knees I do not know. I'm inclined to think he threw them at the foot of a waterfall. Because of the neatness and precision of his work. I think he had some training as a medic or surgeon, and that when he went into one of the three services he was placed as a medic. He found himself too necrophillac to become a doctor (who must save life) and has given up the training. He tends to leave the jaw bone with its identifiable teeth, plus the hair, where they may be found. They are generally found in a female shape, an oval, near a railroad track which curves and when drawn on paper, resembles a shallow saucer. The wateraxefx The oval area above the saucer seems to symbolize a heart. These jaw bones and hair patches are his sign to the world that he has gone through these ordeals. Eventually he hopes to win the acclaim and homage of the world for these great deeds. He sees himself approaching a role of semi-divine human or voung prince.

Where would be live? I've pondered this long and hard. piece of the mutilated body which most interests him is the eves and front of the brain. I think Ted. the male. lives in the left eve. He kills the right eve (warring against his feminine side.) It is my strong conviction that he was raised in the town of Issaguah, that he attended Issaguah high school and graduated in 1964, 1965 or 1966. I lean toward 1965. He then may have a tended the medical school at the University of Washington, then cone to Vietnam, and returned. He is an intellectual person, loves to read, has read in many areas which are foreign to me. His reading has already sent me to read about various mythology, plus were-wolves and various occult groups. He might possibly belong to an occult group, such as moon worshippers. His hobbies are loggy, boxing, perhaps fencing, might like ping-pong. Above all, he loves to read, likes languages. He can be witty and amusing. I have reason to think his mother lives in the town of Issaguah.

In Ted's cabin I see the bare, scrubbed, well-swept floorboards, dark brown. Near the doorway to another room, an empty white shirtsleeve appeared. It was clean, empty, torn neatly from a shirt right at the shoulder. Later, the shirtsleeve seems to contain anntings a man's right arm, and hand. The hand is lying casually with the index finger almost seeming to point toward the door, suggesting to me, but not demanding, that I go into the next room. Later, I look again, but the arm 's gone. Instead I see the full figure of a man, clothed in trousers and shirt, lving face down on the floor. His right arm, attached to the body, again seems to casually point toward the door. Some time later, the body is gone, only a heap of short hair, something like the skin of a bear lies where the body was. The hair's lagged qualities demand going through the door.

> I try to go through the door. It's dark in the other room. I think it's a kitchen, but I see no counter or cabinets, sink or table. Instead I see a man, dressed in shoes, trousers, shirt, jacket - conservatively dressed - sitting in a brown, straight-backed wooden chair. He looks all right except that his head is gone. Only a cork-screw spine extends up through his collar where his head should be. On his lap, a live, nude, attractive blond girl sits, facing him. In mid-air I see a crescent, much like the shape of a crescent moon but not as shiny. Only two sparkles of light near the two tips. Dangling from the lower end of the crescent, two medallions, suggestive of male testicles. Behind the crescent-shaped "boat" .. lovely colors, mauve and rose. .... Somewhere else in the room, a sudden blinding pattern of light shapes - rectangles, squares, some like 2 by 4 hoards, but not boards, flutter from the top of the room to the bottom, bright, quick, a second or less. In one corner of the room, a narrow window, like a small air vent. An old-fashioned bathtub on four legs - in it about 4 inches of clear water which turns to milky white. A girl with punched out eyes with her back against the reclining end of the tub. Wet hair streams across her empty eye sockets. On the floor beside the tub, a bath mat with long hair on one end of it, short (pubic hiar??) on the other. A severed foot rests on the "hair" bath mat. In a mirror appears a smiling male face with a girl's curly ringlet creating the right half of an old-fashioned, flowing mustache. The man in the mirror appears amused. In a narrow window which lets some light into the room, I see the shade is up about four or five inches, one third of the distance. Is there another two-thirds which I have not seen?

Questions: Does Ted fantacize about creating a Male Moon by putting his own testicles on it and does it entertain him to think his "male" weight causes the moon boat to almost drop its liquid sperm?

Is he entertained by placing a girl's cut-off foot so that it "walks" on her own pubic hair bath mat.

