



#### INFO ON HOMICIDES

Complainant, who originally arrived from Australia about 18 months ago, moved into the Maple Ridge area six months after that. Approximately three weeks ago he was watching television on one of the American stations and was listening to a broadcast in reference to the murders taking place in King County, State of Washington USA. At this time the broadcast described a female victims of an unknown male nicknamed or dubbed "Ted". During this broadcast they showed a photograph or composite of this male who was the suspect for these offences. At this time the composite looked familiar and MORTON thought he had seen this person someplace before. It was not until today that he remembered he had seen a similar composite to that one shown on television. This composite he recalls seening about 4 or 5 years back. It was also that of a person believed responsible for murders in Sydney, Australia. He went on to state that although this composite he had first seen in Australia the person had shorter hair, but still it appeared to be one and the same. Referring back to the first photograph he stated that this person was being sought as the responsible party in the slaying of three females between the ages of 15 and 16 year old. These crimes were dubbed the "Wanda Beach Slaying" in an area close to Sydney. Each of the victims were last reported or seen attending the Wanda Beach area and then reported missing. It was not until some time later that they were discovered buried under the sand. Each had been raped and stabbed. As Mr. MORTON recalls, the M.O. seemed to be similar to that used by the person by the name of "Ted" in Washington and this person O had an accent foreign to Australia, possibly an American accent. These murders were investigated by Sydney Police Department, however, Mr. MORTON believes they have never been solved. He also brought up the point that the girls in T Australia were between the ages of 15 to 16 and this did occur four or five years ago - whereas, the victims in Washington State are slightly older - with K the inference being that if the same person was responsible that as he grows ' E older he chooses his victims within the approximate same age group as himself,

As a result of this information being received by Cst. WAMSTEEKER he passed ft onto me and I then attended at Mr. MORTON'S residence to question him further. Nothing further could be learned. He did state that the MO.O used by the person in Australia was similar to that of the one in Washington. Mr. MORTON is passing this information on as a possible aid with the thought that there may be some connection.
