

R/O contacted owners of the Dock Lunch Cafe who stated that suspect had been in the area approx. 2 days; and they had last seen him during the afternoon of 29 Aug. when he was inquiring about the Ferry rates.

R/O & Dep. Hendrickson contacted Ferry Boat personell who stated they had observed the suspect earlier on the beach, but that he had not taken the Ferry that day.

All persons contacted stated that suspect had very striking sun tan and was readily noticed by his striking physical appearance. All persons contacted were alerted to contact this department if suspect was ever seen again.

Victim's responses to R/O's questions matched with description furnished by King County Police of suspect in recent disappearances of females in their area. R/O had victm & her father come to police office where detailed descriptions secured. After recieving description, R/O showed victim pictures of suspect in disappearances as drawn by KC Police. Victim verified that suspect looked similar to composite drawing.

R/O contacted Det.Roger DUNN, KC Police, and advised him of the situation. Det. Dunn requested copies of victim's statement.

R/O contacted Thurston County SO and advised them of the situation.

R/O secured statements from victim, and a couple who on the beach at the time of the assault who could identify the suspect. Witnesses also verified composite drawing as being similar to suspect they observed.

Investigation continueing.

A. I left my house at 4:30 pm and went to my boyfriend's house about a mile away and asked if he wanted to go with meto the beach. He didn't. I left right after to go to Steilacoom Beach. I walked a block away from where I parked at, and went actross the railroad tracks, down to the beach, ablock from Salter's Point.

I went into the water and came out to dry of a little, and there was this guy. I hadn't noticed him walking up to me - he was just there. I noticed he looked like a regular beach bum. He was about 5404 to 5-06, a sandy tint to his hair, basically brown. He had a build in proportion

to his height.

A. Yes.

He didn't say much but general questions, "Is the water cold?""Nice day?", etc. I just answered short.

He was sitting on a rock next to me. I Hadn't noticed him carrying

anything, He just wore renge trunks, not faded, and he had tennis shoes but was not wearing them.

I asked him if he was around here and he said he was visiting his parents. He said he had come here in May and before that he was at Arizona then went to California, the to here.

I told him I was going to take a last swim and then go home. That's when I noticed him from his rocks to a lower one.

I went in and came back and put my cut-offs on. The thing I really not ticed was that he had very straight front teeth, the rest were straight too, but mainly front teeth. There was a slight accent, not that noticeable, but there.

I was ready to climb up onto the tracks, that's when he grabbed me with his left arm, stuffed a rag in my mouth, and tied a strip of cloth around my head to hold the rag in my mouth.

He kept on telling me (He was very quiet & at ease, but his thoughts seemed far away) to shut up and trying to pin me down. He always kept stuffing the rag down my mouth. He didn't seem to be very strong and when he told me to turn on my back, I just calmed down and he eased up.

He was awfully nervous & shouting, so he got another rag out and told me to put my hands behind my back while I was lying on my stomach. Just as I was drawing my hand back he said "I don't know why I put that in your mouth".

Then I just pretended to relax, not caring what he did to me (Idid). He just didn(t seem that strong, so I brought my hand up and grabbed a rock that was next to me and got the gag out of my mouth - which was really loose - and started yelling for help.

He was scared and got up and ran up the rocks to the tracks - from the beach to where I don't know. I threw the rock at him, too, but didn't him.

I was yelling help, and yelled at this couple asking "why didn't you help me?". They came running over to me saying they thought he was a friend of mine and that they thought we were just fooling around. They helped me clean up my nose-bleed; but he didn't cause it, my nose bleeds easily. They picked up their things and walked me to my car. The guy gave me his name and told me I could call him for any informatic to help my situation.

I left, went home, and told my parents. My dad called the Pierce County Police and they said they would contact Steilacoom. We also called the Steilacoom Fire Dept. and they said they would contact the police, so they we left our house to go to the Steilacoom Police Dept.



- Q. You said he grabbed you with his left arm, did he seem to be left-handed or right-handed?
- A. He grabbed me with his left and stuffed the rag in with his right. He s seemed to use his right hand more than his left. I didn't notice any difference in strenght bewteen the two, nor was there any difference in size or shading.
- Q. About this shadeing, you said he looked like a regular beach bum, How's that?
- A.He looked like he spent a lot of time in the sun. He had a very good tan and his hair was kind of sun-bleached; lighter on the top than underneath, but with very little difference in the two. There was just a tint to it, kind of shiny golden.
- Q. Would you say his hair was basically brown, or blonde?
- A. Brown
- Q. Was there anything unusual about the way he wore it?
- A. It was parted in the middle, really full and healthy looking, It wasn't dirty. It came down to his shoulders and had a slight curl or feather in it at the end that wasn't caused by its laying on his shoulders.

- A. He had long toes, longer than I consider normal; his toe-nails were flat. curved naturally with no deformities. His ankles did not protrude, the calves of his legs were muscular (not fat) but shaped more like a girl's (tapered from knee to ankle) instead of a boy's (Knot of muscle near the knee). You could see his knee-cap when he was sitting and his knee was rounded when he stood up. His thighs were well-formed, in porportion to his calves. His waist was narrow, no bulges around the sides. His chest was well formed, it wasn't flat; you could see the development of his breas muscles when you looked at him straight on. You could not see his ribs or his stomach muscles. His shoulders were slightly drooped from neck to joint, not flat or truly square. You could not see his shoulder jaont, ca rather a rounded spot of muscle covering the jiont. His neck was slender, with nothing unasual about it or his adam's apple. His nose was evenly tapered and did not appear to have ever been broken. There was no visible hair on his body, his eyebrows were neat & evenly spaced with no bridge of hair between them. His eyelashes did not appear to be longer than normal. His arms were well formed, but had only a slight bulge in the trapezoid region, the forearm was tapered with no excessive widening at the elbow. His hands were narrow with long fingers, kind of slender like the type associated with piano players. I didn't notice anything about his fingernails. His hairline seemed to start in the normal place, nnot too far up or down on his forehead.