# ADDITIONAL THOUGHTS October 22, 1974

In Ted's dark brown cabin I see the bare, scrubbed, well-swept floorboards. (Am I seeing it all beneath a blindfold? In ancient bear killings, cloths were wrapped around the bear's head just below the snout to catch his "tears", and this was always done after sunset?. Was Janice Ott semi-blindfolded after sunset? Did Ted wish to catch her tears in the blindfold?) In the room, on the floor I saw an empty white shirtslesve. It was clean, torn neatly from a shirt at the shoulder. After a few hours, I ventured another look. The shirtsleeve contains a man's right arm and hand. The hand is lving casually with the index finger almost seeming to point toward the door, suggesting, but not demanding, that I go into the rext room. Later, I look again, and to my relief, the arm is cone. Instead I see the full figure of a man, clothed in trousers and shirt, lying face down on the floor. His right arm, attached to the body, again seems to causally point toward the door. Some time later, the body is gone, only a heap of short hair, something like the skin of a bear, lies where the body was. The general shape of the heap of hair seems to suggest I go through the door.

I try. I try to go through the door. It's dark in the other room. I think it's a kitchen, but see no counter, cabinets, sink, or table. Instead I see a man, dressed in shoes, trousers, shirt, jacket conservatively dressed - sitting in a brown, straight-backed wooden. chair. He looks all right except that his head is gone. Only a grooved spine extends through his collar where his head should be. On his lap sits a live, nude, attractive blond girl, facing him. In mid-air I see a crescent, much like the shape of a crescent moon, but not shiny except for two sparkles of light near the two tips. Dangling from the lower end of the crescent, two medallions, suggestive of male testicles. Does Ted fantagize about creating a Male Moon by putting his testicles on it, and does it entertain him to think his male weight causes the moon boat to almost drop its liquid sperm? Behind the crescent-shaped "boat".. lovely colors, mauve and rose. ... Somewhere else in this room, a sudden bright pattern of light shapes - rectangles, squares, like 2 by 4 boards, but not boards, flutter from the top of the room to the bottom, bright, suick. In one corner of the room, a narrow window, like a small air vent. An old-fashioned bathtub on four legs - in it about 4 inches of clear water which turns to milky white. (Does the milky white water have to do with a belief in Harri Krishna religion?) A sirl with a punch out right eye, with her back against the reclining end of the tub. Wet hair streams across her ampty eve socket. On the floor beside the tub, a bathmat with long hair on one end of it, short (pubic hair??) on the other. A severed foot rests on the bathmat. This seems to amuse Ted. In a mirror also appears a smiling male face with a girl's curly ringlet creating the right half of an old-fashioned flowing mustache. In a narrow window which lets some light into the room. I see the shade is up about 4 or five inches, one third of the distance. Is there another two-thirds which I have not meen? Also, unspoken but definitely heard in this room, the questions remark: She has screwed me out of my mind.

### A WORD OF WARNING

I have been at a fever pitch to sort out my impressional impressions of this killing machine because I feel sure he will strike again on October 31, the eve of the new moon, sometimes called a Werewolf Moon. He will put on his Hallow'en mask, a black stocking and run through the woods, lusting for blood. He may well kill one or two people about 3 a.m. which will be into November 1st. Also, I feel I must warn all police that he will kill a man without hesitation. Yesterday I saw the severed right arm of a man, on a cabin floor, the hand still on the arm. A white shirt sleeve, neatly ripped off at the shoulder line, still on the arm. This a.m. I see the body of a man face down on a cabin floor. I do not know when this killing occurred, perhaps now, perhaps some time in the past. he policeman who takes Ted in a peaceful fashion, will say to him in a confident, sure manner, "I've come to HELP you. Come and let me help you." If he feels that the policeman understands him, he will be the most peaceful and agreeable. If he feels faced with a militant, belligerent attitude, he will either attack or flee. If he is located, he will have to be put into a hospital for the criminally insane. I doubt he can ever be cured.

Other thoughts: the cabin that I see (I how see two different cabins and two other houses where he has lived or is still living) the cabin floor which I constantly see is almost surgically clean; it may have been swept and scrubbed. He likes to do his "surgery" in a clean area and is meticulous about the way he does it.

