SURVEILLANCE:

Subject:

At approximately 1500 hours today, I was invited to accompany Regional Security Officer Brooks to AMU to aid AMU administration in coping with a disturbance created by allegedly psychotic behavior of an employee.

After discussion with R.S.O. Brooks, President Picton, Administrator Latham, I began surveillance of AMU.

At 1630 hours left Grant Hall and walked directly to his room # in Hall, the men's dormitory.

At 1700 hours and a male companion of swarthy complexion, probably part native, early 20's age, 6 ft. height, 175 weight, brown hair, brown eyes, came out of the hallway door which had been shut shortly after I entered.

We spoke briefly. I asked about the cafeteria hours and was told.

They left and walked to the cafeteria for supper. They sat in a position overlooking the walk I followed them in on, so I decided to have supper too, and sat near them playing the hard-pressed role.

As I ate, approached me and asked if I lived on his quad in the Dorm. I explained I was waiting for a guy who was to give me a ride to Tok Junction.

He was curious about why we were meeting in his quad since he didn't know Billy Boyle, and so got the whole schpiel.

I left impatiently, returned to the dorm, left a note for Billy and returned to Student Union for "Coffee". He approached again and this time got my story straight in his mind.

He and his companion left the Cafeteria at approximately 1830 and entered the women's dorm. At approximately 1850 emerged alone and often commiserating with me about my tardy ride, entered the Married Dorm where he remained until arrested.

At approximately 1900 Officer Orr moseyed through and took up position in the parking lot.

At approximately 2120 R.S.O. Brooks, President Picton, Administrator Latham, and Officer Pippin, A.P.D., arrived and made arrest. End of operation.

Jackson locked himself in his son's room for the night and drove back to AMU the following morning. told Jackson not to talk to him, to avoid him in every way and be very cautious about letting any school people see them together.

stated earlier that Jackson was his #1 enemy.

Gail May, WFA, DOB: May 30, 1941 Counsel - AMU - Special Services - MA - Psychology Interviewed by Brooks 4-30-75 at 6:15 p.m.

Stated that a week ago - Monday April 21, 1975, she was attending a luncheon, sponsored by AMU, at the "Club 25". During the meal, who had been introduced to her several times before, turned to her and stated that they had an appointment. He repeated this statement several times during the course of the conversation in a tone indicating a very positive manner. Informed her that she had an appointment with him but refused to comment further. He then said he was from the Seattle area and stated that she was the first person to recognize that he fit the general description of the suspects in the Washington co-ed murders. He quickly became agitated and said "You're going to be #17". He then looked toward Jackson and said "No - you're to be #17."

INVENTORY:

Room 122 was observed, in the presence of Mr. Latham, at 10:00 p.m. The purpose of entry was to collect the personal belongings of Mr. so that they could be turned over to him at API. was terminated by Latham on 4-30-75. Latham and Dr. Picton requested that his personal belongings be secured and removed from the dormitory. Items found in Room were listed on attached form and countersigned by Dr. Latham and Glenn Brooks at 10:45 p.m.

INFORMATION:

had been the subject of an FBI enquiry regarding his possible connection to the co-ed murders in the Seattle area. During the inventory of subject belongings, a small suitcase containing an assorted amount of opened mail and handwritten correspondence was observed. Addresses and checkbooks were found which came from four different states in the western United States and Canada. FBI - Agent Otom - notified of contents at 11:30 p.m.

- and SGT. ROBERT EVANS drove to Rt. Box This is the address of the control on another occasion for burglary. Upon arrival, R/O observed that there were no cars in subject's driveway. However is reported not to own a car. Interior lights of the trailer were on and music was playing inside. R/O also observed that the rear door was standing open about four inches. R/O and DETECTIVE KEPPEL knocked on the door and received no answer. Having probable cause to arrest

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R/O opened front door of the trailer and called to tifying self at the same time. R/O received no answer. - ported to Southeast Precinct, and then on to the King County Jail, where he was booked Hold Inv. Burglary, 2counts at 1720 Hrs.
- R/O transported

 to the main office and started to interview him. was again advised of his constitutional rights, and in turn signed acknowledgement of them on King County form B-118. R/O then took a signed statement of admission from concerning this case and a separate statement of admission concerning case #74-9598. included in this statement that he knew the owner of this house, master case 74-7109, and that he had gone there to steal his stereo.
- to the King County Youth Service Center. While en route there, stated to R/O that he had burglarized another house. R/O asked

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which one, and he replied, the QUANTS' house. get some of the property back if he were not prosecuted. R/O informed him that he could make no deals. Upon arrival at the Youth Service Center, was placed in detention. Just prior to being placed in detention realized that he would be searched by the Youth Service Center workers, and he at that time turned over a man's gold ring to R/O, that he had hid in his sock. R/O inquired where the ring had come from and he stated that he and had ripped it off from a house on the Hobart Rd. also turned over a small packet containing white powder to R/O. R/O inquired as to the contents and was informed that it was cocaine.

