



1130, 11 Sep 74 (RATCLIFF)	<p>Rec'd a call from SFC G., US Army Medical Center (MAMC), Tacoma, WA, who requested that I come over to MAMC and talk to him. G. stated that there may be nothing of value in the information that he had to relate, but that in his own personal opinion he believed that it may be of some value and that it concerned the missing females and the remains of person(s) which had been found in the Issahaqua (phonetic) area. I advised G. that I was busy with other investigative duties at the moment and that I would talk to him at about 1300 hrs.</p>

1300, 11 Sep 74 (RATCLIFF)	<p>Arrived at G's. Duty Section. He related that there was a male whom he did not know who worked in the Orthopedic Clinic, MAMC, who bore an identical resemblance to the composite photo of the male who accosted a number of females on the 14th Jul 74, at Lake Sammamish, WA, and requested aid in loading a boat onto a tan colored Volkswagen. G. said that the male was wearing a cast on his left arm but that he did not know who long the male had been wearing the cast. He stated that the male and another Ortho Tech's photo had been in the Mountaineer Newspaper which is published at the MAMC each week, G. related that the male had attended a Smoking Clinic with his (G's. Wife), and that Mrs G. had made a remark about the resemblance of the male and the one depicted in the newspapers.</p>

1345, RATCLIFF	<p>Requested that G. call his wife and arrange for an interview. Mrs G. consented and was interviewed at the G's. on post Qtr's. While interviewing Mrs G, requested that SFC G. attempt ascertain the males name.</p>

1400, RATCLIFF	<p>Mrs G. related that she had known the male for about six weeks and had talked to him at the Smoking Clinic. She stated that she had a "gut feeling" that this person may have knowledge of the disappearance of the females. Mrs G. said she developed the feeling after looking at the picture in the newspaper and from her personal observations and conversations with the male. Mrs G. described the male as being about 66-67 in tall; light brown, hair with a reddish tint to the ends of his hair, like the hair had been exposed to the sun over long periods of time, Ms G, said that there was almost a blondish cast to his hair. She stated that his complexion was a lt olive or that he had a heavy tan. Also, that she had observed him with his hair parted in the middle on at least two occassions, and that she had observed him walking with a crutch on one occassion. Ms G. related that when she met the male first that to the best of her knowledge he was not wearing a moustache and that the last time she had observed him that he had grown a moustache. Further that his hair appeared to be a darker color and that it appeared as tho it (the hair) had been touched up to appear darker. Ms G. related that the male was shy, quite and withdrawn. she said that he had to be drawn into conversation and that he always had a sad look about him. Ms G. described the males (Cont)</p>

eyes as being , or having a sad haunted look about them. Ms G. said he appeared to be about 19-20 yrs of age and was the type of male, in her own opinion, that a woman would like to "Mother". Ms G. stated that the male looked like he needed someone to care for him or to help him. She said that he was a perfect stranger and requested help from her that she would give him help.

1420, RATCLIFF

While talking to Ms G. SFC G. called his Qtr's and stated that the males name was [REDACTED]. The interviewed was terminated with Ms G. Drove to MAMC personnel Center.

1440, RATCLIFF

Arrived at MAMC Personnel Center and requested the Personnel SGT MAJ, to provide a copy of the alpha roster which lists all person's assigned to MAMC. SGM provided the Roster and it reflected that there are two person's named [REDACTED] assigned at the MAMC. The 1'st person on the roster was a 1'st SGT. The second an SP4 [REDACTED]. Requested the SGM to pull [REDACTED]'s personnel file, to sign the file out in his name and released the file to me (RATCLIFF). SGM complied. Rec'd the records at 1515 hrs. Also requested that the SGM, if possible, obtain [REDACTED]'s Educational Record's. SGM related that he worked at the MAMC Education Center during the evenings and that he would remove the records and have them in his office at 0830, 12 Sep 74.

1530, RATCLIFF

Went to Patient Administration Section to obtain [REDACTED]'s Medical Records. SFC WOOD who usually relases the Medical Information was off. Left a message for WOOD advising him that I would return at 0845, 12 Sep 74.

1600, RATCLIFF

Returned to CID Office and briefed CW3 COUCOULOUS, Opn's Officer of information obtained during the afternoon. COUCOULOUS sated that he would advise CPT RENNER, Commander. Due to the late hour and other investigative duties no further information was developed on 11 Sep 74.