Suggestions: I would look into the year books of Issaquah high school, also Snoqualmie and North Bend. I would look for a boy who probably grauated in 1965, blond, medium build, rather good looking, bright blue eyes, showed interest in science, especially biology and perhaps goology. He took an interest in sports, especially in jogging. He may have also shown interest in literature and language. If the school was not overly strong on discipline, he did well. This boy lived with his mother; father disappeared early. He was born between May 22 and June 22, probably 27 years ago.

Saddest part is that this man has yearned for normal relationships and hasn't been able to find them. He wars constantly with himself within himself. He may be strongly homosexual and lesbian at the same time. It is the lesbian side (the right side) which has the urge to kill.

In recent days, "Ted" has felt trapped, also has found himself constantly shifting deeper into insanity. He begs for help and fades off again into the shadows of insanity. What a full moon on October 31st, will do to him in this shaky condition is a horrifying thought to me.

On Sunday afternoon, October 27, my husband, mother, son, and his girlfriend, and I, in two cars, went on the search for "Tod". We arrived at Snoqualmie Falls about 4 p.m. and again I said I wanted to search the Tokul woods. I was looking for crescent-shaped areas, with remains of cut-up animals or humans, just above the curve in the Tokul railroad. My husband and I plunged into the brush and searched for approximately 45 minutes in pouring rain without finding anything.

Meanwhile, my son and his girlfriend searched the railroad track near the bridge. He came running to find us; he had located two dissected mice on the 108th tie east of the Tokul Bridge. We rushed back with him, and found the right eye of the mouse had been deeply gouged out. In the pouring rain and darkness, without a filter, and shooting down on a dark-brown railroad tie, my husband did his best to photograph the remains. He felt the pictures were not good, but have enclosed them for whatever help they may be.

My son, an excellent observer, dictated the following remakrs about the remains of the two mice:

"Originally there were two mice, although the head and forelegs of one, were missing. Cuts were initiated up the under side of the torso from the pubic bone and extended to somewhere near the solar plexus. A circular cut also originating at the base of the neck on the back side of the body, continued around behind the front legs. The organs of the upper chest in one remained intact except the rib cage had been removed. The interior of one was completely dismantled=, including destruction of bowells and internal organs. On the other, the intestine was left in two pieces, one small intestine, one large intestine. On the one remaining skull, the right eye had been gouged out deeply, and the spine removed all the way to the juncture of the spine and the skull. The pelvis of one was dismantled from the under side; the other was partially cleaned out. There were several flaps of skin left from the dorsal side of the one mouse with the complete skull. Parts that were missing: ribs, one skull, two front legs, no marks were left on the railroad ties from the dismemberment, and the implement used seems to have been very sharp. No tearing was evident. Quite a deep fissue was left from the removal of the right eye in the one skull. The skull was otherwise intact."

My son continued with some interesting comments:
"No scattering of parts, no evidence of blood, brings up two
possibilities. Either it was done long enough proviously for the
rain to wash away the blood, in which case, birds or animals would
have likely eaten most of it. Secondly, it is highly likely that
the dissection was done elsewhere and merely deposited there,
which would also help explain the lack of two complete bodies
and the lack of scattering. I'd guess he brought the parts and
dumped them, but can't understand why. "

As I tramped the railroad I saw the sign near the mice, "Tokul" - does it say to Ted .. "To-Kill."

Question: Did Ted's male qualities die in the living room, and does the female side take over in the "bathroom", as witness the dead man in the chair, the live blonde in his lap?

Question: Since the cabin seems to contain a bathtub and running water, this may not be an abandoned cabin, but one that he rents. He may dissect his victims in the bathtub, thus avoiding bloodstains. I see no bloodstains in the living room.