- 16 The ring and the suspected cocaine was placed in a sealed evidence envelope and transported to headquarters, where they were placed into evidence. A lab request for analysis was made.

R/O brought to the office for further interview. was again advised of his constitutional rights and confronted with this case. readily admitted his involvement, stating that it was his car that was used. also volunteered that had burglarized the house before and knew that the guy had some more stereo equpiment. further stated that sold the stereo equipment from this previous burglary, case #73-94083, and a color TV set to a DENNIS CAMPBELL, who lived in some apartments on Richards Rd. in Bellevue. R/O questioned of the burglary on the Hobart Rd. readily admitted to his involvement in this burglary, stating that he and had gotten two shotguns and some money. described this house as being across the creek near the Hobart Rd. at the Renton cutoff. From this description R/O was able to determine this was case #74-1009. Provided a map to DENNIS CAMPBELL's apartment, saying that he had the shotguns, case 74-001009.
- 18 1200 Hrs. R/O made contact at 13001 SE 28th, Bellevue, along with SGT. EVANS and DETECTIVE KEPPEL. R/O made contact with a SUE COLES at the apartment and ascertained that she lived there with DENNIS CAMPBELL. R/O explained the reason for our presence and was admitted to the apartment. MISS COLES was asked if a search could be made of the apartment, as she was the renter. MISS COLES agreed and gave R/O permission on King County form B-123. R/O and DETECTIVE KEPPEL searched the apartment and found a Pioneer amplifier and a Thorens turntable, along with approximately 150 record albums in the living room. The stereo albums were marked with the names LA COUNT and JULIE WILSON. The stereo matched the description of the equipment listed as stolen in case #73-940883, a residential burglary of this victim's residence. R/O also found an Admiral color TV set, serial #C0155570, marked with Scott's TV Rental, Ft. Lewis. WA. A check revealed this set to be stolen from Pierce County, Pierce County Sheriff's case 72-11790. All equipment was seized as stolen property. MISS COLES stated that she did not know when DENNIS CAMPBELL would return to the apartment. R/O, DETECTIVE KEPPEL and SGT. EVANS cleared at this time.

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- 1500 Hrs. R/O and DETECTIVE KEPPEL returned to 13001 SE 28th and made contact with DENNIS CAMPBELL. R/O advised CAMPBELL of his constitutional rights and questioned him in regards to the stereo equipment and TV. CAMPBELL stated that he had bought the items from toward the end of October, 1973. R/O questioned CAMPBELL toward the shotguns, case #74-1008 and was informed that he knew nothing of the shotguns. An appointment was made for CAMPBELL to contact R/O at R/O's office on 1-24-74 at 0930 Hrs.
- 20 1-24-74 0850 Hrs. R/O made contact with the King County Youth Service Center Judicial Secretary and requested a mug and print order on .
- 0900 Hrs. CLINTON MARROW, case #74-9598 came in and identified the Sears TV and four shotguns as his, and the same taken in this burglary. A statement was taken to this effect.
- CAMPBELL at the office. DENNIS CAMPBELL brought in a Remington .20 gauge shotgun with him, stating that he had gotten it from the first week in January. This gun was believed to have been taken in case #74-1009. Statement was taken concerning the shotgun and the stereo equipement, which was also obtained from
- 23 DETECTIVE KEPPEL brought to the office to be mugged and printed. A copy of the court order was shown to and he was, in fact, mugged and printed.
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- 1300 Hrs. R/O was contacted by the wife of victim in this case, 74-7109. MRS. LA COUNT was shown the Marantz amplifier and the Thorens model TD 160 turntable, along with approximately 45 stereo albums. MRS. LA COUNT positively identified these items as being the same which were taken from her home on 1-15-74. R/O also showed MRS. LA COUNT a Pioneer amplifier and a Thorens model 100 turntable, along with approximately 150 albums. These were also identified by the victim as being belonging to her and being the same, which was taken from her residence in case #73-94083 on 10-25-73. Recovered Pierce County stolen Television set was shown to MRS. LA COUNT, but no identification could be made.

 (Contends that he stole the TV set from the LA COUNTS.) A statement was taken from MRS. LA COUNT concerning the burglary of her house on 1-15-74 and 10-25-73.
