On 3/26/75 at 1730 hours victim Wirta while walking northbound on Macadam Road was approached by suspect [REDACTED] who was travelling northbound in his vehicle. Suspect [REDACTED] pointed a revolver at victim Wirta and twice requested victim to get into his vehicle. Victim Wirta walked away from suspects vehicle and suspect drove away. Victim Wirta went to the Charleson residence and called the Police giving the description of suspect and vehicle. Suspect [REDACTED] was stopped four blocks from the scene by Officer Johnston. Two guns were found in the vehicle one revolver was identified by victim as being the one pointed at her. The vehicle was also positively identified as the one used. Suspect was processed and released to mother per juvenile agreement forms.

At 1720 hours on 3/26/75 victim Donna Wirta began her daily walk from her residence at the LaVista Apartments, from So. 152nd St. and Macadam Wirta took a right and began walking northbound on Macadam. Shortly after passing the Stardust Apartments, Wirta heard a vehicle approaching her from behind. As victim walked on the vehicle pulled up and stopped next to her. At this time victim turned to look at driver and observed the suspect holding a long barrel revolver pointing towards her.

Suspect then instructed victim to "get into the car". Victim did not say anything or move. The suspect repeated to the victim "Get into the car". At this time the victim turned and

started walking up the driveway of 15004 Macadam Road. The suspect then began to drive away. At this time victim ran to the next house and contacted Mrs. Charleson at 15010 Macadam Road.

The victim called Tukwila Police Department and provided a description of the suspect, vehicle and the revolver used. The description was given out and Officer R. Johnston stopped a vehicle with a suspect matching the description. The suspect was taken from his vehicle and was placed into this Officers vehicle where he was placed under arrest and was advised of his rights. He stated that he did not have a gun in the car. A small starter pistol was found in the vehicle by R. Johnson. The suspects physical description matched with the one that the victim related to radio.

Suspect was transported to the station by Sgt. McQueen and processed by G. Fox. This Officer took statements from the victim. Victim was then taken down to the vehicle and she positively identified it as being the vehicle used in the assault. Sgt. McQueen called for an impound while inventoring the contents found a long barrellled twenty two (.22 caliber) in the glove compartment. After the vehicle was impounded, Sgt. McQueen brought the revolver to the victim and she positively identified it as the one that had been pointed at her.

Sgt. McQueen and Officer Johnston to submit follow-ups in regards to their participation. Evidence tagged and placed into evidence by Sgt. McQueen.

DETAILS: 3/26/75,

1735: Responded to S. 154th and the On Ramp to Int. #5, northbound on an assist to Officer Robinson and Johnston who were stopping a suspect vehicle involved in an assault with a gun. Upon arrival radio advised that the suspect had approached a female subject in the 1500 Blk. of MaCadarn Rd. S. and pointed a revolver at her, demanding that she get in his vehicle. The revolver was described as a black long barreled revolver. The suspect vehicle was described as an older model Chevrolet, brown in color. The suspect was described as a white male, early 20's, thin build, narrow face, shoulder length brown hair, mustache, wearing brown jacket and light colored shirt.

Located along side of passengers side of front seat was a small black 22 cal. blank starter pistol. The suspect who had been removed from the vehicle was placed under arrest and advised of his rights by Officer Robinson was at this time asked if he had any other guns by this officer, to which he stated no. The suspect was placed into this officers vehicle and the suspect vehicle was secured while the suspect was transported to the Tukwila Police Department. Officer Robinson contacted the victim for further information.

The suspect was placed into a holding cell, and this officer returned to the location of assault. The victim was shown the starter pistol, to which she stated that was not the gun used by the suspect. This officer then returned to the suspect vehicle, inventoried contents of vehicle, at which time a German made 22 cal. six shot revolver was located in the glove compartment. The revolver was not loaded when found. The revolver, along with a hash pipe were taken into evidence and have since been tagged and turned over to the detectives. A plastic box containing twenty-three rounds of 22 cal. Long Rifle ammunition was also located in the glove compartment and also tagged and placed into evidence. The vehicle was impounded via Big B's Towing to their lot.

On 3/26/75 at 1720 hours I left my apartment to take a walk. As I approached 15004 I heard a car approaching northbound on Macadam Rd. The vehicle pulled up along side of me. The window on the passengers side was rolled down.

When the car was across from me it stopped, I looked over to the driver and then observed him pointing a gun at me. He then said "Get in the car". I didn't say anything or move. He again said "Get in the car". I turned around and walked away from him, up the driveway at 15004 Macadam. I heard him drive away and when he picked up speed I ran to 15004 Macadam to the David P. Charleson residence. I called the Police.

