RE: CORRELATION OF IMPRESSIONS CONCERNING "TED" AND THEODORE BUNDY:

Dear Det. Roger Dunn,

As I said on the phone I sincerely believe that Theodore Bundy is Ted. I have rechecked my notes taken in 1974 and racked my memory to recall all pertinent impressions as you requested. I will proceed to describe Ted and let you match up any similarities. Particulars about the girls are listed in order of who I did 1st, 2nd. ect.

PERSONALITY:

My impression of Ted's personality was that of a cold, intelligent, clever person with no feelings of guilt. His victims were just tools and meant no more to him at the time or since than a cigarette butt one disposes of. To me there is also an underlying awfulness that comes off of him. I don't have this f eeling about all murderers whose photos I have seen, and feel it is partly explained under motive. This profile is based entirely on impressions gathered through working on these cases, and was given to Captain Swindler in 74.

MOTIVE:

Ted's motives for these killings were partly sexual abberations and largely the desire to watch people die in different ways. I think he has witnessed death throes before and they hold a fascination for him, very likely at a hospital as I told Sharon _____ in the summer of 74. Sharon worked also on these cases with Captain Swindler.

GENERAL NOTES:

None of the girls was held captive—they were killed shortly after their disappearance. There have been more victimes than is known even now—probably hitchkikers. I felt Ted resided in the Seattle area as I told you, Roger, and other detectives at K.C. I felt that Ted was quite likely a left handed person which I also told you long before Bundy's arrest. I felt that the man who killed Linda Healy basically seemed the same but that he had a scraggly mostache or beard (or both), was more of a hippie, and seemed to have a different motive—also he knew her however slightly—(more later). I feel there were about 4 bodies left at the Issaquah site. Ted worked alone and did not feel black magic was involved contrary to much speculation. I think you, other K.C. detectives, Captain Swindler and Sharon will recall the above statements as made in 74.

HAWKINS:

There was nothing wrong with his arm, and she left unharmed in a car. I do not know how she died but I thought I could visualize the body and it seemed to bear throat wounds. However, I also felt she was partially clad and in a drainage ditch near a small road, this may be e roneous as it does not fit the other crimes. I felt rape had occurred.

HEALY:

Linda was awakened by a tapping on her window. She recognized the man and although she was unhappy and puzzled about why he was there she got up and let him in the side door. A disagreement started to ensue about sex--I felt he was annoyed because she would not "put out" for him and he started to strangle her with a chain--a gold chain I took to be heavy jewelry. I got no more but feel fairly certain she did not die in the room. She, like Georgann, smoked pot. Captain Swindler accompained me to the Healy girl's room and witnessed these statements.

Janice Ott had her throat slit. Ted's arm was wrapped in 2-3"" wide strips of white cloth, not a cast, and he had the knife under the seat of his car. He took it out and showed it to her after turning left out of the park and gaining speed. (He drove too fast). She was killed in a small clearing with a lot of vine maples around; it resembles only in part the place where she was found. The sun was high in the sky and was in her eyes. indicating time about 2:00 P.M. He told her to lay on her back, close her eyes and then he leaned over and slit her throat, about 3" deep. At this point I "acted out" the part of Janice as I felt as though my throat had been slit and acted accordingly. Sharon was present. I later confirmed with Captain Swindler that how I acted was a typical response to this type of murder. I was also aware of Ted watching intently. Before the death there was an impression of a half dozen or so of horses, and a barn in the distance, and possibly a gold ring with a red stone on Ted's right hand. am not sure if a sexual act occurred but at death they were both dressed. The mife was a bowie type, I believe, with a blade probably 8-10" long and a light colored handle. Captain Swindler is familiar with the above. Oh, the bike went with them, and the only impression about it'd disposal occurs in my notes a couple of times and states that it was tossed into a swampy small pond probably not too far from the body.

NASLUND:

bets Denise Naslund, I felt at first had been drowned intentionally, but before I finished working on this the body was found. After psychometrizing the bones I felt it was lack of air through strangulation. I feel they were making love when this occurred. Naslund was high on drugs and possibly somewhat intoxicated also, and willingly went along with the sex. Ted strangled her with his hands and I notice there is black looking dirt under his nails which seems out of character. I feel sure she was killed where she was found as I saw railroad tracts below a hill and this matches.

HINTS ON INTERPRETATION:

Psychic impressions such as these come from the subconscious of the psychic to the consciousness of said psychic. It will usually resemble a bad telephone connection in which solated phrases or words come through and one is trying thus to get the whole story. Logic is the psychic's worse ememy and you will probably find where I try to do this I am most apt to be wrong. Roger, you will remember the incident with your decoy duck: I would never have suggested you might have worn it as that sounds impossible except that I was so tired I didn't really think about what I was saying. I can also add here that an altered state of consciousness (such as relaxation) is obviously necessary to let the subconscious "take over". Another thing to watch out for is ESP between me and any of you fellows on the cases with preconceived ideas who were around me. Captain Swindler noticed this right off and did his best to avoid this type of influence. An example of this is when Det. Bob Kemple asked me if Naslund was wearing any rings and after thinking about it a minute or so I said yes and proceeded to describe 1 or 2 rings of an antique style. He cut in to tell me she was not wearing any but had owned 2 antique rings and for a while they thought she had indeed been wearing them. I asked then if he had been thinking about them when I was concentrating and he said yes. Also I pick up emotion and people, not numbers, names, ect. too much, and I seem to lose contact at death. Howev er, if I tend to emphasize a particular point it almost certainly has some significance, even though it may not be like I give it to you. Encouragement and optimism helps tremendously.