It had come to me that the Snoqualmie boxer's name was John Steven In an effort to verify this I called an old school teacher friend of mine, who has taught at Mount Si High School for 31 years. She joined me for dinner on October 29th in a Seattle restaurant. I described the boxer and asked if his name was John. She corrected me by admitting it was ". He's a junior in the school, has difficulty with reading and writing. He cannot memorize football plays well enough to help the team, but he is popular with the students, and they permit him to play. He often shadow boxes in the hallways., speaks as if he has a cleft palette, but my friend, Lillian Pakar, said that tests showed nothing wrong with his throat and mouth. She showed me a high school annual picture of him, and again I was stricken by his close resemblance to "Tad". He resembles a newspaper drawing of August 10th, his hair a Dutch cut ... small face going down to a pointed chin. She assured me he could NOT be Ted and advised me to quit thinking shout it. When I brought up the case of the dissected mice on the track at Tokul, she finally said that there was a known mutilationist at Mout Si High School. He's a short, dark-haired boy with a small mustache, and is under care of a psychiatrist. He mutilates small animals. She would not tell me his name. claiming she had forgotten it.

October 31st

The night of the werewolf moon. I woke up out of a sound sleep in the middle of the night and knew that "Ted" was busy somewhere to the south or southwest, busy doing "something he shouldn't".

Daughter Susan at 4:15 a.m., lying awake in the dark, heard a woman's troan "inside her head" and saw a figure in black, black shirt, black parts, black Spanish hat with brim, leaning over something. When he looked up, she ducked, afraid he would see her. On his shirt she says small green-blue flowers fading and reappearing.

Son Brian had a dream of finding a trussed up girl in a lonely care beside a river. Afraid to enter the cave, he took a "cop" with him, and said the girl, still alive, showed signs of having been tied up for hours.

My husband and I went to Issaquah to look for or the name of the killer, I believe. We explored the library for high school annuals, since I believe Ted graduated perhaps from Issaquah High School in 1965. The library, unfortunately, does not collect annuals. We searched for various addresses in Issaquah and were unable to find what we sought. We learned that addresses in Issaquah have been changed twice in the last year.

We located a dark brown shack like an image I had seen a month earlier. The shakes came up on the mutside from the ground up. The windows were painted with green trim (like my vision). In exploring the shack, located on second N.W. near downtown is a saguab, we found two sides destroyed .. on the east and the south. Yet a cuftain still covered the inside of the front door. Could the the saguable of the store of the store inside.

I met a security school guard at Nathan Hale, Carl Luondowsky. He told me he'd been trying to find "Ted" since the first week in August. He told of watching a young blond man who looked like "Ted" at a Ballard High school dance in September. The man's approach to the girls at the dance "freaked them out". Carl and another guard asked for the man's identification. He said he didn't have his wallet but admitted finally to having "a wallet". The name on the wallet was

, age 20, a Boeing worker. Carl did not believe this to be the blond man's name or wallet. He was asked to leave the dance, but returned and walked directly toward a girl. An alert hostess removed the girl, and when the man saw Carl and another guard approach, he ran out of the dance and drove away in a tan Valkswagon.

Early in November at a concert at the Seattle Center, Carl and his wife saw the same young man pick up a blonde girl, heard him offer her marijuana or heroin or candy. He made remakes about Snoqualmie... said he had \$200 to spend on a motel... admired a birthmark on her body. "It looks cute." They left their seats at intermission and Carl trailed the couple to an upper balcony. They again returned to their seats. Carl observed the man trying to steal the binoculars of a couple next to him... heard him say he liked the girl's bright red lipstick, his "favorite color". The man apparently recognized Carl, and tapped him on the shoulder.

The stage was decorated with a 7-headed horse, crescent moon, and other symbols of the Hare Krishna belief. George Harrison's songs contained wording that remind me of Ted's ideas. The album of George Harrison shows him all in black with a Spanish hat like my daughter saw on October 31st. Harrison's guitar is covered with small flowers, some red, some blue-green.

In the Nathan Hale library, Carl and I studied star constellations. My Samitarius sign is a small fat teapot with a shallow saucer-shaped line dissecting Ted's gemini sign...which is two sides of a triangle. Carl's "Cancer" sign dissects my sign distantly.

