3. Narrative

On Friday, March 3, 2023, I spoke to V [REDACTED] H [REDACTED] on the phone reference a tip she reported to the tip line. I did not record our conversation. H [REDACTED] originally reported the tip in January of 2023 and stated she had an encounter with someone she thought was Kohberger. I called H [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] and spoke to her about the tip.

H [REDACTED] told me she was working as a dancer at S [REDACTED] on [REDACTED] Club in [REDACTED] during the 2018-2019 timeframe. [REDACTED] is a two hour drive from [REDACTED] PA. Hoffer stated she was unsure which of those two years the encounter took place.

H [REDACTED] stated she came in to work on what she described as a slow day and noticed only one man seated next to the stage, alone. H [REDACTED] stated she got on stage and began her dance when she noticed the man seemed to be talking to himself. H [REDACTED] stated the man made her feel uneasy but she continued her dance. H [REDACTED] told me during the dance she heard the man state something about "wanting to kill people". H [REDACTED] told me she thought she misheard the man, so she did not acknowledge the statement until he said it again. H [REDACTED] said she could not remember exactly what the man said but thought it was something to the effect of wanting to kill people.

H [REDACTED] told me she engaged with the man after the second comment thinking he was trying to get attention. H [REDACTED] told me she jokingly asked the man who he was going to kill to which he replied something to the effect of "whoever I want". H [REDACTED] completed her dance and left the stage.

H [REDACTED] told me the conversation was strange enough she remembered telling the bouncers at the club to keep an eye on the man who she said sat and watched the other dancers for some time. Eventually, H [REDACTED] told me she offered the man a private dance as he was the only patron in the club. During this dance, H [REDACTED] told me the man told her to look him directly in the eyes the entire time and asked her questions about what car she drove and where she lived. H [REDACTED] told me she finished the private dance at which point the man left and did not return to the club to her knowledge.

H [REDACTED] told me she did not think about the encounter until she saw Kohberger's picture on TV upon his arrest. H [REDACTED] told me she was fairly certain Kohberger was the man she encountered in the club that day. H [REDACTED] did not have any further information to corroborate her story and told me she just wanted investigators to be aware. H [REDACTED] reiterated to me she was fairly sure Kohberger was the man and that she saw.

I concluded my conversation with H [REDACTED] after I confirmed she would be willing to speak again if I needed further information.
