SUMMARY OF EVENTS JULY 14 to SEPTEMBER 7

11:30 JANICE GRAHAM arrived at Lake Sammamish State Park at 11:30 hours.

GRAHAM is 5'6½" tall, weighs 120 pounds, 22 years old, long blonde hair parted in the middle below shoulder length. She was wearing a halter type dress, very short, backless, green in color. Also she had on photogray glasses and wedding rings.

GRAHAM looked around a short while for a picnic table. There were none available so she went to the bandstand area to watch races sponsored by the Rainier Brewery. A strange male approached her and said, "Hello". She said, "Hello" back. She kind of moved away at this time. He asked her if she could help him for a minute. She said, "Yeah, what do you want?" He said he wanted to load his sailboat on his car. She told him, "Sure."

GRAHAM describes him as a white male, 5'8" to 5'10", 150-160 pounds, 25 years old, sandy blonde hair, short on sides, longer in back. He was wearing a white t-shirt with red trim (neckline was crew type) with short sleeves and blue jeans (possibly long length). She did not notice his shoes.

She and the stranger walked up to the parking lot between the bandstand and the restrooms. He asked her what she was doing. She told him she was waiting for her husband and parents. He said, "This is out of sight; there are so many people." He stopped three times during the walk to the parking lot to hold his arm against his body as if it was hurting. His left arm was in a beige sling with no cast. He said he hurt his arm playing racket ball. He asked her if she had ever played it; that it was a lot of fun. He asked if she lived around here. She said, "Bellevue", and that she worked at Boeing.

They approached a newish looking Volkswagon bug, metallic brown in color. GRAHAM did not see a sailboat so she asked where it was. He said, "It's at ^{MY} ~~his~~ folks house; it's just up the hill." He had motioned to the passenger side door as if to open the door for GRAHAM. GRAHAM told him that she could not go because she had to meet her folks. She asked him what time it was and he replied it was 12:20. She told him she was already late because she was to meet them at 12:15. He said, "Oh, that's OK. I should have told you if wasn't in the parking lot. He said, "Thanks for bothering to come up to the car." He walked GRAHAM about halfway back up toward the park. He said, "Thanks for coming with me. I should have told you it was not in the parking lot." He walked towards the bandstand.

12:00 Approximately 1200 to 1215 hours, JANICE OTT arrived at the park beach.

GRAHAM characterized him as very polite at all times, very sincere, easy to talk to. He kept up a continual conversation. He was friendly, nice smile and did not get upset when she told him she wouldn't go with him.

12:30 At about 12:30 hours, SYLVIA VALINT was laying on the beach at the park with her two friends. JERRY SNYDER was about 15 feet from VALINT with his wife. THERESA SHARP was with her family about 10 feet from VALINT. They were all on the beach about 200 yards directly in front of the east restroom.

The above three witnesses all observed JANICE OTT arrive on the beach and position herself between them. VALINT was the closest to OTT; about two feet away. JANICE OTT is described as five feet tall, 100 pounds, long blonde hair straight to the middle of her back. She was

wearing very short levi cutoffs, an offwhite, possibly yellow midriff shirt. She had with her a yellow girl's 10-speed bicycle. She took off her clothes and had on a black bikini. She laid down a plain white towel and laid down. She had with her a dark blue knapsack. She took out some cocoabutter, the type that comes in a small orange jar.

Subsequent investigation revealed the bicycle to be a Tiger brand, 10-speed, girls model, yellow, racing type handlebars wrapped with black vinyl, dual control handbrakes, narrow seat covered with quilted black vinyl, possible serial number P=290 stamped on bottom of crankcase or right side of vertical bar extending from crankcase to seat, tires are 27" x 1½" gumwall mounted on chrome rims and no fenders.

Subsequent investigation revealed the knapsack to be blue in color, canvas, two shoulder straps, waist strap, front pouch as well as the main pouch, and the flaps are tied shut; no metal fasteners.

OTT had been laying on the beach for about a half hour when a white male came up to her and said, "Excuse me, could you help me put my sailboat onto my car?" He said, "I can't do it by myself because I broke my arm."

The conversation between OTT and the suspect was probably more closely heard by VALINT due to her close proximity. SNYDER and SHARP readily admitted they only heard portions of the conversation.

OTT told the suspect to sit down and said, "Let's talk about it." He said, "It's up at my parent's house in Issaquah." OTT said, "Oh, really. I live up in Issaquah. Well, OK."

SHARP heard OTT say she did not know how to sail and the suspect said, "It will be easy for me to teach you." She asked if there was room in the car for her bike and he said, "It will fit in the trunk."

