Concerning DNA Testing;

Sgt. Barclift & myself spoke with Wash. State Crime Lab / Don McLaren #464-7074 who was recently trained by the FBI in Wash. D.C. Our state is one year away from having equipment to test with, assuming the legislature funds it. McLaren's understanding is that the FBI will take nothing other than new cases after 12/1/88 & nothing if another lab (private) worked on it.

Our evidence needing testing / comparison, consists of a swab or gauze pad of a small amount of spermatozoa and (3) three hairs. Wash. St. Lab Lynn MacIntire said evidence hair marked "J, x, & c" were pulled hairs, but it is unknown if or not they contain more than the root. We need as much as possible. A problem is that old evidence loses its DNA in breakdown as time goes on. As this case is 15 years old, plus, McLaren warns that it may be too old anyway. This is confirmed by Eubank of FBI Lab & 12/1/88 is their cut off date. They will not handle it.

The one man to advise is Ed Blake of Forensic Science Assoc., San Francisco, Ca. #415-222-8883, who can duplicate sampler, thus giving more to test. It is called PCR (a chain reaction).

I called him this date. Our (3) three hair samples are so old as to have to call them close to zero in

value for testing. The spermatozoa evidence of that age would be a test of the maximum limits of technology in both quantitative & quality terms. BLAKE will not say it can't be done, just that it seems unlikely. Spermatozoa heads were identified by the WSP crime Lab on the 9/25/86 report from Don MacLaren in "Item #48" (vaginal smear). We don't know how the sperm was counted in this case. In older times, only sperm with tails were counted. For every tail sperm, there are 100 without tails, so are counted by today's methods of examination.

BLAKE has made such an old case before, but can not encourage us on this **101C** case, but is willing to try.

If we chose to have him examine the spermatozoa against William CORDEN & **101C** then boyfriend, then the cost is \$1500. - (average figure) + \$125. - witness fees per hr. based on an 8 hr. day. We have CORDEN's evidence, but never had the victim's boyfriend, **101B** **101B** who is currently in Walla Walla Pen. (They are believed to have had sexual relations 2 days prior to her running away.)

We have been talking about interviewing Cosden for over a year now in reference to the 101C and 101C homicides. We would like to try to get Cosden to take the polygraph test reference the murder of 101C and 101C

At the present time, Cosden is a prisoner at McNeil Island for a rape here in Thurston County. (McClanahan and Barclift worked on the rape case.)

We think that Bundy is the number one suspect but Cosden is also a suspect. In order to clear Cosden, we would like to see if he will take the polygraph test to eliminate him or Bundy.

Tentative plans have been made for detectives Joe Vukich and Brian Schoening to go to McNeil Island on Friday, 27 June, and talk to Cosden about taking the polygraph test. A court order has been requested to bring Cosden here if he consents.

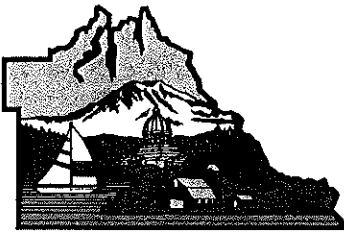

Bill digitally penetrated her with fingers & would rub against her body, clothed / unclothed, 3 times weekly, throws fits, items at her, touched her breasts, body, kissed her for the first time when he got back from Vietnam, on the mouth. Sometimes couldn't get an erection & would hold his penis up to rub against her crotch & body, backside. Would leave vials for **101C** to find to expose abuse, but they didn't, i.e. hid the vaseline to draw attention.

Tim used vaseline to smear all over her body to rub against her as she pretended to sleep. Tim watched Bill abuse at **101C**, in St. Mary's, Maryland. The **101C** thought Bill touched an ⁵⁷⁻⁵⁸unoccupied house there & grilled him. He denied it. The murder there brought much publicity & the family moved out here to avoid publicity. Bill was sent to Johns Hopkins Hosp. 1 1/2 yrs. Abuse occurred whenever Bill was available & both brothers abused her at same time frame at one point. **101C** was too young to even know & never woke up. **101C** was also abused.

Bill went to Vietnam about 1963 ish age 17, quit high school, came back 1 yr later & immediately abused her that evening, & up until his being sent off to prison.

The Thurston County Sheriff's Department is investigating Tim Cosden and his brother William Cosden in a routine manner.

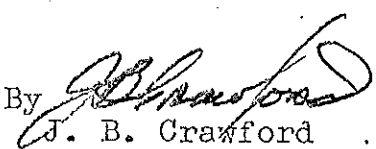
Tim was recently arrested for attempted rape, involving a short petite, young hitchhiking female, who was taken to a secluded area near Millersylvania State Park. The body of another female hitchhiker was recently found in the same area. Our most current victim alleged that Tim forced her to this area, fondled her breasts and shoved his finger into her rectum and fondled her buttocks. He did nothing else before she escaped.

We are writing jurisdictions between Olympia and Lynnwood because his vehicle was purchased at Lynnwood Dodge. We think he may have been active in your area.

His brother, William Earl Cosden, Jr., was once arrested for a brutal murder, i.e. stabbed a female to death, multiple wounds with a broken pool cue. Current activities, if any, are unknown.
