Comp. reports receiving a phone call from a Mrs. Macurkas stating that she and FRANK SULLIVAN were shown the decomposed body of a young female by BILL GEORGE, AND IVAN GEORGE. She states they found the body when they were cutting wood Sunday. 8/6/74 1645 Contacted WILLIAM (NMI) GEORGE ST. RT. Box 279 Kingston at his residence in Little Boston. Mr. George advised that he and FRANK E. SULLIVAN dob: 2/10/31 St. Rt. 2 Box 231 Kingston were on Pope & Talbot land located off S. Gamble Bay Rd. Sunday afternoon gathering wood and they found some cut alder stacked alongside a logging road. Stated that when they started loading the wood a strong smell came from under the stack and he saw some fragments of cloth. States that either a fox or a cyote had been digging there. Further stated that he did not investigate further and is unsure as to what is there. Mr. George then called F.E. SULLIVAN who agreed to take me to the location of the discovery. When Mr. Sullivan arrived we proceeded to the scene where I was met by Dep. Neal and assisted by him dug up the area. We were unable to locate anything at the location given other than further pieces of white cloth which is present in abundance at the location. After digging two holes 2 1/2 feet deep we were advised by Det. Sgt. Berg, and Sgt. Brookbank that apparently nothing is there and clear the area.





Dear Detective Dunn:

On March 7, 1975 a citizen called to express concern about a group of people living at 1 [redacted] 21st NE, Auburn. At that residence lives a Steve, 5'7", black hair, full beard who is crippled but who gets around with the use of a cane. He drives a blue VW bug, Washington license THZ [redacted]. Also at that address is a man and woman, allegedly married, who go by the names of [redacted] (" [redacted] ") and Donna [redacted]. They drive a metallic brown SAAB, Washington license IFN [redacted]. At that location also is a black over green Fiat, California license UKS610.

Per the informant, Subject [redacted] is allegedly in real estate, travels to California frequently and professes to be a minister in an off-beat religion. He has been seen using crutches on occasion and on other occasions very mobile, ie, jumping over hedges and playing with his dogs. His wife indicates that he has a bad back which goes out on him at times. He is also known to carry a Bible. His physical description is 5'10", blonde hair cut like "Ted's" which has darkened since last summer, dresses well and is similar in appearance to the composite of "Ted". Informant states that when [redacted] moved into location in about August, 1975 the SAAB had an Oregon license plate.

On March 8, 1975, Detective Caldwell of our department had reason to be at 1 [redacted] 21st NE on an apparently unrelated matter. In his opinion, his presence created a paranoia at that location. He was not allowed to enter the premises and later received a telephone call from [redacted]. [redacted] told Detective Caldwell that he was in real estate and police presence at his home would be detrimental to his business. Detective Caldwell was in plain clothes driving an unmarked vehicle.

The informant is willing to talk to you and if you desire to do so, please contact me.