OTT put her cutoffs and shirt on. VALINT heard OTT say, "Under one condition; that I get a ride in the sailboat." He said, "My car is in the parking lot." OTT said, "Well, I get to meet your parents then." As they were walking towards the parking lot, VALINT heard him ask who she knew in Issaquah.

As OTT and the suspect were talking on the beach, VALINT heard OTT introduce herself as JAN and the suspect said his name was TED.

VALINT and SHARP thought he had a slight english accent although SNYDER did not notice an accent. All three witnesses observed that the suspect had on a beige sling. VALINT thought he also had on a cast. SHARP noticed that he took his arm out of the sling when he was talking to OTT and there was no cast.

TED
A consensus of opinion from VALINT, SHARP. and SNYDER described the suspect as 5'8" to 5'10", medium build, blondish brown hair, wavy down to the back of his neck, tanned skin. The suspect was wearing white tennis shorts, white t-shirt, white socks, and white tennis shoes.

OTT and the suspect talked on the beach for about 10 minutes.

12:30 At about 12:30 hours, JANICE GRAHAM observed the same man who approached her walking towards the parking lot with a girl who had a yellow bicycle. GRAHAM thought the bike was a 10-speed because of the curved handlebars. GRAHAM did not know where he was going to put the bike. GRAHAM met her folks at 12:45.

13:00 At about 1:00 PM, DENISE NASLUND, KEN LITTLE, BOB SARGENT, and NANCY BATTEMA arrived together at the park. They set up about 200 feet in front of the restroom near the end of the parking area. DENISE NASLUND is 18 years old, 5'4", 110 pounds, long dark brown hair parted in the middle. DENISE was wearing faded blue cutoff levis and a dark blue halter top. She also had two rings on each hand. One ring is a large

blue stone on platinum. The second ring was a very large black onyx. She had a small metal band on her little finger. The fourth ring is unknown. She wore a gold watch with chain clasp, ladies style. Throughout the afternoon, the NASLUND group laid on the grass and watched games that were being played.

15:00 At approximately 3:00 PM, PATRICIA TURNER and her friends arrived at the park. TURNER is 18 years old, 5'2", 108 pounds, long brown hair parted in the middle. She was wearing a black flowered halter top tied in the back and long blue levis. She was also wearing rings and pierced earrings.

16:00 At about 4:00 PM, SINDI SIEBENBAUM was at the park. SIEBENBAUM is 5'6" tall, 120 pounds, 16 years old, long golden brown hair. She was walking back from the restroom about 100 yards from the restroom, when a man who was walking towards her said, "Excuse me, young lady, could you help me launch my sailboat?" She asked him what he had done to his arm. He said he sprained it and could not find anyone to help him. She told him that she was sorry, but she could not help him because she had people waiting. He said the boat was up the beach and that it would only take a few minutes. It appeared to SIEBENBAUM that the guy meant the sailboat was up towards the restroom since he pointed with his hurt elbow. She again told him that she could not help. The suspect kept on asking and tugged on SIEBENBAUMS'S arm. SIEBENBAUM finally just told him she was sorry and left.

SIEBENBAUM described the man as a white male, 5'10" to 6' tall, skinny, suntan, in his late twenties, sandy brown colored hair, parted in the middle, bangs over his forehead, 2" below his ears, clean shaven. He was wearing sort of bleached white boxer swimming suit with elastic band waist and his left arm was in a sling. He had sort of a pointed

nose and thin lips. SIEBENBAUM got the impression he was nervous because he spoke rapidly and gestured with his hand. She described his eyes a bug-eyed, set back, and small pupils. His shirt was long sleeved, left arm rolled up, in sling, faded light green, unbuttoned.

16:15 At about 4:15 PM, TURNER was not feeling good so she walked along the sidewalk to the concession stand. She was approached by a man that had a sling on his left arm. He said, "I normally wouldn't ask this favor, but my brother is busy and unable to help." He sort of pointed in the direction of the parking lot with his elbow. TURNER told him she was sorry and in a hurry to go. He said, "That's OK." She did not notice an accent. He stood for a few seconds and then walked away.

At about 4:00 PM, BOB SARGENT had returned to the NASLUND group with hot dogs. All had hotdogs and potato chips. KEN and BOB fell asleep. DENISE had taken about 4 valium when she got to the park. DENISE mentioned to NANCY BATTEMA that she was feeling high. The NASLUND group had come to the park in DENISE'S car and DENISE had left her purse and personal items in the trunk of her car. NANCY asked DENISE

16:20 what time it was. DENISE either answered 20 after 4 or 4:30. After
:30 a few minutes, DENISE got up without saying anything and walked straight

towards the restroom. NANCY BATTEMA was the last person DENISE knew to see DENISE NASLUND alive.

