3. Narrative

On March 4, 2023, C [REDACTED] T [REDACTED] called the MPD tip line and left a voicemail regarding a tip for this case in which she described seeing a man walk by her house at [REDACTED] sometime during August or September of 2022. SGT Blaker sent me the tip on March 15, 2023. I spoke to T [REDACTED] via phone on March 21, 2023. I did not record our conversation.

I asked T [REDACTED] to relay to me what her tip was in reference to. T [REDACTED] told me she used to live at [REDACTED]. This home is located approximately .13 miles due east of 1122 King Road. T [REDACTED] told me she was home one day in August or September of 2022 when her daughter came running into the house saying there was a man walking through their yard. T [REDACTED] stated she looked out the window and saw a man who "looked nervous" walking on the south side of her house from east to west. T [REDACTED] told me she frequently saw people walk by the house but not in that particular area. T [REDACTED] said the man had curly hair with a large nose, and he walked by without saying anything. T [REDACTED] stated the encounter became stranger when the same man walked back by the house in the opposite direction but taking the same route approximately fifteen minutes later. T [REDACTED] said she stepped outside and yelled to the man he was on private property. T [REDACTED] said the man didn't look at her and simply walked away.

T [REDACTED] then told me, unprompted, that she believed the male she saw was Kohberger after she saw a side profile picture of him on the news after his arrest. T [REDACTED] stated she was "92 percent sure" it was Kohberger. T [REDACTED] stated she did not see the man any other times after the occurrence in August or

September. However, T [REDACTED] told me there was another occurrence in June or July of 2022 when a white sedan was parked near her mailbox for over an hour. It should be noted [REDACTED] is a dead-end road with only residences. T [REDACTED] told me the vehicle left after her neighbor walked out to ask the man if he needed help. T [REDACTED] could not positively say what type of vehicle she saw that day. T [REDACTED] was not able to provide any further specific detail about dates.

On March 22, 2023, SGT Blaker and I went to the area where T [REDACTED] said she saw the man. There is a well-worn path from Boyd Avenue through to Blake Avenue which is likely where T [REDACTED] saw the man. In addition, I spoke to the neighbor who spoke to the man in the white car (identified only as "[REDACTED]" at [REDACTED]) who stated he remembered the encounter but could not add any further information.
