Dear Captain Mackie:

This will confirm my recent telephone conversation with you at which time I discussed the person who had confided in a minister the fact that she was suspicious of a person whom she believed to be possibly identical with "Ted" in the cases of several missing and/or murdered young women in the area, and who wished her identity to be anonymous.

The informer believes that "Ted" could be identical with one [REDACTED] and supplied the following information concerning this individual:

The suspect lived at [REDACTED] - 111th S. E., Bellevue, Washington, from 1970 to mid-August 1974. This is an area referred to as Surrey Downs. He reportedly came from New Zealand and has an "Aussie" accent.

The suspect is approximately 29 to 33 years of age. The informant who lived in the neighborhood the entire time he resided at the above address said she was about eye-level with the suspect, and therefore estimates his height at about 5'8". He has strong shoulders, almost stocky. His appearance is very similar to the artist's composite drawing which appeared in the newspaper, and the source also stated that the suspect's wife, [REDACTED], made the same observation. His manner is suave, and the source stated that she had uncomfortable vibes in his presence on occasions.

The suspect brought his fiancée, [REDACTED], from New Zealand and they were married. His wife is petite, attractive, sexy, and wore provocative clothes. She resembled descriptions of the missing girls. The suspect's wife reportedly worked in obstetrics and gynecology at a clinic in Bellevue, probably the Bellevue Women's Clinic, located at 1026 - 112th N. E. In February 1974, she delivered a baby boy at Overlake Memorial Hospital in Bellevue.

There was considerable domestic tension in the [redacted] residence during the summer of 1974. The informant reported loud yelling usually heard by the neighbors, they were also known to have thrown things at each other. In the winter of 1974, the suspect reportedly caught a "Peeping Tom", and the "Peeping Tom" was beaten considerably by the suspect. The Bellevue Police were involved in this incident. The suspect also reportedly carried a gun.


According to the source, the suspect worked as an automotive mechanic and race car driver in New Zealand. During the time that he was in this area he was employed at Freeway Volkswagen in the University District until May or June of 1974. He had a variety of cars around at different times, including a Volkswagen.

The suspect returned to New Zealand in mid-August 1974 via Los Angeles, going back to New Zealand by boat. He reportedly planned to return to Bellevue in March of 1976. He still owns the residence at the above address.

The suspect's residence in Bellevue is now rented by some "loners" from the South. They have a red old Ford truck with Washington license T70 [redacted], and a fairly new Mercury station wagon with Florida license ARRIVE [redacted]. They are believed to be sending the rent money to a real estate company, possibly Benton-McCarthy in Bellevue, or a bank.

The informant related that he had had several contacts around the Century Tavern with a [redacted] who is a white male about 25 yrs. old. [redacted] had apparently been involved with a cult-type activity on the East side of Lake Sammamish. Supposedly he had viewed several goat-type sacrifices as well as one human sacrifice. The informant appeared to be rather knowledgeable of cult information. He stated that most cult sacrifices of goats relate to the male goat only. A goat sacrificed with no horns usually means an assimilation to female human white; it is similar to a young female in her teens to twenties, there is no spiritual meaning in sacrifices of dogs or cats. Most people who believe in occult sacrifice goats and humans. Most sacrifices involve white female humans.

240 [redacted] may be AKA a guy named [redacted]. He has met [redacted] on several occasions outside the Rainbow Tavern. [redacted] will do anything for money. He is a W/M 5'9", 170-lbs., black shoulder-length wavy hair. [redacted] is supposedly married to a girl [redacted] who works at the Century Tavern. She is SKINNY and in her 30s, black long hair. She worked there from January to June 1974, supposedly lives somewhere in the U District on 12th Ave. [redacted] had told the informant of viewing a sacrifice at a cabin between Woodinville and Issaquah. The person doing the sacrifice was a guy by the name of [redacted] who was Hungarian who dated a black woman. [redacted] supposedly had a cast and slipped it on and off. The informant knows that the occult definitely buries the bodies and they also use women to

SHORTLY BEFORE 0300hrs DATE I WAS ADVISED BY MERCER ISLAND POLICE THAT THEY HAD A SUBJECT IN CUSTODY WHOM THEY BELIEVED MIGHT BE THE SUBJECT "TED" BEING SOUGHT IN THE DISAPPEARANCE AND DEATHS OF THE OTT AND NAS-LUND WOMEN.