16:30 Sometime between 3:30 and 4:30, BETTY BARRY, a Seattle Police employee, claimed to have seen DENISE NASLUND in the restroom. NASLUND was talking in the restroom to another girl who was wearing a knit maroon bikini top. The two girls walked out of the restroom together.

17:00 At about 5:00 PM, JACQUELINE PLISCHKE arrived at the park on her bicycle. PLISCHKE is 20 years old, 5'4", 108 pounds, long blonde hair. PLISCHKE was wearing a very brief pink bikini top and short blue jean cutoffs.

PLISCHKE was at the park for about 20 minutes. She had gone to the point in the park where people waterski from. She observed a man who was watching her. She described the man in his early twenties, 5'8" tall, medium build, dark blonde hair, hair length was to the middle of his ear, beige sling on his left arm, the sling was not neat. She could not remember what he was wearing.

PLISCHKE came back along the path and the man approached her near the corner of the beach. The man said to her, "Hello, I was wondering if you could help me put my sailboat on my car." She said, "I'm not very strong." He said, "It's better that I asked someone who was alone." She told him she was waiting for someone. He then seemed to not have any interest in her. He said, "Oh, I see." He then turned away and walked towards the bathhouse.

PLISCHKE felt that the man talked smoothly, talked clearly, used no slang words, everything was very distinct.

Throughout the day of July 14, the weather was clear, hot, and sunny. The temperature was in the 90's through the afternoon. It was estimated that there were 40,000 people at the park. The main event at the park

was the Rainier Brewery picnic. The Brewery sponsored numerous races and contests for the public-

LOCATION
On September 7, two hunters were hunting in the Issaquah area when one of them found a human skull and what appeared to be a spinal column with portions of ribs attached. Subsequent investigation revealed that human remains belonging to three (3) people were scattered over an area of approximately 130,000 square feet. The remains, consisting of hair, decayed flesh, and bones, was scattered by animals. The area is covered with very dense foilage and undergrowth. It is located 4.4 miles east from Lake Sammamish which takes 12 minutes to drive. The remains were 300 feet north of I-90, a location that was accessible by a logging road.

A skull was identified as belonging to DENISE NASLUND and a mandible was identified as belonging to JANICE OTT. The third person hasn't been identified as there was only four (4) lumbar vertebra found belonging to that person.




SUMMARY OF EVENTS JULY 14 and SEPTEMBER 7

Mary arrived at Lake Sammamish State Park at 11:30 a.m. Mary is 5'6½" tall, weighs 120 pounds, 22 years old, long blonde hair parted in the middle below shoulder length. She was wearing a halter type dress, very short, backless, green in color. Also she had on photogray glasses and wedding rings.

Mary looked around a short while for a picnic table. There was none available so she went to the bandstand area to watch races sponsored by the Rainier Brewery. A strange male approached her and said: "Hello." She said, "Hello" back. She kind of moved away at this time. He asked her if she could help him for a minute. She said: "Yeah, what do you want?" He said he wanted to load his sailboat on his car. She told him: "Sure."

Mary describes him as a white male, 5'8" to 5'10" ; 150-160 pounds, 25 years old, sandy blonde hair, short on sides, longer in back. He was wearing a white t-shirt with red trim (neckline was crew type) with short sleeves and blue jeans (possibly long length.) She did not notice his shoes.

She and the stranger walked up to the parking lot between the bandstand and the restrooms. He asked her what she was doing. She told him she was waiting for her husband and parents. He said.: "This is out of sight; there are so many people." He stopped three times during the walk to the parking lot to hold his arm against his body as if it were hurting. His left arm was in a beige sling with no cast. He said he hurt his arm playing racket ball. He asked her if she had ever played it, and said it was a lot of fun. He asked if she lived around there. She said: "Bellevue," and that she worked at Boeing. They approached a

newish looking Volkswagen bug, metallic brown in color. Mary did not see a sailboat so she asked where it was. He said: "It's at my folks' house; it's just up the hill." He had motioned to the passenger side door as if to open the door for her. Mary told him that she could not go because she had to meet her folks. She asked him what time it was and he replied it was 12:20. She told him she was already late because she was to meet them at 12:15. He said: "Oh, that's OK." "I should have told you it wasn't in the parking lot." He said: "Thanks for bothering to come up to the car." He walked Mary about half way back up toward the park. He said: "Thanks for coming with me." "I should have told you it was not in the parking lot." He walked towards the bandstand.