0800, 12 Sep 74
(RATCLIFF)

Arrived at MAMC Med Records Section. WOODS was not there. Went to SGM's Office, was advised that he would not be there until Monday. Went to Education Office, had [REDACTED]'s file checked, it was not in the file. Obtained SGM's tele #, called him. He stated that he had the file at his Qtrs. advised him that I would come by and pick the file up. Returned to Med Records. Told WOOD that [REDACTED]'s Record's were required. Further advised WOOD that the record's were probably at the Ortho Clinic instaed of Med Records Depository where they should be and that he (WOOD) would have to devise a method of obtaining the records. WOOD stated that he would have the records by 1030 hrs.

Went to the News Paper Office, MAMC, requested to look a copy of the Mountaineer. Was provided a file containing back copies of the newspaper. Located the picture of [REDACTED] and another male in the 5 Aug 74 issue. Obtained copy.

0930, RATCLIFF

Talked to SA James HOOTMAN who is presently assigned to MAMC and works in the Provost Marshal's Office. Advised HOOTMAN of information developed and requested any information he may have relative to [REDACTED]. HOOTMAN has been receiving treatment at the Orthopedic Clinic for about a year on a regular basis. HOOTMAN related that he knew [REDACTED] casually. That [REDACTED] and three other males lived in an Apt somewhere on Wash Ave, Tacoma, WA. HOOTMAN stated that he had been picking one of the males up, a red headed male who worked in the Ortho Clinic with [REDACTED]. HOOTMAN said he had asked the male what had happened to his car and that the male had replied that the car that he had been using was in the shop being repaired. HOOTMAN stated that he had heard that another Ortho Tech had broken his leg and that the reason that [REDACTED] and another males picture had been in the Mountaineer was because they both worked in the Cast Room and that they had both broken their bones, [REDACTED]'s arm, the other male had broken his leg and they were pictured putting plaster casts on ~~each other~~ each other.

HOOTMAN stated that he had heard that a third male had broken his leg or injured his foot and was in a cast also. he (HOOTMAN) said that he knew the photographer of the Mountaineer well and that we should go and talk to the photographer and see if he would take another photo of all three males using the ruse that the picture would be published in the Mountaineer.

Talked to Photographer at the Provost Marshal's Office, MAMC. The Photographer stated that he would obtain the pictures. Made arrangements to pick up the film at about 1400 hrs.

1100, RATCLIFF

Drove to SGM's Post Qtrs' picked up [REDACTED]'s Education Record.

1115, RATCLIFF

Returned to CID Office, ate lunch, went to Tacoma, WA to receive a certified package which required a signature.

1220, RATCLIFF

Returned from Tacoma and started reviewing [REDACTED]'s Records.

Examination of Medical Records reveal that [REDACTED] broke his wrist on 30 Jul 74. Allegedly fell from a chair and struck his arm on a counter top while working at the Ortho Clinic.

The record reveals no mental disorder. He has had had corrective eye surgery and had an uneventful recovery. When [REDACTED] broke his wrist he was admitted to the hospital overnight. The Admission Sheet revealed that he gave his brother as next of kin. (Cont)

He could remove a brace, or with his training devise a brace of his own to use as a prop to lure other unsuspecting person's to his aid.</p> <p>[REDACTED] has a Volkswagen which is 8 yrs old, which is or has been red colored. Red paint oxidize's easily. If the car has not been in a garage the paint has probably faded considerably, or there could have been an attempt to re-paint the car, if so the paint would have to be removed and a primer coat (tan-brownish) in color would have been applied prior to re-painting. The identity of the car which [redacted]'s room mate stated was being repaired?(re-painted)?has not been determined.

All the locations which the females have disappeared from, Lake Sammamish; University of Washington; Evergreen College; Central Washington College, are all less than three hours driving distance from Ft Lewis, WA.

[redacted] has been observed in an unidentified van near MAMC smoking marihuana. Could this van have, or was any van observed in the Lake Sammamish area on the day the male with the cast or sling was observed asking females for assistance. Could [redacted] have murdered two person(s) without assistance? If in fact he is a good suspect at all?

Ms G. related that if she were to be approached unknowingly and he requested assistance that she would probably render the assistance requested.

Prior to the disappearance of the Cen Wash College Coed, or the U Wash Coed, a male with a brace on one leg and a cast on one arm requested assistance from a female. Who did help the male with his books and accompanied the male to a Volkswagen. The Coed in question became apprehensive because of the males actions and ~~departed~~ departed the scene in haste.