The suspect had a thin face, shoulder length hair, curly hair brown in color, I am not sure about facial hair. The suspect appeared to be in his early twenties. He was wearing a light colored shirt and dark jacket. He had a small mouth and thin lips.

The car was a metallic brown and was cluttered. Officer Robinson took me to the car and I positively identified it.

The gun had a long dark barrel with a sight on the tip, Sgt. McQueen of Tukwila Police Department brought a gun which I positively identified as the gun that was pointed at me.

The above statement is true to the best of my knowledge and I am willing to testify to it in a court of law.



## Homicide To Check On Man

BY PAUL BOYD

A spokesman for the homicide task force investigating the missing women case said yesterday they will interview a 19-year-old salesman who assaulted his girl friend late Sunday, stating he was going to kill her "just like I did the other four."

The victim, an 18-year-old nurse's aid, said she has been dating the suspect for the past year. They attended a wedding reception Sunday and he drove her home.

He became irate, police were told, and began striking her repeatedly with his fists, accusing her of flirting with another man at the wedding reception. As he was hitting her, he said:

"I've just been using you. I'm going to rape and kill you. I'm going to kill you, like I did the other four. I'm going to kill you, kill you, kill you."

The victim eventually escaped and phoned police. The city-county task force said it will follow up on the report and question the young man concerning his remarks.

The skeletal remains of six women and the unidentified remains of a seventh person, have been discovered in the mountains near Issaquah.



## DETAILS:

On Wednesday, this writer was informed that our task force should check out the area West of the Search Area where remains were found. Checking into this aspect, Dets. find that above reportee does have a Casing in the area West of the Search area. Made contact with Officer Meeks and set up appointment with him for survey search of area. This appointment was tentavily set for AM on 3-20-75. Called Meeks and set up appointment for 12 noon. Traveled to Issaquah area & met Meeks. Out travels were to the PRESTON-FALL CITY OFF RAMP where we proceeded to the area of the RAGING RIVER. From I 90 at the turn off of PFC off ramp, we proceeded approx 4 miles south on the PRESTON ROAD SE, and after passing numerous farm and other reside ence we came into a PRIVATE ROAD. This road leads south bound into a area consisting of numerous cabins and homes, which are surrounded by the Raging river. They are generally used for Summer retreats, but there are many where families live the year around. MECKS showed me his cabin, which is near the end of the road, and turns to the West. His cabin is presently being torn down for replacement of new one. Of all the dwelling, one in particular was brought to my attention. From MEEKS cabin, the road journeys in a westerly direction, and comes to a DEAD END. Approx: 100 yds. from the dead end area, there are two cabins. One is used for storage, the other living. There is found a KAWSAKI motor bike in the storage cabin. The extreme cabin (Livable) was found with all blinds curtains etc closed. MECKS informed me, that a young MM name of [REDACTED] has this cabin. Has many parties, and many women in the cabin. Is well acquainted with the area overall. His father owns a home at the entrance of aforementioned project. There were no vehicles sighted at [REDACTED] cabin. It was noticed on the way out that fathers truck was sitting along side

of the road. This is a two toned Ford truck, Green/White bearing license # PC 8 [REDACTED] MEEKS. Then showed me end of road and to the right of this road, is a very rough road that leads to the POWER LINES. A truck or Bike would be only able to travel this road. This road leads into Hgwy #18, and approx is 1/10 mile to Hgwy 18. Many Bike riders are known to use this road for their trail rides.

MEEKS was asked at the conclusion of this investigation about [REDACTED], and he states he would cooperate in every way possible. That [REDACTED], did in fact use his cabinx occasionally and when he MEEKS returned to the cabin, he always found cabin oredrly, Question was asked as to any findings of matters that would draw his attention when he went to his cabins. He replied that when he returned he found cabin orderly, nothing indicating any evidence from KC case, or Spd cases.

MEEKS informed this writer that [REDACTED] had went to ISSAQUAH HIGH SCHOOL and other schools within the Issaquah area, is well familiar with the entire area.





Mr. Charles A. Meyer, Security Manager, Meyerhaeuser Co.; was in the North Bend Officer and brought up this information on a "Ted" suspect.