I called you about 15 minutes after Bundy's conviction but did not realize it. I knew of course, he was on trial for several things but really had not been watching that closely partly because I thought it was petty stuff and partly because of interest in something involving me personally that also

started last August. I am very pleased he will get a good deal of time it sounds like and get him off the streets. My interest in the Bundy case was really stirred last Friday by an article in the paper. I sincerely hope I have been of some help, and as we discussed on the phone I will go to the Taylor Mt. site for the 1st time in the next couple of weeks, and see what I get there, if anything. I will let you know any findings of significance.



Subject: A personage identical to Lake Sammamish Ted we have come upon in one of the three areas we have considered prime as a human-remains disposal site of the killer we have all long been seeking. And based upon his complete likeness to your latest composite sketch of "Ted" witnesses allegedly say is identical to the real him, and based upon the demeanor and reactions of the individual we met, we feel there is a good chance the person we herein mention is Lake Sammamish Ted.

In retrospect, we had studied multiple-murder types and their habits and felt that ultimately such a one as "Ted" would react as others of his sort had. And for a while we thought this was the circumstance: e.g., the various newspapers left at both the Issaquah and the Taylor Mountain sites, especially the one with Wiley Linder's photo. But seemingly nothing has transpired from all of this and whoever was leaving the items could have been a senseless joker. If we were fooled, we were fooled—but we aren't sorry we had followed through. Captain Mackey asked for help from the public in locating the individual and hearing how swamped by phone you people were, we gave you all the help we could in the field.

The third site we were drawn to was the Lake Desire area where a human leg (we remember hearing of it as that of a woman) was reportedly found some years back.

Nearby Shady Lake was where I came upon, on Wednesday May 19, 1976, at 1:45 P.M., this utterly remarkable likeness to your composite sketch of Lake Sammamish Ted, one previously of 149 51st Ave. S., Seattle, Washington 98168, his current address being in Tacoma (he states). He was parked at the Shady Lake Department of Game boat launching facilities and preparing to launch a boat. His car was a 1971 green Mazda station wagon with license plate BRH A boat trailer with a red boat numbered WN 66 was hitched to his vehicle.

In a conversation lasting over half an hour I gleaned quite a few things about him, but unless this is your man, my stating much here would be merely airing useless suspicions. Suffice it to say: on the topic of fishing large local lakes, subject blanched several times on the

mention of Lake Sammamish and each time changed the subject; our dogs were keenly interested in a strong scent coming from the back of his open station wagon, where there was a very large frosted-white plastic bag lying on its side full of something bulgy; and that individual stood in an arms-folded blocking position stopping me from approaching closer to his vehicle. I did nothing to arouse his suspicions of my interest in him and he doesn't know I acquired his auto and boat license numbers. We parted quite cordially.

If you lose the master copy of your composite sketch of Lake
Sammamish Ted, photographing will achieve you an exact
likeness. And also commuted between Seattle and his
job at Nalley's in Tacoma, a commuting similar to Ted Bundy's. Possibly
there is a tying together of these two men.

Detective Trent and myself arrived at the scene where the listed articles had been found. Approximately one-half hour later the crime lab arrived. The crime lab took all the items and made a complete check of the area. Measurements were not taken due to the extended length of the scene.

Ditchen stated he found the clothes at approximately 1115 on 10-8-75. The cloths were laying in the same position that they were presently in. After hearing that the head of a female had been found near by he returned to the 72nd St. scene. At this time he looked into the sack and saw the tampax. Leaving all items he had his daughter-in-law call this office. He further

The following evidence was collected on October 8, 1975 at the scene where the head was discovered and transported to the lab by the writer:

Item 26 - sweepings taken from the top of the bridge directly above the head and extending 10 feet in both directions. The sweepings include the debris along the western rail of the bridge and extending out toward the center line about 4 feet. Examination of the sweepings reveals a number of hairs which are retained for possible future comparisons.

Item 27 - a soil sample from the field where the head was located. This is saved for possible future comparisons.

Item 28 - a bottle cap from a Colt 45 bottle. Examination reveals
nothing of laboratory significance.

Item 29 - a paper match found 5 inches from the severed neck area. This is saved for possible future comparisons.

The following evidence was collected on October 8, 1975 at the Rigdon Funeral Home where the head was examined by Dr. Lium:

Item 30 - the wire loop for a pierced earring that was in the victim's right ear. There is no earring attached to the loop.

