Mrs Saari in office with her nephew, Victor. Det McClesney sat with her in the interview-room and let her talk for about one hour and then had to leave for a appointment. McClesney was unable to relate what she had been told. (Mrs Saari continually talks yet her thoughts are impossible to follow). McClesney said she had talked with Mrs Saari, about six months ago, on another matter and that she was completely rational at that time, just a complete 180 from now.

After consulting with Lt. Kraske writer phoned Saari's place of employment; "Child Development Center Program" [587-3463]. Her immediate supe is Mr Kuamme, who was out, as was his supe., Mr Henry Caldwell. Writer talked with Georgene Lavo [587-5102] who works with Caldwell. Explained briefly about Mrs Saari contacting the various police agencies and other public offices, such as Senator Magnuson's office, and that no one can figure out what Mrs Saari really wants. Told Georgene that Saari was in the office at that time and we wondered if maybe she or someone that knew her might be able to suggest what avenue we could take that would satisfy Mrs Saari. Georgene suggested I call a psychiatrist, Dr. [redacted] [324-[redacted]], who is connected with their program. Writer located her at 546 [redacted]. The Dr requested her name not be used since she was under the direction of Mrs Saari, who is a supervisor in their program. She did say that Mrs Saari probably needed to see a psychiatrist and take some tranquilizers to bring her "down". She suggested we be firm with her and tell her to seek help from a Psychiatrist, then if she felt the need, to recontact the police.

Det Keppel listened to Mrs Saari while writer was talking with aforementioned people. Writer then attempted to

talk with her but ended up listening. Write, secured at 1555 hours aft, explaining to her that if she felt she needed protection for her situation that she would have to contact the law enforcement agency in that jurisdiction (she had mentioned a fear for her daughter that lives inside the city limits of Seattle and for herself, on Mercer Island. She left write numerous notes that are attached.

Mr Caldwell, Director of the program, phoned. He said he had heard from other sources that she appeared to be overly nervous of late, that they haven't been able to find her. Said they would have to take some action because she is ahead of a federally funded mental health grant this summer, in the hundred of thousands of dollars. Said he looks into the matter and keep in touch. (D)

Bob Pig SSA called + said there is no record of [redacted] in Wash + the SSAN given by Mrs. Saari (338-38-5495) is no good - no national record.

She says veh #1 lives by her daughter, who was the victim of a rape attempt Jan 74, by a guy who looks like Ted. Veh #2 she says, followed her from Mercer Island + was acting suspicious. Mrs. Saari feels someone is out to get her so she moved from her house to a Sheraton or Sherwood Hotel.

So, Mrs Saari started talking about a [redacted] (or [redacted] who is about 30 yrs + a past mental patient at HMC. She thinks he could be Ted - NO address.

About 6-19-75 there was a sniper by Skykomish with the name on [redacted] - Saari says that translates to [redacted] rohd in German - So, [redacted] must be the man.

Saari works for Seattle School Dist in some type of a mental health project.

She makes reference to a sniper on I-90 6-21-75 that occurred when talking to Sgt. Connally KCP Radio.

She believes [redacted] did the sniping that day because on the same day he received 50 mg. of Thorazine from HMC - She thinks that was not enuf so he was frustrated.

6-30-75 I went through Sgt Wilkie who contacted Sgt Connally - The sniping incident turned out to be someone using a shing-shot on Hwy 18.

I talked to Lt. Wally Lee MIPD. The guy Mrs Saari saw on 6-4-75 was a [redacted] 5-[redacted]-12. Mr. [redacted] is A Mercer Isk. Local who had bandages on his Arms because he was ran over on 6-3-75 by a car. [redacted] does NOT look like Ted says Lt. Lee.

Mrs Saari felt MIPD scared he Ted away when she called by using their sirens so she called SPD + wanted them to block off the Floating bridge so this SAVAGE Ted could be caught. Meeting with NO luck there she went to MIPD station where she saw another MAN who looked like Ted standing at the business counter. Lt. Lee says the guy is 42 yrs 6'4 220 lbs + does NOT look like Ted. Mrs. Saari Demanded they arrest him + became upset when they did not. MIPD called in E. Side Mental Health. Robinson + Hanney from E. side M. H. talked to Mrs. Saari.

SYNOPSIS:

This investigation was initiated on July 16, 1975 upon assuming custody of above captioned subject on a writ ordering the production of [redacted] from the Whatcom County Jail, Bellingham, Wash. to the United States Marshal, Seattle, Wash. for production of [redacted] to court for the charge of illegal re-entry into the United States after Deportation.

