"The whole trial was basically on me. I felt." she said. "They said very little about the man."

Susan, not her real name. added, "The defense lawyer asked me do I wear a bra, do I have any see-through blouses, how many cigarettes I smoke, did I have an orgasm while I was raped, did I enjoy being raped?"

Defendant Acquitted

The jury acquitted the accused rapist, and Susan said he now is facing trial for another rape, an attack that occurred while he was free on his own recognizance before going to trial in Susan's case.

Susan agreed to testify before the House Judiciary Committee Wednesday only if she could remain anonymous.

The all-male panel is consi-

state law to prohibit the introduction of evidence in court about a rape victim's past sexual encounters or her genchastity.

The changes have drawn the support of women's groups, police spokesmen and prosecutors as a means of protecting rape victims from courtroom questioning that preclude many rape victims from reporting an assault.

Killings Reported ..

Susan said her assailant "told me he had killed four girls and raped them all. He told me he was going to kill me. I didn't know what to do except try to talk him out of

A-small, pretty woman in her early 20s, Susan said her attacker would be convicted now if the jury in her case had not been influenced by her character.

"I don't feel he would have gotten off if they hadn't delved into my past, humiliated me, embarrassed me," she

She said her rape took place after a chance meeting with a strange man at a tavern she had gone to with a girl friend. She said that after she agreed to drive him home, he ordered her to a secluded place and then assaulted her three times over a four-hour period.

She said she finally managed to get free and notified

twice before I would go through (a trial) again," Susan told the committee.

State Rep. Vera Katz of Portland told the committee, "I think it is fair to conclude that present rape laws protect male interests and that, in most cases, the rape victim finds herself standing trial with the accused.

Trial "Pain" Noted

"The pain and humiliation during the trial is far greater for the woman than the rape attack itself."

She also said laws that per-"If this happened to me mit questioning about a rape

ence and moral character are that she has ensented to sexbased on myths that exist about rape - that women enjoy being raped, that they provoke rape through their dress and manner, that women with frequent sexual contacts are more likely to consent to intercourse with a rapist than chaste women.

"A man's previous rape conviction may not be used unless he takes the stand," she said. "In other words, legally, a man's previous sexual attacks or relationships are of no relevance to his credibility, but once a woman has had sexual rleations with one man,

ual relations with all men."

of the cap and Officer Kulju placed it into the Property Room. He also brought two ashtrays, which the suspect had handled, which still contained burnt cigarettes. The ashtrays were dusted for prints by ID with negative results and they were returned to the victim.

A taped interview was conducted with the victim and sitting in on the interview was Rape Advocate Marga Sarriugarte.

stated that at approximately 1:45PM, on 1-3-75, she had a flat tire on her way to downtown and that a car, which she describes as being an old auto, possibly being maroon in color, which contained two male subjects and a girl, approximately four years of age, had stopped and had assisted her to a service station where she had been told that it would be some time before they would be able to repair the flat and that at this time, the two subjects and the little girl drove her to her home. Upon arriving at her home, the two male subjects and the little girl came into the house. She described the driver of the car as being approximately twenty five years of age, having dark skin, and she believed that he could be Mexican and that she also believed that the little girl, who was according to her, white, was the daughter of the dark skinned subject. She stated that she only recalled the name of the second subject, this being the suspect in this case, and that he had told her that his name was MISS stated that they had only stayed in the house a few minutes. and had left. Since that time, she stated, she has been receiving phone calls from this subject, She stated that she had not given him her phone number, that he had, apparently, copied the number stated that the phone calls were not obscene down himself and she had not noticed this. MISS but that he had wanted to go out with her and that he had wanted to come over to see her, but she stated that she had always put him off.

MISS stated that on 1-8-75, at approximately 9:30PM, this subject, had come to her house and she did let him in and that he had stayed approximately a half hour and that he had made several advances towards her, attempting to kiss her, he had tried to embrace her, but she stated that she didn't need anything like this and that she did have a boyfriend. did not know where the knife was and that while he was committing sodomy on her, that he had one of his hands around her throat. She stated that he had performed oral sodomy on her for approximately twenty minutes. MISS stated that she pleaded with him, as she did not care for this, and he would stop and talk to her for awhile and then would start to commit sodomy on her again. She stated that he did commit oral sodomy on her three times and that he had also attempted to have normal sexual intercourse with her three times also, but that he had never penetrated her completely. Had only but in a small portion of his penis into her and with her pleading and squirming, he would remove his penis and continue to commit sodomy on her.

stated that there weren't any lights on in the bedroom, but that after the first oral sodomy, the suspect had lit a candle, which is on a night stand next to the bed. Writer, upon hearing this, recalled having another rape-sodomy case where the arrested subject worked at Rose's Restaurant and. at this time, writer showed MISS a group of throw down mugs, these consisted of PPD 60254, PPD 54334, PPD 56491, PPD 54638, PPD 54834, PPD 57791, and PPD 52567. MISS viewed these mug shots and upon coming to PPD 52567, this being she immediately stated that this was the subject that assisted her with the flat tire, that had come to the house previously and the subject that had assaulted her. complete penetration into her, she was not taken to Holladay Park Hospital.

stated that she was very nervous and shaking her entire body and pleading with the suspect not to harm her. She informed him that he must be crazy for doing things like this and he, at this time, asked her if he could help her if she wanted to take a bath and she stated that she would be alright, once he had left. He, at this time, did dress and left by the front door. She was asked how the subject had got into her house and she stated that her front door does not lock. to kill her she leaped from the van and ran, naked, toward the nearest houses she could see.