Approximately 1200 to 1215 hours, Janice Ott arrived at the park beach.

Mary characterized him as very polite at all times, very sincere, easy to talk to. He kept up a continual conversation. He was friendly, nice smile and did not get upset when she told him she wouldn't go with him.

At about 1230 hours, Jane was lying on the beach at the park with her two friends. John was about 15 feet away from Jane, with his wife. Sue was with her family about 10 feet from Jane. They were all on the beach about 200 yards directly in front of the east restroom.

The above three witnesses all observed Janice Ott arrive on the beach and position herself between them. Jane was the closest to Ott, about two feet away. At about 4:15 p.m. Diane was not feeling good so she walked along the sidewalk to the concession stand. She was approached by a man who had a sling on his left arm. The sling was bleached white and clean. Diane described the man as about 5'8" tall, 160 pounds, well built, hair was dishwater blonde, neck length, and cut in a shag, about 25 years old. His hair was parted in the middle and messy. Diane thought he was a good looking man. The man was wearing white shorts, white t-shirt, and white tennis shoes.

As Diane walked to the concession stand, the man followed her. He talked to her on the sidewalk. He said: "I need to ask a really big favor of you." He asked her to help him launch his sailboat. He said: "I normally wouldn't ask this favor, but my brother is busy and unable to help." He sort of pointed in the direction of the parking lot with his elbow. Diane told him she was sorry and in a hurry to go. He said: "That's OK." She did not notice an accent. He stood for a few seconds and then walked away.

At about 4:00 p.m. Bob Sargent had returned to the Naslund group with hot dogs. All had hot dogs and potato chips. Ken and Bob fell asleep. Denise had taken about 4 valium when she got to the park. Denise mentioned to Nancy Battema that she was feeling high. The Naslund group had come to the park in Denise's car and Denise had left her purse and personal items in the trunk of her car. Nancy asked Denise what time it was. Denise either answered 20 after 4 or 4:30. After a few minutes, Denise got up without saying anything and walked straight towards the restroom. Nancy Battema was the last person Denise knew to see Denise Naslund alive.

Sometime between 3:30 and 4:30, Ruth, A Seattle Police employee, claimed to have seen Denise Naslund in the restroom. Naslund was

talking in the restroom to another girl who was wearing a knit maroon bikini top. The two girls walked out of the restroom together. AT about 5:00 p.m. Kathy arrived at the park on her bicycle. Kathy is 20 years old, 5'4", 108 pounds, long blonde hair. Kathy was wearing a very brief pink bikini top and short blue jean cutoffs.

Kathy was at the park for about 20 minutes. She had gone to the point in the park where people waterski from. She observed a man who was watching her. She described the man in his early twenties, 5'8" tall, medium build, dark blonde hair, hair length was to the middle of his ear, beige sling on his left arm, the sling was not neat. She could not remember what he was wearing.

Kathy came back along the path and the man approached her near the corner of the beach. The man said to her: "Hello, I was wondering if you could help me put my sailboat on my car." She said: "I'm not very strong." He said: "It's better that I asked someone who was alone." She told him she was waiting for someone. He then seemed to not have any interest in her. He said: "Oh, I see." He then turned away and walked towards the bathhouse.

Kathy felt that the man talked smooth, talked clear, used no slang words, everything was very distinct.

Throughout the day of July 14, the weather was clear, hot, and sunny. The temperature was in the 90s throughout the afternoon. It was estimated that there were 40,000 people at the park. The main event at the park was the Rainier Brewery picnic. The Brewery sponsored numerous races and contests for the public.

On September 7, two hunters were hunting in the Issaquah area when one of them found a human skull and what appeared to be a spinal column with portions of ribs attached. Subsequent investigation revealed that

human remains belonging to three (3) people were scattered over an area of approximately 130,000 square feet. The remains, consisting of hair, decayed flesh, and bones were scattered by animals. The area is covered with very dense foilage and undergrowth. It is located 4.4 miles east from Lake Samammish which takes 12 minutes to drive. The remains were 300 feet north of I-90, a location that was accessible by a logging road.

A skull was identified as belonging to Denise Naslund and a mandible was identified as belonging to Janice Ott. The third person has not been identified as there were only four (4) lumbar vertebrae found belonging to that person.

ISSAQUAH DUMP SITE

The location where OTT and NASLUND were found is 4 miles east of Lake Sammamish State Park on Interstate 90. It is on the north side and access to the north side is by the old abandoned Sunset Highway; a median prevents a left turn when eastbound. The corridor along the highway has been condemned for highway expansion and all homes near the site were vacant. There is a small gravel road which leads north uphill from "old Sunset Highway" and across an abandoned railroad line.