In March of 1974 Mr. Meyer was working for Seattle First National Bank, and was investigating a forgery case in which one [REDACTED] "Ted" [REDACTED] had forged the checks. These particular checks were stolen from a location right next door to where one of the missing girls worked before her disappearance. All of this is pretty sketchy because Mr Meyer was giving me this information from memory. [REDACTED], forged the checks using the name, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] carry's a gun and both sells and uses heroin. SPD has had him on TVB and larceny, his SPD number is BA 23932. Officer Cline of our department, states that this subject was in our jail and released on March 5th of this year under the name [REDACTED]. At that time he gave an address of Bx [REDACTED] Thorp, WA. Thorp is located between Clellum and Ellensburg. His King County ID number is unknown, BA 97676 KC

Mr. Meyer discovered [REDACTED]'s identity through two women. Miss Czarmecki, who had lived with the subject; she would probably not be co-operative, address of 311 NE 53rd Seattle. The other women, who was more co-operative, Miss Michele Wilson gave Meyers information concerning [REDACTED] to the effect that he was very sadistic and that she was afraid of him. Further, one of the girls had a VW which [REDACTED] used on occasion.

I realize this information is not complete and Mr Meyers has stated that if you need it he can get a copy of the forgery case on which he was working at the time all this occurred. Mr Meyer's business phone is 924 5428 and his home phone is unknown at this time.



On March 11, 1975, I met with a young lady from the Leavenworth, Washington, area-- Judy L. Meuret, by her request. This meeting was in reference to the multiple unsolved female deaths that occurred in the Greater King County area. Miss Meuret advised this officer that for a short period of time in January and February, 1974, she lived with an individual by the name of [REDACTED] aka TED in the Hawaiian Islands. She described the individual as:

approximately 20-21 years of age, 5'7"-5'8", 145 pounds, sandy brown semi-long hair, blue eyes.

According to the young lady, Mr. [REDACTED] is mentally unstable and although she has no proof, advised that the subject was discharged from the military on a Section 8. It is also unknown to her as to whether or not he was treated for this condition. She described Ted as being a very possessive individual whose personality was subject to change at a drop of a hat. Miss Meuret furnished this department a photograph of her and Mr. [REDACTED]. This photo has been sent to Seattle for blowup purposes. On March 15, 1975, she furnished this officer with an additional photo of Mr. [REDACTED] which we are enclosing with this letter, and as soon as we have received the blowup of the first photo, it will also be forwarded to your office.

Miss Meuret stated that she would be more than willing to talk to any member of the Task Force involved in this investigation; however, the interview would have to take place somewhere other than her residence. Arrangements could be made through the Chelan County Sheriff's Office by Detective Jerry Monroe.

Mr. [REDACTED] is presently living in the Burien area. It is unknown if the subject owns or has access to automobiles; also unknown if he has a Washington State Driver's License.

If sometime in the near future your department finds it convenient, we would appreciate any additional composite pictures of the suspect, other than the one which appeared in "The Seattle Times" recently, as this department has on occasion checked out several individuals in our area.

# Murder Suspect Arraigned

SALEM — Once-convicted

butcher murderer Richard Marquette was arraigned in Marion County Circuit Court Wednesday morning for the weekend dismemberment slaying of Betty Louise Wil-

son, 35, Scio.

Judge Val Sloper appointed Salem attorney Rodney Miller to defend Marquette, who was released two years ago from Oregon State Penitentiary after serving 12 years of a life sentence for the 1961 hacking-killing of Joan Rae Caudle, a 24-year-old Portland housewife.

At the brief arraignment Wednesday, Marquette was whisked past waiting press photographers by county sheriff's deputies.

"I don't want them treating him so rough — Richard was a gentle man," said Enza Oswald, secretary at Salem Plumbing.

The petite Italian woman was accompanied "reluctantly" by Zelma Stone, mother of plumbing firm owner Otho Stone. Mrs. Stone said her son was "taking very hard" the arrest of the only convict he had ever hired.

Mrs. Oswald said her boss was "wonderful to Richard, always giving him good

advice." Stone was understanding when Marquette called in to report he had been drinking and would miss a day's work, she said. When Marquette had his driver's license revoked once, Stone drove him to and from work and after securing a limited license which would allow Marquette to drive a company van to his plumbing jobs.

Pacing the courthouse floor in a pink angora sweater and red slacks, Mrs. Oswald told The Journal that she wasn't as shocked as others at work when she learned of Marquette's arrest.

"I've tried never to be alone with him after I heard a year ago (about the 1961 murder). A person might be 'cured' but you never can tell when the mind might just flip back," she said. "I've got two beautiful boys (12 and 15 years) and they don't need their mother dead."

"As soon as I read about the murder, I thought: 'Richard? I wonder...'"