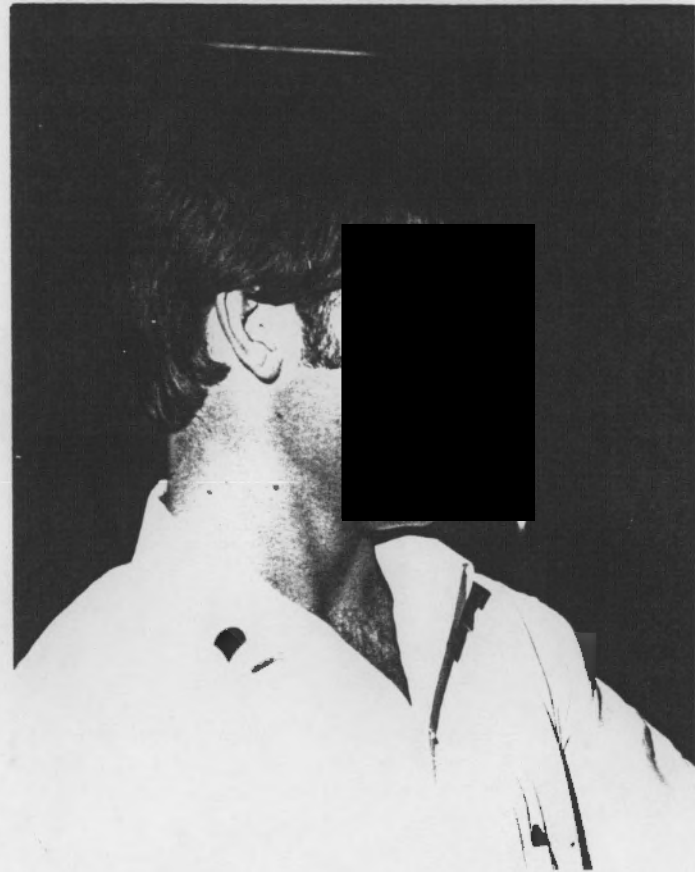
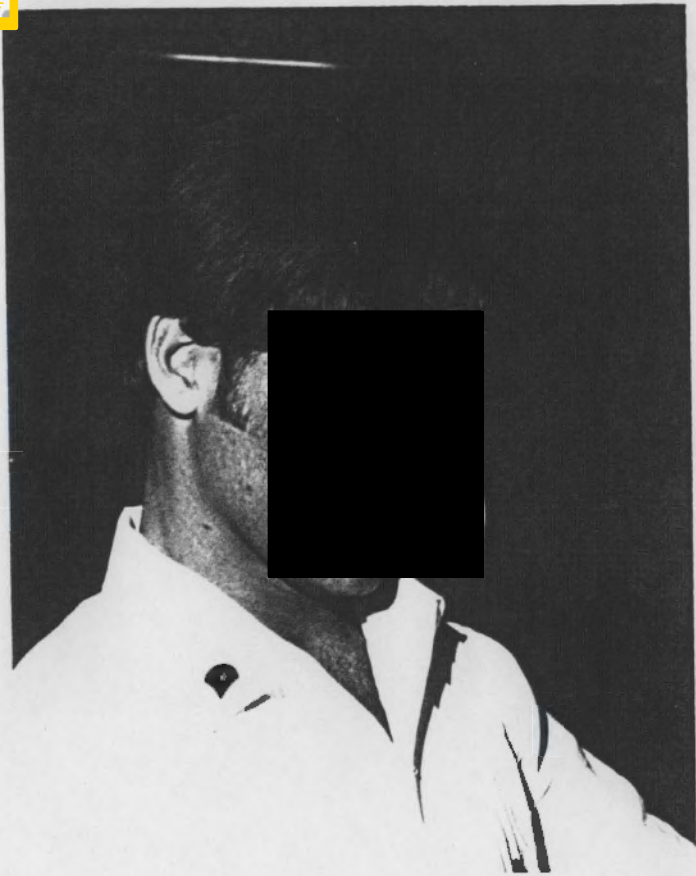
[redacted] would be capable of constructing an arm or leg cast himself. After the cast has set (hardened) it can be bi-valved (cut down one side and removed), the cast can the be reapplied and secured with tape. [redacted] with his knowledge could bi-valve a cast, replace it and cover the line of the cut by simply rubbing wet plaster of paris into the cut. He could, with his knowledge, do this to an arm or leg cast.

Due to the state of decomposition of the body's which were found there is a possibility that the body's were dismembered prior to being deposited. [redacted] would have access to surgical instruments and has had basic training in ~~stomach~~ anatomy.

Advised CPT RENNER and gave him reading file. RENNER advised COL KANAMINE, PM, of info thus far developed. Notified King County Sheriffs Office. A Det NELSON stated that Detectives working the case would be notified and to expect a call on 13 Sep 74.