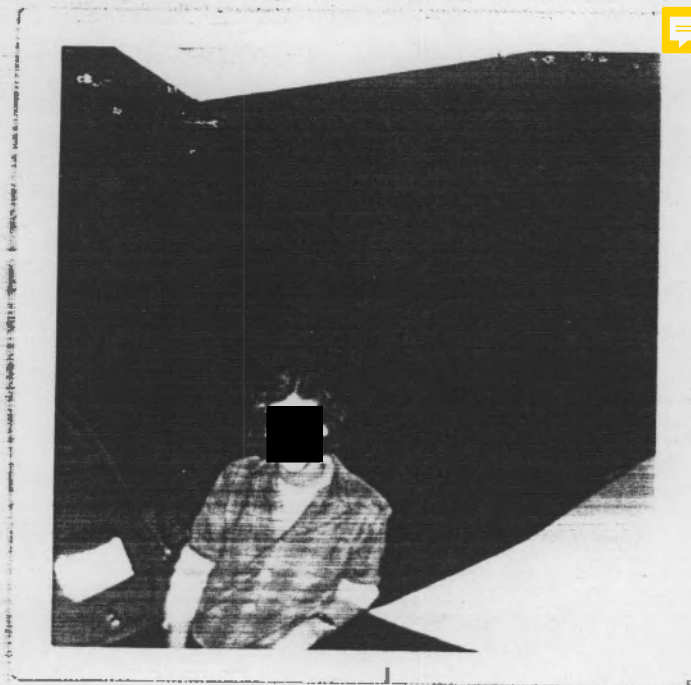

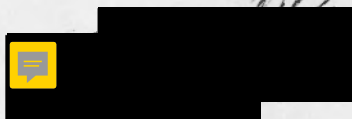

Possible "Ted":

[redacted] age 21. Lived at [redacted] 21st S.E., Auburn, Unit # [redacted] ([redacted]) from 9/74 to 11/4/74. Told the landlady that his loan did not come through and he was going back to his family. Listed his prior residence for nine years as 6 [redacted] 39th N.E., Seattle, 524-[redacted]. That is the same phone number he listed for his father, [redacted]. There is a [redacted] at 6 [redacted] 39th N.E., same phone. He said he went to Green River Community College and worked part time for Northwest Construction, Inc. Listed references Jerry Fiorito of Northwest Construction and Jack Shaw of Associated Grocers. Listed his car license as OSV [redacted] and his social security number as [redacted]. All the above came from his landlady who said he was a "very nice boy".

Prior to an informant contacting our department and before ascertaining the above, we ran a check with a dummy DOB and got back the above license numbered car registered to [redacted], DOB: 12-[redacted]-53.

Over this past weekend, a young lady came to the department with information about [redacted]. On 3-10-75, I made contact with her and her sister, both of whom knew [redacted] for about 2 1/2 weeks. One is eighteen and one is twenty. There is a third young lady who knew him, but I did not have a chance to talk to her and believe she may have left the area. The sisters are willing to be interviewed by your department, but would prefer that you go through me.

They first met [redacted] in the middle of October, 1974. They were at a gasoline station and he drove up in an orange VW bug with ski rack; he struck up a conversation and asked lots of intensive questions about them. He asked them to meet him at 1900 hours behind Olympic Junior High in Auburn. At about 1930 hours, they drove by the school and passed him. He honked and stopped so they stopped. He got out and early in the conversation, said "My name is [redacted], not Ted". On later occasions, he mentioned this again, stating that he was from the east, possibly New Jersey and that he did not know about Ted until he came out here; stated he had a friend who knew one of the victims, and the girls believe it was Janice Ott.

During the time that they knew him they noted the following things about him and about his conversations: stated he was from the "U" District in Seattle, that he was an adopted child, that he was very interested in working with retarded children and applied daily at Buckley because he had a retarded sister who died when he was five. Said he was a student at Green River Community College and did not have to work because his father was rich. Stated that he had been in an institution, unknown where, two years ago, for 1 1/2 month but cannot remember anything about it. He had a soft English accent that one of the girls asked him about. She asked if he was from England, and he laughed and said he was from Seattle. Talked a lot about wanting to buy a house near Black Diamond in the wilderness and left them with the impression that he felt confined in apartments; always wore long sleeved shirts rolled up above his elbows; when asked why, stated he felt confined by sleeves down around his wrists. He told the girls that about a year ago, he broke his back skiing and they believe that he said he skiied at Crystal Mountain; made daily trips in the afternoon, said it was to Seattle, sometimes did not return all night. Told the girls that he was an Aquarian (latter January through about February 20). He appeared emotionless and "flat" in speaking. Both girls said they felt a combination of "fear and compassion" for him, that he exuded a kind of helplessness, but yet they were afraid of him. They felt for him because he was interested in retarded children. One sister said that the description of Ted as "mysterious and smooth talking" fit [REDACTED] to a "T". He was fascinated with death and dying and especially liked two of Elton John's songs, "Funeral for a Friend" (about the death of a young girl) and "Ticking" (about a quiet catholic boy who grows up and kills fourteen people). He went to the Elton John concert and really got off on Elton John's singing of Funeral for a Friend, during which he wore all black. He also loved an Emerson, Lake and Palmer record about death, unknown what title, and talked at great length with one of the sisters about it. Stated he was majoring in one of the behavior sciences, believe it was sociology or psychology.

