The personality type of this subject is: 1) exceptionally intelligent; 2) hatred or fear of women; 3) has had mother problems, probably that the mother was dominant and he felt that any punishment she would inflict on him was cruel; 4) suppressed homosexual type, unable to express male sex; 5) good looking, but only good looking in a non-attentive way (in other words, he would not get attention by his good looks); 6) able to play down what people tell him; 7) he's trustworthy; 8) he's slightly independent; 9) he's under 30, possibly 26 - 27 yrs. old; 10) he's close to home in Seattle. MRS. MURPHY related that the Libby, Montana missing girl was more than likely a runaway, possibly elopement involved. She's on the southern Oregon border, but she's not happy with her situation at this time. MRS. MURPHY did an astrological chart on LYNDIA ANNE HEALY. She related that if her calculations are correct, LYNDIA ANNE HEALY is 2.5 miles from where she was abducted on a south, southeast axis. She's in an improved land area, in the open. MRS. MURPHY gave examples of the Arboretum, ball field, and the area would be lush, but not weedy. She felt that NASLUND and HEALY had the same injuries; severe head injuries, possibly throat cut. At approx 0130 hrs this date I was detailed to 5360 S. Avon to contact witness 1 about the missing girls at Lake Samamish State Park. Upon my arrival The witness contacted me outside her residence as she did not want to alarm her family.

Kathy related to me that on Sunday she and the other two witnesses had gone to Lake Samamish to watch the races. They placed their blanket on the beach approx 75 feet from the water directly behind the floating raft. At about 1230 hrs they saw this "well built fox ^{NEAT} come down the beach with a yellow ten speed bike." The girl placed her beach towel down to the witnesses, and sat down on the towel. Sylvia was the closest to the girl with Pam and Kathy on the other side of Sylvia. This girl was described as about 5'-5'6" long blonde hair, approx 3" over shoulder. 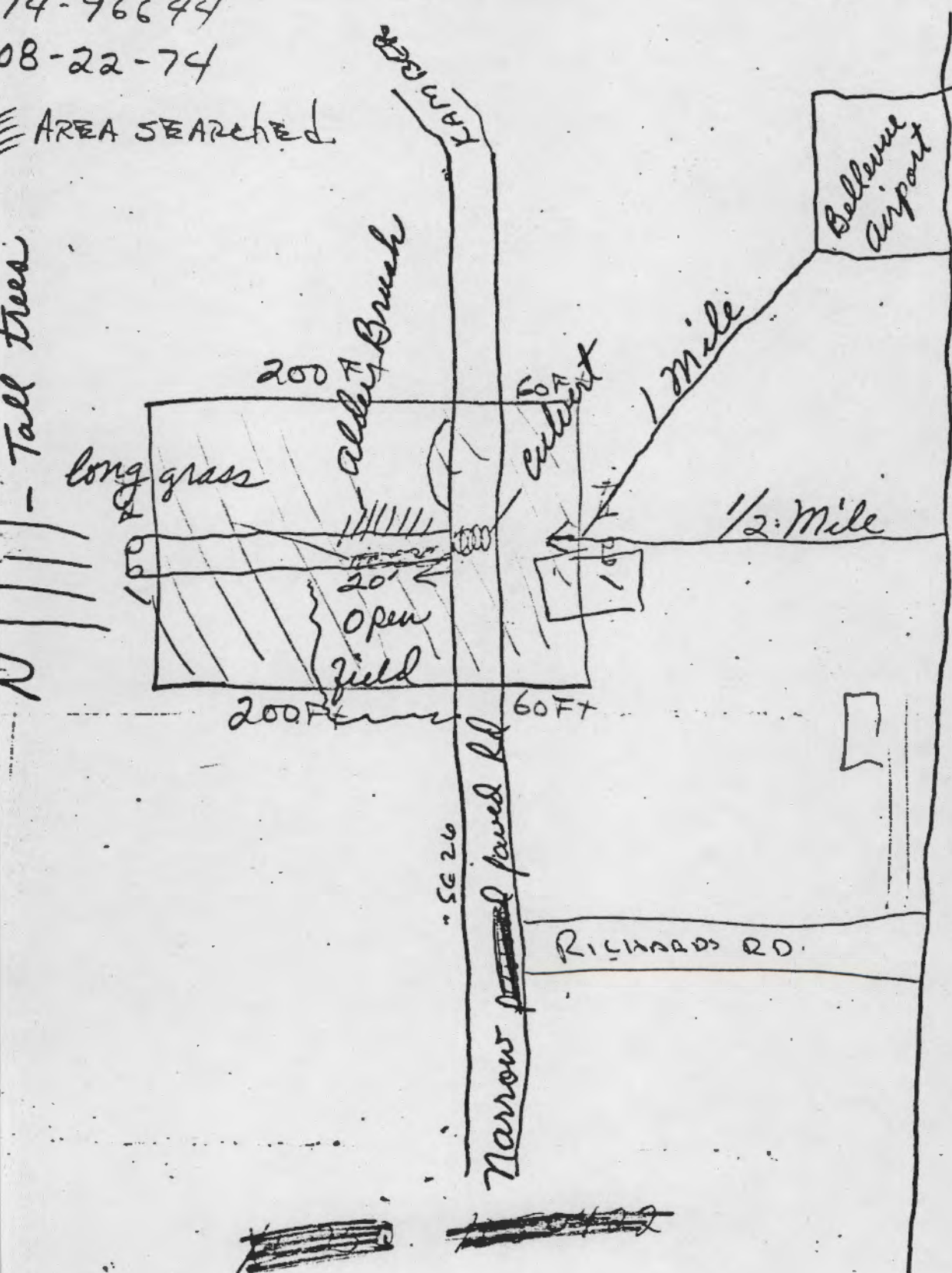

