



Complainant, Mrs. Joseph Wahler, called to advise that they have received more phone calls, letters, flowers, and visits from subject [REDACTED]. The letters have become quite obscene that are being sent to complainant's daughter, KAREN WAHLER. In some letters he has stated that a subject by the name of [REDACTED] was out to kill her and that he would protect her from him.

Complainant has contacted Eastside Mental Health regarding this subject and they have advised her to change all locks and keys and keep house locked, and Eastside Mental Health after reviewing the letters and talking with complainant believes this subject to be possibly dangerous.

Upon arrival this date, U/S made contact with complainant who gave U/S the attached outline of past events regarding harrassment from [REDACTED] since July 1974 until just before Easter 1975.

Investigation revealed that the letters and phone calls are getting more obscene and threats have been made on KAREN's safety. The suspect knows where Karen goes to school (B.C.C.) and has made contact with her there against her wishes and was reported to B.C.C. security. Complainant has contacted Seattle Mental Health Center, 329-5400 and talked to LIZ JONES and HANK BALDERVAMA, and they advised complainant that suspect obviously needs help and would look into the matter. Complainant has become extremely worried for her daughter's safety (Karen is age 18) and for the safety of the rest of her family as the suspect has come to the residence on several occasions. Investigation has revealed that suspect has threatened Karen's life if she will not marry him and she has never indicated anything of the sort to him.





Karen Wahler (our 18 yr. old daughter) met  on a bus trip last summer. He claimed to have been traveling a lot & wanted her address to tell her of his travels. She did not express any interest in him.

In Sept. He called Karen from Calif. & from Oregon & when she came thru Seattle he called her even tho he knew Karen wouldn't be home. He talked to me about how wonderful Karen was & told me things about himself. It was strange, but I didn't think too much of it.

He told Karen he was moving from Montreal to Vancouver, B.C. On his way to Vancouver, he spent a weekend in Seattle. Karen didn't part. want to see him & I wasn't incl. to invite him here, so Karen agreed to show him the sights in Seattle on Saturday. He wanted to come home with her to meet the family, but Karen knew I didn't want him to, so she didn't let him.

He moved to Vancouver.

abt. a week later he moved to Seattle.

Since then we've had no peace! He has written many ridiculous letters (once three copies of the same letter).

He has called repeatedly to the point of our sometimes having to leave the phone off the hook.

Since before Thanksgiving he was told emphatically by Karen + me that nothing existed betw. him + her + for him to leave us alone. He was told in the phone + in letters + we then began to hang up whenever he called — + still do. Once, in resp. to his pleading, I heard him out (on phone) + expl. the situation to him + urged him to forget her + go out + meet others, etc. He promised not to bother us anymore.

Since then he has pestered us with letters, flowers, donate, phone calls & attempted visits! We send him away, tell him we never want to see him, & slam the door in his face! He walks away smiling & goes to Kirkland & orders flowers! He rides bus from Seattle - walks to our house from Kirkland.

Last Sunday ^{visits} morning our kids awakened me to tell me [redacted] wanted to see me.

I said I wasn't available. He then asked for my husband. The message was then that no one wanted to see him.

He called the following Wed. Karen bawled him out & hung up.

He came again on Friday. His persistent knocking & shouting woke one of the kids. Again he was sent away.

He came again the next day (Sat.)

I sent for Karen - woke her -
+ had her go to the door
+ send him away. She was
very angry + really shouted
at him, but he continued
to shout that he loved her.
He went + had flowers sent from

- Beg. July Karen went from Seattle to Idaho by bus. [redacted] sat next to her and they talked - mostly about travel. He was headed for San Francisco, but changed his ticket + went as far as Twin Falls to continue their conversation. He asked for (+ got) her address so he could tell her about his trip to S.F. Karen has been to S.F. + loves it.

- early Sept - Karen rec. birthday card from [redacted] with picture of himself.

Sept) - He called from Calif. + talked about his trip
Sept) - He called from Portland to say he was coming thru Seattle. Karen told him she'd be at school - and she really didn't care cause she wasn't interested in him.

- Karen - while visiting her friend in Idaho during the summer, fell in love with a guy she was introduced to.

→ when [redacted] came thru Seattle, he called + talked to me for about a half hour - told me about himself + about his travelling + about how wonderful Karen was. I thought it a real odd experience, but didn't consider it important. He said he was moving from Montreal to Vancouver.

a few days later (approx) he came to Seattle for the weekend & wanted Karen to meet him there, or for him to come here to see her. So far, he appeared perfectly normal. It was a particularly hectic weekend for me, so I told Karen we couldn't have him as a guest. She suggested taking him sightseeing in Seattle & telling him to quit calling her cause she wasn't interested & was in love with someone else. He begged to be taken home to meet the family, but Karen told him it was out of the question & took him back to his hotel.

approx. a week later he moved from Vancouver to Seattle & got a job.