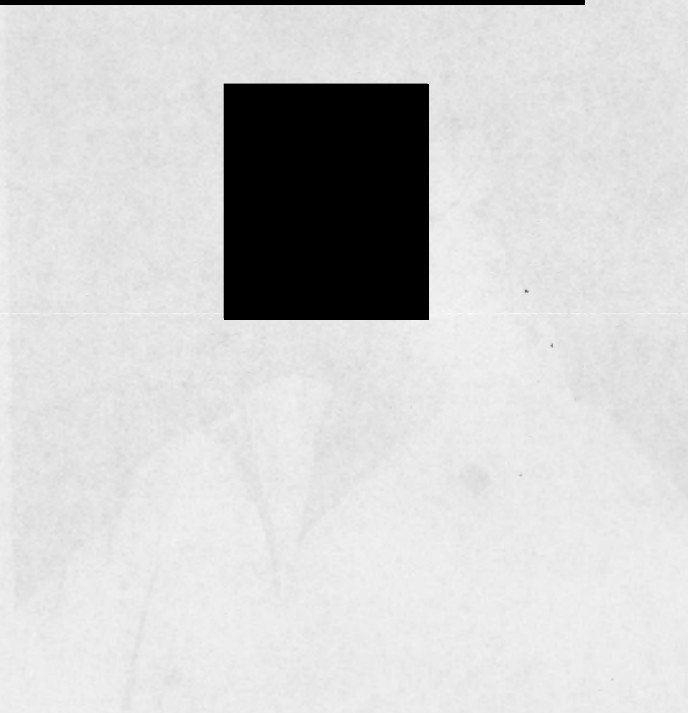
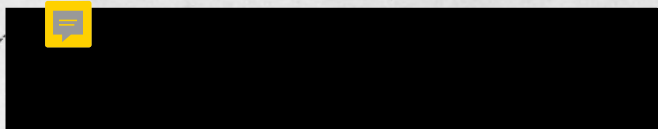

On 04-12-75, 2300 hrs, Det. Nolan was working an off duty job at Lake Hills Roller Rink when he was approached by a frightened teenage girl. The girl, JULIE HADLEY, 7933 7th S.W. Seattle, 762-8442 stated she was dancing with a young man who acted very suspicious and asked the girl her name and her place of employment. The girl asked the boy what his name was and he replied "TED" the girl became frightened and the boy grabbed her arm. Miss Hadley described the boy as being W.M. 23, 5'8", slender, brown hair parted in middle thin moustache, wearing blue pants, navy blue sweater with white collar. Miss Hadley stated that the boy resembled the composite of the suspect "TED" Miss Hadley also stated that she was a friend of Denise Naslund and Bonnie Stuth.

04-12-75, 2315 hrs, a suspect answering the description of "TED" was observed on the dance floor. The boy was identified as [redacted] [redacted] DOB 11/[redacted]/56, 5'8", 145#, Blue, Brown, 12 [redacted] 83rd So. 255-[redacted]. 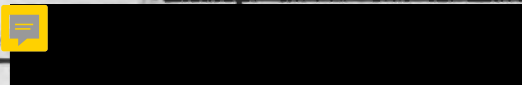

Dear Sir:

I believe that I might have some helpful information for you in the case of the missing girls and this person who calls himself "Ted".

I hope you check into the following information, as I feel that if he is not found before this weekend has ended, there shall be another missing girl.

The only information that I have is as follows:

Ted is a construction worker for Brown Construction.

He has blue eyes, light brown(sandy)hair, is between 5'10 and 6'. His age is in the middle to late 20's.

I think he might possibly have a tatoo or a scar on one of his forearms.

His usual dress at work is a denim jacket, a long sleeved, lightweight, pale blue shirt, which he has the sleeves rolled partially up, blue jean pants, and heavy boots.

The boots are brown or black in color, and are fairly well worn.

He also might wear a gold watch on his left wrist or a black leather band on his right wrist. Also, he sometimes wears sunglasses that are of a rounded shape.

He has been letting his hair grow since his sighting in the park where he was seen with Janice Ott. His hair is now almost shoulder length, but not quite.

I feel that the construction sight where he is now working, is a large area where the trees have been cleared away and there is a lot of dirt surrounding a rectangular shaped hole dug out for possibly a foundation for a new home.

I decided to send you this information, after I clairvoyantly received the image of a girl, who had long dark hair, was of medium height, and very slender build.

