From the radio transmission this writer concluded that the vehicle was involved with an indecent exposure. :: I drove to the address of 2 Jackson which was the complainant's address and there met Officer Reader who explained to me that this concerned an attempted rape. This writer checked the apartment of the victim, and noted that the apartment consisted of one foom, approximately 14' X 20', a bed in one corner and the room divided in half by a low bookcase made of plumis block and board on which were a large number of records. His rights were then read to him from the Miranda Warning Card and he stated that he did understand them. He was asked if he had helped undress her and he stated that she did not need any help, she was quite willing to take her clothes off by herself.

Subject was asked if he had any kind of sexual activities with the girl other than the attempted intercourse, he stated that he had not done anything else.

The subject stated that he had been arrested 6 or 7 times in the past for different offenses, had never been found guilty of anything, did not want to relate what the arrests were for, except he did admit that one of them was for burglary. by this writer regarding his feelings on sexual intercourse and his girlfriends. He related that his girlfriend was 25 yrs. old, had been married previously and it is not possible for her to have any more children. He stated that they had intercourse previously and their ideas on intercourse were quite liberal. He was asked if he thought that she would possibly panick if he came to the door while she was in such a position and he stated that he did not believe so because he believed that she had had intercourse since they had been going together and this was something that was entirely up to her. He stated that both of them pretty much believed in "free love" and there were "no hang ups in this regard."



The subject was identified as: US WM 21 D.O.B. 11- -43 5'9" 155# -Lake Washington Blvd. Northeast, Kirkland, Wa. home address 6 home phone 827student at Bellevue Community College senior year The subject was cooperative but obviously nervous. The subject advised the reason for his nervousness was he couldn't figure out who called detectives about his photograph. (Detectives had prefaced the interview with an explanation that an anonymous caller had advised the subject was at this time developing a photograph of a human skull.) The subject went on to explain the photograph, a lake, wood and skull scene, were actually the brain storm of one of his proffessors at the college. The professor was shown the lake photo and remarked to the subject how desolate and dead the area in the photo was. The subject, who recently attended Canada College 4200-Farmhill Blvd., Redwood, Calif. had several archaeology photos obtained while attending and one of thiese was the photo of and Indian find in Calif. The hotos included one of a skull and the subject has spent the day superimposing one onto the other. and was able to show detectives numerous negatives of these archaeology diggings.

The subject took from his school brief case a portfolio with row after row of negatives

The subject did not have a cast on his arm as per information but instead had surgical wrapping on his right arm from the finger tip to elbow. The subject advises he had surgery to this arm last Tuesday for tendon damage. The wrapping is fresh and the hand appears consistant with the subjects story.

When detectives initially contacted the subject he and several other photography "buff's" were admiring his finished job. The studio there caters to photography "buff's" and has on going classes.

It would appear at this point that the above subject is in fact NOT "Ted".

As previously mentioned the subject after the initial shock of the interview was very cooperative and stated that if it became necessary he would make any or all of his negatives available to Seattle Police Officers.