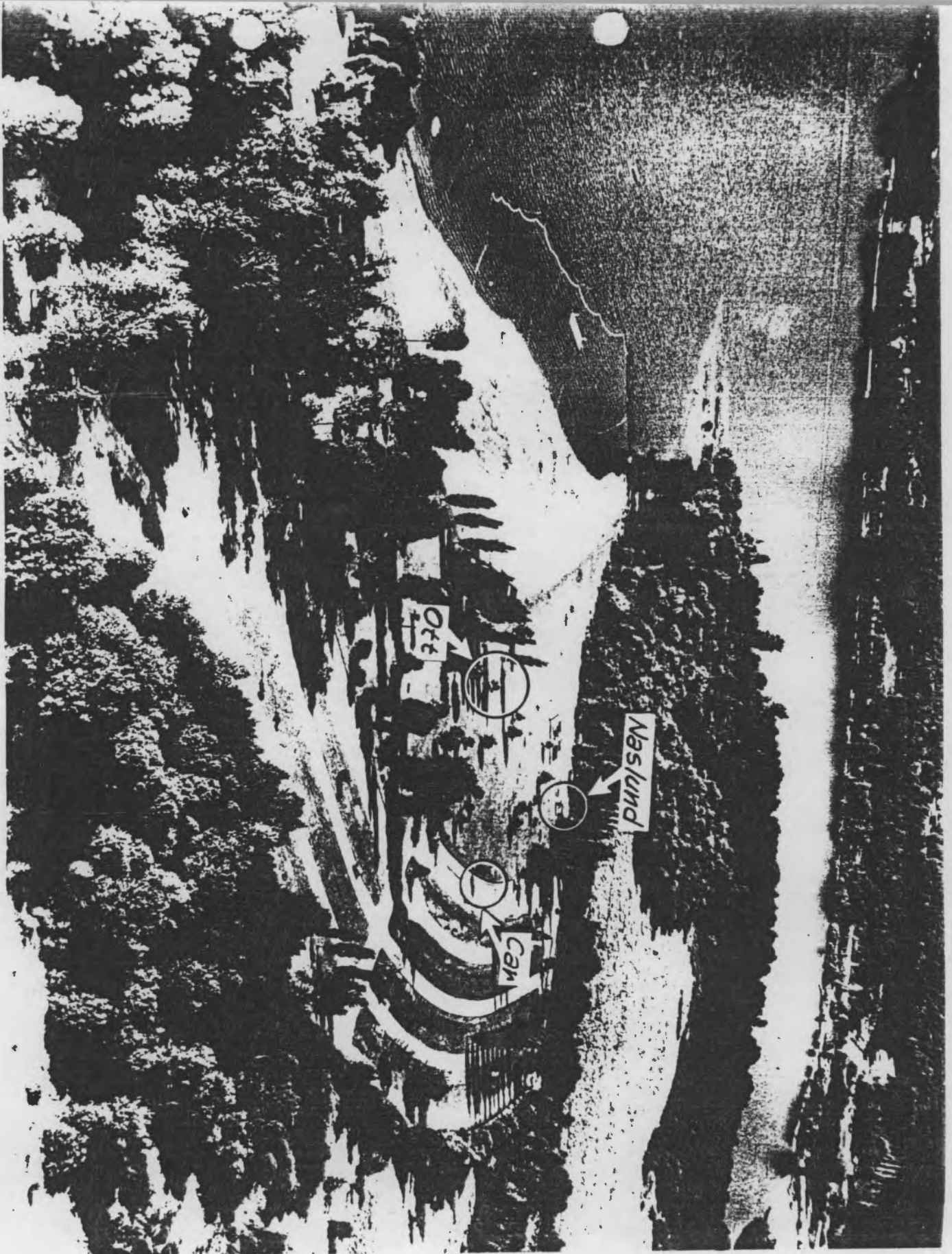
When they were dumped, the stinging nettles and underbrush were very thick, but a vehicle could drive back into the brush to within 40' of where the characteristic grease spots were found. There was a third set of bones found at the site but no skull or mandible was found which could provide identification. There were two grease spots within driving distance with blond hair nearby. There was another grease spot a little farther uphill near NASLUND's skull and mandible.