ROUNDTREE related that she was of similar appearance to the missing girls. Refer to paragraph 75. No statement taken.

72 8-14-74 1045 hrs.: Had phone contact with CAROLYN MURPHY, CH 2-1394. She is an astrologer working on the missing girls' cases. She related that the next likely occurrence of a missing girl would be 4-5 days before the full moon, and 4-5 days after the full moon. She related that a subject under maximum stress would have to abduct a girl on October 10-11, more likely October 26-27, and the maximum stress would continue until November 30. Most similar assaults take place in the winter and spring, and then the summer months of June and July. The pattern shows from two to three months of activity, then the subject lets off. The personality type of this subject is: 1) exceptionally intelligent; 2) hatred or fear of women; 3) has had mother problems, probably that the mother was dominant and he felt that any punishment she would inflict on him was cruel; 4) suppressed homosexual type, unable to express male sex; 5) good looking, but only good-looking in a non-attentive way (in other words, he would not get attention by his good looks); 6) able to play down what people tell him; 7) he's trustworthy; 8) he's slightly independent; 9) he's under 30, possibly 26 - 27 yrs. old; 10) he's close to home in Seattle. MRS. MURPHY related that the Libby, Montana missing girl was more than likely a runaway, possibly elopement involved. She's on the southern Oregon border, but she's not happy with her situation at this time. MRS. MURPHY did an astrological chart on LYNDIA ANNE HEALY. She related that if her calculations are correct, LYNDIA ANNE HEALY is 2.5 miles from where she was abducted on a south, southeast axis. She's in an improved land area, in the open. MRS. MURPHY gave examples of the Arboretum, ball field, and the area would be lush, but not weedy. She felt that NASLUND and HEALY had the same injuries; severe head injuries, possibly throat cut. She felt that if her calculations were correct, the 2.5 miles was accurate, but if it were not correct, then you multiply 2.5 by 7.

73 MRS. MURPHY did an astrological chart on [REDACTED]. She felt that the subject who abducted [REDACTED] was maybe in his early 40s, male, black or brown hair, 6'0", rather tall, not heavy set. The suspect has a strong attraction to a girl looking like [REDACTED]. His initial motive may have been for money. He's not particularly good looking; he's got a big nose. He may have a sex deviant background. Has a record for check forgery. The suspect is from some distance away, and not from the local neighborhood. MRS. MURPHY felt that due to the press coverage of the [REDACTED] case that this has possibly scared the suspect into doing away with [REDACTED].
