On 11-12-74 Reporting Officer contacted the FBI, Salt Lake City, where I obtained numerous photographs of possible suspects matching the description of the composite in this case. The photographs were shown to Rae Lynn Shephard. From the group of pictures she picked the photograph of Steve Alan Russell as the individual fitting the composite and the one that she saw at Viewmont High, with the following exceptions: She stated that he appeared to be about five or six years to old and his skin was just a little to dark. She did state that the individual in the photograph had on the same type of coat as the suspect that she saw at Viewmont High School.

I also instructed Mrs. Shephard to sit down when she was alone and make a drawing of the suspect which she saw at Viewmont High. She gave the drawing to Reporting Officer at 1510 hours on 11-12-74.

Reporting Officer and Officer Winter took Mrs. Shephard to the Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office where she looked through the file on sex offenders. She was unable to identify anyone as the suspect in the case.

On 11-12-74 Reporting Officer received a phone call from Salt Lake City Police Department stating that they had stopped an individual matching the artist's drawing in our case. The suspect's name is Donald J. Weir, [REDACTED] He was driving a 1969 Oldsmobile 2 dr, dark green in color, [REDACTED] Subject is described as follows 5'9", 160#, brown hair and brown eyes [REDACTED] Mr. Weir previously lived in Provo, Utah and moved to [REDACTED] approximately two months ago. His home phone number [REDACTED]

This subject was stopped by Officer Mike Pless. Mr. Pless stated that the subject was quite nervous at the time.

Also on 11-12-74 Reporting Officer and Deputy J.R. Hunt of DCSO stopped an individual in a 1969 dark green Firebird, [REDACTED] The subject was Ralph J. Rabberra, [REDACTED] Described as follows: 5'11", 170#, black hair, olive complexion, DOB: [REDACTED] However the photograph in the drivers license picture is a very poor likeness of the subject. This subject very, very closely resembles the description given by all of the witnessess at Viewmont High School.

Also on 11-12-74, Reporting Officer and Deputy J.R. Hunt made contact with [REDACTED] She observed the suspect on the night of the disappearance of Debra Kent. She described the suspect as follows 6', 170#, dark brown hair, full mustache, possibly of Italian descent. Wearing a navy blue coat, light pants and a ring with a large wide gold band with a big large stone in the center of it. She stated that the subject had the nervous habit of pinching his nose and she thought with the right hand. He also has a tendency to shrug his shoulders quite a bit. She described him as a movie star type looking individual. When I asked her if he was handsome she stated "Oh yes."

On 11-13-74, at 2130 hours, Reporting Officer was contacted by Julie Jensen at my residence. She stated that after the disappearance of a girl in Provo some time ago, shortly after she received a phone call from an individual who called himself Mike Smith and stated that he lived in North Salt Lake. She did not receive any more phone calls from this individual until this evening. The subject then again called Miss Jensen stating that he wanted to see her and then identified himself as Mike Smith.

Miss Jensen asked where he lived and he stated North Salt Lake. She stated that the subject made an appointment to call back at 1530 hours on Saturday 11-16-74. Miss Jensen lives at [REDACTED] and she stated to this Officer that she checked the phone directory and there is not a Mike Smith who lives in North Salt Lake, however, there is one that lives at [REDACTED]

Reporting Officer thinks that he has heard the name of Mike Smith used in this case now under investigation. It seems that it was with the name of Flesher for leads for this department to check out.

Reporting Officer and J.R. Hunt on 11-12-74 also attempted to make contact with a Roger Schwinn, one of the suspects in this case, however, we were unable to locate any individual at Dixon Auto where he is reportedly working. We went to the residence of Roger Schwinn and located a vehicle listed to Roger and Carol Schwinn, a 1967 Chevrolet 2 dr, royal blue [REDACTED]. This vehicle is in very excellent condition.

It was felt that we not make personal contact with Mr. Schwinn at this time, in an attempt to observe him and see if he does closely resemble the composite in this case.

Reporting Officer received a call from Carl Rocks who lives at [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] Utah, [REDACTED]

Mr. Rocks stated that an individual by the name of Howard Schmutz Jr. who worked with him at Grand Central, and as he understands, presently works night shift at J.C. Penny's in Bountiful, fits the description of the artists conception of the suspect in this case.

Mr. Rocks described Mr. Schmutz as 30 years of age, dark brown hair, 6'5", 200 #, and sporting a mustache. Mr. Rocks stated that we would be able to obtain Mr. Schmutz's present address by contacting the general office of Grand Central.

Mr. Rocks beleives that Mr. Schmutz has Fridays off. He stated that Mr. Schmutz has sexual problems and should possibly be looked into as a possible suspect in this case.

Mr. Rock stated that he would be out of town Saturday and Sunday but would be back on Monday if the detectives needed to contact him.