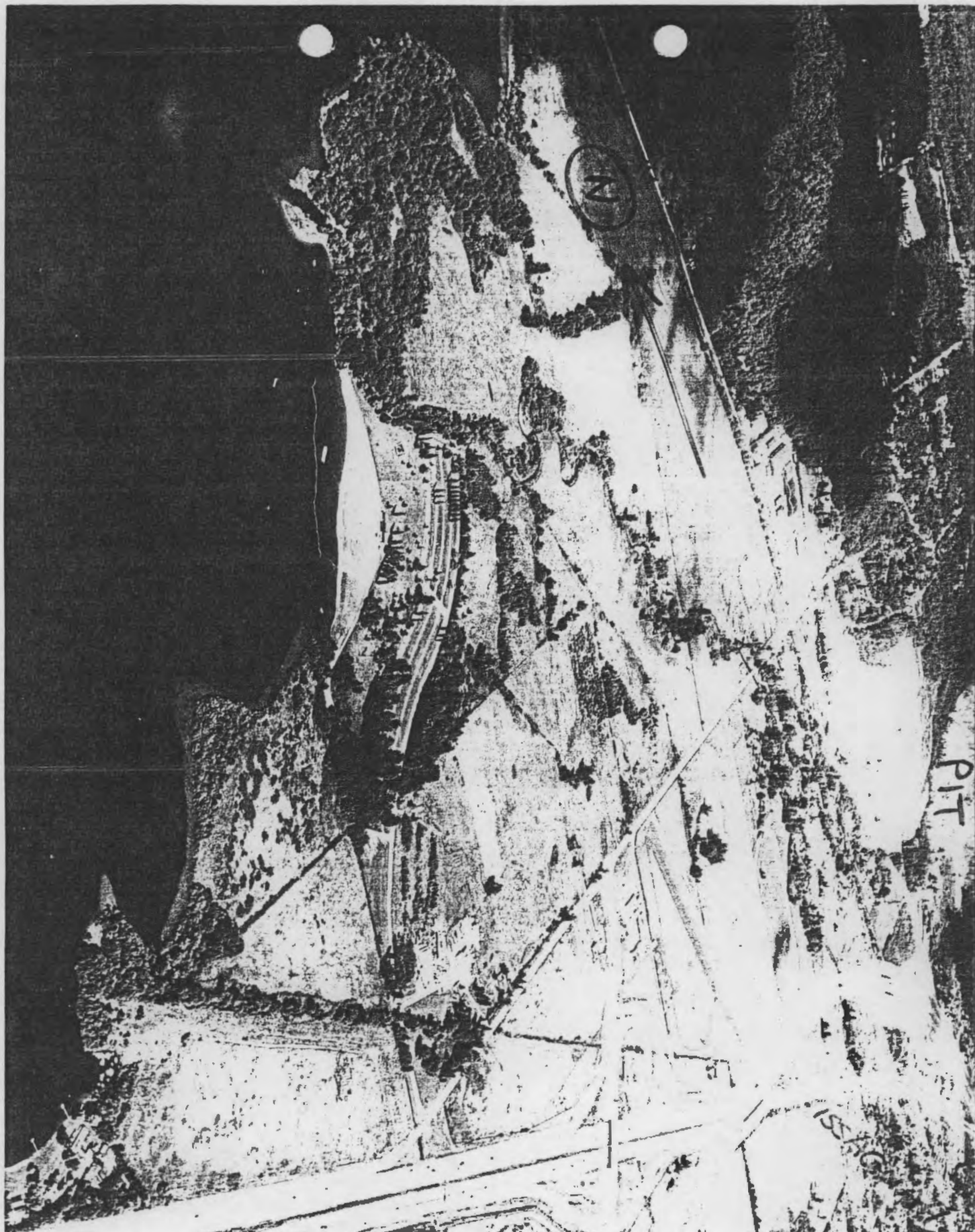
The skeletons were badly scattered by animals and no evidence of trauma, dismemberment or assault could be detected. There was no clothing, jewelry, or other personal effects near the scene. In a mile radius of the site several articles of women's undergarments were found but none belonged to any of the known victims. No occult or witchcraft symbols were found near the scene.

The victims were probably killed elsewhere and dumped at this location shortly after their disappearance. They were found 55 days after their disappearance. An extensive search was made in the area but the skull of OTT is still missing as are the skull and mandible of the third person. The two possible victims for the third set of bones would be Georgann HAWKINS and Donna MANSON.

A large quantity of immature elk bones were found 1/4 mile east of the scene on "Sunset Highway." These bones were bagged in burlap gunny sacks and bound with twine. On October 16, 1974, a citizen found a porno book near the scene. It described an incident of "TED" luring "teaser" type girls to his parent's house on the hill so he could seduce them. These victims were short with long hair parted in the middle and wearing tight levis or ski pants.

