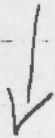

She left her luggage and started walking west on NW Jackson Ave. In the 1300 block she was asked by the suspect to help him with his car. He wanted to have her hold a wire so that he could get his car started. He got it going and then asked her if he could give her a lift home. She replied "No." He asked again and she still replied no. She continued to walk west. In the 1500 blk or near there suspect parked his car and started walking with her. He continued to talk to her and she replied. When they arrived at 2 [REDACTED] NW Jackson Ave, her apartment, he walked in without an invitation. He talked about many things, zen, existentialism, that he had shot speed, and she had talked with him. She commenced to do the dishes she had left and he took over the dish washing. She sat on the bed and attempted to get him to leave by using polite phrases such as; "I'm very tired as I have ridden a bus all the way from Burns" and "I have a busy day tomorrow". He came over to her and tried to grab her hands. She moved them and told him "No, I don't want any of this". He asked for a kiss. "No." Asked again for a little kiss. "No." He then grabbed her and threw her on the bed. He laid partly on her and kept her from saying anything with his hand over her face. He had her face partly buried in pillows also. She had her hands up by her chest attempting to push him away. He told her to put her hands down. She was getting very frightened at this and thought that she was going to be raped and then killed to keep her from talking. clothes. Everytime she would moved he would press her down in the pillows and hold her motionless. She was wearing blue jean type pants, bikini panties, a black turtle neck sweater, and an India indian type tunic. When she was naked he made her lay flat on the bed and held her down with one hand while he took off his clothing. He had taken off most of his clothes and was trying to unlace his boots when she tried to run for the door. To get to the door she had to go over the book shelf. She tried to spring to her feet and jump the book shelf but couldn't. He caught her at the book shelf and threw her back on the bed. Some things were knocked off the shelf during this. He then told her she wasn't going anywhere and to lay still.

She asked to go to the bathroom but he wouldn't let her. He held her and got the rest of his clothes off. He then sat astride of her body and made her perform fallatio upon him. She didn't like this and stated it almost made her choke. He made her do this for about five minutes. She told this writer that she thought if she pretended to like it maybe he would stop. She asked him if he would like to play with her. She stated to this writer that she thought it would be better to go along with him somewhat to keep him from hurting or killing her.

When she asked him if he wanted to play with her, he said "Sure". He then rolled over on her so that he was facing toward the foot of the bed. He had kept her doing fallatio on him all the time and had told her to keep sucking everytime she stopped. He then lay partly on her and kept her performing fallatio on him while he performed cunelungus on her. This was done for about one minute when she heard ANDY BORTZ drive up outside. She started to scream and suspect got off. She ran to the door and suspect also went to the door and unlocked it. She ran out the door, up the stairs (basement apartment) and out to his car (Andy Bortz's). She found a coat in the car which she was wearing when she arrived at the station. BORTZ and the suspect had a few words (covered in another report and statement) and then Bortz came and drove [REDACTED] to the station.

At the station [REDACTED] was hysterical and almost incoherent for about 10 minutes. She then gradually calmed down and I obtained the forgoing information from her.

About 1:00PM her eyeglasses were brought from her apartment by Det. Sgt Uhden. One side was bent almost 90 degrees. She had stated that when he had first forced her onto the bed and lain on her to keep her quiet, her glasses had been mashed against her face and then off to the side, bending them. Pictures were made of the bent glasses and they were returned to her. They were found under the head area of the bed. She had two marks on her nose from the glasses nose pieces. They were quite red.

Several times during her story of the incident she had said that she was sure he was going to rape her and then kill her. She seemed very frightened of him. While never actually hitting her he had used considerable force to hold her down and make her do what she did.

The suspect was stopped just west of Philomath by Philomath PD. He was requested to come to Corvallis to clear up this matter of rape or the attempt of. He came willingly. He was advised of his rights by Officer Breazeal, witnessed by Officer Kittel. See other reports.

[REDACTED] was married in 19 Sept 1964 to a [REDACTED]. A divorce was obtained Mar 19, 1971. They were separated in Mar 1970. They had two children, [REDACTED] age 3, and [REDACTED] age 2. These children are in the court appointed care of the husband. She got her maiden name back.

