AT 1900 THIS DATE I CONTACTED MRS. NORMA MORGAN, 407 PARK ST, SNOQUALMIE; 888-2457/^{BP} 22-5122 AND REV. WOODROW MORGAN AT THEIR HOME IN SNOQUALMIE. SGT RICHMOND HAD REQUESTED THAT I TAKE TAKE A COLOR "TED" COMPOSIT TO SHOW THEM AND DETERMINE IF A CONTACT THEY HAD WITH A SUBJECT IN LATE SUMMER 1974 MIGHT BE "TED".

MRS. MORGAN, WHEN SHOWN THE PICTURE DRAWN BY DEAN QUALSAND DTD 10-30-74, SAID THAT IT LOOKED MUCH LIKE THE PERSON THEY ENCOUNTERED. SHE SAID HIS HAIR WAS LONGER THAN THE PICTURED PERSON'S & NOT AS FLUFFY. SHE SAID SHE COULD NOT PROVIDE A BETTER DESCRIPTION THAN THE PICTURE.

REV. MORGAN WAS SHOWN THE SAME PICTURE. HE STATED THAT THE SUBJECT THEY MET HAD BASICALLY THE SAME FEATURES BUT HAD LONGER, STRAIGHTER HAIR. BOTH SAID THAT THEIR SUBJECT HAD "WILD EYES".

THE MORGAN'S DESCRIBED THEIR ENCOUNTER WITH THIS SUBT AS FOLLOWS. THE INCIDENT WAS REPORTED TO CHIEF MASSEY OF SNOQUALMIE PD AT 0845 08-22-74, CASE #74-674. A COPY OF THE SNOQUALMIE REPORT IS ATTACHED TO THE ORIGINAL OF THIS REPORT.

MRS. MORGAN WAS SITTING IN HER LIVING ROOM AT 0630 08-22-74 NEAR THE FRONT WINDOW WITH THE DRAPES OPEN WHEN THE SUBJECT POUNDED ON THE FRONT DOOR. SHE OPENED THE FRONT DOOR AND THE SUBJECT CAME IN AND ASKED FOR HELP SAYING THAT THE DEVIL WAS IN HIM AND THE DEVIL WAS MAKING HIM BURN HIMSELF. HE SHOWED HER HIS HANDS AND THE LEFT HAND & ARM WAS RED AND SEEMED TO BE BURNED. SHE SAID HE WAS WILD & UPSET, BUT HE DENIED BEING HIGH ON DRUGS. HE SAID HE HAD NOT SLEPT. AT ONE TIME HE PICKED UP A BIBLE, OPENED IT AND BEGAN READING ALOUD. THE PASSAGE HE HAD SEEMED TO INDISCRIMINATELY OPENED TO INVOLVED KILLING AND HE FLIPPED TO ANOTHER PAGE

AND BEGAN READING. IT TOO INVOLVED KILLING AND MRS. MORGAN NOTICED THAT HE BECAME MORE UPSET. SHE WENT IN AND GOT HER HUSBAND UP & HE CAME INTO THE LIVING ROOM. MRS. MORGAN LEFT A SHORT TIME LATER AND REV. MORGAN WAS ALONE WITH HIM FOR ABOUT ANOTHER 15-20 MINUTES.

REV. MORGAN SAID THE SUBT WAS OBVIOUSLY VERY MENTALLY DISTURBED. HE SAID HE KEPT SHAKING HIS HEAD AND HAD MANNERISMS THAT REV MORGAN FELT WERE AS IF THE SUBT WAS TRYING TO FORGET SOMETHING OR KEEP SOMETHING OUT OF HIS MIND.

REV. MORGAN COULD NOT REMEMBER TOO MUCH OF THE CONVERSATION BUT GAVE THE FOLLOWING DETAILS THAT THE SUBT GAVE ABOUT HIMSELF. THE SUBT NEVER GAVE HIS NAME.

SUBT SAID HE HAD WORKED IN AN OCCULT PUBLISHING HOUSE & BECAME INVOLVED IN OCCULT ACTIVITY IN NORTH OR SOUTH DAKOTA.

WHILE AT THE MORGAN RESIDENCE SUBT WANTED TO CALL SOMEONE IN A MONISTARY IN NORTH OR SOUTH DAKOTA. REV MORGAN THINKS THE NAME SUBT MENTIONED WAS "MCKENZIE". SUBT STATED HE WAS GOING BACK TO EITHER NORTH OR SOUTH DAKOTA WHEN HE LEFT.

REV. MORGAN GOT THE IMPRESSION FROM SUBT THAT HE HAD BEEN IN THE AREA FOR "SEVERAL WEEKS".

WHEN REV. MORGAN MADE THE REPORT TO SNOQUALMIE PD HE TOLD THEM SUBT WAS DRIVING A RED CHEV, 61-62 WITH N. DAKOTA PLATES. A SNOQUALMIE OFFICER ALSO REPORTED SEEING THE CAR, BUT SUBT WAS NEVER ID'ED.



She related she knows an older woman at 6001 who is very talkative & knows what is happening up there and seems to know who to contact for drugs.

This woman related to her that there is a subject there that all the woman refer to as "TED". She stated he'd worn a cast on his arm during the summer. He's described as 5'10" 165/170 light build, with a receding hair line. He also drives a white Cadillac & his facial features match the sketch of the "TED" in local papers. (Reference K.C. Abduction during summer). The lady advised informant that this subject has raped 4 woman at 6001, but that they will not report it because they do not wish to testify. He always works out at the sauna & makes his contact with the woman there.

Informant also advised of numerous obscene phone calls being made to women at 6001. This same woman reportedly has heard of a subject with a telescope that looks into women's rooms. He then calls them & describes items seen on dressers, etc. He is supposedly obtaining phone numbers through one of the gate guards.

Informant states she will contact this woman again to try and obtain names of victims.

Informant also feels that through this woman possible deals or connections for drugs can be made.

Informant advised of various drug traffic at 6001, and states she will attempt to make contact with some people there. Also advised informant to detectives.

On 3-12-75 at 2035 hours, these officers were dispatched to the Public Health Hospital, 1131 14th S., to see the security guard about information on "Ted". Security guard David E. Franklin, Burns Security Company, met these officers and related the following;

At 1850 hours, a white female, age 44-5 yrs, 5'5", 200 lbs, heavy, dark red hair, had observed the wanted flyer on their information desk and confronted officer Franklin. The woman seemed very nervous and stated that she shouldn't say anything about it. Officer Franklin asked her if she knew anything about the suspect "Ted" and she stated she thought she knew who it was. She went on to say that the suspect was a very close friend of the family. Officer Franklin continued to question her and she added that the suspect has been what she termed a "Mother hater", had been deserted by young women which upset him, has served time in Mac Neill Island Penitentiary, is a drug user, and that he or a member in his family owns a brown Volkswagen. She also stated that the suspect's parents would defend him at any cost. Officer Franklin was also able to obtain that the suspect was a student at the U. of W. and Highline College, he was born in San Diego, has a brother in Canada, and that the suspect travels up and down I-5 for pleasure.

These officers checked our records section and found a [REDACTED] had been a victim in a larceny in 1969 and had given [REDACTED] N. 35th Street as an address, no other record was found.