Had one friend visit him but because they disagreed so much, the girls felt they were not friends. He was Paul, blonde hair in a pony tail, wire rimmed glasses from one of the Islands, unknown which (San Juans). One day returned home with a dented fender and door (right side) in his orange VW Bug; had it fixed immediately. Said a teacher at GRCC backed in to him. Was never seen driving any other cars other than one he rented while the bug was being fixed. On the night they met him (it was one sister and another friend who has long brown hair, parted in middle, wire frame glasses, hair to shoulders), he expressed great interest in the friend and tried very hard to take her home; she refused. He never showed any interest in her again, either by attempting to contact or by asking one of the sisters about her which both girls said was unusual for a man. He was overly friendly, said it was because he was a very open person.

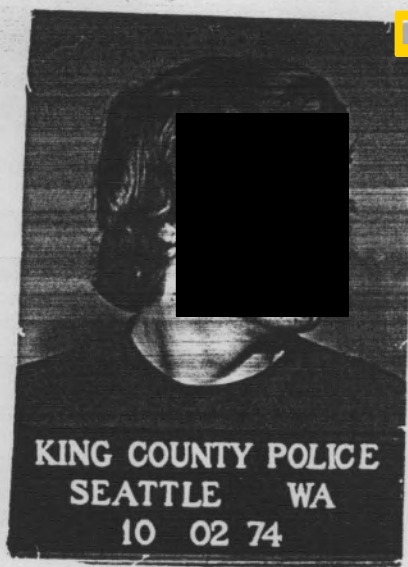

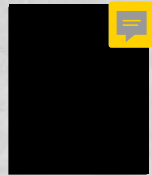

Police search region for drug robber, auto

Local authorities continued their search today for a white automobile believed used in the theft Thursday of a large quantity of Class 2 drugs from Ellison Rexall Pharmacy.

Detective Lieut. Richard T. Willis of the Sidney Police Department said today an all-states bulletin has been issued on the auto and at least one man believed involved in the robbery. Pharmacist Darrell Seifert said the loss could be "several hundred dollars."

A composite picture of the gunman has been made by a Nebraska State Patrol sergeant from North Platte based on eyewitness descriptions.

Police investigators have pieced together the following account of the incident.

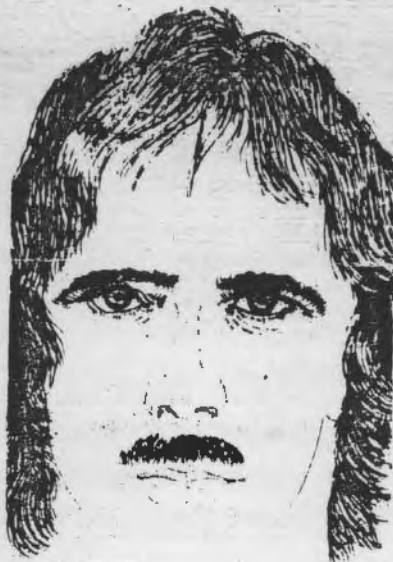
At about 9:30 a.m. Thursday a lone man entered the pharmacy, pulled a gun, and asked clerk Phyllis Dodds, for "all your Class A drugs." Mrs. Dodds gave the man the drugs in three small paper bags.

As the gunman left the store, he told Mrs. Dodd police must not be called for at least one hour because he had or would get hostages.

Police Chief Roy Bauer said talk of hostages was a hoax, but that another person may have been involved. Mrs. ~~Dodds~~ ignored the threat and called police immediately. No money was taken and no one was injured.

