TikTok Multi2 Warrant

On July 20, 2023, I applied for a warrant for user data from June 1, 2022, to November 14, 2022 associated with the TikTok accounts with the any of the following identifiers:

Ethan Chapin's TikTok account with any of the following email address(es):

A previous warrant to TikTok requested the data for Madison Mogen, Kaylee Goncalves, and Xana Kernodle. Based on information obtained from Washington State University, Bryan Kohberger moved to the Pullman, Washington on or about June 23, 2022. I requested both historical records and real time/provisional records in order to determine if Kohberger had any interactions with the victims leading up to the November 13, 2022 crime.

On July 24, 2023, the warrant was granted and signed by Magistrate Megan Marshal with fourteen (14) days to serve the legal process. On July 25, 2023, at approximately 1145 hours, the warrant was served via the TikTok Law Enforcement Portal (<https://law-enforcement-tiktok-uscan.zendesk.com/>). I received an email shortly after the submission, confirming the receipt of the request and assigning the internal reference # [REDACTED]

On August 17, 2023, I received an email from TikTok stating the data requested pursuant to the warrant was available to download. In an accompanying email, TikTok disclosed the following:
Please note that after a diligent search we are unable to locate any TikTok

accounts associated with the identifier "[REDACTED]
[REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED]"

On August 22, 2023, I logged into the Law Enforcement Portal and began downloading the files to the forensic computers located in the secure forensic computer lab at the Moscow Police Department.

A warrant return receipt and affidavit were completed and these documents were sent to the Latah County Prosecutor's Office to be returned to the court. A copy of the receipt was sent to [REDACTED]@law-enforcement-tiktok-uscan.zendesk.com, as this was the originating email address associated with the documents.
