The reporting officer and Detective Beal contacted Mr. Gordon BARLAND, the Psychology Department at the University of Utah and requested that they run a polygraph examination on Ronald Dennis AUTH. A polygraph on Mr. AUTH was run by Mr. BARLAND and Mr. BARLAND contacted this officer and informed me that Mr. AUTH had passed the polygraph and was not the man that we were looking for in this case.

However the official results as of the writing of this report have not been received from Mr. BARLAND.

A Park City Police Officer, name unknown stated that he observed an individual that he mistook for Ron AUTH in a 1974 Mercedes Bens coupe, California license [REDACTED] A 10-28 was requested through teletype and came back to a 1974 Mercedes Bens coupe to John Lawrence FAESSELL, [REDACTED] California. Vin number [REDACTED]

This individual was seen with Eileen BLACK, Ron AUTH'S girl friend.

At the writing of this report this individual has not been located by the reporting officer.

Also received information that Allen VAN DYKE, Paul VAN DYKE'S father, who lives at [REDACTED] had information that Paul had the SMITH girl's activity card. He located this when he was going through Paul's drawers, in his bedroom. This information was passed on to Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office and it proved to be negative at the time.

According to the Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office Chief Smith has all of the SMITH girl's activity cards for the past three years.

Reporting officer received a letter from Sgt. Bill STETTLER of the Ogden City Police Department of a suspect by the name of Brent TOLSON, who reportedly had been arrested for rape and assault while in the military and had also been in a mental hospital for this treatment. In talking to Sgt. STETTLER, he stated that TOLSON is currently living in the Salt Lake area, present address unknown. He stated that he would attempt to gain further information for this department and he stated that it was possible that Mr. TOLSON could be located through the military at Hill Field.

Also information was received by the reporting officer that a John MATTSON, 25 to 30 years, lives at [REDACTED] goes away on Fridays and does not return until Sunday nights, frequently, and he matches the composite in this case.

Reporting officer had an individual check this individual out as they knew him

personally and Mr. MATTSON, through information received from the informant, has been eliminated as a suspect in this case.

Reporting officer and Detective Beal obtained all of the vehicles driven by Eileen BLACK, Ron AUTH and Jeff WELLS, Ron AUTH'S roommate. We were unable to locate a Volkswagen in any of these vehicles which match the description in the cases in question. The copies of all of the vehicles will be placed with the original case.

Information was received that a suspect Joseph D. HOY III who lives at [REDACTED] in Murray, drives a Saab, 1973 model, license number [REDACTED] and is a good suspect in this case. This department has been unable to locate a record on Mr. HOY or a drivers license photograph.

Further background on Mr. HOY is being conducted and will be included in the additional reports in this case.

The reporting officer received information from the Salt Lake City Police Department to contact Santa Fe Police Department in Santa Fe New Mexico as they had recovered a female nude body, 17 years of age, 5'1" to 5'2", 101 to 105 pounds.

I called Santa Fe and talked to Detective BACA and he described the deceased to me. I advised him that we would contact or try and locate a telecopier as they had one in their department, to send photographs of Debbie KENT for identification purposes.

Charlie SHEPHERD of the F.B.I. was contacted and consented to allow our department to use their telecopier where copies of Debbie KENT'S photograph were sent to Santa Fe and they in turn sent copies of the deceased with the following description:

Santa Fe City Police and Sheriff's Office investigating a homicide case reported December 2, 1974. WFA, about 17 years of age, 5'1" to 5'2", 105 to 110 pounds, brown-blondish hair, wearing earrings and small wedding type band ring. Abdominal scar above pubic area.

This photograph was compared to Debbie KENT and found and concluded by reporting officer, Detective Beal and Charlie Shepherd of the F.B.I., that this was not in fact Debbie KENT.

The reporting officer was in an interview with Ben FORBES of the Salt Lake County Sheriff's Office and a psychiatrist, Dr. TEDROW, first name unknown, was present. The cases inquestion were outlined to him and he gave the following psychiatric

May possibly have been in prison or in jail. Was jilted by a female in his younger life. Very possibly had retired to the drug scene. Dr. TEDROW was not inclined to believe that it would be by amphetamines but would be something heavier, like the hard narcotics.</p> <p>There was a letter found in the Trade Tech parking lot. This was given to Dr. TEDROW to read and he stated that this individual very possibly could be going to Trade Tech to school.</p> <p>The subject will be in a class or taking classes that require him to be neat and fastidious, such as drafting or something of this nature. Dr. TEDROW stated that the individual would be competitive and compulsive.</p> <p>It is Dr. TEDROW'S opinion that the subject may not be destroying the clothing for evidence purposes, but may be keeping them for later use on masturbation purposes.</p>