The girl was wearing a dark colored dress, with a chain belt, or tie belt at the waist, and she also had a charm bracelet or a watch on her right wrist. I figured her age at about 18-20. I then received her name as being Barbara Ann Healy.

Upon this, I called the Tacoma Police and found that there was not a Barbara, but there was a Linda Ann Healy, missing. She fit the description I gave them, so I felt that the information I had received on Ted might be helpful.

I do hope you are able to find him soon.

Also, I feel that you will find Linda in a mine shaft or in a place that would be somewhat similar.

Would you please notify me if anything comes of what information I've been able to give you.

Details: This was on Sunday, July 28:

Mrs Rockwell and hubby were riding cycle up Mt. Tenniriff when they came across horrible smell of something dead. Skirted area and continued on. On returning, when they reached the smelly area they looked around for dead animal or some such, saw nothing, but did see disturbed earth as though something buried. They returned to camper truck and suddenly young man driving blue VW went roaring by up the same road. She said road had not been used for many years yet this guy was tearing along a fierce pace. They left and went to North Bend where they reported whole thing to Sheriff. He was supposed to call us with details.

NOTE: As you leave North Bend, there are trails that go to Mt. Si. We went beyond those trails because we were riding motorbikes. There was shutdown zone #14, that is the gate that is generally locked but it was open Sunday. We took ride thinking we would get to Mt. Si but we never got there so we went on over to Mt. Tenneriss. As we were almost to the top you come (over)

you go to the left or to the right but we had gone on up to the left. When we made this turn up the left, the terrible odor was there. When we came back down we decided we would stop and look around. We usually see dead animals in mountains, or part of the animal that has been dead. This time there was nothing to be found except loose dirt. Just down from the spot where we looked there was something that looked like blood. There was no odor from that part of the road. The area that smelled so bad looked, or was about the size of a table, about 5', with a hump. It was a blank area and nobody has been in that area for years.

As we were coming back to the road to give our report to the North Bend sheriff a young fellow in a light blue Volks, old tinny, license OTC- [redacted] or ORZ- [redacted] we gave both numbers to sheriff at North Bend around 4 p.m. on Sunday. When we got home we saw pix of girls, and little [redacted] and we had to tell you about it.

Even if it's a dead animal, please let Rockwell know because she's worried, and upset.

Altruism and Ambient Noise

Canon ran another study, this time in a natural setting, to support the hypothesis that high noise levels lead to less attendance to cues defining another as an individual. On a street near campus, one confederate was positioned such that when he was given the signal (from another confederate across the street) that someone was approaching, he would lift a box of books out of the car he was bending over and walk across the sidewalk in front of S. Right in front of S, he would let a few books slide off the top so that S could either pick them up so the stooge didn't have to put the box down to pick them up, or he could walk around them and continue on his way. In the noise condition, someone was positioned about 5 feet away adjusting a power lawn mower and reviving the engine (it had no muffler). In the original (no Cast) run, results were inconclusive because almost nobody stopped to help. Other things were tried, such as having the top of the box drop out or having the confederate be a woman, but what worked was having the male stooge use an old shoulder to wrist cast on his arm. A dramatic difference between the noise and no noise conditions was shown by the results this time.

The objection was raised that the S might just be trying to escape the noise, but this doesn't fit with the lab study previously discussed. The only thing that might help S reduce noise there would be to help the stooge and get him on his way faster so it would be S's turn sooner. The deindividuation hypothesis fits both these studies and the one which showed that Ss would sit closer to the stooge in the noise condition.

Paloutzian studied altruism in a N.Y. subway by having a stooge fake an emergency by suddenly collapsing. They found that the best way to analyze the situation was on a cost-reward basis. The costs included the possibility that the stooge was drunk and would be unpleasant or that he was critically ill and the S would have to stay with him a long time. A reward would be reinforcement of S's self-image of the admiration of others. On the other hand, not helping might cost guilt or provide the reward of uninterrupted progress.

Shoper and Matthews found that people to whom we do not attribute responsibility for their plight get more sympathy. This would affect whether we helped someone if we thought he was drunk versus his being ill. The person with the cast in the experiment was viewed as being less responsible than a healthy person, so the rewards of helping him were greater, as were the costs of not helping.

It has also been found that people will become verbally disinhibited under a high noise condition and will say fouler things or admit or discuss embarrassing personal experiences. People may be less concerned about the effect of their remarks because of deindividuation.

DEINDIVIDUATION (given by Allen Boni)

There was a handout giving an outline of the lecture and Zimbardo's interpretation of the deindividuation process.

