Mr. Eagles stated that he has a summer cabin in the griffin creek area. The cabin is directly behind camp Don Bosco, a Catholic Youth camp located 1/2 mile south and 1/2 mile east of Carnation off of Hyw 203.

About 1 month ago Mr. Eagle was driving to his cabin and in the area of a gravel pit on Griffin creek rd. he observed 50-60 people ~~what~~ what appeared to him to be a cult type activity. He saw skulls, candles, and some sort of cult ritual taking place. Mr. Eagle did not stop, but continued on to his cabin. Mr. Eagle described the ages of the subjects at the cult activity as being 19 to 25 Years old.

Mr. Eagles then advised me that about 1 year ago in the same area of griffin creek rd. There were found 4-5 great dane dogs that had been killed. Mr. Eagle also advised that the medical examination showed that needles had been stuck into the heart and that all the blood had been removed from the hearts of these dogs. Animal control of King County was handling the case at that time.

1840 I then talked to Gary Eagle the son of William H. Eagle. "e lives at the same address and phone number is the same. Gary told me that about the end of June or the 1st part of july 1974 he was fishing in the area of his fathers summer cabin. At that time he observed a van type vehicle unk. color part at the side of the road and 12 male subjects got out of the van and walked up a small hill and disappeared over the top of the hill. Gary did not see the male subjects come back down the hill.

On this date at approx. 0245 hrs I was working car 3-S-4 with officer J. Pryor 3701. While on routine patrol in the Rainier valley area we received a call via police radio concerning a man yelling for help and that he was trapped over an embankment. The address was the 4900 blk of SW Bruce. After officers arrived on the scene they were directed to an area behind 4955 SW Bruce where officers observed a W/M/ 18 to 20 years. He seemed to be trapped or stuck in some blackberry bushes. Officers found a rope and with the assistance of an unidentified person pulled the young male out of the bushes. At first appearances the subject seemed to be under the influence of something (eyes very glassy and dilated; also seemed dazed and his mind far off from reality. His speech was very good, but he repeated himself often; polite, but on the defensive). Officers observed the subjects actions and remarks to different questions and after a few minutes felt that he was a mental case. My partner called the West Seattle hospital when a sales slip was found in his front pocket ~~addressed~~ addressed to the hospital and the fact that he stated that he was going to the hospital for treatment. After confirming that he was not a escapee officers decided to take the subject home to his parents (2333 - 44th SW). Officers arrived at the subject address just as another unit broadcasted the description of a possible rape/assault suspect in the West Seattle area. There was not much of a description but they did state that the suspect could have scratches or bite marks about his person; also the location of the offense was only about five blocks from where we had rescued our subject. Officers felt that the person they had in the rear of their vehicle could in fact be the suspect in the assault case.

Officers returned to West Seattle Hospital to talk with the officers who took the report on the assault. While my partner was inside the hospital I tried to inform the subject that he had several constitutional rights and I tried to read them to him from my MIR card, but due to the subjects continuous rambling I was unable to establish if he understood his rights or not. I decided not to ask him any direct question about the incident for two reasons (1) I knew very little about the incident (2) a Question if he understood his rights. During the next hour that we were in the police vehicle I began to talk with the subject and to form an opinion of his nature. He was a very unstable person mentally; one who is searching for true love from someone (kept talking of his girlfriend " Cindy "). He stated that his father had left his mother when he was three years old and that his mother was very protective of him and didn't want him to go out with either boys or girls and in fact stated that he felt his mother had turned him against girls to some degree. The subject kept referring to himself as a super horny stud and that he wasn't a common criminal for what he had done in the past and that he had never been caught for doing his thing. I tried to get him to explain what he meant by the statement, but he laughed. I felt that his whole world was built around the word " SEX " and that he talked freely about his feeling towards girls and sex.