At approx. 11:30 PM 6-3-71 this writer ~~XXXXXXXX~~ accompanied by Officer Kittel went to the basement apartment at 2 [REDACTED] NW Jackson Str. This writer took photographs of the interior of the apartment which were later turned over to Det. Sgt. Uhden.

Returning to the Police Dept. just after 12:00 Mid. on 6-4-71 this writer was asked by Sgt. Conlee to talk with a suspect in connection with the attempted rape. This writer went into the booking room and introduced myself and Officer Kittel to the subject. The subject stated that his name was [REDACTED] and that he lived in Toledo, Ore. At this time this writer advised the subject of his rights, and he stated that he understood them. I asked the subject if he had been in the city of Corvallis prior to being stopped by the Philomath Police. The subject stated that he had been in Corvallis but had done nothing wrong while in the city. This writer asked the subject to tell me what he had done while he was in Corvallis. The subject stated that he had done nothing wrong, and did not wish to tell me anything. At this time I asked the subject to stand up and undue the front of his pants as there were a pair of mens undershorts (jockey type) left in the complainant's apartment. The subject did this and it was noted by this writer that the subject was not wearing undershorts. I asked the subject where his under shorts were and he replied that he had left them in a girls apartment. I again asked the subject to tell me what had happened. The subject stated that he had had some car trouble while in Corvallis this evening and had asked a female passer-by to help him fix his car. The female did help the subject fix his car and then was invited by the female to her apartment. The subject went to the females apartment with her and after arriving there helped her do some dirty dishes. The subject stated that after finishing the dishes, the female subject lite a candle and some insence. The subject stated it was very cozy in the apartment and that the female was very friendly towards him. The subject stated that the two of them started kissing while seated on the bed and then disrobed completely. It was noted at this time by this writer that the subject was wearing shin high lace up leather boots which were laced completely. The subject stated that just prior to entering into actual intercourse with the female there was a knock at the door, and the female got up stating its ~~psy~~ psychedelic Andy. The female went to the door and talked with the person at the door (female was nude at the time) and then left the apartment. The subject stated that he got up and put on his clothes at that time and left the apartment. The subject stated that the female was not forced into the sexual act by him, but was cooperating on her own behalf.

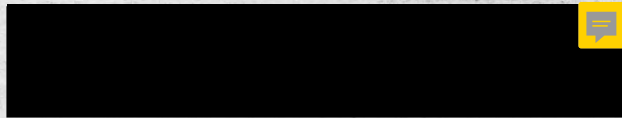

At 9:00 AM, 6/4/71, this writer was assigned to do a follow-up on the attempted rape involving [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] NW Jackson Avenue, Corvallis, Oregon.

These two girls live in apartment #3 which is on the top floor of the apartment house at 2 [REDACTED] NW Jackson Avenue, Corvallis, Oregon. They both stated that they were home on the evening of June 3, 1971 but heard no screams or no unusual commotion coming from the down-stairs area of the apartment house during the evening. The girls indicated that the other apartment on the top floor was vacant, this being apartment #2.

These subjects living in the front north apartment were contacted and they stated that they were home until about 9:10 PM on June 3, 1971. At that time both Ron and Bob Hewitt and their girl friend left the apartment house and attended a movie in Corvallis and they returned about 11:15 PM. These subjects were not home during the incident on June 3, 1971. Bob Hewitt's girl friend is FRANKLIN, Erin, 343 NW 8th St., Apt. 6, Corvallis, Oregon. Both Ron and Bob Hewitt and the girl, Miss Franklin, indicated that during the day of June 3, 1971 they had not seen the subject by the name of [REDACTED] who lives in the basement apartment. They stated they had not seen her all week. However, they did say that around 3:00 PM a subject arrived at the apartment who was driving a Rambler Classic about a 1966 model. Subject knocked on the door, they did not see him enter, but stated that he was there for approximately one and a half hours. They stated he had long dark hair and that was all they knew about him. Also, subject #2, person about 30, partially bald who wears shirts with pictures on them, green slacks and sandals arrived about 4:30 or 5:00 PM. They stated this subject had been at [REDACTED]'s apartment before and at one time had knocked on their door and asked for [REDACTED]. They directed him to the basement apartment.