[redacted] was incarcerated in the Whatcom County Jail charged with robbery and kidnapping. [redacted] was subsequently found guilty of robbery and sentenced to 20 years, and is presently incarcerated, as of Aug 6, 1975, at the Washington State Correctional Center, Shelton, Washington. I WAS CONTACTED BY SANDERSON, SCOTT H. W.M., 29y rs, 12-28-44 RESIDING AT THE NORTH BEND MOBILE HOME COURTS, #34/BOX 259 NORTH BEND 98045, NO PHONE. THE CONTACT WAS AT THE NORTH BEND SUBSTATION. HE RELATED THE FOLLOWING TO ME. ON A THURSDAY EITHER OCT 10 OR 17 IN THE MID AFTERNOON HE HAD OCCASION TO BE AT THE SNOQUALMIE FALLS. HE WAS DOWNRIVER FROM THE OBSERVATION DECK AT THE END OF A SPECTATORS TRAIL. HE WAS LOOKING AT THE FALLS THEN NOTICED THREE PEOPLE COME DOWN THE TRAIL TO THE END WHERE HE WAS. THEY STOOD VERY CLOSE TO HIM AND TALKED AMONGST THEMSELVES. SANDERSON OBSERVED TWO MEN IN HARDHATS WALK OUT OF THE TURBINE OUTFLOW TUNNEL ACROSS THE RIVER AT THE BASE OF THE FALLS. SANDERSON MENTIONED THIS TO THE THREE PEOPLE THAT CONSISTED OF A COUPLE HE BELIEVES TO BE IN THEIR SEVENTYS AND A MAN (WHO HE FEELS RESEMBLES THE PICTURES OF TED) IN HIS LATE TWENTYS. THE OLDER MAN WHO WAS STANDING UNUSUALLY CLOSE TO SANDERSON DIDNT QUITE UNDERSTAND OR WAS HARD OF HEARING STARTED TO LEAN ON SANDERSON AND ACTING A LITTLE "FUNNY" IN ATTEMPT TO COMMUNICATE. HE DEFINITELY FELT THAT THESE PEOPLE ESPECIALLY THE OLDER COUPLE FIT THE TOURIST MOLD.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On Oct. 2nd, I interviewed ~~Denise H. Bettex~~ regarding the "Ted Murders". She had indicated that the artist's drawing in a recent newspaper article looked like a former boyfriend.

She stated that she went with a man named Ted about five years ago. She doesn't know his last name or much about him. She stated that when she knew him he lived in West Seattle in a house behind a real estate office. She thinks it was near Holly and Frontenac Sts. about a block from McDonald's Restaurant. The real estate firm may begin with a "G". She thinks the house was dirty white and the real estate office was grey or brown. While in Ted's place you could hear people talking in the real estate office on the other side of the wall. Ted lived with an alcoholic called, "Dad". (house was on opposite side of street from McDonald's.

The last time she saw Ted was about two years ago in the Flame Tavern at 128th & Ambaum Blvd. in Burien. She didn't know if he had a car at this time, but he owned an old "raggy" green pickup truck when she went with him before.

She describes Ted as a W.M., 6'1", skinny, and thinks he's about 26 or 27 years old now. She believes he has brown eyes and brown hair described as shaggy, but above the collar. She says he is a "speed freak". He used to wear a dark blue or black knit type watch cap. He has no tatoos and doesn't wear glasses. She believes he's originally from somewhere in Oregon near the Wa. state line. She stated that his face was longer and more drawn out than the artist's sketch in the paper. She stated he has always been unemployed while she knew him. He drinks beer, wine and whiskey, and rolled his own cigarettes.

Ms. Bettex stated that Ted used to talk about dogs, mountains and having a cabin. When she saw him two years ago, he told her he finally found what he wanted and she thought that to mean that he had moved into a cabin. She stated there is a place on Route I-90, somewhere near Easton, on the map, where he indicated he wanted to live. There is a certain overlook or pull-off where she has been with him. She thinks the cabin may be in that area.

She thinks he now has two dogs, a German sheppard and a big red dog. When she read about one of the victim's body's being only partially there, she wondered if Ted had fed human flesh to his dogs.

Ms. Bettex states she went to Sealth H. S. with the victim, Denise Nasland and had met the victim, Janice Ott a couple of years ago.

On August 10, a Washington resident, Ms. Judy Schneiderman, of 6820 51st Street, N. E., Seattle, a visitor in our state, contacted a member and indicated that she had seen a person who resembled a police composite drawing in connection with the several kidnappings of college students in the state of Washington. She indicated to our member that this person was observed in Seaside, Oregon, earlier that day.

Our members checked Seaside and later, that same afternoon, interviewed subject identified as [REDACTED] P. O. Box [REDACTED] 9th Boulevard North, Long Beach, Washington, DOB 11- [REDACTED] 55, 5'10", 170, light brown reddish hair, curly, collar length. His left arm was in a cast from his shoulder to fingers. He was operating a 1974 two-tone brown Maverick, Washington VAR [REDACTED]. A check with DMV in Olympia revealed the vehicle was not yet of record. This subject informed our members that he was unemployed but generally worked as a laborer setting up mobile homes. When further questioned, he indicated that he had been in Seattle and King County on several occasions during the past year. Corporal James D. 
