On March 30, 2023, I applied for a warrant for Call Data Records from June 23, 2022, to August 1, 2022 associated with the T-Mobile accounts with the any of the following identifiers:

A previous warrant to Snapchat requested the date range "August 1, 2022, to November 20, 2022." Based on information obtained from Washington State University, Bryan Kohberger moved to the Pullman, Washington on or about June 23, 2022. I requested both historical records and real time/provisional records in order to determine if Kohberger had any interactions with the victims leading up to the November 13, 2022 crime.

On March 30, 2023, the warrant was granted and signed by Magistrate Megan Marshal with fourteen (14) days to serve the legal process. On April 3, 2023, at approximately 1049 hours, the warrant was served via the T-Mobile Law Enforcement Email ([REDACTED]@T-Mobile.com).

On May 30, 2023, I received an email from T-Mobile with the data requested pursuant to the warrant was available to download. I downloaded the files to the forensic computers located in the secure forensic computer lab at the Moscow Police Department.

A warrant return receipt and affidavit were completed and these documents were sent to the Latah County Prosecutor's Office to be returned to the court. A copy of the receipt was sent to [REDACTED]@T-Mobile.com, as this was the originating email address associated with the documents.
