Release of personal property from City Shop:

On April 14, 2023 I was contacted by S [REDACTED] C [REDACTED] via phone. S [REDACTED] told me she was in town and was informed MPD may still be in possession of some of Ethan's belongings. I told S [REDACTED] I was not aware of any but told her I would respond out to the City Shop where personal belongings retrieved from 1122 King Rd. were stored and see what was there. When I arrived at the City Shop I found there were 5 boxes of items labeled as being from both the living room area and the spare bedroom of the home. There was also a clear plastic tote which had miscellaneous clothing items in it. I advised S [REDACTED] she could come to the City Shop and look through the items if she wished.

S [REDACTED] arrived a short time later with her husband and daughter. The family looked through all of the boxes and collected three items they believed belonged to Ethan:

1. Sigma Chi Banner
2. Black sweat pants
3. Brown belt

I created a receipt for the items utilizing a MPD supplemental statement form which S [REDACTED] and I signed. I scanned and attached the receipt to this case.