Subject #3 who comes to the apartment quite often is what they thought an Arabian fellow. They stated he came on the day of June 3, 1971 around 4:30 or 5:00 PM was there around fifteen minutes or so and then left with some papers.

The other subject which they see there quite often is the main boyfriend of [REDACTED] by the name of Andy. They stated that Andy had been living there since they had read about the

fire down on 14th Street where the marijuana plants had been seized. Ron and Bob Hewitt and Miss Franklin stated that there was all sorts of people coming and going from [REDACTED]'s apartment at all hours of the day and night. Some of them real creepy looking characters.

The basement apartment at 2 [REDACTED] NW Jackson Avenue was contacted. The two female subjects living there were home.

Pamela Woodside stated that on the evening of June 3, 1971 she came home about 8:30 PM and went right to bed. She went to sleep and woke up about 9:40 PM when her roommate, Laura Wagner, came home. They stated they stayed up and talked until about 10:00 PM, Laura Wagner left again and Pamela Woodside went back to bed. Laura Wagner then returned about 10:55 PM. Miss Wagner stated that upon arrival at 10:55 PM she met a tall thin white male subject coming up the stairs. She said he was approximately 6-1, had short brown hair. Miss Wagner stated that the subject still had his shirt unbuttoned, shirt was also out of his pants and that he had boots on. As the subject went by her, she heard him exclaim, "Oh damn" evidently talking to himself. She said he seemed to be in quite a hurry. Miss Wagner also stated that when she was home the first time, she had went out to check her bicycle and had seen Andy which was just a short time before she saw the man on the stairs.

Pamela Woodside said she heard or saw nothing as she was a very sound sleeper. Both girls stated, however, that [REDACTED] has many callers at various times and of various types. They stated they also have seen the person who looks like he is an Arab at the apartment. They did see him around 6:00 PM on June 3, 1971.

Bob Hewitt was instructed to have the couple that live on his floor call the station if they did come home today. They still were not home at the time the interviews were concluded with the other girls.

[REDACTED] and her boyfriend, Andy Bortz, came to the Corvallis Police Station at 11:45 AM and both gave written statements. See attached copies.

At 1:40 PM, 6/4/71, [REDACTED] was interviewed by this officer and Matron Freundt. She stated that she had arrived in Corvallis around 9:30 PM on a Greyhound Bus from Burns, Oregon. She stated that she had been in Burns since Monday, May 31, 1971. She stated that she had traveled to Burns on the bus alone and had returned to Corvallis from Burns also alone on Greyhound Bus.

Miss [REDACTED] stated that she started walking home on Jackson carrying a sack with her possessions. She went on to say that she first saw the subject between 13th and 16th Street on Jackson. The subject at that time asked her to hold a wire underneath the hood until he supposedly fixed the Volkswagen.

[REDACTED] stated they arrived at the apartment about 15 or 20 minutes after she got off the Greyhound Bus which would put her at the apartment about 9:50 PM. She stated that the subject parked his car and then walked with her to the apartment. She made no attempt to keep him out of the apartment, but on the other hand did not request to come into the apartment. She also mentioned that it was quite strange that the subject talked the way he did but his appearance did not fit him, referring to his crew cut.

SUBJECTS INVOLVED: [REDACTED] Complainant MASSENGALE, [REDACTED], suspect.

Miss [REDACTED] was asked to explain in detail the scream let out when he threw her on the bed. She indicated that it was not a blood curdling scream, but she felt that she screamed loud enough so the other people in the apartment could hear it. However, she stated she did only scream once. She gave an example as kind of a loud "o-oooh". She stated that the only people she heard in the apartment during the time the subject was attacking her was the girls in the basement apartment around 10:15 PM.

[REDACTED] was asked about the fellow that came to her apartment on June 3, 1971 in the Rambler. She stated that his first name is Doug that he was from Dallas and came to the apartment quite often. Also, she stated his girl friend was usually with him, her name is Cindy Street and that she babysits in Corvallis.

She was asked about the balding man about 30 and she also stated that he was a graduate student, his name was Dave Whinton, she wasn't sure of the correct spelling.