My family and I met Carl Luondowsky and his wife, ginnry at Snoqualmie Falls. I put my hand against my nose, held my arm at an ancle, and Carl identified my movement as "a bear stance" in Karati. We decided to walk the Tokul railroad tracks for 3 miles, hunting for a possible, hidden treehouse or mutilated animals. We started at the Tokul bridge, where we found the remains of the dissected mice. Not far on the other side of the bridge, we mammax saw the spine and entrails of a larger animal, possibly a domestic cat. We also saw he remains of a bird a mile down the track and the remains of some other small creature, with two rubber bands attached to it. We observed that a car, possibly a Volkswagon, had driven down the abandoned track. We munched sandwiches in a pouring rainstorm and discussed the possibility of exploring other sections of track between North Bend and Preston. Also looked at maps.





I saw an article in the newspaper lately where the girls!

bodies had been found in the North Bend area, and also the composite sketch that had been drawn up; on this "TED" character. There was a guy that I was in contact with just prior to when I was arrested who I remember had the same type hair as this fellow in the drawing.

Another quirk that he had was he was wearing a neck brace, even at that time it was pretty obvious to me that he really didn't need it, that he was wearing it for sympathy.

DET .: Where did you meetthim, now?

: It was at JOANNE's house, my girlfriend's house in North Bend, where I met him . . . I met him there aecouplettimes, in the spring.

DET.: Do you remember when the first time was?

: April or May.

DET: April or May of 1974. . . and you met him at your girlfriend's house?

: As well as I can remember.

DET .: What is her last name?

: Who, JOANNE? . . . COMPTON.

DET.: Does she live in North Bend?

: She's living down here now.

DET .: In Steilacoom?

: Um. . . Spanaway.

DET.: Spanaway . . . but she was living in North Bend at that time. Was she the one . . .

: You arrested me at her house . . .

DET.: Was she the one who was working in Redmond, or someplace like that?

Bellevue. . . . Well, anyway he was wearing a neck brace and it was pretty obvious to me, even then before I knew anything him, that it was a phony thing that he was wdoing and uh . . .

DET.: He did look like the composite?

: He had the hair, was all I remember.

DET.: Did you know his name?

: BILL.

DET.: That's all you knew him by was, "BILL"?

: I didn't care for the guy personally, so I didn't bother to question him.

DET.: How did your girlfriend happen to . . .

: Imm not sure how she came into contact with him.

DET.: But he was at her house?

He came over a couple times while I was there. . . then I was arrested and sent here, and JOANNE was still living in North Bend.

This guy continued coming around, and it was rather obvious that he was kind of a hustler. . .

DET.: You mean she told you that he was still coming around after you were here, huh?

was sent here . . . JOANNE was pretty religious at that time, and he came over one day . . . she called me up and was quite upset about it he and told me about it, and/layed a pretty heavy dope trip on her about something he'd done that GOD would never forgive him for. She started getting upset because she didn't know what he was talking about; and he said that he had killed somebody, then cut the conversation and wouldn't say anything more and he left.

DET .: This is back in, uh . . .

: This would be back after I got arrested . . .

DET.: Then he told JOANNE that he'd done this . . . ?

At the time that I heard this, I just figured he was playing a game with her, you know . . . 'cause he was a hustler. All I can think of right off hand . . . I wish there was more . . .

DET.: Does the tape recorder bother you?

Ya, a little bit . . .

DET.: You say JOANNE is living . . .

: In this area.

DET.: Is she here because you're down here . . . to visit you?

She came down here originally for that, but her and I have she broken apart,/cut the relationship off.

DET.: How long ago?

: Over the past two months.

DET.: Has she said anything more about the guy . . .

No, I've been trying to contact her for the past two weeks to tell her that I was going to go to the cops with this information that I feel I might have.

DET.: But you haven't . . .

: I haven't been able to get through to her.

DET. Did you ever bring it up to her that . . . about this.

At the time we talked about here in the ward with a couple other members, somebody mentioned that, wow, he had to be the "TED" we'd been hearing about in that area; we kind of passed it off.

DET.: Who said that, that it could be the guy?

: It was either myself or RICK DRAS.

DET.: Who's RICK?

: He was an inpatient here.

DET .: You mean he noticed that the guy looked like . . .

No, just from what he'd heard over the radio and in the news-

DET.: But, never saw anything?

: No.

DET.: How many times did you see him?

: Only twice, I remember.

