On 03/10/75, I was contacted by a JERRY WARREN, N. 4318 Maple, 327-4976, work phone number: 244-3752. Mr Warren stated that he had lived in Issaquah several years ago, and has a possible suspect in mind, who would be approximately 24 years of age now; that he would like to see the composite of the suspect thought to be named TED. On 03/10/75, in the p.m., Mr. Warren did come into the Detective's Office and did view the composite sent out by the King County Police Department, dated 08/08/74; that the composite on that flier, he thought, did resemble a subject (name unkn to him) who did live just to the east of Issaquah in 1965 or 1966. Mr. Warren did draw a map, indicating on it - Issaquah and North Bend. Did mention that approximately 2-miles east of Issaquah there was an old Richfield truck stop service station; that in 1965 or in 1966, he did help his father clear the timber from a field located across the highway from this old truck stop. Mr. Warren went on to state that approximately a block and a half east of the old truck stop, there is a road that turns south, that you turn south and go to the first road that goes east, and the second house there was a blonde haired boy who did assist him in 1965 or 1966 with the clearing of the land. Stated that he does not know this subject's name, and is sure that the subject has since moved from that house, but did note that the blonde haired subject he is referring to was very familiar with the land in that area. Mr. Warren went on to state that there is an older couple, he believes, still residing in the area, who may know the name of this blonde haired subject. This older couple would reside approximately two to three blocks east of the old Richfield truck stop, and they would live on the north side of the highway.

Approximately 0800 hrs., on 03/12/75, I did telephone the King County Police Dept., where I did talk to Detective Roger Dunn. I did explain to him about this map, and told him a copy would be forwarded to him, but I thought explanation was in line because of the map itself, was not that explanatory. Detective Dunn stated that he would forward more recent information on the subject, thought to be named TED, to this writer.

At approximately 1300 hrs., on 03/12/75, a female, who called herself Mrs. MOSS, came into the Detective's Office. Stated she did have some information that may be the TED we are looking for. I did talk with M. Moss in Interview Room #2. Mrs. Moss stated that her closest friend, named [REDACTED], and Mrs. [REDACTED] currently resides in Auburn, Washington; that [REDACTED] is recently divorced from her husband, [REDACTED], who Mrs. Moss stated is in his late 30's, but does appear much younger. She described him as being: medium build, on the slender side, and she believes that he currently resides in Tacoma; however, she stated that he has been arrested in Auburn, and the Police Department there should have information on him; also, possibly a picture. She stated that she is not sure of the time the female turned up missing from the University of Oregon, but at about that same time, this [REDACTED] was living in Oregon. Mrs. Moss stated that in approximately 1968,

\_\_\_\_\_ went off the deep end and lost a \$250,000.00 tire business that he had in Tacoma, and apparently since losing this business, by drinking away the profits and not sticking to the job, he has become very despondent. Mrs. Moss stated she has not seen \_\_\_\_\_ for five years. She does believe he works for ED PATE at a tire shop in Tacoma. Mrs. Moss stated that \_\_\_\_\_ likes boats and does enjoy the water, and she did mention that after the divorce, she was talking with \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_ did tell her that \_\_\_\_\_ did have unusual sexual behaviour, but \_\_\_\_\_ did not go into detail with Mrs. Moss. Mrs. Moss stated that when she and her husband heard about a tavern mentioned where one of the females that was abducted from, it rang a bell with both she and her husband, that \_\_\_\_\_ did frequent that tavern, so she thought that they should come in and give us the information.