BRIEFLY, MERCER ISLAND ADVISED THAT THEY HAD BEEN CONTACTED BY DONNA LOUISE CAMPBELL, 31yrs, AND TOLD THAT SHE HAD BEEN AT DENNY'S RESTAURANT IN BELLEVUE AND THAT UPON LEAVING SHE HAD BEEN FOLLOWED BY A SUBJECT DRIVING A BLACK/ORANGE 1972 FIAT. THE SUBJECT APPARENTLY ATTEMPTED TO GET THE CAMPBELL WOMAN TO STOP, THE CIRCUMSTANCES ARE NOT KNOWN TO ME. THE WOMAN TOLD MERCER ISLAND POLICE THAT AT ONE POINT WHEN THE SUBJECT DROVE ALONG SIDE OF HER SHE GLANCED OVER AND BECAME SCARED WHEN SHE THOUGHT THE SUBJECT RESEMBLED "TED". SHE OBTAINED THE LICENSE NUMBER AND REPORTED THE INCIDENT TO M.I.P.D.

A SHORT TIME LATER M.I.POLICE STOPPED THE SUBJECT AND UPON CHECKING DISCOVERED THREE OUTSTANDING WARRANTS TOTALING \$170.00 IN BAIL. THEY TOOK THE SUBJECT TO THEIR OFFICE AND IT WAS WHILE AT THE OFFICE THAT THE RESEMBLANCE TO "TED" WAS NOTED. MERCER ISLAND OFFICERS STATE THE SUBJECT WAS EVASIVE IN ANSWERING QUESTIONS AND APPARENTLY WAS QUITE UPSET AT THE THOUGHT OF BEING TAKEN TO THE COUNTY JAIL.

AT 0340hrs I CONTACTED MERCER ISLAND OFFICERS IN THE JAIL. AT THIS TIME I ADVISED [REDACTED] THAT A HOLD FOR INVESTIGATION OF HOMICIDE WAS BEING PLACED ON HIM. THERE WAS ABSOLUTELY NO VERBAL REACTION TO MY STATEMENT. I SAID THAT THIS WAS BEING DONE DUE TO THE CIRCUMSTANCES OF HIS ARREST BY MERCER ISLAND POLICE AND HIS RESEMBLANCE TO A WANTED SUBJECT KNOWN AS "TED". HE REPLIED, "ABOUT THE MISSING CHICKS, HUH?" I STATED, "YES. AND YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO CALL AN ATTORNEY NOW OR AT ANY TIME. WE'RE NOT GOING TO ASK YOU ANY QUESTIONS NOW, THOUGH". HE THEN MADE SOME COMMENT ABOUT HAVING BEEN ARRESTED BECAUSE OF A BANK ROBBERY AT SOME PREVIOUS TIME. THE IMPLICATION WAS THAT THAT HAD BEEN A MISTAKE ALSO. HE FIDGETED SOMEWHAT AT THIS TIME BUT DID NOT COMPLAIN AT ALL OF THE FACTS OF THE SITUATION.

I ADVISED THE BOOKING OFFICERS THAT FINGER AND PALM PRINTS AND PHOTOGRAPHS WERE TO BE TAKEN. AT THIS POINT THE SUBJECT'S WIFE APPEARED AT THE JAIL TO POST BAIL. The individual responsible for the deaths of the missing women, whose remains are now being found in the North Bend area and were found in the Issaquah area last year, could possibly be an employee or former employee at the Echo Glen Children's Center.
**** *or else he is doing nothing there*

The theory is based upon these assumptions, which, after consideration, tend to make some sense.