DET.: Both times at JOANNE's house? In North Bend?

No. . . I don't the . . . all I think I remember is his first name was BILL, I'm sure about that.

DET .: About how old was he?

: He must have been 25-, 5'10", 150#, dark complected, I mean medium complexion.

DET .: How was his hair?

: Curly . . . the only way I know how to refer to it is Afro-ish.

DET.: And he had a neck brace on, not a cast, or one of those . . .

Ya, a neck brace.

DET.: Was it like they wear for a whip-lash?

Ya.

DET.: And he always wore it, did he have it both times?

Ah. . . I did see him more than two times, I saw him two times with it, and then there was one time in the middle that he wasn't wearing it.

DET.: Did he act like a doper?

. . . No. . .

DET.: I mean, did he act like he had taken dope, or did he ever mention it to you?

I can't remember ever talking about it with him. I was smoking pot at the time. I don't remember if I was smoking at that particular

time with him, but at that part of my life I was.

DET.: But he didn't act like he was spaced out, or anything?

: No.

DET.: He was always rational when you talked to him.

: Right.

DET .: And he acted like he was playing the sympathy bit?

Ya, at the time I was convenced of it, and now when I look back on it I'm even more convinced of it, along with the knowledge I've gained: here.

DET: Did you ever ask him what was wrong with his neck, or why he wore the brace? Did JOANNE ever mention it?

There was some talk about it, something about he had to go into the hospital for an operation - or why he was there.

DET.: Did you ever see the car he drove?

: Uh, ya, I saw it. It was a small car, I think it was red.

DET.: Was it parked outside at JOANNE's in the driveway?

: Ya.

DET.: Did you know anyone else who knew him except JOANNE? Did any of your friends know him?

No. . . I know thereeare other people in that area, but Idon't know their names . . . there's no mutual . . .

DET.: Do you know where he worked? Do you know where he might have worked, or may have come from?

: I didn't like the guy, so I never took the time to even get to know him.

DET.: Did JOANNEkkind of.... indicate maybe he was another boyfriend?

No. . . I was just jealous at the time. They were just friends.

I was jealous of guys hanging around.

DET.: Well, what do you think of JOANNE? Is she a pretty straight gal, or what?

: Straight?

DET.: Is she in to dope?

: She smokes pot occasionally, that's all. She uses alcohol.

DET.: Is she working here?

: Going to school.

DET.: Where at?

: Clover Park.

DET.: Is that a community college?

: I don't know if its a community college or a tech school.

DET .: What's her name:

: JOANNE COMPTON

DET.: Dids she live with her folks up there? Or did she have her own place?

: Up there? She lived with me for awhile, and then . . .

DET.: In that little house up there?

: Then she left me and . . . no, I lived out in the woods.

DET.: Well, who lived in that little house?

: Where you arrested me?

DET .: Ya.

: Well, she left me and moved to that place, then we got back -together after that.

DET.: You lived in the woods, what did you have?

: A little cabin out towards Valley, where I was living when I was arrested.

DET.: Dh, okay. You were living there at that time? It belonged to a doctor, or something?

The guy was from Texas.

DET .: But were you leasing from him?

He just let me live there, rent-free, for maintaining it and watching the property. In fact that this time I'd moved out of the cabin, that was after the first time I was there, when I was P/R'd to my folks. I was supposed to be in my folks' custody. I was supposed to be staying at my folks' house, but more often than not I would stay at a friend's or with JOANNE.

DET.: Donyouvthink JOANNE'probably knows this guy pretty well? Did did you she ever bring him up again, or/bring him up in your conversations after?

: Not since this incident where he layed the story on her and she got upset about it, wanting to know what the deal was, so she called me.

DET.: Oh, she did discuss it with you?

: Ya, we discussed it at that time.

DET.: She called you and told you that this BILL said he'd done something pretty bad, and that he'd killed somebody? He didn't say who?

: No, he didn't . . . she also said he wouldn't discuss it at that time, and at that time she was convinced that he was serious and she was scared. She picked it up from him that he was really weird.

DET.: Do you know JOANNE's address?