He began to call daily, begging Karen to go visit him. She never did & kept telling him to go meet other people & leave her alone because she intended to marry Larry.

He started calling & asking to talk to me. He seemed to think that Karen wouldn't see him because I disapproved of him. He said he bet I thought he was Negro or wasn't a "full man" etc. I told him those things didn't concern me. He asked if I'd approve of him for my son in law. I told him that was absurd talk since Karen wasn't interested in him & intended to marry someone else.

— We began hanging up every time he called, but he just kept calling till some nites I'd have to unplug the phone so we could sleep.

— During bus strike he came to our house by cab — only younger kids, (10 thru 15) were home. He told them he thought surely someone could take him back to Seattle since cab fare was expensive. The kids assured him no one would & besides none of them could drive — so he left flowers for Karen & ret. by cab.

— He cont. to call — we cont. to hang up.

— Later he came by bus. Karen had just written him a long letter (her first) telling him emphatically that she was going to marry Larry & that she had never expressed any interest in him & never would. She told him to go home & read it & heed it. He grabbed for her & she shoved him away & ran into the house.

— Then his letters began — pleading that she just had to marry him. She tried returning them, but they came back.

— More phone calls — we continued to hang up. He kept asking for me & pleading for me to just listen for 5 min. On two or three occasions I listened & then gave him my advice for coping with his problem, wished him luck, & hung up.

— letters became more frequent & more ridiculous. Sometimes he made copies (copy machine) & sent two copies of same letter in one envelope — sometimes copies of same letter in separate envelopes.

— I went to Kirkland Police to see if we could get rid of him. He was also coming & banging on our door & shouting "Karen, I love you" when we refused to answer the door. No one wanted to see him. They (police) said all they could do was send someone to remove him if he made a disturbance & refused to leave, but couldn't keep him from continuing to come.

— Several times he came & brought flowers & had flowers sent. Several times he came with boxes of donuts & when we refused to answer the door, he left the donuts & notes.

— One Saturday morning he came when some of us (incl. ~~was~~ Karen) were still sleeping in. I sent for Karen & asked her to go to the door & tell him as fiercely & cruelly as she could to leave & never come back. She shrieked at him so that our younger kids shuddered — [redacted] smiled & walked away smiling after she slammed the door in his face. (Before Karen came he was telling the kids to come to help & he grabbed for them frantically.)

— A short time later he walked into one of her classes at B.C.C. She left her seat

Called several times from Canada we hung up.
Finally he had the operator ask us to stay on the line + I told the operator that I wouldn't stay on the line because I didn't want to talk to him — + hanging up.

and walked into the hall + told him to get out + never come back. She went back to her seat and a minute later looked up + saw him standing behind her desk, smiling. She shouted at him to leave. He walked past the teacher, smiling, said goodbye + left. Last week the Germans announced that Panzer forces had captured Jacob, son of Joseph Stalin.

National Ordeal: The Government and People of the United States declared war on the Japanese Empire at 4:10 p.m. Monday, Dec. 8, 1941. At dawn the day before, the Japanese had bombed the U.S. naval base at Pearl Harbor, savagely attacked the whole great U.S. island-bridge which stretches to the Orient. It was premeditated murder, masked by a toothy smile. The Nation had taken a heavy blow.

Instantly on the news from Pearl Harbor, President Roosevelt ordered the Army and Navy: "Fight Back!" The U.S., after 22 years and 25 days of peace, was at war.

A history of the year condensed from the pages of Time

Silence, Exile and Death: Last week a little group of people got together in Manhattan in an atmosphere of unaccustomed awe. They were friends of James Joyce. Fortnight before, a terse cable had announced that the author of *Ulysses* and *Finnegans Wake* was dead in Zurich. To many a baffled reader, the death of Joyce meant merely that the "cult of unintelligibility" had lost its chief prophet. To his admirers, it meant the loss of the greatest figure in European letters since Marcel Proust. To his friends Joyce's death seemed like some simple lapse in nature, grandly tragic and fitting.

Most Valuable: Second-generation Italians made a clean sweep of U.S. baseball honors in the season just past. Joe Di Maggio, native of San Francisco's Fisherman's Wharf, was voted the American League's Most Valuable Player. Dolph Camilli, another San Franciscan, was voted Most Valuable in the National League. Phil Rizzuto, New York Yankee shortstop, was the outstanding rookie of the year.

Stocking Run:


U.S. women, who are credited with having the shapeliest legs in the world, last week faced the horrifying knowledge that soon they would have

to go silk-stockingsless. Raw-silk imports from Japan had ended.

War In The Laboratories: "In modern warfare, one hundred trained physicists may be more valuable than one million infantrymen." This week not 100 but some 1,500 U.S. physicists—one out of every four—are absorbed with problems of defense. Last week the National Defense Research Committee released a few cautious details on what it was up to.

