Reporting Officer contacted Julie Jensen, in regards to the suspicious phone call which she had in which an individual representing himself as a Mike Smith called her and wanted to see her.

Miss Jensen was asked by Reporting Officer if the suspect had again called and she said he had not. I instructed her if she received another call to make an appointment to have him call back and we would see if he would meet her some way other than at her apartment.

It should be noted that Detective Beal checked with Merrill Lynch Stockbrokers to see if a Mike Smith worked in the Salt Lake area and Detective Beal stated they do not have this individual working for them in the Salt Lake Office, however, they do have a Mike Smith that works in the Provo office. It is not known if this is the same individual or not.

Reporting Officer then went to South Ogden Police Department where I contacted Officer Jim Jensen 4-F-14 and inquired if he knew a Greg P. Lesley. I advised him that we had a photograph of him without a mustache and we needed one with a mustache. Officer Jensen stated he did not know this individual but he would ask around and contact this Department on Tuesday, November 19th.

Reporting Officer then went to Ogden Police Department where I obtained photographs of Arley Paul Gines and Mike Romero. These individuals were arrested for kidnap and rape in Ogden. The kidnap and rape occurred the same night as the Kent case. I also obtained the statements of both individuals made.

These photographs will be shown to the witnesses and then given to the Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office for their information.

Reporting Officer then went to the Utah State Penitentiary in an attempt to locate photographs of a Gaylen Pyle and a Rick Brent Barney and Steven George Marsh. The only photographs that could be located at the Prison were those of Steve Marsh. These will be included with the others we have to see if Marsh could be the suspect in this case.

Reporting Officer received information from Sgt. Don Taylor that he had checked the phone number which a Lisa Johnson had stated was her home phone number. He stated this is a blank number and has not been assigned to anyone. Therefore, it appears that the phone call from Lisa Johnson was a prank call.
