We received information from a confidential source on this date of a possible "Ted" suspect. The possible suspect is [redacted] who is a white male d.o.b. 7- [redacted]. He has a Seattle address of [redacted] 49th avenue south phone number PA. 3- [redacted]. He has resided in North Bend Wash. Rt. [redacted] Box [redacted] and may still have this property. He works as a mail clerk for KOMO tv and has worked for both Ploeger Mortuary in Rainier Valley and Issaquah Mortuary. He has been known to drive a Volkswagen color unknown and some years ago started having his friends call him "Ted". The informant stated that the composite shown on tv looks like [redacted] and that [redacted] knows the Issaquah area. [redacted] mother was killed by an automobile several years ago near the North Bend address and [redacted] began to act funny after that. He likes to hang out around young girls and told the informant that a girl friend some time ago told him that she would not go out with him if he continued working at the mortuary. (this was prior to the homicides). Hopefully this information will be of use to you.

The suspect stated he had beaten a girl and attempted to rape her. I advised the suspect of his Constitutional Rights and asked him if he wanted to talk about the case. The suspect waived his rights and stated he had attempted to rape the victim who was at 22059 S.E. 60th, Issaquah.

The victim stated at approximately 0345 hours this date, she was at a party at 22059 S.E. 60th Street, Issaquah Washington. The suspect was also at the party. As the victim started to leave the location the suspect asked if he could get a ride into town and the victim agreed. Once inside the city the suspect asked the victim if she would take him to High Valley and she agreed. The suspect could not find the place he wanted to go and asked to be dropped off at Newport Way and 17th Ave N.W., Issaquah, Washington (Commonly known as Good's Corner). The victim stopped the Chevrolet on the south side of Newport Way west of 17th Ave, so that the suspect could exit the vehicle. The suspect asked the victim for a kiss and she refused. He then asked several times if he could feel the victim's breast and she refused. The suspect reached across the center of the vehicle and turned off the ignition. He then started moving across the seat and groping the victim. She exited the vehicle and the suspect chased her. When the suspect caught the victim, he knocked her to the ground and began beating her in the face with his fists. The suspect overpowered the victim and dragged her to a small

abandoned shack. Once inside the shack the suspect advised the victim he was going to rape her. The victim began scratching at the suspect and screaming. The suspect advised her that if she did not stop screaming he was going to kill her. When the suspect began beating the victim again she agreed to do anything if the suspect would let her live. The suspect began taking off the victim's pants and she began kicking at him. The suspect overpowered the victim and removed her pants and underpants. The suspect then removed his trousers and under shorts and attempted to get on top of the victim. The victim bit the suspect on the cheek and kicked him in the groin area in an attempt to keep the suspect from raping her. The suspect became extremely irate and stated, "now I'm going to kill you!" and he began beating her in the face. The victim could not stand the pain and begged the suspect to let her live. The suspect ceased beating the victim and told the suspect to orally copulate his penis. The victim feared that if she did not do as she was told that the suspect would kill her and she complied. The suspect reached a climax in the victim's mouth. The suspect then dressed and advised the victim to dress. He then asked the victim to drive him to the Police Station because he was sick and he wanted to turn himself in.

I observed the left side of the victim's face to be extremely swollen and her left eye to be black.





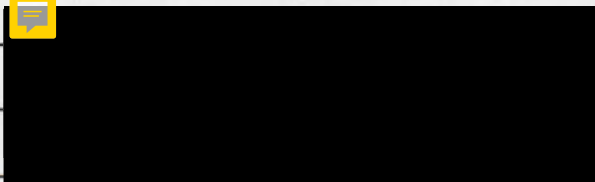

This date, we were contacted by a woman who reluctantly expressed her concern that the following subject might be the "Ted" you are seeking for the deaths of University of Washington coeds:

[REDACTED], DOB 05-[REDACTED]-50, POB Seedro Wooly, WA [REDACTED]

She based her suspicion on what she considers to be a close physical resemblance to the composit drawing, which has appeared in the press and personal exposure to [REDACTED]. She states that [REDACTED] apparently had been in the V.A. hospital in Portland, OR and on occasion, had contacted her daughters. He claimed to be a Viet Nam veteran with war injuries and on at least one occasion, had a "medic" bag he claimed to have carried in Viet Nam. He is reported to have called the woman's home alledging he was calling long distance from a foreign country and she believes one of the calls was reported to have been made from Fort Lewis, WA.


She is not aware of his present location or travels, but considers him to be peculiar and interested in young adult females, seeking sympathy to gain their attention.

In checking locally, we believe [REDACTED] had been arrested in the Portland area on a Linn County Warrant for N.S.F. checks, however, it is unknown what disposition was made of the case. It is also unknown if [REDACTED] was photographed or printed in Portland when arrested. We have the impression he posted bail after arrest.

Our personnel recall this person from his having come into this department in 1968 or 1969 with wild stories of being a secret agent and making recordings of other space radio conversations. We have no present knowledge of him.

Again, the woman who called suspicion is based on physical resemblance and peculiar actions. We have no other information that might involve or direct inquiry towards this subject. Perhaps the arresting agency in Portland, the V.A. or the military might have some knowledge of subject [REDACTED].

The disappearance of Roberta Kathleen Parks, a 20-year-old freshman at Oregon State University, could conceivably be linked to several coed attacks in Washington State involving a young man driving a yellow Volkswagen.

Amos Shaw, chief of campus security, said university officers are renewing their plea for help in the case on the basis of information showing similarity in cases.