: Ya. Rt. 2, Box 25D5, Spanaway, Washington. Right next to

J&J Auto Wrecking is where she lives, in a little trailer. I've never

been there, she just gave me the address. Its about 15 minutes from here.

She has no phone. Her neighbor has a phone.

DET.: Do you know the neighbor's phone:

: It's WI' J-2828

DET.: Do you know the neighbor's name?

: I think its JIM.

DET .: How old is JOANNE?

: 22 or 23.

DET.: What was that school you said she's going to?

: Clover Park.

DET .: And that's in town?

:. No, its about four or five miles down the road here.

DET.: What is she taking?

: Commercial art.

DET.: When was the last time you saw her?

: About January.

DET .: And that's when she broke off with you?

: Ya . . . we still have telephone communication . . . but the relationship was broken.

DET .: And it was her idea to break it off?

: Ya.

DET.: Did she give any reason? Did she say she had another guy?

: No. I asked her about that, and she said it was not another

guy. I don't feel I know the reason. It could have been a bunch of things.

DET.: Okay . . . every time you saw this BILL, you're sure this is his name?

: Yes, I'm sure. He never gave a last name, or at least I don't remember it if he did.

DET.: Did he say what he did for a living? or where he was from?

: No.

DET.: Do you remember anything about him or conversations you had with him?

: He said he would be going into themhospital, and he wanted us to come visit him there; he was going in for surgery, or something. DET.: Did he say he was in an accident or something?

: I don't remember.

DET .: Did he have a moustache or beard?

: Sideburns, half way down his cheeks.

DET.: Did he wear glasses?

: I don't think so.

DET .: How about his dress?

: Very casual, blue jeans . . .

DET.: You can't recall any friends, or anybody else who knew him? Was anyone else there at JOANNE's?

There may have been, but there was always people in and out of her house and I can't remember a specific incident.

DET.: Do you feel there are other people in the north end who might know him?

: Yes, who <u>might know him</u>. I think I remember discussing people whom we both knew.

DET.: Do you remember their names?

: No. There was something about living in Issaquah at that time. Really, all I can do is to refer to you JOANNE. She had more contact with him and knows more about where he lives and things.

DET.: Do you think JOANNE would be receptive to talking to someone from the police?

: Its only my opinion, but no, I don't.

DET.: You don't think she would be receptive?

I have a personal feeling about it because of the way our relationship is now.

DET.: You mentioned that you were going to talk to her and tell her, or discuss this with her.

Ya, and tell her I feel I gotta do this.

DET.: She would remember this?

She would definitely remember the incident.

DET.: She would remember this incident and what he told her, and everything?

Her words were something to the effect that, gee, this guy really has killed somebody and now I impethe only one who knows and I'm afraid that now he'll come back and kill me. She was really scared about it.

DET.: Do you think she knew him from way back, or did she act like she just met him?

: I don't know. I feel that, it was . . . I knew thetacquaintances she had.

DET .: You thought you saw a small red car?

: It was a small car, foreign-type automobile.

DET .: Anything else about the car?

: I just remember it wasn't a VW. I do remember that.

DET .: Not a VW?

: In my mind it should be a red car.

DET.: How about his speech? Anything unusual about it? An accent, a normal voice? High pitch or anything?

: He was a slow speaker but kind of nervous at the same time.

DET.: You don't recall anything particular about his manner of speaking . . . how long was he there when you were there?

: 15 minutes . . . to 1/2 hour or 45 minutes. At any one time.

DET.: /the two times you saw him, close together?

Yes they were, real close together.

DET.: Did you ever ask JOANNE about him, what happened to him, or if she still sees him, or anything?

After I was arrested and sent here, he continued coming around

her place and there was some involvement there, and at that point she cut out.

DET.: But he didn't particularly act like a loner, he seemed to know people up there?

: When you put it that way, he was a loner. He never had anybody with him.

DET.: And you think that people he may have dome into contact with were friends of JOANNE's? More than acquaintances of his?

: Ya, I think it seems to fit. Its really hard to say anything.

I never really put any thought into it.

DET.: He never mentioned anything about employment?

: Not that I can remember.

DET.: That he had to go somewhere or be to work, or anything like that?

: Not that I can remember.

