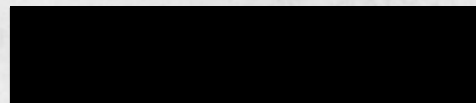

Transported the subject to KCSO and went to the Sgt's office where I advised the subject of his rights. Which he stated that he understood. I then asked him again why he followed the young lady home? he stated that he was lonely and that he likes to make new friends. I then asked if he was married? He stated that he was. I then asked if he was having problems with his wife and he stated No. That he works 7 days a week and his wife also works. His wife is asleep when he gets home. I then asked if he had followed any other women home. He stated he followed one home to the NORMANDY PARK area in South Seattle sometime in late 1973 or early 1974. He gave this officer the impression that he followed other women home other than the two he told this officer about.

Stated that he moved to KITSAP Co. in Feb. of 1974. I then asked him where he was going after I stopped him he stated that he was going out to his property on LATHROP Rd. Flannagan discretely interviewed [REDACTED]'s father and learned that [REDACTED] owned a Red V.W., that he was a student at a Seattle Barber College, that he got into some type of trouble and returned to Pennsylvania. [REDACTED] is presently attending a Barber School on Murray Avenue in Pittsburg.

Phoned DMV, Professional Licensing and learned that [REDACTED] attended the Modern Barber College located in Lake City in 1972. Mrs. Wolfe agreed to mail photo of [REDACTED].

09-10-75

Per Det. Ron Freeman, Pittsburg P.D., MR. [REDACTED] was incarcerated in a mental institution 1972-1973. Det. Freeman ascertained that [REDACTED] was in Washington State and California during 1974. [REDACTED] worked as a school guard in Sacramento.

Det. Freeman from Pittsburg called back. States suspect returned to Pittsburg and enrolled in barber school there on 6-25-73. He had approximately 6 months of school here which would have placed him here in 1-73.

Suspect graduated from school in Pittsburg on 10-30-73.

Between 10-30-73 and now he has served 15 months of apprenticeship in unknown locations.

Suspect's father states he did return to Washington sometime after 10-30-73.

Director of barber school states suspect is a very moody individual going from a state of friendliness to hostility at a moments notice. Also, that he has had trouble holding a job due to his temper.

Suspect is described as 5'9", 175, med. build, med. complexion, short but full cut blonde hair over his forehead.

[REDACTED] was questioned about his disappearance he stated that pressure forced him to take some time off. The dates of our homicides and missing girls were furnished to Pittsburg P.D.

[REDACTED] was described as "inadequate" and stated he was not the man he wants to be.

Dear Ms. McChesney:

In regards to a telephone conversation that I had with you earlier regarding your homicide suspect, Ted, dealing with the Seattle coeds. I have enclosed with this letter a custody sheet on a subject by the name of [REDACTED]. In addition to the custody sheet are photographs of the above, [REDACTED].

During a short interview with this subject, he indicated to me that he went to the University of Washington during the same time period that the college coeds were murdered. He also indicated that he had been to Oregon State University, but did not state whether he went to the school or not. Added information is, this subject does drive Volks-wagons and currently has two Volks-wagons in his possession, one yellow, and one black, both in Sedan styles.