According to authorities, a Central Washington State College coed at Ellensburg had an ominous encounter with a young man wearing a cast on his arm four days after another coed there disappeared.

A man fitting the same general description is being sought in connection with the disappearance of two other women from Lake Sammamish State Park, near Seattle, July 14. The suspect also wore a cast on his arm.

Shaw said the incident involving the unidentified coed in Ellensburg occurred in front of the college library.

He said the girl told police she observed a man carrying some library books, which he dropped. She went over to assist him, he accepted her offer of assistance and told her he was in pain.

Shaw said the girl accompanied the man for several blocks. They went to a yellow Volkswagen and she put the books in the car. The man asked the girl to get into the car — she refused.

Shaw said the man reportedly tried to force the girl into the vehicle, but she broke away and went for help.

At a later date, said Shaw, the girl reportedly saw an artist's sketch of the suspect in the Lake Sammamish incident and identified him as the same man she had trouble with.

"We have no indication Kathy Parks met with foul play — none whatsoever," said Shaw.

Four days before the attempted abduction of the coed at Ellensburg, Susan Rancourt, 18, Anchorage, disappeared from the campus.

A variety of reports indicate the same man may have been involved in the disappearance of six women and a four-year-old in Washington and an abduction in Syracuse, N.Y., 20 months ago.

The man is described as about 25 years old, weighing 165

pounds, and approximately 5 feet 7 inches tall. His left arm may be in a fingertip-length cast or sling.

However, Shaw said, the cast may be used by the man to gain sympathy and assistance from his victims.

Shaw added that the suspect's car reportedly had no front seats.

Shaw said anyone who may have seen such a person or car near campus about the time Roberta Parks disappeared, May 6, should contact OSU campus security.

The coed was on her way to the Memorial Union the last time she was seen.

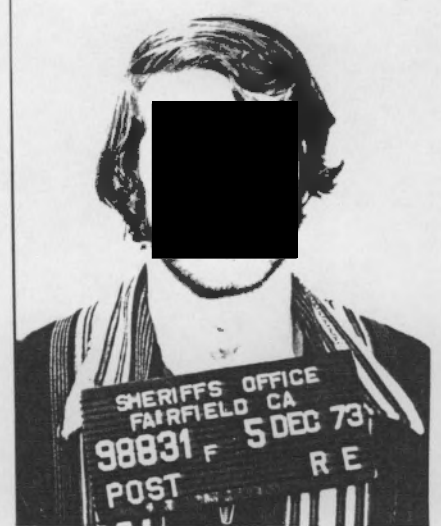

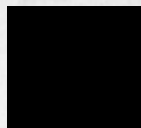

The following is a report from the Blackfeet Tribal Court concerning [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was arrested on June 18, 1975 in Browning on a Vagrancy charge; Section 42, chapter 5, Blackfeet Tribal Law and Order Code. When he was arrested he did not have any identification with him and there was a discrepancy in his stories (social security number, birth date, and place of residence).

Gurwede provides that the Blackfeet Tribe has jurisdiction over all Indians. Mr. [REDACTED] claims he is 1/4 Aleut. He was arraigned on June 18th on this Vagrancy charge. He was given his rights, appointed Counsel and from there he made a plea of guilty and was sentenced to 10 days in jail. During this incarceration period we have been trying to get positive identification on him but this is to no avail. We have had him checked by a Doctor of Psychiatry from Seattle. This evaluation report will not be released except on a Federal Court order.

The Court feels that this man is a dangerous mental case and should be institutionalized for further treatment. We can legally hold him until Friday, June 27th, at which time he will be released unless the Public Health Hospital takes measures to have him committed to the State Mental Hospital for further treatment and evaluation.

Mr. [REDACTED] called at the Branch of Social Services, Blackfeet Agency, late in the afternoon on May 21, 1975, requesting financial assistance and help in obtaining information about dividend payments available to him through the Alaska claim settlement. He said that he was born on 9/[REDACTED]/42 in Ninilichik, Alaska and was part Aleut. He gave his full name as [REDACTED], his father's name as [REDACTED] and his mother's maiden name as [REDACTED]. He said that he was reared by a maternal [REDACTED] in Hamilton, Montana and had a cousin, [REDACTED], in Victor, Montana. He had among his papers a notice from the Cook Inlet Association and said that he wanted to go to Alaska to a dividend meeting. He gave his address as [REDACTED] Blackburn Place, Ventura, California when he received his last dividend. He also said that he had not received his social security disability payments and had with him a letter from the Social Security Office addressed to the Department of Public Welfare in Hamilton, Montana indicating a delay in payments.

A call was made to Alaska (907-274-4523) and it was verified that a [REDACTED] was enrolled as 1/4 Aleut. Due to the differences in time between Alaska and Montana, it was not possible to secure any information about claim settlement funds as it was already past closing time for our office. Mr. [REDACTED] was asked to return the following day in the afternoon when the Alaska office would be open.

When he returned the next day, he also talked with the Social Security Representative from the Great Falls District Office who was at the Agency on this date. He was told to call the Great Falls office. When he called this office on our telephone about his delayed disability payment, he began to talk on and on about his having worked with headstart and having a letter from Lady Bird Johnson and other irrelevant matters. It was obvious that his rambling talk had little relationship to his request. When he left the office, a call was made to the Hamilton Welfare Office and we were advised that Mr. [REDACTED] was an emotionally disturbed person who had been in a mental institution in California for many years, that he had been arrested on rape charges and not convicted, that he was receiving disability payments through social security, and that we should call the sheriff. The Tribal Police were called.