She banged on the door of 3606 SE 16th until the occupant answered and admitted her. The

MISS stated that during this time she was screaming and attempting to nis fight the suspect off; however, she was not successful in keeping him away from her. She stated that he several times put his hands around her throat and did squeeze fairly hard. Suspect kept telling her that if she did not keep quiet, that he would kill her. MISS stated that she was very frightened and several times, attempted to talk him out of committing rape on her. stated that he did have intercourse with her four times, but does not believe that he reached a climax and that, at one point, he wanted her to commit oral sodomy on him. She stated that while she was lying onthe floor, he had her head between his knees and did insert his penis into her mouth and kept telling her to "suck me". She stated that she started to get sick and at this point, he committional sodomy on him. stated that they were in the van for approximately four hours, this being from 1:00AM to 5:00Am and that when the suspect was not having intercourse with her, he was just lying next to her and that they would just be talking. She stated that she tried to tell him that she would be his friend and that she would help him. She stated that she did tell him that he must be sick at doing something like this and he informed her that he realized that he was and that he needed help. At one point, he told her that he had committed rape on four other girls and that he had killed them. While in the back of the van, the suspect had pointed to a railroad pedestrian overpass which is between Lafayette and Rine on 18 and had told her that he had committed rape on the girls and after he had done so, had thrown her off this overpass. It should be noted that there is no report of any body being found on the railroad tracks at this location.

stated that the suspect had gone through the rear of the van looking in cabinets and drawers and in one of the drawers, he had located three \$20 bills and two \$10 bills, this money belonging to s girlfriend, ANITA WEATHERFORD. She stated that he had this money in his hand, that she had taken it away from him and had put it back into the drawer.

At one point, MISS told the suspect that she had to relieve herself and both he and she went out of the van. She stated that he held onto her and that both had relieved themselves and then had forced the victim to get into the van again. Stated that she went to two homes and knocked on the doors, but did not receive any answer. These were 3524 SE 16 and 3534 SE 16. After knocking on the second

house, she stated that she was walking back towards Lafayette Street when she noted a man and that this man assisted her. She stated that she was in the nude and that the man who lives at 3606 SE 16 had taken her up onto the porch, but that his door was locked and that he rang the bell and while they were still on the porch, the suspect walked up onto the lawn and stated 'you might as well take your pants and get your own way home". The suspect was last seen at this time.

Writer contacted the occupant of 3606 SE 16 and this is LAREN L. WELDON, who stated that he was asleep in his camper as they had visitors and that at approximately 5:00 AM this date, he heard screaming and someone asked him for help, that he had gotten out of his bunk and seen a nude female running west on Lafayette Street. MR. WELDON stated that, upon seeing this nude female running on Lafayette St., he ha-d gotten dressed and, as he was getting out of his camper, he noted that this female was coming towards him, this being after she had knocked at the two houses, and at this time, he took her to his home and finding the front door locked, had rang the bell and while they were waiting for someone in the house to open the door, that a male subject came up onto the lawn and had thrown the pants onto the porch. MR. WELDON stated that he could not describe the subject other than to say that he had bushy hair, he stated . that he could not see him very well as it was still quite dark. MR. WELDON stated that his mother-in-law gave MISS a bathrobe and that within a short . time, the Police arrived. (rmb 9-21-74 4:00pm)

Writer then went to 3535 SE 16, this being the home of FREDERICK G. FISHHER, and he stated that at approximately 5:00am this date both he and his wife were asleep in the living room, as they also had guests and that their front door was open and that they both had heard screaming and someone yelling, "help me, help me." MR. , "Mr. Education" to state school groups and political leaders, died August 11 at Overlake Hospital, after a two-year bout with cancer. He was 71.

earned the "Mr. Education" title as executive secretary of the Washington Education Association for 25 years (1940-65). He represented the Association in every legislative session during that period, and was regarded by both school forces and state political leaders as "the most effective, yet the most conscientious and trustworthy lobbyist in Olympia," according to a survey by political scientists Dr. Daniel Ogden and Dr. Hugh Bone. During "s retirement dinner, Governor-elect Daniel J. Evans characterized him as "a friendly neighbor and a hard hitting spokesman for education."

Born March 26, 1903, in Colfax, Washington, attended public schools in Walla Walla and was a basketball star as a student at WSU, from which he graduated in 1925. During his long career in education he was a teacher, coach and principal at LaConner (Skagit County). He also held the presidency of the Northwest Washington Athletic Association and of the Skagit County Education Association. Named LaConner superintendent of schools, he served seven years in that post before being selected as executive secretary of WEA in 1938. In 1940 he succeeded the late Arthur L. Marsh in WEA's top job.


During his 25 years as WEA "exec", helped the Association grow from a membership of 10,790 to 32,000. His legislative accomplishments included bills substantially equalizing funds for public education...subsidizing school construction...providing funds for handicapped and other special education...improving teacher retirement benefits, including access to social security...guaranteeing a continuing contract for teachers...and providing sick-leave benefits for school personnel. He believed in and worked for an Education Round Table in which all organizations related to the schools worked together upon common needs.

With state s death, we have lost a friend of education. And he will be missed.

Survivors include his wife Marie, at their home on Lake Sammamish near Issaquah; a daughter, Johnn of Honolulu; a son Ted of Lopez Island; three grandchildren, and two sisters, Mrs. Ollie Hansen of Aberdeen, Idaho, and Mrs. Eva Stamper of Portland, Oregon.