She was asked about the Arab who came to her apartment and she stated that he would not appreciate us calling him an Arab. She stated that he was a Persian from Iran and that his name was Farahod Nambroin, she was also not certain about the correct spelling. She indicated they called him Hod for short.

[REDACTED] was asked if she had ever had any intimate relationship with Doug, Dave or Hod and she stated that she did not. She stated that she was quite close to Hod at one time but had never slept with him or had any intimate relationship.

[REDACTED] was asked about her husband. She stated that he was now living in Sackett she did not know which one. She stated that one of the children is with his mother in Springfield and the other child was at Jack and Jill Nursery. She indicated that she was married when she was 18 years old, they were married for six years when the divorce was final and that she was the one that filed for the divorce claiming Mental Cruelty. She said that their marriage was a mutual incompatibility, also, she said that this was his second marriage and that he had had no children by his first marriage. She said that this was her first marriage to [REDACTED].

In conclusion, [REDACTED] still contended that everything on the evening of June 3, 1971 was committed against her will and due to the statements made by the suspect was very afraid for her life, safety and well being. She indicated that she doesn't exactly believe in free-love but believes in love with anyone she desires to have it with if she really cares for that person. She said that a marriage was nothing but paper work. [REDACTED] said that she did have intimate relationships with Andy Bortz and that she has had intimate relationships with other men of her choosing.

She stated that her relationship with the subject, [REDACTED], was against her will, that she did not enjoy it, that she pretended to enjoy it being afraid she would be harmed. She said the subject was very much overbearing and considerably more powerful than she was, also she stated that he never reached a climax and also that she never reached a climax during their relationship. She also indicated that at first he almost smothered her with his body and that he had his hands around the area of her throat but never really strangled her, just pushing her back, etc. She did have a small scratch on her left cheek bone, a small bruise, approximately the size of a quarter, on her leg just above the knee and a small scratch on her right shoulder, just near the top of the back near the shoulder. These points were checked by Matron Freundt.

No further information at this time.

At approximately 11:00 PM, 06-03-71, this officer was dispatched to 16th and Tyler to look for a yellow VW in regards to an attempted rape. I was unable to locate the vehicle at that residence and at approximately 11:15 PM was dispatched to the address of 2 [REDACTED] NW Tyler, the scene of the attempted rape, to see whether or not the suspect was still at this address. Upon going down to the basement of 2 [REDACTED] NW Jackson and turning to the door which I was instructed opened into the apartment I observed the door standing approximately 12" open and everything dark in the interior. I pushed the door open and stepped inside and turned on the light. I at first look to see if there was any subjects in the apartment. It is a one room affair and there was no one in there. I then proceeded to take mental note of some of the conditions existing. At that time I noticed the bed as shown in the picture, pushed at an angle from the wall, and messed up with the pillow in the middle, towards the foot of the bed there was numerous pieces of changes laying strewn across the edge of it, and approximately 12 pieces of change laying on the floor below the same areal I observed a woman's pair of sandals next to the bed and two pull over terry cloth tops on top of them and slightly to the NE of these I observed a pair of mens undershorts, in a heap as if dropped. On the dresser on the east wall, I observed what appeared to be mens [REDACTED] under. Also, running across the middle of the room at the foot of the bed is a bookshelf affair, set on cement blocks. The second or top shelf had been knocked over and the board was at an angle, and the metal or wrought iron fixture which had apparently been sitting on top of it was laying across the record stack. There were several articles of jewelry that appeared to have fallen to the floor from this. In the corner which would be the SE corner of the bedroom area against the dresser and the shelf were two bags of clothes and in the middle of these clothes were a pair of levis which were turned partially inside out and a pair of pokadot bikini type woman's underpants still entangled in them, as when underpants and levis are removed at the same time. One of the legs of the levis was pulled through the underpants, partially turned inside out. I noted dishes in the sink at this time in water, one the dresser next to the head of the bed I observed a paper can with metal lid which had a burned stick of incense stuck into it. I could smell the fragrance of recently burned incense in the room. At about this time Sgt. Uhden arrived and I left him at the scene and returned to the Police Station with Officer Breazeal. We obtained a Polaroid camera, returned to the scene and shot some pictures. We then returned to the Police Station and met with the suspect [REDACTED] and at our first contact in the booking room Officer Breazeal advised the subject of his rights. The subject stated that he understood his rights and Officer Breazeal began questioning the subject. First the subject was very reluctant to answer any questions and asked what