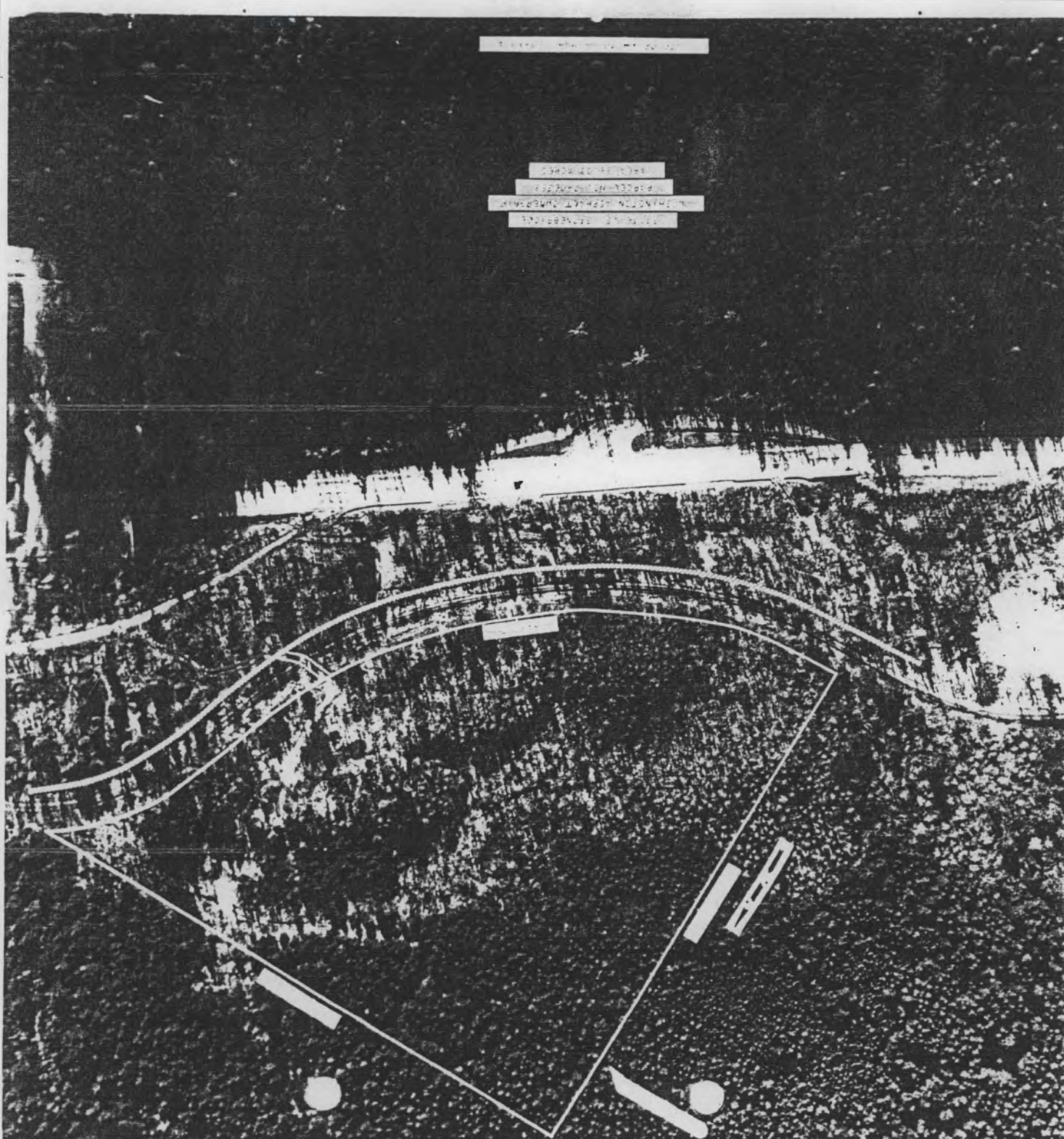

TAYLOR MOUNTAIN DUMP SITE

The Taylor Mountain site is four miles south of Interstate 90 on the south side of Highway #18. It is a remote area and the property is adjacent to a power transmission tower line.

The skulls and/or mandibles of HEALY, RANCOURT, PARKS, and BALL were found at this location. There were several other bones found at this location but they were all non-human. This gave rise to the theory that the girls had been decapitated, however, no cervical vertebrae were found in the search. Animals in the area include coyotes, bears, and rodents, but the possibility of their consuming all bones of the body is slim.

The area at all times of the year is very brushy and would be extremely dense during June when BALL disappeared. The killer could have dumped the bodies in an area of evergreens nearby where there is less underbrush but no grease spots were found in this area either. No clothing, weapons, jewelry, or occult symbols were found at the scene.