Recently the undersigned officer read in a local newspaper and account of a number of murders across the United States, once case in particular was mentioned at the sammamish state park near Seattle in which two young women were murdered. The bodies later found.

Newspaper described the suspect as 5-8 150 lbs with dark blond hair with the name of Ted.

This department recently arrested a subject for assault with intent to murder who has since admitted another murder in nearby village of Ortonville. In the assault case here, a 16 ol d boy was struck numerous times with a golf club. When the victim regained consciousness the assaulter was removing his shirt, had shorts unbuttoned and one shoe off. In the Ortonville murder a 14 old boy received injuries to the head and was strangled. That body was sodomized. The murder in Ortonville took place in a secluded area near a creek, the Goodrich assault case, the victim was in a low damp area.



Police stymied in murder case

SEATTLE (AP) — The detective heading the search for "Ted," the elusive young man sought in the deaths of at least seven young Northwest women, admits there is a "good likelihood the case will never be solved."

Capt. Nick Mackie of the King County police said the chances of tracking "Ted" are "very remote" with evidence police have.

"We have no crime scene evidence, no means of death," Mackie said Tuesday. "It's the worst case I've ever been on. There's just nothing."

Mackie, who heads an 11-man task force, said police will need a "break" to solve the slayings. He said police have come to a dead end in their attempts to create a psychological profile on the suspect. He said psychiatrists attempted to find a "common denominator" among the victims but were unsuccessful. Mackie said psychiatrists also were unable to develop a profile on "Ted" with the limited evidence available.

Appointments made

OLYMPIA (AP) — Former American Samoa Gov. John Haydon and Jon Lindbergh, son of the late aviator Charles Lindbergh, were named to the state Oceanographic Commission by Gov. Dan Evans Wednesday. Lindbergh was reappointed to his seat.

The skeletal remains of six women, along with those of a seventh, unidentified woman, have been found in the mountains near Issaquah, east of Seattle. Police are looking for a young man known only as "Ted" as the prime suspect in the slayings. He was seen with one victim after he asked her to help load a sailboat on his car. One of his arms was in a sling.

Mackie said the task force has files on 2,247 "Ted" lookalikes. Mackie said the task force of city and county police has narrowed its list to "well under 200" individuals.

Mackie said his pessimistic prediction that the case might never be solved isn't a declaration of discouragement. "The name of the game is tenacity," he said.

Mackie said the 11-man task force is expected to work fulltime on the case until June 1, when vacation schedules will require the officers to return to regular duties. Mackie said by then, even if "Ted" hasn't been found, police will have followed all present leads and can turn the case over to fewer officers.

Mackie said about six members of the task force returned to the Taylor Mountain site where five of the skeletal remains were found. Chief of Police Seattle Wash

Dear Sir:

Having heard over the radio that you would be interested in information from people with Physic ability to clear up the mystery of the missing co-eds from Seattle University, you might be interested in the following. Although I don't profess to have the ability of Peter Hurkos, or of Serios, the system I use is a little different in that it is more of a combination of Physical, and mental process, but after more than 30 years experience I Have proved that it can bring results when the usual method of search fails, the biggest obstacle is to get anyone in authory to believe it. If you have not heard of, or used this method before, the following explanation may be in order. Every law enforcement officer knows that no two fingerprints are alike, that is now an accepted fact, but what does not seem to be an accepted fact is that the radiatons, or wavelengths of humans, metals, animals, etc; are also different, although that is now an accepted fact by many Scientists. Now what is needed in order to trace a missing person, is a photograph, also, if possible a Piece of clothing that has been worn by the missing person, (a sample), unwashed. From that you adjust on the radiations, and begin the search. It is not always easy, since there there are many pitfalls, you can liken it to tuning in a radio to your favorite program, and suddenly another cuts in and blasts your program off the air, then there are meterological disturbances to contend with. but having worked out a method of eliminating those obstructions, it can sometimes be amazinginly accurate.

I am enclosing tracings from a Metsger map of King County, they are not very distinct owing to the small scale, but if placed in turn over a similar map, may give you an idea of the territory in question. In the case of Heidi Peterson I first located her in a wide part of the Duwamish Canal below the bridge on Michigan St, after several days the body was carried out into Elliot Bay, then carried back and forth with the tide, a shorter distance each time until I find it now at the corner of West Florida, and 13th St.

In the case of Linda Ann Healy, Georgeann Hawkins, see Normandy P. rk, Janice Ott, and Denise Nasuland, see location marks Sth of Hwy 10.

the case of the other missing persons listed I have nothing to work from.

I would like to make it clear I am not doing this for the sake of publicity, all I ask is for those engaged in finding a solution to these cases, is to keep an open mind, and if I failed to supply the proper answers it does not mean that the system is of no value, but rather a propensity of the human to make mistakes. In my own experience I know that in many cases that a vast amount of time, and expence could be saved if more use was made of the method. Trusting you will put investigation before discrimination,