he was doing here. When Officer Breazeal asked him if he had been told by the Philomath Police or Benton County Sheriff's Office what the reason for being stopped was, they told him yes, it had something to do with rape or something like that. Officer Breazeal then replied "Then you know what you are here for." The subject at first denied or refused to answer all questions put to him and then gradually pieces of information were released by Officer Breazeal indicating our knowledge of the happenings, the subject began to admit them and then to tell his side of the story. The subject denied all questions and refused to answer almost all questions until the point where he was asked to stand up and remove his outer pants which he did, revealing the fact that he was wearing no underpants. Officer Breazeal stated, "You left your underpants at her apartment didn't you". It was at this point that he began to answer questions and began to admit a knowledge of the event. This was the extent of my contact with the subject. I then left and returned to routine patrol.

This writer while in his police unit, heard over the air that several units were looking for a yellow Volkswagen in the vicinity of 16th and Jackson. From the radio transmission this writer concluded that the vehicle was involved with an indecent exposure. I drove to the address of 2 [redacted] Jackson which was the complainant's address and there met Officer Reader who explained to me that this concerned an attempted rape.

This writer checked the apartment of the victim, [redacted], and noted that the apartment consisted of one room, approximately 14' X 20', a bed in one corner and the room divided in half by a low bookcase made of plums block and board on which were a large number of records. The bookcase had been disarranged and some of the plums blocks knocked over, the bed was in a state of disarray, there were clothes scattered about on the floor, also a cigar box had been tipped over which apparently held a large amount of change. One of the things noted on the floor were one pair of men's shorts, 2 terry cloth pull over shirts, one orange and one green. At the foot of the bed was a black long sleeved pull over shirt, blouse, and beside it a green tunic with decorations on it. Also, there was noted a pair of blue jeans with a belt in and in the blue jeans were a pair of green and white bikini panties. It appeared that from the way the panties were in the jeans that both had been taken off simultaneously.

The bed was checked by this writer for any sign of stains (semen) there were none found. The men's underwear were also looked at and nothing was noted on them. On the table beside the bed was a pack of Kool cigarettes with one cigarette left in it and a small ash tray beside the cigarettes had three cigarette butts in it, which also appeared to be Kool's although no brand name was seen on them. After taking note of the above conditions, the room was secured and locked by this writer, we then cleared the area and came to the Police Station.

While this writer had been in the room checking the contents, the suspect had been stopped by the Philomath Police Department. It was found that the subject was: [redacted]. This subject was at this time in the booking room of the Corvallis Police Station. When this writer arrived at the Police Station [redacted] was being advised of his rights by officer Breazeal and Officer Kittel. Officer Breazeal advised the subject of his rights quite plainly, emphasizing that he did not have to talk to us and that he could have a lawyer present if he so wished. Subject stated that he understood these things and just wanted to know what this was all about.

His rights were then read to him from the Miranda Warning Card and he stated that he did understand them. The subject was then interviewed concerning his actions previous to being stopped and his whereabouts for the evening. The subject stated that he had had car trouble around Philomath, and was on his way back to his home in Toledo when he had been stopped by the Philomath Police Department and that was about all he could tell us. He stated that he was in the area because he was going to go to Foster to see a friend. Subject was then asked if he was wearing underwear at this time and

Subject wanted to know why we wanted to know this. We stated it was one of the things that we had to find out at this time. Subject then unbuttoned his pants after being told to do so. Subject complied with this and it was found that he was not wearing any underwear. When asked where the underwear was he stated, "Well, its probably in that girls apartment". He began to tell us about his time at the apartment and he then related that he had car trouble and while he was stopped a female came by to help him. She then suggested that they go to her apartment. They went to her apartment where she did the dishes and he helped her, and they talked for a while, she then lit some incense also lit some candles and as he stated "things got very cozy" and he was about to have intercourse with the girl when her boyfriend came knocking on the door. the subject was asked at this time if both he and the girl were naked at this time and he stated that they were. He was asked if he had helped undress her and he stated that she did not need any help, she was quite willing to take her clothes off by herself.