I. Deindividuation and violence; statistics were given on crimes of violence such as assassination, rape, mob violence, etc. We are losing the value placed on the loss of life and on behavior control. The following lecture is based on the premise that self-knowledge leads to self-control.

II. Lorenz (skipped)

III. Interpretations of deindividuation. Individuation is defined as being when a person acts and takes responsibility for his action. Deindividuation is anything opposed to this process, such as irrationality, irresponsibility, or chaos. In Zimbardo's view, social conditions lead to a change in our self-perception and free constrained behavior. Although it is violence that is most typically released in the U.S., it could just as well be love or joy. This lecture will concentrate on antisocial behavior.

A. Freud would have seen individuation as the acting of the ego and superego, whereas deindividuation would have been the release of libidinal energy to satisfy the selfish impulses of the id.

B. According to social learning theory, we develop cognitive controls to inhibit behaviors disapproved by society. Any condition minimizing these controls allows expression of these behaviors.

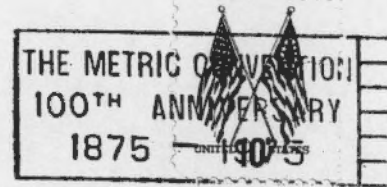

Eleanor Rose:

I have read several of your press releases, some of which were not directly identifiable to you press releases that were not deserved because you are not a politician, or otherwise a director of public affairs.

The following information is from a young, very attractive informant. [redacted] is 28 years of age, 5'6" to 5'8", 150 lbs., wiry, but powerful in the arms. He has two brothers, 24 and 26. The 26-year-old brother, [redacted], looks even more like the composite than [redacted]. [redacted]'s hobby is mainly skiing, but he had a sailboat some time ago and sold it for a motorboat to haul water skiers. His father is a prominent ophthalmologist living in Laurelhurst. All three brothers live with the mother (parents are divorced). One strange aspect is that the father is still paying child support on all three, which leads me to believe that some possible psychiatric problems may exist.

[redacted] has a VW van that he repainted. It was originally a beige color. They have several cars which he seems to have a phobia for painting. Informant does not know at this time if there is a VW as described in the Lake Sammamish case. The family is quite wealthy and [redacted] just started working about six months ago in a Georgetown company that has to do with staple guns. He served in the Air Corps - volunteered to go into the service. It would be interesting to see what type of discharge he has.

[redacted] on two occasions put on a perfect English accent for just a few moments and then stopped and has never repeated it again. He has very good looking teeth and has an obsession about them. He says he can get anything he wants as long as he keeps smiling. He says his brothers are nuts. [redacted] is married and his wife is an airline stew.

Informant has known [redacted] about one month. He talks about sex constantly. Has asked informant, "How do you get in your house if you had lost your key?" He giggles a lot about unfunny things. Typical conversation he has had with informant - "Don't you think you would like a beating with a rope while we're having sex?" He says many times, "I'm going to rape you." Does not use any other terminology but "rape." Recently keeps referring to tying someone up. He has gone into precise details about how he would rape informant. Recently stated that anal intercourse is the only way to go. Another conversation, "I was built so slight, but hung like a horse." Doesn't drink much, says, "I'm afraid what will happen if I do."

Another conversation, "Wouldn't you really like being tied on a bed and raped?" He calls informant very frequently and always turns the conversation to rape. He also talks about little girls and "hotdogs in the bun" and giggles, and evidently means penis.