Luridest field of NDRC work is atomic power—smashing of atoms to release the locked-up voltages which hold them together. NDRC's Chairman Vannevar Bush expects nothing to come of this work, but there is a slight chance—and that chance has such terrifying industrial and military implications that no nation can risk neglect of the problem. "I hope they never succeed in tapping atomic power," says Bush.

"It will be a hell of a thing for civilization."

My report is to be on the salmon of the Pacific Northwest, the fish, and the commercial and its commercial & sport uses.

There are five varieties of salmon; the King, sockeye, "silver", humpy, ~~etc.~~ and chum salmon.

The King, also known as chinook, spring, or blackmouth, averages between 10 and 20 pounds in the Puget Sound but can be as big as 60 lbs. It is the largest, with its blue ~~back~~ & black and spotted back and tail.

The sockeye or "blue back" is a smaller fish ~~3 lb average~~, fish averaging 3 lbs. Since it feeds only on microscopic organisms it is very seldom caught by the sport fisherman or commercial troller, however its bright red flesh makes it the most commercially valuable salmon.

The coho or silver salmon is almost as good eating as the sockeye. It has a dark bluish-green back and tail, ~~and~~ with no spots & averaging a pound or two larger than the sockeye.

The humpback is the smallest Pacific salmon with lots of black spots on its humped back and blue tail.

The Chum or Dog Salmon is ~~some~~ somewhat rare in Puget Sound but popular

In Alaska. This fish can be confused with the "Red" or "sockeye" red (sock eye) but is generally larger by several lbs., and has coarser gill rakers, since it feeds on small fish and not plankton, also the Dog has a more silvery tail than the Red.

A few uncommon salmon might be the Jack (sometimes called grilse) or the Kokanee or silver trout. The Jacks are ^{mature} make silver's and Kings that stayed in fresh water longer than normal before going out to sea. The Kokanee are land locked sockeye.

Commercial Fishing

The Bostonians ~~propose~~ got their first taste of a Pacific salmon in 1829. In 1833

The Hudsons Bay Co set up a fishery with their fur trade on the Columbia and in the Puget Sound. Honolulu and London received most of the fish at this time.

Ten years later John Cough set up a salmon trading post at Pillar Rock on the Columbia. By 1840 the Pacific salmon was known around the world.

After the boundary dispute was settled more independent moved in and Hudsons Bay faded out.

In the middle 1850's the first fish traps and gillnets were used. In the ten years production more than doubled while the price fell to ~~half~~ half.

Soon after, salmon canning was discovered and production shot upwards. As many as 40 canneries were on the Columbia ~~Along~~ alone but fishing regulations and prices caused things to level off by 1900 with 20 canneries left in production.

With the development of the gasoline engine commercial trolling became popular in the mouths of rivers and in Puget Sound. It was not until ~~then~~ only twenty five (25) years ago, however, when a minimum size limit was put on trollers.

Sport Fishing

The King and silver salmon are the most popular salmon for sport fishing ^{North of} in Puget Sound.

A deep slow troll with live herring about ~~about~~ the first hour and a half after low water slack gives best results for Kings. In the summer time active Pies, Canada; Pt Lawrence, Orcas Island; and Eagles Cliff off Cypress are the local "hot spots". Governor's Point; between Eliza and Pt Francis; and ~~Obstruction~~ the South west end of Obstruction Pass

He said that he goes there everyday and apparently plays the horses quite abit. He did know who had won the daily double this date. He said he ~~also~~ also went to the Hazelnut Restaurant in Tukwila every morning and ~~other~~ other conversation in general.

He then danced with Kay Riedel and propositioned her in the same manner as he had Paulette, asking her if she would give him a ride to Burien and telling her that he could not drive as he did not have a driver's license as he was suspended.

After the dance, while sitting at the table, he showed the driver's license to Mrs. Walther. She noted at the time that first name on the driver's license was "THEODORE" and recalled that the last name began with a "K" and ended in "VITCH". speaking alone with the different girls, he gave different stories as to where he worked, etc., telling one that he worked at Pacific Car and telling another he worked at Pacific Iron and Foundry in Renton. Apparently the employment he was speaking of was Pacific Car & Foundry. He said he had only worked four days out of the last thirty, saying he was a stainless steel welder and those four days were all worked on Saturdays because he got double time.

It was also noted by the subjects that when this [REDACTED] was dancing with Paulette and Kay, he barely held their right hand with his left hand. He told Kay while dancing with her that he had cut the heel of his hand up pretty badly and this was the reason he was not gripping her hand tightly. He attempted to show the scars to her, however she said in the dark she could not observe anything. He was not wearing bandages of any kind on the hand. The reason the women wished this reported is because this ~~XXXXXX~~ subject fit the description of "TED", who has been involved in the disappearance of several young women in the Washington area.