The subject rambled on about his actions for the night just prior to when the officers rescued him from the bushes. He stated that he left the hospital a few hours before and that he had talked with several men at the corner of 35th SW & SW Webster at some store; also that he had asked a woman for a couple of cigarettes and had a few words with the men and left ~~the area~~ the area before he got into trouble. The next thing he said was that he had went to an apartment which had a screen door which was hard to open, and he had a friend inside, but couldn't or didn't want to remember where the apartment was or what the inside was like or who was inside. Also stated that he had meet the prettiest lady in a phone booth and that he had asked her for a dime so he could make a call. Subject stated that the lady seemed

very nervous at his being there and gave him the dime and told him to go away until after she finished. He stated that he did not leave the area but only walked off a little ways. He stated that he could really get turned on by that lady and that he could reach a climax without touching her. Stated that he went back to the phone booth to ask her if he could go home with her and to make love to her and that she could love him if she wanted to. At this point the subject went off on another subject and wouldn't or couldn't return his train of thought to what he had been talking about.

Other comments that the subject had made were as follows:

- He kept referring or using the word " Bitch " as a female ; also relating it to a dog and that the female and the dog are the same.
- Referred to himself as a Male Pig and that all police officers were also a kind of Male Pigs and were in the same shape as he -- then laughed very loudly.
- At one point he stated that he had borrowed a dime from a lady and almost told her he loved her without saying a word.
- Referred to the apartment as one having a hard screen door and the inside as being clean, compact, neat, nice, cool, with soul.

After referring with the investigating officer at the hospital (off L.Ash & G, Weedin) we (Off Zuray & Pryor) took the subject to the South Station where the arrest was screened by Sgt. Hansen and the subject was taken to the city jail where he was booked suspicion of assault B/A #22736 . The subject was taken to the jail doctor for a check up (Dr. J Hanson) and he will testify to the scratches on the subjects face and body. While talking with the jail doctor the subject made a comment about the fact that he hated red and that the red suit made him feel like a teddy bear. My partner asked him something about a teddy bear and he stated that he had seen a teddy bear earlier and had had a fight with it and he had to physically throw it off his back so he could get away. (Note: there was a damaged teddy bear in the victims bedroom near her bed).

I feel that this person could have committed a crime and in his frame of mind never really admit to doing it or in fact connect it with reality.

When they reached there Emerson saw a poster on the front door. The poster was different, and on the bottom of it was "COME TO MIDDLE EARTH". She recognized the picture to be one from the fantasy book written by J.R.R. Tolkien. As they walked through the door [REDACTED] told her in a very serious manner that he was really Gandalf. "Gandalf" is a subject in the fantasy books that can change into a wizard.

While they were in the apartment, and no one else was there, [REDACTED] was very persistent to have sexual relations with Emerson. She told him that she was having her period and he said that it didn't make any difference, so she told him, as she had before, that she had just broke-up with her husband and she had gone in for a V.D. test. She told him she didn't think he wanted that. He seemed to be satisfied with that reasoning. She stayed in the livingroom and he went to the bathroom, which could be seen from the livingroom. All he had on was his shorts. He was standing in front of the mirror flexing his muscles. This is when she could see what type of body he had. He asked her to come into the bathroom so he could put his necklace around her neck. She had come to the conclusion by this time that he was really weird and was in fear that she would not come out of the apartment alive. He kept asking her if she liked him and told her over and over that he was horny.

They were at the apartment a little over two hours. They left and went over to her girlfriend's house. When they arrived he would not go inside because there were males there and he wanted to be with girls. They sat in the car for awhile and he made her promise many times that she would go out with him again. She went into the house and he left. She has seen him since at the My Place Tavern. They have not talked. He just sits and stares at her.

The reason she has not reported [REDACTED] before was that she was afraid that he really was "Ted". After she went out with him she didn't spend much time at home because she lived alone and was afraid he would come to her house. Now she has a roommate living with her. Emerson is a student at Highline College and is home after 1230 hrs. She may be reached at home.