DET.: And the last time you saw JOANNE was about two months ago? Since you talked to her on the phone?

Several times. Even the times we did contact, she didn't want to talk.

DET .: Did she have folks here?

Her folks live in Seattle, somewhere near Woodland Park, but I don't know.

DET.: Has she been around the North Bend area for a long time?

: She goes up there occasionally, on weekends . . .

DET.: But when she was living up there, was it because of you, I mean, did she have. . .

: Well, she grew up in the Seattle area, and she'd been around the North Bend area for about 6 years, anyway . . . and then we started living together about November, 1973.

DET.: How long have you lived in that area.

I grew up there.

DET .: You must know an awful lot of people up there, then.

: Actually, yes. . . . I know practically everybody.

DET.: You wouldn't know anything about anyone that was involved in the other sex . . . like rapes in that area, would you? We've had quite a few up there . . . Are you familiar with the Tiger Mountain area?

the picturessin the paper, I know the approximate area where the findings were . . . I don't know the area, but I've been by Highway #18 so many times, I know where the five mile junction is with US.#10. DET.: Do these guys here, these are two different guys, do they look like anybody you may have seen?

: . . . Hmm . . . .

DET .: How about JOANNE? --

Uh, this has some resemblence to a guy I know as "Droopy."

DET.: Do you know his name?

Just as "Droopy"... I really don't know why, but that's what I flashed on when I looked at it.

DET.: Do you know anybody who drives a Toyota? A yellow Toyota or Datsun?

: Yellow?

DET.: Is Droopy . . . is he from the North Bend area?

: He is in that area now, he comes and goes . . . he's a junkie and is from New York originally.

DET.: But you don't know what type of car he drove?

He's driven several vehicles since I've known him, mostly pickup trucks.

DET.: How about the taverns up there around North Bend? Did you spend any time in them?

: Very little.

DET.: Of those that you did, which one was it?

I'd go into the Monogram occasionally, in North Bend, and the Falls Tavern in Snoqualmie.

DET.: How about the Monogram . . . do younger people hang around there.

: I attribute it to a multi-people place.

DET.: Okay . . . well, do you have any objections then if I, or somebody, contacts JOANNE?

: No . . . like I say, all I can really do is to refer you to her . . . I personally feel that it might be of some help . . . she's a very emotional person. She's going through a lot of hassels right now at home.

DET.: What kind of hassels?

: Uh . . . some . . . personal problems . . . she's very emotional and has the personality and emotions of an artist, very sensitive.

OET.: Did she . . . has she ever been in trouble with the police that you know of?

: Uh . . . a few encounters where she was a passenger in the car. . . that marijuana was found in, but not other than that I know of .

DET.: Now in the event that JOANNE doesn't want to talk to us about anything, can you think of anyone else that might have some more know-ledge on this guy, anybody at all that we might contact to ask, or any place we might go to that might know something about him?

Okay, this is speculation . . . I got it out of the newspaper originally . . . they were checking out all angles and even looking into the witchcraft cults, and thete are several groups of people into that type of thing in the North Bend area.

DET .: Okay, now do you know any of them? Or know of . . .

Not on a personal level, I have had some contact with the people involved . . . her name was MARILYN, that's all I know her by is just MARILYN. On Taylor River Road, out of North Bend. Do you know her?

DET.: Why would I know of her?

: Well I thought if you had any involvement in the case, and if there was anything done by the people who are into witchcraft, or the occult, that she is, in my mind, the primary #one person that of that I'm pretty sure.

DET .: Witchcraft?

Everything I ever heard about her was . . .

DET .: Oh, you mean you read something in the paper about her?

. Not about her, no, but about the police checking into every angle, including the cult.

DET.: Oh, so you figured the police had undoubtedly talked to MARILYN.

: Oh . . .ya, 'cause she's pretty well into that. . .

DET.: 'Cause she's pretty well known in North Bend as being into the cult? Did you ever have any personal involvement yourself?

: I talked to her once, and we didn't really discuss the cult and her beliefs . . . and had no real. . .

DET.: Did you know anybody, or hear of anybody, who had gotten into the occult?

: No, I never have.

: I never heard anybody discuss it, no.