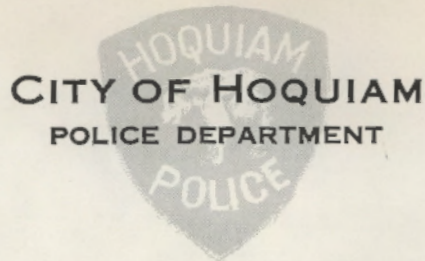

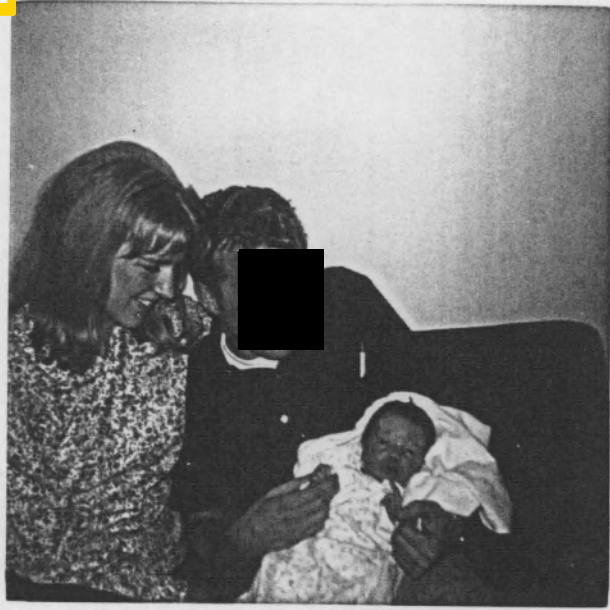

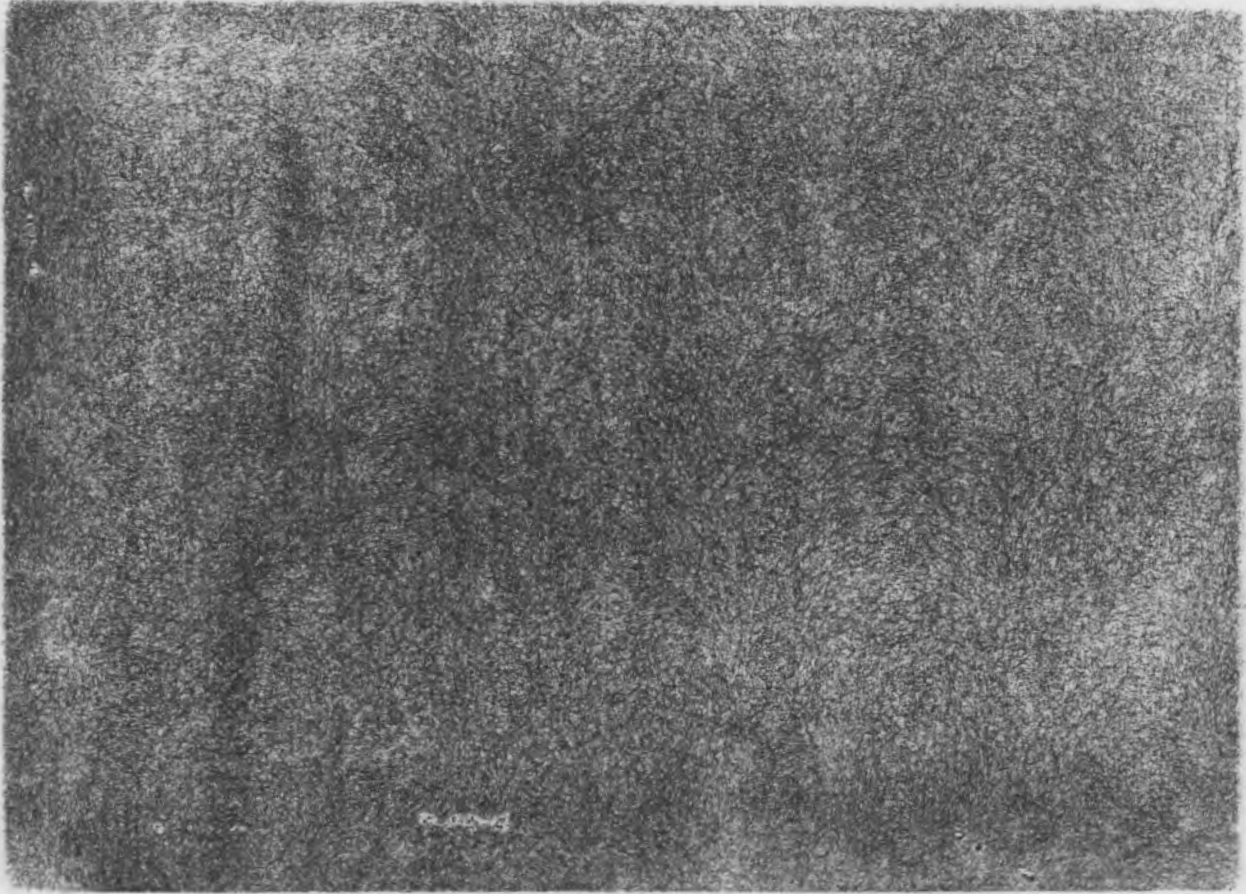

This is the picture I called about. The man in the picture is known to me as [redacted] two years ago in Hawaii this man, at the time between 22-24, tried to pick me up on the beach. I could fit the description of their girls long brown hair 5'6 dressed for sunbathing. At first he tried to coax me away from the beach to go to another island on his boat, but I refused. The girl I was staying with came down later at which time I introduced them and accepted a date for dinner. I felt as long as someone knew who I was with I'd be pretty safe. The original plan was, he was going to pick me up and take me to dinner. What happened was someone had called him from Las Vegas and he was going to have to wait for that same person to call back, would I please take a cab over to his apt. and meet him outside. I did and he said he had to do something upstairs it would only take a minute would I come up. Meanwhile he had asked me to come to Vegas with him, I said no that I wanted to stay in Hawaii and all of a sudden he pushed me in the bedroom. He was kneeling on top of me and said if I made a sound he'd knock me out.

