BRENDA moved in about the first week in May and had paid up for the month of May. BRENDA's clothing and personal items are still at the apartment. When JANICE and SHARON got to Sun Lakes on Saturday, BRENDA did not show up.

SHARON stated that the bartender at the Flame Inn knew BRENDA and had seen her in the early morning hours on 6-1-74. She had asked MARK, a band member, for a ride home and he refused. BRENDA constantly hung out at the Flame. She would frequently get picked up by anyone at the Flame. She would drink beer and wine occasionally and was not known for using drugs. She would occasionally smoke pot. BRENDA was not employed and did not have much money.

3. 0950 Hrs: Talked with ROSMARY ARNOUD, mother of BRENDA, BRENDA normally would call her mother every day to talk. She thought if BRENDA was out of town she would have called collect. BRENDA has been gone for periods of time but has always called.