The man has been described by employees as Caucasian, about five-foot-eight to five-foot-ten, 170 pounds, about 21-years-old, dark hair, and wearing a mustache. He is believed to have fled the store on foot, before driving away in the white auto.

Seifert said the Class A drug classification the robber demanded has

not been used for several years. "Although he asked for Class A drugs he was given Class 2 medications. The Class A classification hasn't been used for about three years."

Class 2 drugs include amphetamines, methamphetamines, and narcotic analgesics.

He appeared to Mrs. SNYDER to very strongly resemble the "TED" look like. This subject came into her antique shop. Looked around and spent approx 4 hours. This would be from 3:00 o'clock in the afternoon until approx 7:00 o'clock p.m. in the evening.

During this period of time he gave the following information to Mrs. SNYDER: that he has a grandmother in Monterey, California who owns an antique shop there. Later mentioned that it was a friend's grandmother who lived in Monterey, California. Stated that he knew Mrs. BAKER of Baker's Antiques and Vintages in Snohomish on Union Street. Mrs. "BAKER is reportedly a favorite antique dealer of his. This subject advised that he worked part time for Butterfield Galleries in Seattle. Also stated he wants to buy antiques for his

grandmother in Monterey.

This subject advised Mrs. SNYDER that he used to attend the University of Washington, and he also used to be in the service. He is now attending Shoreline Community College in Seattle and taking classes regarding interior designing.

Mrs. SNYDER noticed that this subject had a Washington license plate on his vehicle. The only number on it was a number [REDACTED], in the center of the plate. She made mention of this to him. And this subject advised Mrs. SNYDER that his parents have the same number [REDACTED] on their license plate in Cleveland, Ohio.

This subject had the following items for sale: a lamp table made of solid dark wood approx 22 inches square with the corners rounded off. He had an old electric clock, postal telegraph painted white. She noticed that he had an old pair of workman's boot inside the vehicle, and also noticed that there was a book on the seat of the vehicle marked Shoreline Community College.

This subject was driving a beige colored VW station wagon. A registration check of the license number [REDACTED] Washington comes back to [REDACTED] of 19 [REDACTED] 35th N E, Seattle. It is a 72 VW. The legal owner is NBC of Seattle. It also comes back with an address of 4 [REDACTED] Burke Avenue N., Seattle.

Seattle PD has two traffic charges in reference to the 4 [REDACTED] Burke Avenue N., Seattle address.

The suspect hung around for approx four hours looking at everything. He crawled under the table to check underneath them. They had a shed full of items that were trucked in but were not prepared for sale. This subject also crawled all thru these items looking them over. They were becoming very apprehensive because they couldn't get rid of him until he left to go to Mrs. ANEY's place. Mrs. ANEY is an antique dealer in the City of Everett. Mrs. SNYDER stated that she called Mrs. ANEY. Mrs. ANEY had the same problem with the young subject. He did not leave her establishment until nearly 11 o'clock that same night.

Both Mrs. ANEY and Mrs. SNYDER felt that this subject resembled the suspect "TED" that the City of Seattle and King County are contending with.

14 March 1975 Mr. Joe HARVEY, a security guard for Bruce Miller Shingle Company of Rt 1, Box 154, Granite Falls, no phone, can be contacted thru Pat JOHNSON, the City Street Superintendent for the City of Granite Falls, Washington. Mr. HARVEY advised that he was talking to a [REDACTED] works as a grave digger at the American Legion cemetery at Granite Falls, Washington. [REDACTED] told Joe HARVEY that this guy "TED" operating in Seattle is his brother-in-law, [REDACTED], and during the period of time that the females come up missing in the City of Seattle and the King County area, his brother-in-law, [REDACTED], had blond hair, and drove a VW. Since that time he now drives a big car and his hair is now a dark sandy brown. [REDACTED] apparently told Joe HARVEY that at home, his brother-in-law [REDACTED] is a lamb. In Seattle he is the exact opposite. He is a tough acting character and he knows Seattle like the back of his hand.