Subject was asked if he had any kind of sexual activities with the girl other than the attempted intercourse, he stated that he had not done anything else.

The subject stated that he had been arrested 6 or 7 times in the past for different offenses, had never been found guilty of anything, did not want to relate what the arrests were for, except he did admit that one of them was for burglary. Checks were ran through NCIC and also the bureau at Salem and both came back negative on the subject. The subject stated that he was originally from Michigan and his wife was from California. These two states could possibly be checked for any record of the subject. At the time this officer was talking to Massengale, Sgt. Conlee was interviewing the victim, [REDACTED], and after talking to her for a few minutes, this writer and Asst. District Attorney Jim Brown and Hank Dickerson went back to the [REDACTED] apartment where the mens shorts were taken from the floor of Miss [REDACTED]'s apartment. Also picked up at this time were a pair of glasses which belonged to Miss [REDACTED]'s, which were bent, also a pair of suspenders which belonged to [REDACTED] which were laying on top of the dresser, also a green tunic with a zipper down the back which Miss [REDACTED]'s was wearing. She stated that [REDACTED] had taken this off of her. The tunic was turned inside out and the zipper to it was still zipped up except for about 1" at the top. This writer does not believe that any girl would take a garment off in this manner and it would appear that this had been pulled from the bottom up, over the victim's head. Also taken into custody were a pair of blue jeans with a pair of bikini panties inside which also belonged to Miss [REDACTED]'s. These items that were picked up are currently in the evidence locker.

Mr. [REDACTED] maintained throughout the evening that the only reason the girl hollered was because her boyfriend had came to the door and she was afraid to be found in the position that they were in at that time and that was why she was raising Cain now, to keep her boyfriend happy. This writer talked to the boyfriend at some length. The boyfriend is Wallane Andrew BORTZ, known as Andy Bortz. The boyfriend was questioned

by this writer regarding his feelings on sexual intercourse and his girlfriends. He related that his girlfriend was 25 yrs. old, had been married previously and it is not possible for her to have any more children. He stated that they had intercourse previously and their ideas on intercourse were quite liberal. He was asked if he thought that she would possibly panick if he came to the door while she was in such a position and he stated that he did not believe so because he believed that she had had intercourse since they had been going together and this was something that was entirely up to her. He stated that both of them pretty much believed in "free love" and there were "no hang ups in this regard."

A written statement was also taken from the subject and is attached to this report.

No other information at this time.



As per your phone call 2-13-75 1921 hours, above listed detectives responded to Photo Workshop 10738-5th. Ave. Northeast phone 365-8960 and arrived at that location 1935 hours.

The possible "Ted" likeness described by you in the above phone conversation was still on the premise and was interviewed by detectives.

The subject was identified as:

home address 6-[redacted]-Lake Washington Blvd. Northeast, Kirkland, Wa.
home phone 827-[redacted]
student at Bellevue Community College senior year

The subject was cooperative but obviously nervous. The subject advised the reason for his nervousness was he couldn't figure out who called detectives about his photograph. (Detectives had prefaced the interview with an explanation that an anonymous caller had advised the subject was at this time developing a photograph of a human skull.)

The subject went on to explain the photograph, a lake, wood and skull scene, were actually the brain storm of one of his professors at the college. The professor was shown the lake photo and remarked to the subject how desolate and dead the area in the photo was. The subject, who recently attended Canada College 4200-Farmhill Blvd., Redwood, Calif. had several archaeology photos obtained while attending and one of these was the photo of an Indian find in Calif. The photos included one of a skull and the subject has spent the day superimposing one onto the other.

The subject took from his school brief case a portfolio with row after row of negatives and was able to show detectives numerous negatives of these archaeology diggings.

The subject did not have a cast on his arm as per information but instead had surgical wrapping on his right arm from the finger tip to elbow. The subject advises he had surgery to this arm last Tuesday for tendon damage. The wrapping is fresh and the hand appears consistent with the subject's story.