- 1) The man either lives in the North Bend area and drives the short distance to the Glen, or he commutes to the area. Either way, he would have some knowledge of the surrounding countryside, having traveled the roads from time to time looking for runaways from the institution or just looking over the area.
- 2) He is probably a psychologist, or an employee in one of the cottages who is working on a Masters or P.H.D. in psychology. This assumption is based on the fact that such a project would give him ample excuse to appear at several different college campuses (Central, UW, Evergreen, etc.) to do one of two things: converse with professors or utilize library facilities.
- 3) If he is a student, a grad student, his academic semester would roughly coincide with the disappearances, from the campuses of at least four of the women. These disappearances took place between Jan. 31 1974 and June 11 1974. Other disappearances which took place on June 1 and July 14, 1974, were possibly connected in that, to be completely blunt, a psychotic killer needs relaxation, too. And it must be noted that Brenda Ball, found near North Bend, and Denise Naslund, found near Issaquah, frequented the Flame Tavern which could possibly link them with their killer. Thin, admittedly, but still something to consider.
- 4) The man could be in advanced stages of schizophrenia - split personality - and not really aware of what he is doing. He is probably single, living alone, and with few outside interests due to the pressures of his work and studies in attaining the degree this theory assumes is involved.
- 5) It is entirely possible that the man has some access to a state owned vehicle for transportation, which could explain his ability to arrive on a college campus without much notice. Either then or ~~at~~ later, after staking out victims, does he strike. Being a grad student would give this individual a certain insight into the activities and atmosphere on a college campus.
- 6) The man is probably effete in some way, as described by some as "smooth talking, quiet" etc. His ability to lure victims could be because of this trait, i.e. a girl sees this pitiful person in a dilemma and therefore decides to help out. He could use his background in psychology to further put on the act. He is probably sexually insecure in that he may not be sure of his ability to keep a steady girl friend - to satisfy her needs - and therefore he preys on women in order to release his sexual urges.
- 7) Assuming that he killed all his victims at night, except for Ott and Naslund, he probably had the bodies somewhere until early morning when he went about placing them in the two wooded areas (The third body, parts of which were found at the Issaquah site, is still unidentified and therefore could have been any one of the women who disappeared at night.).
- 8) Also on assumption is this: if he is an employee at Echo Glen, he does get time off for vacation, travel, research, sick leave, etc. which would give him plenty of time to do some roaming around. Assuming, also, that he may have graduated with the degree in June, 1974, the July incident could have been a classic "final fling." If he did graduate, he could have quit at the Glen or may still be working there or in the area, in the field of psychology or related work.

9) Now we get down to specifics. The man could have known at least four and perhaps all of his victims beforehand. I will explain:

a. Lynda Ann Healy was a fourth-year psychology graduate student at the UW who, according to her friends, quoted in the Seattle P-I, "wanted to be a psychologist, explored human behavior." (July 28, 1974).

b. If he was doing research on a paper or dissertation, we'll go one step more and say that he worked at Echo Glen for the purpose of studying behavior in criminally motivated youngsters...a project that could have put him in touch with Janice Ott. She worked for the King County Juvenile Court.

c. He may, during off hours, have visited the Flame Tavern, at which place he could have met one of, or both Denise Naslund and Brenda Ball. That being possible, since they both frequented the place, he could have been seen by both on June 1, possibly by Naslund as he accompanied Ball away from the place. Then, on July 14, he sees Naslund again, at Lake Sammamish, after he has made off with another acquaintance, Janice Ott. Fearful that Naslund may put something together, he asks her to help him and she does, because she has met him before at the Flame.

d. Donna Gail Manson disappeared from Evergreen, BUT, she had attended a quarter at Green River Community College. Not that far from Echo Glen and perhaps a place where she would have met her killer, especially since he may well have frequented several college campuses "on research."

e. It is possible that all these girls knew him, so check out the courses they took at college. Psychology could be a link.

Time Frame:

✓ 1) Lynda Healy - Jan 31 - It's the beginning of the semester for the killer. Grad students do their course work usually on a semester schedule, even at quarter undergrad schools like the UW. He says something to her, they talk psych, he says "I'm going your way" and he does.

2) Donna Gail Manson - March 12 (40 days) She is next victim. Maybe she recognizes him from Green River. They talk, and he says that he is there on research or to see a prof. Or, perhaps, he tells her he is on business for Echo Glen.

3) Susan Elaine Rancourt - April 17 (36 days) He is at Central, again on research. She sees him trying to wrestle his books around, having trouble. He has approached other women, but Rancourt is the only one who helps. Her mistake.

✓ 4) Roberta Kathleen Parks - May 6 (19 days) She is ripped off at OSU. He could be there on study or research. He does his helpless act and she suckers for it.

✓ 5) Brenda Carol Ball - June 1 (24 days) She is at Flame Tavern. She knows him, maybe, but the place is a dive and girls go there to get picked up. She'd already asked the musician to give her a ride and he declined. The killer didn't.

6) Georgeanne Hawkins - June 11 (10 days) She is latest victim. He is on campus to do more research. He has been around the area, at Greek Row, and he finally finds a victim, perhaps one he knows.

✓ 7 & 8) Denise Naslund and Janice Ott - July 14 (33 days) Ott vanishes first. Naslund second. Explained above.

Why Does He Kill?

Simple, really. In order to put this freak together, consider that he is probably a person with a limited social background and therefore feels inadequate to build a lasting relationship. Instead, he rapes the girls, when his alter-ego takes over, and when he finally discovers what has happened (supposing that his schizophrenia is so far advanced that neither self knows what the other is doing) he feels that if they report the crime, his career is down the drain. He kills them instead, taking their nude bodies to his graveyard, right near Echo Glen....