He had one hand around my throat one knee on my arm and the other holding my hand down. I was crying. I thought I'd seen enough shows where the woman talks the man out of raping her so I told him if he got off me we could go to Las Vegas. You don't have to return this picture. One other thing when I took this picture he was so mad he broke the camera and I just happen to pick up the film.

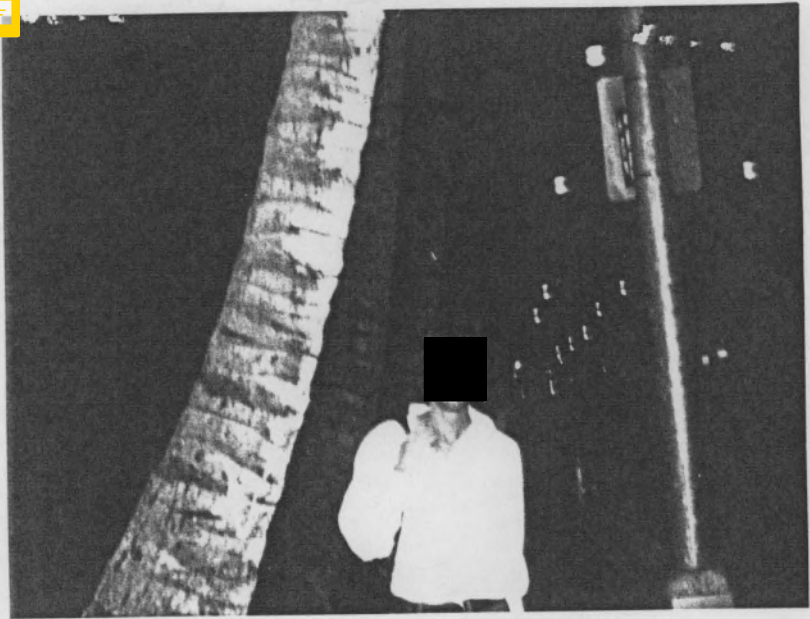

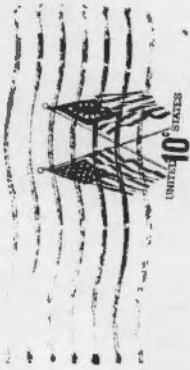

Time: At approximately 7:00 P.M. my wife and I entered the Seattle Public Library, Lake City Branch, 12501 - 28th Avenue N.E., Seattle, Washington. I parked my 1970 F-85 Oldsmobile, License No. OTM 443, on the east curb facing north on N.E. 28th; one car length from N.E. 125th, behind another vehicle.

While in the library for about 10 minutes, we observed a man acting very emotional and irrational in his attempts to get the librarian to secure a copy of this week's edition of TODAY paper. He acted as if he was in a great hurry and appeared to be extremely nervous.

DESCRIPTION: Approximately 6' tall, 28 years of age, 160 lbs., brown, curly hair; well-groomed, dressed in a light blue pin-stripe suit - may have been seersucker.

It appeared to us to be unusual that anyone would be so irrational and upset just because he was unable to get the copy of TODAY which had an article about the co-ed at the University of Washington being followed by a man who could have been linked with "TED".

My wife and I left the library, entered our vehicle, and attempted to pull away from the curb to go home. This was approximately 7:15 p.m. Another vehicle was parked closely behind mine now.

In backing up a few inches, our bumpers touched. At this time the above irrational man was coming out of the library, wildly charged toward me and shouted, "I'm phoning the police!" He then went to the front of my vehicle and said he was taking the license number. I got out of my car and went to the rear of my vehicle to see with him if any damage had been done. He remarked, snarling, "I don't see any marks of any kind," and jumped in his car and "peeled out" and sped away at a high rate of speed going north on N.E. 28th.

I had gone back to the front seat of my car to get a pen or pencil to get his driver's license, etc. but he sped away while I was doing so.

Upon return to my residence, I went to my neighbor Gary Burchfield who is employed by the Seattle Police Department and reported this incident and left my official calling card. I prepared this report the next day, March 20, 1975, and also phoned my insurance agent.