When detectives initially contacted the subject he and several other photography "buff's" were admiring his finished job. The studio there caters to photography "buff's" and has on going classes.

It would appear at this point that the above subject is in fact NOT "Ted".

As previously mentioned the subject after the initial shock of the interview was very cooperative and stated that if it became necessary he would make any or all of his negatives available to Seattle Police Officers.

Caution with Horses Urged

"Be careful."

That's the way [redacted] answered when he was asked what kind of advice he would give to the young people now becoming involved with training horses and entering horse shows.

"You just can't trust a horse no matter how long you have had it," he said. "It can take only a second or two for a horse to change your life."

[redacted] put a little too much trust in a Thoroughbred mare he had had for six years while he was coming out of the St. Joe country after a successful elk hunt on Dec. 3, 1968. The horse kicked him in the head and nearly killed him. The kick paralyzed his left side and made it impossible for him to talk for a long time.

[redacted] and Leon Buckles, also of Spokane, had killed elk on the East Fork of Big Creek in the St. Joe drainage and

were coming out in a snowstorm when the accident occurred. There was 18 inches of snow on the ground.

[redacted] dismounted to tighten the cinch on the saddle and fell in the deep snow. He reached up for the stirrup so that he could pull himself back to his feet. That apparently spooked the mare. She began kicking and whirling. One of her hooves hit [redacted] in the head.

"She didn't have a mean bone in her body," [redacted] said. "She just had to be scared."

The kick was the last thing

[redacted] knew for several months. Buckles made him as comfortable as possible, found some hunters in the vicinity and had them stay with him while he went for help. The next morning a helicopter flew [redacted] out to a hospital.

[redacted] became semi-conscious the following February and soon was flown to Seattle, where he was placed in a hospital. During the next nine months he was in four hospitals.

"I had to learn how to talk all over again," he said. "At first, my left side was completely paralyzed."

"I started weight lifting. When I started, I could lift only two pounds. When the doctors told me to quit because there wasn't much hope of more improvement, I was lifting 170 pounds."

[redacted]'s wife divorced him and then his house burned down. He now lives alone in a

large mobile trailer at El [redacted] Portland, but hopes to hire a live-in housekeeper.

He set up his own business, Ideal View Photo Buttons.

He takes pictures of persons and mounts the pictures on the 2 1/4-inch buttons. One type of button has a pin for attaching to clothing. The other has a mirror on the back and can be used by women to carry in their purses.

Still interested in wildlife, he's the secretary-treasurer of National Migratory Birds Unlimited, which is headed by Leonard Keefer. The group is trying to get farmers to leave grain for ducks and geese.

Although [redacted] is still confined to a wheelchair, he does get around. He has a half-acre garden and grows everything from peanuts to sunflower seeds.

He's even feeding seven baby skunks that apparently were deserted by their mother.

He still has hopes of walk-

ing normally again. Every day, providing the weather is fair, he walks back and forth between his parallel bars 120 times.

His almost constant cheerfulness and love of life continually amazes his friends.

"How are you getting along, [redacted]" he was asked the other day.

"Couldn't be better," he answered cheerfully.

That from a man whose horse nearly seven years ago made him a cripple for the rest of his life.

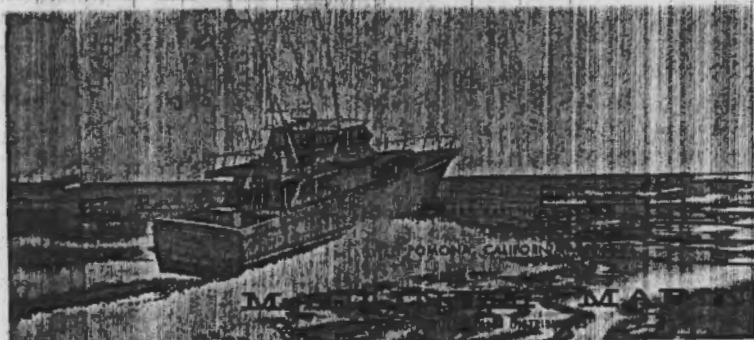