The nearest homes to this site are 5 miles away but trailbike riders and hunters are usually in the vicinity on weekends. This site is 7.7 miles S.E. of the Issaquah site and 11 road miles.

"TED"

A witness lying next to Janice Ott on the beach saw a white male approach Ott. After a few pleasantries were exchanged Ott introduced herself as "Jan" and our witness heard the male say his name was "TED." This 15 year old witness is the only one who heard a name from the suspect.

When he contacted other girls with his ruse at Lake Sammamish State Park he did not mention his name. Witnesses' descriptions vary slightly but are consistent for the most part. His line varies slightly from witness to witness but remained basically the same. His demeanor was always polite and courteous, and his dress and appearance were clean.

Two separate incidents at Central Washington State College in April 1974 also involved an individual approaching girls and using a ruse to gain sympathy. This individual was described as grubbily dressed and somewhat hippy looking. Again his demeanor was polite and he wasn't pushy or discourteous. Both witnesses walked to a car with him. One described it as a ^{yellow} VW bug with a black interior and the passenger seat was missing. The other witnesses also said it was a Volkswagen but it was too dark to note the color. Both of these incidents occurred near the campus library and the second was only two hours before Rancourt disappeared. No names were exchanged between the witnesses.

The Central Washington State College incidents were not reported until the Lake Sammamish incident was extensively reported through written and electronic media.

Another possible "TED" incident in connection with our victims' disappearances is another late report by a barmaid at the tavern where Brenda Ball was last seen. The barmaid said that a guy who looked like the composite drawing with his left arm in a sling first tried to hustle her; and then picked up Ball and she saw them leaving the tavern at closing time on 6/1/74. The barmaid described his demeanor as obnoxious. He was loud, boisterous, and pushy.

One witness at Lake Sammamish State Park walked to the parking lot with "TED" and he stood by a metallic brown Volkswagen bug but did not get in or unlock it. There was nothing else noticed which was distinctive about this VW by the witness.

There is no other known connection to a "TED" type individual with any of the other victims. There is no direct evidence to link him to any of the deaths.

Psychiatrists and psychologists have tried to develop a profile of "TED" but with such limited data it is very difficult. There is no known cause of death or indication of mutilation on any of the victims which could give us insight into his personality.

His actions and demeanor tend to categorize him as a sociopath and it is fair to say he is also a sexual psychopath.

ANTISOCIAL PERSONALITY OR SOCIOPATH:

1. Shoot someone just for the hell of it.
2. No emotion; very controlled.
3. It is not known what they do with emotion.
4. Very calm.
5. Billy the Kid; fun to be around; exciting; people like him.

6. Inadequate personality - not interacting with others.
7. Drug addicts more psychopathic than alcoholics; very self-centered; somebody's fault for their drug usage.
8. The theory of moral insanity.
 - a. No ethics or morality in sociopath - no remorse.
 - b. Lack of conscience.
9. Knows the difference between right and wrong but doesn't care.
10. Most psychopaths are children of psychopaths.
11. Freud would say he doesn't have a super-ego - "I want it, I'll get it." Has no conscience.
12. Characteristics of Sociopath
 - a. Inability to establish warm personal relations with others; friendly but no depth. Emotionally a loner - "I don't give a damn about anyone but me."
 - b. Disregard for community or group standards of behavior. Knows the law but doesn't care. Laws for everyone else but him.
 - c. Apparent absence of guilt feelings - nothing bothers him.
 - d. Failure to learn by punishment. Goes to prison and learns what he must do to do better next time.
 - e. Desire for immediate satisfaction; impulsive; try to take what they want; treasurer of mental inst. parties.
 - f. Continued sexual experimentation--if married, he's out chasing around; he may feel his home is falling apart, and lies to his wife to have him stay.
 - g. Undue dependence on others; like a sadist. Be nice to people on the way up to promotion, because these are the same fold you'll be with on the way down.

- h. Usually an extrover - uses relationships to his own advantage.

In summary: We know very little about our death investigations and have recovered no clothing or personal property. We know very little about "TED" and in fact "TED" may not be the killer, but someone who just hustled girls. We have checked out over 2,400 possible suspects and over 900 vehicles. We still have several suspects that can't be eliminated on various means.

We have compiled some cases from various jurisdictions going back to 1969. A great percentage of these victims was hitchhiking but none of ours were at the time they disappeared. Most of the girls were nude and transported away from the crime scene and dumped. None of the California victims is attributed to "ZODIAC." Most of the cases are unsettled with very little physical evidence.