At 1415 hours, 03/12/75, I did go to the Seattle First National Bank where I contacted a NONA (NMI) HENRY, dob: 10/20/19, home address: 18503 East Bow Road, Greenacres, Washington in the Spokane Valley, phone: 926-6362. Mrs. Henry stated that approximately five or six years ago, her daughter, Susan, who currently is about 27-years old, was a student at Western Washington State College in Bellingham; that Susan was working for the library at the College, and had made mention to her mother about a subject who continually stared at her. Mrs. Henry stated that Susan never dated the subject, and probably never said more than "hello" to him, but it did seem like wherever Susan was, this subject was. Mrs. Henry stated the subject, in question, is a \_\_\_\_\_ approximately 26 years, who lives at 68 \_\_\_\_\_ Oswego Place, N.E., Seattle, Washington, 98115, phone: 522-\_\_\_\_\_. She described him as being approximately 5'10"; medium build; slender side, with dark brown hair. Mrs. Henry stated that her daughter, Susan, is currently Mrs. JOHN BROWNE, and she lives in Ferndale, Washington; that Mr. JOHN BROWNE is at present a Security Officer at Western Washington State College. Mrs. Henry went on to state that almost five years after the subject, \_\_\_\_\_ and her daughter Susan were in school together at Western Washington State College, she, Mrs. Henry, did receive a long-distance phone call from \_\_\_\_\_ - this being this last Summer, 1974 - exact date unknown - and \_\_\_\_\_ asked to speak to Susan. Mrs. Henry told \_\_\_\_\_ that Susan did not live there. He stated that he wished to talk to her. Mrs. Henry stated she told him again that she did not live at that house. He stated that he wished to talk to her. Mrs. Henry told him, again, that she did not live at that house. That was the extent of the conversation at that time. The one she opened, she kept, and cannot find at this time, but did tell me that in context it read that he still loved her, and would like to get things going with her. She stated she looked around and did not see his car anywhere, but learned, later from a neighbor, that the car he was driving was

A VW "Bug"; however, the color was unknown. The neighbor does not recall at this time. [redacted] asked Mrs. Henry if he could talk to Susan. Mrs. Henry again told him that Susan was married, and did not live in the house any longer. She stated that [redacted] seemed bothered at this time, that after learning of Susan getting married, after a long pause, told her that he wouldn't bother her any more, and did leave. She stated that approximately a month or two later, there was again a knock at the door, and her younger daughter, age 23, answered the door, and there was [redacted] again, standing on the porch. Mrs. Henry stated that she came to the door, then, and again his car was not in sight. Again, he asked to talk to Susan, and again, Mrs. Henry told him she (Susan) was married and did not live at this residence, and [redacted] said, "Can you prove this to me?" Mrs. Henry said she went to get a picture of her two grandchildren (Susan's children) and showed them to [redacted]. She stated that [redacted] said, "I have had my problems, but I am over them now." Mrs. Henry stated that [redacted] did leave, and that is the last she has heard of him. She does believe that there is something emotionally wrong with [redacted] - and he is possibly thought to be the subject named "TED", that the King County Police Department is looking for.