Item 31 - a hair sample from the victim's head to be used as a standard. The hair is slide mounted for future comparison.

Item 32 - a cotton swab taken from the victim's mouth. Examination fails to reveal the presence of any seminal fluid.

Item 33 - a green twisted strand of material made of many small fibers. This is 5/16 inch long and has the appearance of a strand from a short shag carpet. The strand is saved for possible future comparison.

The following evidence was collected on October 8, 1975 along 72nd Avenue approximately three-fourths of a mile south of Hazel-green Road by writer and transported to the lab:

Item 34 - a red plaid dress with the label Smart Time almost ripped out of the neck area. There is no size indicated. The dress shows moderate wear and is quite wrinkled. It has short sleeves and shows a small tear of the seam in the left armpit. There are five gold

Item 34 - (continued)

buttons down the front with only the top three having a corresponding buttonhole. The dress opens only to the third button and then is sewn closed from there to the bottom. There is a large pocket on the right side which is empty. Examination reveals nothing of laboratory significance.

Item 35 - a blue and gold plaid dress with no label or size indicated. The dress has long sleeves with a cuff and large brown button on the end of the sleeves. The dress has a number of stains and is quite wrinkled. There is a zipper running half way down the front. The pull ring on the zipper is quite corroded. There are no pockets. Examination reveals nothing of laboratory significance.

Item 36 - a brown paper sack containing a number of items not of laboratory significance. These items appear to be someone's garbage.

The writer believes the above three items are not connected with the crime.

The following items were received from Dr. Lium at 5 PM on October 8, 1975 in his office at the hospital and transported to the lab by the writer. These items have been labeled Jane Doe LA 118-75 by Dr. Lium as the victim was not identified at this time.

Item 37 - a plastic bag containing gastric contents. Examination reveals nothing of laboratory significance.

Item 38 - a plastic bag containing the distal portions of the left radius and ulna bones.

Item 39 - a plastic bag containing the proximal portions of the left radius and ulna bones.

Item 40 - a plastic bag containing the distal portion of the right femur.

Item 41 - a plastic bag containing the proximal portion of the right femur.

Item 42 - a plastic bag containing the first dorsal vertebra.

Item 43 - a plastic bag containing a portion of the liver. Examination of this fails to reveal the presence of a narcotic or dangerous drug.

On March 17, 1976 Richard Waterhouse appeared at the United States Courhhouse, Seattle, at which time the Marshals Office was contacted by the Receptionist, United States Attorney, because a mentally unstable person was present. Subsequent contact with Waterhouse developed the following:

He is WMA, born February 3, 1953 at Billings, Montana.

Brother:

Ray Waterhouse 1903 Lakeway Drive Bellingham, Washington

He is presently a transient enroute to California but without funds. He has a weapon in his car and frequently carries a weapon for which he had a permit. He is well known to the Bellingham Philice Department because of frequent encounters. He was previously in California and "psychic voices" told him four times to kill President Ford. As a result he was temporarily confined in a California Mental facility.

He has "solved" the "Ted"murders and the Zodiac killings. He furnished King County Sheriff's Office, Seattle, with information on both but they wouldn't listen. He acknowledged a strong resemblance to the composite drawings in the "Ted" murders. He discussed this with someone at the King County Department of Public Safety on March 17, 1976, as he was at that office prior to coming to the Federal Court House.

Regarding the Bundy case, Have you ever thought of checking with the two or three girls who were accosted by Bundy (or?) but either thru the mercy of God or their own intuition managed to escape the fate which awaited the others? Surely those girls could be of invaluable help in identifying the man. If only you would not publish all of your leads and findings but keep mum and work like - on the case you could solve it. Surely there must be enough facts that, if sifted thru with a fine tooth comb would yield a solution. Remember the old adage, "the mills of the Gods grind slowly but exceedingly fine".

I'm not personally involved in this case at all and do not even know the girl (Hawkins) or her parents, who was one of his victims and happened to be from Tacoma. But I do recall that a girl had met the man just minutes before he made away with Miss Hawkins and had told him that she had to run into the sorority house for just a minute * but would be right out again. She was in the same House that the Hawkins girl belonged to , Certainly she would be able to identify him.

Then there was another girl on an eastern Wash. campus (could have been Ellensburg or Cheney) who was accosted by him as he (with his arm in sling)asked her for help in picking up his books. When they arrived at his car, parked in a dark spot near a bldg, and he dropped his keys and asked her to pick them up fortunately something warned her in time and she took off in a hurry, so escaped the fate of the others. Surely this girl could help immeasurably.

It's a tough job, I know, but think of what a feather it will be in the cap of the one who has the grit, stamina and dogged determination to stick with it until he solves it. If we can get people of that calibre working on cases maybe we can get crime under control.

Take these suggestions for what they are worth. Perhaps my sending them to you was like grasping at a strw but it was all I could think of to do. I guess it was just an indication of how desperate many of us feel today. We want so much to help change conditions but know not where to begin nor what to do.
