TikTok Kohberger Warrant

Case # 22-M09903  
Date: 4/3/2023

On January 24, 2023, I applied for a warrant for the user subscriber information and user data associated with TikTok account of Bryan Kohberger with the any of the following identifiers:

[REDACTED]

On January 25, 2023, the warrant was granted and signed by Magistrate Megan Marshal with seven (7) days to serve the legal process. January 26, 2023, at approximately 0830 hours, the warrant was served via the TikTok Law Enforcement Portal (<https://law-enforcement-tiktok-uscan.zendesk.com/>). I received an email shortly after the submission, confirming the receipt of the request and assigning the internal reference # [REDACTED]

On March 3, 2023, I received an email from TikTok stating the data requested pursuant to the warrant was available to download. I logged into the Law Enforcement Portal and began downloading the files to the forensic computers located in the secure forensic computer lab at the Moscow Police Department.

The email received from TikTok also stated:

Please note that after a diligent search we are unable to locate any TikTok accounts associated with the identifiers "[REDACTED]@gmail.com, [REDACTED]@desales.edu, [REDACTED]"

In reviewing the contents, I found the account subscriber information of:

In searching for the geolocation of the IP address [REDACTED], I found it returned to NordVPN out of Seattle, Washington. NordVPN had been located as an installed app on Kohberger's phone.

No information was provided by TikTok regarding messages sent or received, followers or following accounts, or user created content.

A warrant return receipt and affidavit were completed and these documents were sent to the Latah County Prosecutor's Office to be returned to the court. A copy of the receipt was sent to [REDACTED]@law-enforcement-tiktok-uscan.zendesk.com, as this was the originating email address associated with the documents.