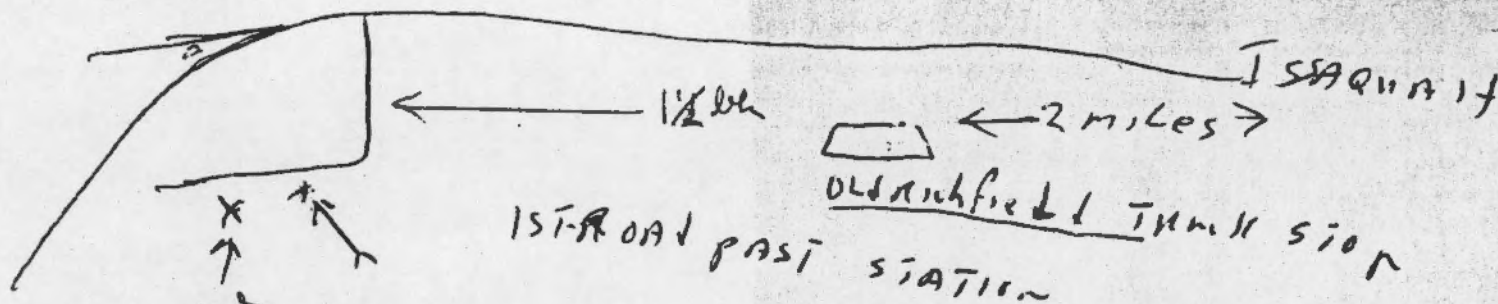

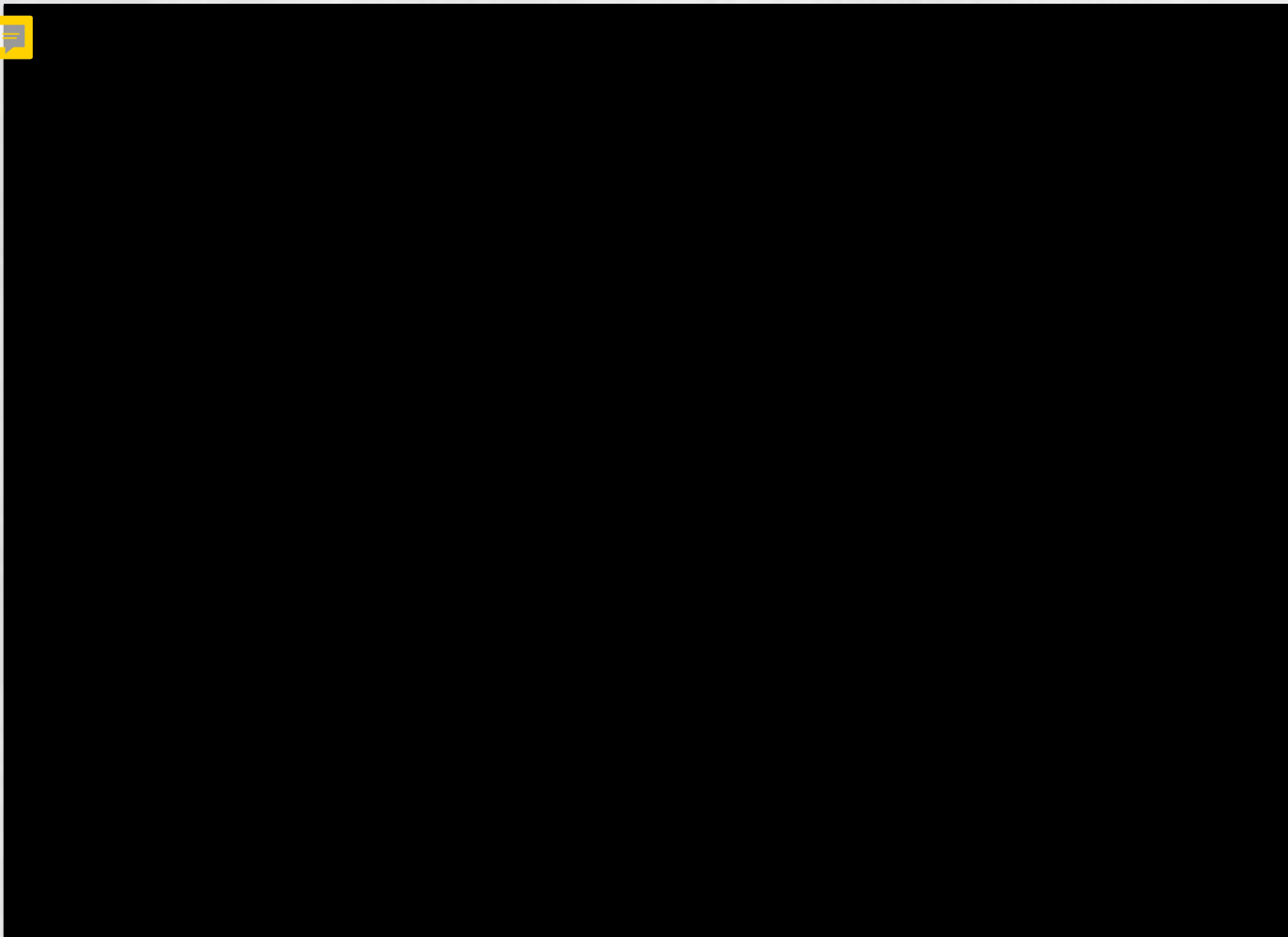
